Series History

DePaul leads series, 3-0-0

Having met in each of the last three seasons as members of the BIG EAST, the Blue Demos have consistently gotten the better of the Bluejays. DePaul took the first meeting between the two squads in overtime (2-1) at Morrison Stadium on Oct. 12, 2013. Since then Creighton has been shutout over the last two matchups, 2-0 (Oct. 11, 2014) and 4-0 last season on Oct. 1. It has been just under 263 minutes (262:44) since the Bluejays last goal against DePaul.

Scouting DePaul (4-4-2, 1-0-0 BIG EAST)

DePaul stumbled out of the gate this season as the Blue Demons went 1-4-2 in their opening seven contests. Since then DePaul has found its rhythm, outscoring the opposition 12-2 during the current three-match winning streak.

Three different Blue Demons sit atop their leader board with five goals, Ana Greik, Franny Cerny and Abby Reed. Cerny delivered four goals and one assist during the previous two matches to claim the BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week.

DePaul opened BIG EAST play in impressive fashion as the Blue Demons routed Xavier, 5-0 on Sunday, including three goals by Cerny.

Beyond the shut out of Xavier, the Blue Demons defense allowed just five shots to the Musketeers. A mere two shots came from Xavier in the second half, despite DePaul holding a 2-0 lead.

"DePaul is a very organized and attacking minded team offensively," said Creighton head coach Ross Paule. "They are equally talented on the defensive side, but we will create scoring chances and we simply have to convert."

Bluejays open BIG EAST play with Victory for First Time

In each of their four seasons as members of the BIG EAST Conference, the Bluejays have kicked off conference action against Marquette. For the first time, however, Creighton will enter game number two with a 1-0-0 record. The Bluejays have finished each of their three seasons as members of the BIG EAST with two victories, Thursday will offer a chance to equal that win total.

Sullivan's Golden Goal Stuns Marquette in Double Overtime

Trailing 2-0 early in the second period senior Lauren Sullivan breathed new life into her squad with an unassisted goal, then delivered the knockout blow in double overtime with a golden goal in the 108th minute.

The match didn't get off to the start that head coach Ross Paule wanted as the Golden Eagles jumped out to a 2-0 lead with goals in the 23rd and 25th minutes.

Down 2-0, the Bluejays looked to their leader for a boost. With just over ten minutes remaining, Sullivan responded. Taking a pass from junior Gabriela Braga on the Creighton side of midfield, Sullivan split three defenders to the top of the box. After slipping past another Golden Eagle at the top of the box, Sullivan beat Marquette's Maddy Henry to make it 2-1.

Sullivan's goal sent the Bluejays into the half with the momentum. The close of the half gave Creighton the confidence to return as the aggressor in the second half. The Bluejays controlled possession early in the second period, earning the equalizer in the 79th minute.

Freshmen Taryn Jakubowski put the play in motion, beating her defender along the right side of the pitch just outside the box. The Illinois native centered a pass to fellow freshman Ashleigh Cearlock, who blasted home her first goal of the season from 12 yards out.

The first extra period saw both teams create chances as Creighton sent shots on frame in the 93rd and 98th minutes only to have Henry make the saves. Marquette, meanwhile, forced consecutive corners in the final minute only to have a header saved by Meola.

In the second overtime the Golden Eagles created a corner kick in the second minute, but were unable to get off a shot.

The decisive play of the match saw Sullivan send a pass from the top of the box out to wide on the right side to sophomore Kaira Houser. After corralling the ball just before it went out, Houser sent it back towards the junior Darby Hugunin, who tapped it back for Sullivan to send the Bluejays into celebration from 12 yards out.

Sullivan's Goal Came Late, but Not Latest

The golden goal in double overtime by Lauren Sullivan came with under three minutes remaining until the match was declared a draw, but it wasn't the latest goal to give the Bluejays a victory.

Sullivan's goal came at 107:32, while in 2011 Kelly Connolly gave the Bluejays a 1-0 win over South Dakota in the 109th minute (108:13) on Sept. 4.

The NCAA adopted the golden goal format prior to the 1999 season.

Speaking of Golden Goals

Sullivan also knocked in a golden goal during the 2014 season, defeating Nebraska-Omaha on Sept. 21. She is one of just three players with more than one golden goal. The others are Regina Moench and Lulu Quigley.

Sullivan Up Fifth in Goals

Sullivan's two goals against the Golden Eagles moved her into a tie for fifth in Creighton history. Sullivan finished 2015 with 10 goals and already has seven goals this season.

Cearlock Claims Another BIG EAST Freshman of the Week for Bluejays

For the third time in 2016 a different Bluejay claimed the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor as Ashleigh Cearlock nabbed the honor on Sept. 26 to join McKenzie Meola (Sept. 4) and Taryn Jakubowski (Sept. 19).

Cearlock earned the award with her game-tying goal against Marquette one day earlier. The Creighton rookie took a pass from Jakubowski before putting it home from 12 yards out.

Sullivan's Five Point Effort, the First By A Bluejay Since 2014

Sullivan closed the match against Yale with five points on two goals and one assist. It marked the first time since 2014 that one Bluejay accounted for at least five points. The last player to notch five points in a contest was Alyssa Jara (2G/1A) against New Mexico State on Sept. 5, 2014.

Sullivan Stymied by Power Outage

Senior Lauren Sullivan got the Bluejays out to a 1-0 lead with a goal in the fifth minute, but the lights went out in Kingston in the 20th minute of play. Shortly thereafter a transformer exploded, ending the match for the night.

Initially rescheduled for Friday, the two teams were unable to agree on a start time forcing the cancellation.

Jakubowski Claims BIG EAST Freshman of the Week

Bluejay freshman Taryn Jakubowski became the second Creighton women's soccer player this season to nab the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Monday, Sept. 19.

Jakubowski totaled three points off a goal and assist at Yale on Sunday afternoon. The rookie scored the game's first goal just six minutes into the contest before dishing to Jaylin Bosak for the game-sealing score in the 61st minute as the Bluejays earned a 4-2 victory.

Bluejays' Play Opening Eyes and Bringing in Fans

Creighton's success this season combined with a doubleheader with the men's squad, yielded 1,444 fans in attendance to watch Creighton's 2-1 win over South Dakota on Sept. 9. That number ranks as the third largest home crowd in Bluejay history.

The largest crowd came on Sept. 20, 2013 as Creighton bested Nebraska-Omaha, 3-2.

Meola Earns BIG EAST Freshman of the Week

Goalkeeper McKenzie Meola nabbed the first BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor on Monday, Sept. 4.

Making just her second and third appearances in a Creighton uniform, Meola played all 200 minutes of Creighton's 1-0-1 week, making six saves and posting a .750 save percentage. Meola made four stops against Kansas State in a 1-1 draw before denying two shots in a 2-1 victory at South Dakota State on Sunday. McKenzie moved her record on the season to 2-0-1.

Baby Birds Spreading Their Wings

The Bluejays have already seen 12 of 15 newcomers make their Creighton debut this season.

Maybe more impressive 10 newcomers earned their first start in the opening four matches.

The three newcomers that have yet to see the pitch are Haylee Blach, Elizabeth Bolland (GK), Cassie Legband. Each are expected to redshirt the 2016 season.

And Taking Flight

The freshmen are doing much more than simply seeing time and earning starts for Creighton, the Bluejays' second through sixth leading scorers are freshmen. Entering the match with DePaul, freshmen have accounted for 35 of the Bluejays' 60 points.

Taryn Jakubowski leads the baby birds (second on the team) with nine points. Caeley Lordemann (8), Jaylin Bosak (7), Callie Hawkins (4), and Hannah Miller (4) follow in third to sixth.

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Five Goals

Creighton kicked off 2016 in historic fashion, scoring five goals to best Iowa 5-3. It was just the second time in school history the Bluejays scored five or more goals in the first match of the season, the last time coming in 1998 (a 5-0 win over Huron).

The five goals were the most scored under Paule and the first time the Bluejays have sent that many into the back of the net since a 6-0 win over New Mexico State on Sept. 5, 2014.

Speaking of the 90s

While the five goals took the WABAC (Wayback) machine to 1998, freshman Callie Hawkins pressed a little deeper.

With two goals in her Creighton debut, Hawkins became the first Bluejay to post a multi-goal game out of the gate since Kristina Schoeck did so in 1996. Other Bluejays to tally two goals in their first game (as a freshman) were Kalan Malone (1993) and Allison Dunham (1990).

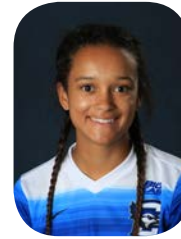

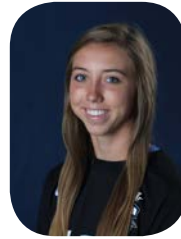
