### #2 Tatum Rembao - Jr. - G

Tatum came up just one rebound short of the first triple-double for a Bluejay since 2004, finishing with 19 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds in the Bluejays' 82-75 win over #23 West Virginia on Nov. 28th.

### #3 Dee Dee Pryor - Fr. - G

Dee Dee knocked down two free throws in Creighton's 69-59 win over Temple on Nov. 29th.

### #4 Temi Carda - Jr. - G

Temi led Creighton with 17 points in the win over the Owls on Nov. 29th, giving Creighton a 2-0 mark in the Cancun Challenge.

### #5 Jaylyn Agnew - Sr. - F

Agnew collected back-to-back BIG EAST Player of the Week honors, scoring a career-high 34 in the Bluejays' 82-75 win over #23 West Virginia on Nov. 28th.

### #12 Gracey Griglione - So. - F

Griglione finished with seven points on 3-of-6 from the field against Temple on Nov. 29th.

### About South Dakota

- Located in Vermilion, South Dakota.
- The Coyotes finished 2018-19 with a 28-6 record and a 14-2 mark in the Summit League. South Dakota reached the Summit League Championship final and closed its season in the NCAA Tournament
- South Dakota returns four starters from last season and 11 letter winners.
- Head coach Dawn Plitzuweit is 275-116 in 13th seasons and 87-23 in her fourth season at the helm of South Dakota.

### Scouting South Dakota (7-1)

South Dakota is off to a hot start as the Coyotes lone loss came to #22 Missouri State on Nov. 25. South Dakota is coming off a pair of win over Ohio State and Northern Illinois in the South Point Thanksgiving Shootout.

Four Coyotes are averaging double-digits this season, led by 17.6 ppg and 6.5 rpg from senior Ciara Duffy. South Dakota is a team that likes to shoot the three, shooting 41.5 percent from long range this season. The Coyotes also are a team that gets to the foul line a bunch (making a 110-of-145, 75.9 percent, this season).

### Scouting Creighton (6-1)

The Bluejays are riding a four game win streak including victories over instate rival Nebraska 79-74 and an 82-75 win over #23 West Virginia at the Cancun Challenge on Nov. 28 to start the season 6-1. The Bluejays only loss came in the hands of Drake on Nov. 16.

Creighton's hot start has come behind the efforts of the veterans. Four starters are averaging in double-digits with senior Jaylyn Agnew leading the way with 20 ppg and 6.7 rpg while playing 37.9 minutes a game.

The Bluejays have turned to their defense early on this season forcing teams into 14 turnovers per game, which transitions to their offense as Creighton is shooting 35.8 percent (69-of-193) from behind the arc

### Bluejays' Hot Start Has Gained Some National Attention

Off to a 6-1 start, including wins over South Dakota State, Nebraska and #23 West Virginia, the Bluejays gained a measure of national attention during the first week of December as the Bluejays are receiving votes in both the AP and *USA Today*/Coaches Polls, released Dec. 2nd and 3rd respectively.

### Bluejays Have Taken First Three Quarters From Summit League

Four of Creighton's non-conference opponents during the 2019-20 season are from the Summit League. The Bluejays defeated Nebraska-Omaha 67-54 to open the season, then bested South Dakota State 61-48 in the second game of the year. Creighton's third victory came on Nov. 18, an 80-59 over North Dakota State. The final game against a Summit League team comes on Wednesday at South Dakota.

### Agnew Hauled in National Jesuit Player of the Week, An All-Tournament Selection and her Second Straight BIG EAST Player of the Week After Her 34-Point Performance against #23 West Virginia

Coming off back-to-back 20+ point games against North Dakota State (25 points on Nov. 18th) and Nebraska (26 points on Nov. 24th), Agnew took her game to another level with a career-high 34 points to push the Bluejays past #23 West Virginia in the opening game for each squad at the Cancun Challenge on Nov. 28th. Jaylyn followed her efforts against the Mountaineers with 15 points in the Bluejays' 69-59 win over Temple on Nov. 29th.

Agnew's efforts led her to be named the National Jesuit Basketball Player of the Week on Dec. 3rd. Agnew also earned her second straight BIG EAST Player of the Week award on Dec. 2nd and was named to the Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team.

### Bluejays Have a Bright History in Cancun

Head Coach Jim Flanery secured another pair of win to move to 4-0 all-time in Cancun. The Bluejays upset No. 23 West Virginia 82-75 on Nov. 28 before downing Temple 69-59 on Nov. 29.

The Bluejay squad went to Cancun once before, competing in the Caribbean Challenge in the final month of 2012. The Bluejays participated in a four-team tournament, defeating Miami (OH) 66-57 in the opening game on Dec. 21, then besting South Florida (RV) 91-74 on Dec. 22. During the win over the Bulls, the Bluejays equaled a then program-record with 16 treys. Creighton did not face the fourth team, Nevada, in the tournament but as the lone undefeated squad the Bluejays captured the tournament championship.

### Rembao Was This Close

It's been over 14 years since a Bluejay posted a triple-double, but Tatum Rembao came so close. Rembao finished with 19 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds in the Bluejays' win over No. 23 West Virginia on Nov. 28 in the Cancun Challenge.

The last triple-double in Bluejay history came in 2004 as Laura Spanheimer notched 12 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists in the Bluejays' 87-69 win over Indiana State on Jan. 8.

Senior Jaylyn Agnew and junior Tatum Rembao combined for 47 points (25 by Agnew and 22 from Rembao) in Creighton's 70-59 win over North Dakota State on Nov. 18th. It was the first time a pair of Bluejays posted at least 20 points in one game since Audrey Faber (30) and Olivia Elger (20) did so against #13 Florida State on Dec. 21, 2017, a span of 57 games.

**Three Have Eclipsed 20, Four on the Roster**

In the first four games of the 2019-20 season, three different Bluejays have topped the 20-point plateau. Agnew and Rembao did so against North Dakota State, while junior Temi Carda finished with 25 in Creighton's victory over UNO on Nov. 5th. The other Bluejay to top the 20-point mark is senior Olivia Elger, who did so against South Dakota State on Dec. 15, 2017 and in the following game versus #13 Florida State on Dec. 21, 2017.

**Dworak Proving Her Worth Off the Bench**

Over her first 21 games as a Bluejay, sophomore Chloe Dworak delivered 36 points and saw 158 minutes of action. In four games this season the Lincoln native has 21 points and is shooting a blistering 70% (7-of-10) from the field.

**The Creighton Way - Every Player Since 2010-11 Has Graduated as a Bluejay**

Since the 2010-11 season, every player to enter the Creighton women's basketball family has not only played the remainder of their career with the Bluejays, but they have also graduated from Creighton. The current string is 37 consecutive players including seniors Jaylyn Agnew and Olivia Elger, who earned their bachelor's degree last year and are currently working towards master degrees.

**Road Win at UNO Boosts Bluejays' Record in Season Openers**

Following the 67-54 win at UNO on Nov. 5th, Creighton is 20-26 all-time in season openers, including an 8-10 mark under Jim Flanery. In home opening contests, such as the one on Nov. 12th against the Jackrabbits, the Bluejays are 32-14 and 13-5 under Flanery.



### Bluejays Sign Five for 2020-21

Creighton women's basketball head coach Jim Flanery announced the signing of Mallory Brake, Jayme Horan, Morgan Maly, Molly Mogensen and Emma Ronsiek on Wednesday, Nov. 13th as each individual signed their National Letter of Intent (NLI) to become Bluejays in 2020-21.

"This is a tall, physical class that will help us continue to compete in the BIG EAST, their size and physicality will let us do things defensively," said Flanery. "The length of this incoming class will make us a much better rebounding team."

Brake comes to Creighton from Hastings, Minnesota. The 6-0 forward is currently a senior at Hastings High School and plays for the North Tartan AAU team. She averaged 20.2 ppg, 12.8 rpg, and 2.4 bpg during her junior season, while obtaining All-AAAA Section 3 Conference for the fourth straight years. Brake currently holds school records for assist, steals and block, while scoring over 1,000 points in her career.

"Mallory is a really good athlete. She is a post player that can run the floor, block shots and rebound," said Flanery. "She has a high motor, good basketball intelligence and defensively can make a impact right away."

A 5-10 guard from Omaha, Nebraska, Horan is a senior at Millard South High School and played for the Nebraska Attack AAU squad. She has scored over 1,000 point, while averaging 23.1 ppg., 7.9 rpg. and 2.5 spg. during her junior season. Jayme collected First Team All-State honors during her sophomore and junior seasons, while also being named to the All-Nebraska Team last season. Horan's efforts led to being named the 2018-19 Nebraska Gatorade Player of the Year.

"Jayme is an efficient shooter that can score. A physical wing player, that defensively will contribute from the beginning," said Flanery. "She makes dirty work plays, drawing charges and diving on the floor, but is also skilled wing player."

Maly is a 6-1 guard from Crete, Nebraska and currently a senior at Crete High School and played for the Nebraska Lasers AAU team. She is a 1,000 point scorer as she averaged 20.1 ppg. on 61 percent shooting and collected 8.6 rpg, during her junior season. Morgan's talent led to her being named a First Team All-State and All-Nebraska Team member during the 2018-19 season. Maly also collect a state championship is softball, while setting the school record for most home runs in a career.

"Morgan is really strong and has a chance to be a really special player," said Flanery. "Offensively she is very gifted and skilled with a high level of physicality. I think that she has all the physical tools to be a really good scorer at the college level."

Mogensen comes to Creighton from Farmington, Minnesota. The 5-7 guard is a senior at Farmington High School and played on the Minnesota Fury AAU squad. Molly averaged 13 ppg., 6.0 rpg., 5.0 apg. and 2.5 spg during her junior season, well also collecting All-AAAA Section 1 Conference honors for the third year. Mogensen also received All-State Honorable Mention honors twice during her career at Farmington.

"Molly is a competitor that is very strong and physical. She is a capable scorer that knows the game and will make the dirty plays diving on the floor," said Flanery.

A 6-1 forward from Brandon, South Dakota, Ronsiek currently is a senior at O'Gorman High School and played for the South Dakota Attack AAU team. She earned All-State honors during her sophomore and junior season, while her talents led her to being the Midco Play of the Yea in 2018-19. Emma is a 1,000 point scorer and was a Gatorade Player of the Year nominee during her junior year. She also earned All-State recognition for volleyball during her sophomore and junior season, setting O'Gorman's school record for kills with over 1,200.

"Emma is a very skilled five player that can shot it, put it on the floor and is good passer," said Flanery. "She has a really good feel for the game as a post player. Offensively she is going to be ready to play right away. With her skill set and being a multi-sport athlete, I think she will fit in really well here."

### Carda Named to BIG EAST Honor Roll

Carda posted the single-game high last week with 25 points off 7-of-12 shooting in the Nov. 5th win at Omaha. She added six rebounds, four assists and four steals to stuff the stat sheet in the Bluejays' season opener.

### Agnew Climbing the Bluejay Scoring Ranks in 2019-20

After joining Creighton's 1,000 point club last season, senior Jaylyn Agnew is expected to climb that Bluejay ladder throughout the 2019-20 campaign.

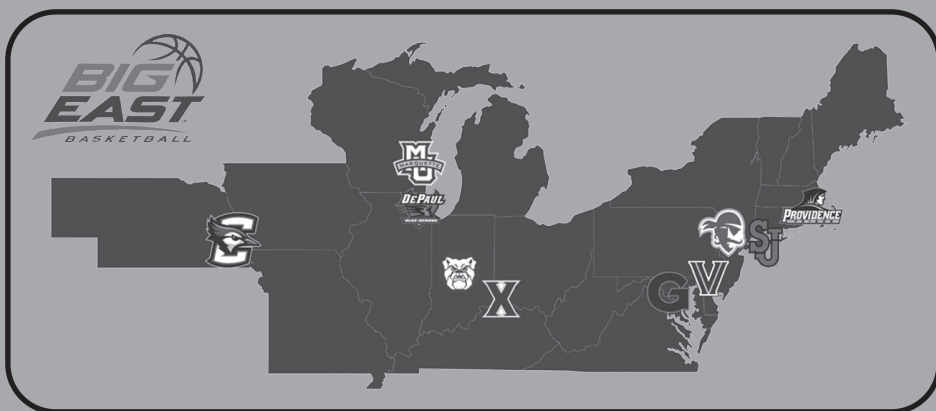
