Lining Up for the Tip

- Creighton and South Dakota have faced off in seven of the past eight seasons. The only omission coming during the 2016-17 campaign.
- The Bluejays hold a slim 12-11 lead on the Coyotes, but have claimed nine of 12 meetings in Omaha.
- South Dakota, however, has claimed four of the last six meetings. Eliminating the Bluejays from the WNIT in both 2015 and 2016.
- Creighton is 19-25 all-time in season openers.
- The Bluejays are 7-9 in season-openers under Jim Flanery.
- The Bluejays are 5-1 when opening the season at home under Flanery.
- Creighton is looking to reach three consecutive NCAA Tournaments for the first time in program history.
- Both the Bluejays and Coyotes have impressive postseason streaks. South Dakota has been to the postseason in each of the last eight season, while the Bluejays have reached the postseason in 11 consecutive seasons.
- Wednesday is the first of four five games for the Coyotes against teams from the Omaha area. South Dakota faces Creighton and UNO on the road, while hosting College of Saint Mary, Bellevue and UNO this season.
- Three players on the South Dakota roster come from Nebraska. Sisters Allison and Monica Arens are from Crofton, while Regan Sankey is from Lincoln.
- Creighton was picked to finish fourth in the 2018-19 BIG EAST Preseason Poll, while South Dakota was slated to finish second in the Summit League's Preseason predictions.

About South Dakota

- Located in Vermilion, South Dakota.
- The Coyotes finished 2017-18 with a 29-7 record and a 14-0 mark in the Summit League. South Dakota, however, was upset in the Summit League Championship final and closed its season in the WNIT.
- South Dakota returns three starters from last season and nine letterwinners.

South Dakota Head Coach: Dawn Plitzuweit, 3rd Season (Michigan Tech, 1995)

- Plitzuweit has a career record of 240-109 in 11 seasons, including a 52-16 mark at South Dakota.
- She guided the Coyotes to consecutive WNIT appearances in her two seasons, leading South Dakota to the WNIT quarterfinals last year.

Scouting South Dakota (0-0)

The Coyotes return starters Ciara Duffy, Allison Arens and Madison McKeever. All three were named to the Summit League preseason squad, highlighted by First Team honors for Duffy and Arens. The trio combined to average 32.4 ppg and 12.5 rpg.

South Dakota is typically a team that likes to shoot the three, hitting 325 from long range last season. The Coyotes are also a team that gets to the foul line (430 free throws made in 36 games last season).

Scouting Creighton (0-0)

Creighton lost three starters from a squad that reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament in consecutive seasons. The largest loss from Creighton's 2017-18 team was point guard Sydney Lamberty, who played a team-high 1,230 minutes. Although Lamberty was the glue for the Bluejays, Creighton returns five of their top six scorers from last season.

Senior Audrey Faber and junior Jaylyn Agnew will lead the way for the Bluejays. Faber enters her senior season with 1,348 points, leading Creighton in scoring in the last three seasons. Agnew was a unanimous All-BIG EAST preseason selection, delivering 464 points last season.

Faber Looks to Climb the Bluejay Scoring Ranks in 2018-19

After joining Creighton's 1,000 point club last season, senior Audrey Faber is expected to climb that Bluejay ladder throughout the 2018-19 campaign. Entering the season opener she needs 13 points to move into 13th place.

Bluejays over 1,000 Points
