Creighton leads series with Missouri, 8-7  
 Creighton has never played Georgia Tech or Dayton



### Bird Seeds

- The last time that Creighton and Missouri met was in the 2014 WNIT as the Bluejays ended Missouri's season with a 77-51 win over the Tigers in Omaha.
- Missouri and Creighton are tied by current Tiger Athletic Trainer Alison Mosel, who served with the Bluejays' women's basketball team for two seasons prior to moving into the same role at Missouri during the summer of 2012.
- Both Dayton and Missouri were in action on Tuesday, Nov. 22 as the Flyers dropped a 98-65 to No. 2 Connecticut, while Missouri bested Indiana State, 77-48.
- Regardless of Friday's outcome, the Bluejays will face a new opponent as Creighton has not faced both Georgia Tech or Dayton.
- The quartet of teams in the Bluejays' bracket enter action on Friday with a combined record of 10-5.
- Although the two brackets will not face one another, the other side of the bracket in the Bahamas are Georgia, Minnesota, North Carolina and South Florida.
- Junior Myah Mellman delivered a career night to lift Creighton to its first win of the season, scoring a career-high 18 points against Bluejay rival Drake on Nov. 17.
- The Bluejays will be wrapping up one of the tougher portions of its schedule in the Bahamas this weekend as Creighton opened the season with four of its first first games away from home.

## Bluejay Bird Feeder - 2016-17

### #2 Myah Mellman - Jr. - G

After not playing in the first two games, Mellman showed the importance of being prepared as she drained her first five treys against Drake on Nov. 17. Myah went on to notch a career-high 18 points in the victory.

### #3 MC McGrory - Sr. - G

Considered the Bluejays' stabilizing force, MC went to the line 13 times in the first two contests. Averaging 8.0 ppg, she was 2-for-7 against Drake.

### #5 Jaylyn Agnew - Fr. - G

The Bluejays' lone freshman (albeit a redshirt freshman) Jaylyn has been a nice surprise off the bench, she is 3-of-7 from the field and has grabbed four steals.

### #12 Lauren Works - Sr. - G

Coming off the bench for the first time this season, Works appeared more comfortable as she reached double-figures for the first time with 10 points in the win over Drake.

### #23 Marissa Janning - Sr. - G

Marissa was just one rebound away from recording the first triple-double by a Bluejay since 2004 as she finished with 11 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds against Drake.

### #40 Ali Greene - So. - F

Ali was a spark off the bench for the Bluejays against the Jackrabbits, scoring seven points and grabbing six rebounds.

### #50 Brianna Rollerson - Sr. - F

Brianna recorded her ninth career double-double, and second in as many games, against Drake with 14 points and 12 rebounds on Nov. 17. Rollerson's biggest play, however, was a block of Drake's Lizzy Wendell in the closing moments of the game to preserve Creighton's victory.

**Head Coach Jim Flanery**

Entering his 15th season as the Creighton head coach and his 25th consecutive year on the Bluejay bench, Jim Flanery led the Bluejays to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history (2012 & 2013), is the all-time victory leader for Creighton (269 and counting) and led the Bluejays into the BIG EAST Conference in 2013-14.

Flanery has guided the Bluejays to the post-season 12 times, including each of the past nine seasons. He recorded eight 20-win seasons, captured two Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships (2003 & 2013), an MVC Tournament Championship (2012) and brought Creighton to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship game four times. In addition, Creighton has made two appearances in the WNIT Final Four capturing the 2004 WNIT championship.

The Bluejays third season in the BIG EAST (2015-16) saw Creighton fight through a season-ending injury to Marissa Janning and make a run to the BIG EAST Tournament Final. The Bluejays closed the season with a 17-18 mark and an 8-10 record in conference action. The Bluejays secured their eighth consecutive post-season appearance, reaching the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

**Creighton vs. Missouri:**

Missouri and Creighton have met 15 times, with the Bluejays holding a slim 8-7 edge. The last meeting came in Omaha in the opening round of the WNIT in 2014. Creighton advanced with a 77-51 win.

The Bluejays and the Tigers met one other time in a tournament setting as Missouri defeated the Bluejays, 70-66, in the State Farm Tiger Classic in Columbia, Mo during the 2005-06 season.

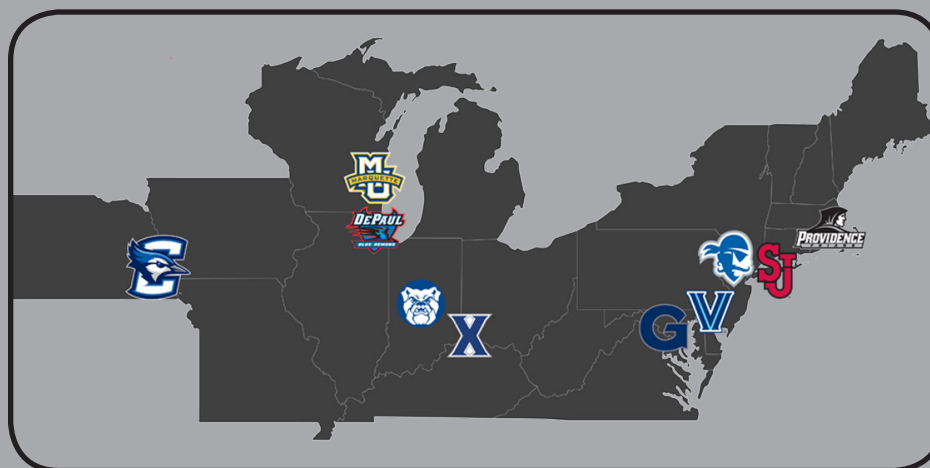

#### **Creighton 80, Drake 77**

Omaha, Neb. -- Led by 18 points off the bench by junior Myah Mellman, the Creighton women's basketball team earned its first victory of the season, 80-77 over Drake.

After an 18-18 first period, Drake opened the second with five straight to edge in front 23-18, Creighton countered with an 8-2 run on treys from junior Sydney Lamberty and Janning that surrounded a layup from Rollerson. The game remained within one bucket for much of the second quarter. Up 40-39 the Bluejays pushed ahead 43-39 with a three-pointer from senior MC McGrory and took a 45-42 lead into halftime.

McGrory started the scoring once again in the third period with another trey to push Creighton out to a 48-42 edge. Following a defensive stop, sophomore Audrey Faber joined the long distance plan with the Bluejays' 11th three-pointer of the game to make it 51-42. The Bluejays pushed ahead by as much as 11 (60-49 with 3:59 left), but a late Bulldog surge sent the game to the fourth with the Bluejays clinging to a 65-60 advantage.

The two teams traded blows throughout the final period. Holding a 75-69 lead with 5:55 remaining, Creighton watched as the Bulldogs rattled off eight straight to seize the lead at 77-75 with 2:56 left. The Bluejays' seniors, however, refused to be denied. Lauren works pulled her group even with a driving layup from the left corner, earning a three-point opportunity with a foul. Works knocked down the shot from the charity stripe to put Creighton back up one (78-77) with 1:22 left in the contest.

Creighton defense stiffened to deny Drake on three consecutive chances, but were unable to create any separation on offense. With just 5.9 seconds left, the Bulldogs held possession and used their final timeout. When play resumed Drake turned to scoring leader Lizzy Wendell, but Lamberty forced Wendell to her weak side (her right) and Rollerson came over to block the game-winning attempt. Janning picked up the rebound, then nailed two free throws with 0.1 seconds left to seal the Bluejays' win.

Mellman led Creighton with a career-high 18 points on 6-of-7 from beyond the arc. Rollerson posted her second straight double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds. Faber finished with 12 points, while Janning was just one assist from a triple-double with 11 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists.

Drake got 20 points from Caitlin Ingle, while Wendell contributed 19 points in the loss.

### Bluejays Add Three for 2017-18

The Creighton women's basketball team announced the signing of Temi Carda, Gracey Griglione and Tatum Rembao for the 2017-18 season on Wednesday, Nov. 9.

"The thing that we like about this class is how competitive all three are," said head coach Jim Flanery. "We are very pleased with this trio and feel they will fit in nicely with our returning core."

Continuing a long line of talent from Minnesota, Carda is a 5-9 guard from Lakeville, Minn. Temi enters her senior season at Lakeville North HS having already claimed two All-State selections, four All-South Suburban Conference selections and is a four-time All-Metro recipient. A member of the Lakeville North varsity since her eighth grade season, Carda enters her senior campaign with over 1,200 points, 300 rebounds and just under 200 assists.

"Temi may be one of the best defensive players we have ever recruited," said Flanery. "She was a multisport athlete in high school, who will continue to improve as she focuses on basketball."

Griglione is a 6-2 forward from Truro, Iowa, where she stars for Interstate 35 HS. Gracey earned a spot on the varsity squad as an eighth grader, she went on to earn an All-State selection following her freshman, sophomore and junior seasons. Griglione has raised her scoring average each season, posting 13.7 as a freshman, 19.3 as a sophomore and 19.7 last season. She set the Iowa State record for blocks as a freshman with 140 and went on to set Interstate 35 records for blocks in a game (11), rebounds in a game (18), points in a game (40), points in a season (464) and rebounds in a season (262).

"Gracey is a skilled big, that doesn't mind getting physical," noted Flanery. "The ability to go down low is becoming rare. She can also play away from the basket. She has played for a talented club program and understands how to work hard to improve."

The Bluejays' final addition is also a 5-9 guard, Rembao comes to Omaha from Loveland, Colo. Projected as a combo guard at Creighton, Rembao enters her senior season with 1,290 points over three years at Loveland HS. She tallied a school record 606 points last season, including 39 against Fruita Monument (12/11/15). She set the LHS record with 24.1 points per game last season and has averaged 17.9 ppg over her high school career. A three-time All-Front Range League selection, Rembao has earned two All-State honors. She was named the All Around Athlete (Big School) 2016 Colorado Sportswoman of the year and was the Coloradoan Northern Colorado Sports Awards Female Athlete of the year.

"Tatum is an explosive, competitive kid, that has the ability to play off the ball," said Flanery. "Similar to Temi, she has been a talented multisport athlete, who will make a significant jump."

### Rollerson's Block Seals the Deal

Senior Brianna Rollerson entered the fourth quarter with Drake on Nov. 17 with 74 career blocks. Her 75th was the biggest of her career as Rollerson blocked a four-footer by Bulldog Lizzy Wendell with under one second remaining in the Bluejays' 80-77 victory.

### Janning Just Missed A Chance at History

It's been over 12 years since a Bluejay posted a triple-double, but Marissa Janning came closer than anyone every has. Janning finished with 11 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists in the Bluejays' win over Drake.

The last triple-double in Bluejay history came in 2004 as Laura Spanheimer notched 12 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists in the Bluejays' 87-69 win over Indiana State on Jan. 8.
