Bird Seeds

- Creighton is 18-24 all-time in season openers.
- The Bluejays are just 10-32 in road openers as a program.
- The Bluejays claimed a win in the opener last season, 79-54 over Wichita State.
- The Bluejays' last on the road to open a season came in 2011-12 as Creighton bested North Dakota, 72-54.
- Creighton is 6-8 in season-openers under **Jim Flanery**, but the Bluejays are 2-7 when opening the season on the road under Flanery.
- Creighton is 2-12 in its first road game of the season under Jim Flanery.
- The Bluejays hold a 6-2 series lead on South Dakota State. Creighton, however, has lost two of the last three meetings with the Jackrabbits. SDSU took a 53-51 contest last season in Omaha. Creighton holds a 3-1 record against South Dakota State in Brookings.
- Creighton leads the overall series with Wichita State, 33-24, but is just 11-16 against the Shockers in Wichita. The last meeting between the two squads in Kansas came in the opening contest of 2014. Wichita won that battle, 65-54.

Building on the Past

With all but one player returning from a squad that capped the 2015-16 season with a spirited run to the BIG EAST Tournament Championship game, expectations are high for the Bluejays entering the 2016-17 season.

"I think it's easy to make a lot of how we closed the season, but it goes back to our team not giving up when we didn't play as well as we could have," said head coach Jim Flanery. "If you don't keep your head up and continue to work towards getting better, you don't have the ability to finish the way we did."

Although Creighton came up just short of completing the four wins in four nights to earn a bid to the NCAA Tournament, the Bluejays did secure an invite to the NIT to extend its consecutive streak of postseason appearances to nine.

"I'm equally as proud of the way we kept practicing and believing in one another throughout the season, as I am in how we finished," said Flanery.

Not only do the Bluejays bring back all five starters from last season, as well as 13 letterwinners, the Bluejays also welcome back the 2014 BIG EAST Player of the Year, **Marissa Janning**.

In addition, senior **Brianna Rollerson** has fully recovered from the Jones fracture that limited her to 155 minutes last season and top-100 recruit **Jaylyn Agnew**, who redshirted last season, will be woven into the rotation.

"In one season we went from a very young team, starting three sophomores and a freshman, to a veteran group," noted Flanery. "The return of Janning and Rollerson gives us two fifth-year seniors to a group that gained tremendous experience."

Sidelined after six games last season by a broken left fibula, Janning received a medical redshirt and is primed to end her Bluejay career with another NCAA Tournament run.

"Coming back this season gives me a chance to finish my collegiate career on my terms," said Janning. "We have the potential to be a very special group and I'm very excited to a part of that."

The Bluejays' leading scorer for each of her first three seasons, Janning enters her senior campaign with a chance to become just the fourth player in Creighton history to score 2,000 points in her career. Janning's return adds another weapon to Creighton's arsenal, but several Bluejays spread their wings last season.

MC McGrory directed the Bluejays' run to the BIG EAST Tournament Final, earning a spot on the All-Tournament Team as she averaged 17.3 points and 6.3 rebounds during those four contests.

Sophomore **Audrey Faber** produced an outstanding freshman season, leading Creighton with 462 points (13.2 ppg). Her efforts were rewarded with a spot on the 2015-16 All-BIG EAST Freshman Team as well as All-BIG EAST Honorable Mention.

"Basketball is rarely a linear path to improvement," said Flanery. "It took our players a little time to adjust to the increased roles following injuries to [Janning] and [Rollerson], but that improvement set the stage for our finish."

Floaters

The game of basketball lends itself to labeling players in the traditional roles of point guards, shooting guards, small forwards, power forwards and centers. This is far from the case for the Bluejays. About a third of the Bluejay roster typically play multiple positions during the season and Flanery believes that is to the benefit of his team.

"We pride ourselves on teaching the game of basketball as a whole," said Flanery. "Sometimes that takes longer for younger players, but it makes us more versatile and helps the team be comfortable with multiple situations. We try to teach the how and the why as opposed to simply the what."

The result is a group of players that float from position to position. A few examples from last year saw the Bluejays use Faber in the post

with four guards. Another put junior **Sydney Lamberty** in a point-forward role, with two shooters and two posts.

During their four years at Creighton, Janning, McGrory and senior **Lauren Works** have all served as point guard, shooting guard or even at the small forward. Additionally Lamberty has played one through four and Faber has slid from three to five.

Expect Agnew to join the group of Faber, Janning, Lamberty, McGrory and Works that float between rolls.

"It makes us somewhat unique that we are not married to positions, we want players to be well rounded," said Flanery. "That makes us harder to prepare for as we are less traditional. In addition, our flexibility helps our players prepare for the wide range of systems in the BIG EAST."

Guards

Junior **Jade Owens** flourished as the starting point guard in 2015-16, leading the Bluejays with 121 assists. In addition to directing the offense, Owens proved to be a tremendous rebounder as the she finished tied for the team lead with 170 rebounds, despite standing just 5'6".

In addition to Owens, Janning, McGrory and sophomore **Olivia Elger** will see action in the traditional point guard position.

Juniors **Myah Mellman** and **Aimee Rischard** provide sharpshooting options off the bench to bolster a potent three-point attack for Creighton.

Posts

The return of Rollerson in the block adds another low post presence to the Bluejay offense. Like Owens, junior **Bailey Norby** flourished in the starting role last season. Norby was not only able to bang down low, but she stretched opposing defenses with her mid-range shot, even knocking down five trifectas.

Junior **Kylie Brown** and sophomore **Ali Greene** provided strong minutes off the bench last season, giving Flanery tremendous depth.

Putting the Team First

While the depth of the Bluejays is expected to be a strength, Flanery knows that he needs his entire team on the same page to meet or even exceed the lofty expectations.

"I'd like to think we are mature enough to realize how many good players we have," said Flanery. "That will allow us to hold each other to higher standards not just in games, but in practice as well."

Head Coach Jim Flanery

Entering his 15th season as the Creighton head coach and his 25th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (269 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the post-season 12 times, including each of the past nine seasons. He recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays third season in the BIG EAST (2015-16) saw Creighton fight through a season-ending injury to Marissa Janning and make a run to the BIG EAST Tournament Final. The Bluejays closed the season with a 17-18 mark and an 8-10 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive postseason appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

Bluejays Add Three for 2017-18

The Creighton women's basketball team announced the signing of Temi Carda, Gracey Griglione and Tatum Rembao for the 2017-18 season on Wednesday, Nov. 9.

"The thing that we like about this class is how competitive all three are," said head coach Jim Flanery. "We are very pleased with this trio and feel they will fit in nicely with our returning core."

Continuing a long line of talent from Minnesota, Carda is a 5-9 guard from Lakeville, Minn. Temi enters her senior season at Lakeville North HS having already claimed two All-State selections, four All-South Suburban Conference selections and is a four-time All-Metro recipient. A member of the Lakeville North varsity since her eighth grade season, Carda enters her senior campaign with over 1,200 points, 300 rebounds and just under 200 assists.

"Temi may be one of the best defensive players we have ever recruited," said Flanery. "She was a multisport athlete in high school, who will continue to improve as she focuses on basketball."

Griglione is a 6-2 forward from Truro, Iowa, where she stars for Interstate 35 HS. Gracey earned a spot on the varsity squad as an eighth grader, she went on to earn an All-State selection following her freshman, sophomore and junior seasons. Griglione has raised her scoring average each season, posting 13.7 as a freshman, 19.3 as a sophomore and 19.7 last season. She set the Iowa State record for blocks as a freshman with 140 and went on to set Interstate 35 records for blocks in a game (11), rebounds in a game (18), points in a game (40), points in a season (464) and rebounds in a season (262).

"Gracey is a skilled big, that doesn't mind getting physical," noted Flanery. "The ability to go down low is becoming rare. She can also play away from the basket. She has played for a talented club program and understands how to work hard to improve."

The Bluejays' final addition is also a 5-9 guard, Rembao comes to Omaha from Loveland, Colo. Projected as a combo guard at Creighton, Rembao enters her senior season with 1,290 points over three years at Loveland HS. She tallied a school record 606 points last season, including 39 against Fruita Monument (12/11/15). She set the LHS record with 24.1 points per game last season and has averaged 17.9 ppg over her high school career. A three-time All-Front Range League selection, Rembao has earned two All-State honors. She was named the All Around Athlete (Big School) 2016 Colorado Sportswoman of the year and was the Coloradoan Northern Colorado Sports Awards Female Athlete of the year.

"Tatum is an explosive, competitive kid, that has the ability to play off the ball," said Flanery. "Similar to Temi, she has been a talented multisport athlete, who will make a significant jump."

Exhibition Recap: Creighton 90, Fort Hays State 56

Faber and 31 assists as a team, the Creighton women's basketball team posted a 90-56 win in the Bluejays lone exhibition game on Thursday, Nov. 3

Bursts to begin the first and third periods set the tone for the evening as Creighton raced out to a 15-2 lead in the opening six minutes and opened the second half with a 20-4 run.

Faber notched seven points in the opening burst, while returning senior Marissa Janning has four points and three assists during the initial stretch. Creighton closed the first period up 26-13 and took a 40-28 lead into halftime.

The Bluejays' second half surge was ignited by four treys, two each by Faber and junior Sydney Lamberty. With 4:48 remaining in the third quarter Creighton extended its lead to 62-32 and never looked back.

Faber's 25 points led all scorers, while Janning finished with a 15 points and 13 assists.

Fort Hays State got a team-high 10 points from Iill Faxon.

Starting with an Easy One, Not Under Flan

Known for his penchant to play a tough schedule, Jim Flanery has made a habit recently of opening the season against an NCAA Tournament team. Including 2016-17 (South Dakota State), the Bluejays have battled NCAA Tournament teams to open the past four seasons - Oklahoma (2012-13) and Wichita State (2014-15 & 2015-16). Thus far the Bluejays are 1-2 in those battles.

Bluejays Split Against Valley Since Joining BIG EAST

Entering their four season as members of the BIG EAST Conference the Bluejays have a small sample against the former rivals from the Missouri Valley Conference. In seven contests Creighton is 4-3 overall and 1-3 in road contest against its former conference foes.

The Bluejays are 0-2 at Drake (62-55 on 11/9/13 & 81-72 on 11/24/15) and 0-1 at Wichita State (65-56 on 11/15/14). Creighton earned a victory at Northern Iowa (58-56 on 12/8/14) and holds home wins over the Panthers (69-61 pm 12/22/15) and over the Shockers (79-54 on 11/13/15) as well as a home win over Drake (93-71 on 12/14/14).
