Series History: Creighton Trails Providence, 8-6-2

The Bluejays and Friars have met 16 times, including eight times in Rhode Island. Creighton is 2-5-1 versus Providence on the road. Providence has won four of their last seven matches, while two others ended in a draw. Creighton's lone victory came in 2021 with a 2-1 win in Omaha. The last victory at Providence came in the BIG EAST Tournament during the 2016 season.

Scouting Creighton (4-2-2, 0-1-0 BIG EAST)

Following victories over Grand Canyon and Tulsa, Georgetown stripped the Bluejays of their third consecutive win and a victory in their BIG EAST home opener.

Debuting conference play from the comfort of home, Creighton surrendered the lone goal of the match 70 minutes into the battle, taking only their second loss of the season on a 1-0 result to the Hoyas.

Now, jetting off to Rhode Island to take on the No. 18 ranked Friars, the Bluejays are set to face a tough Friar squad who has fared well against Creighton teams in past years.

Since their first matchup in 2011, Creighton has posted a 2-5-1 road record, the Bluejays' most recent victory as visitors in Providence coming in November of 2016. In series history, the Bluejays have managed six total wins, paired with eight losses and two draws.

As a team, the Bluejays boast a diverse group of talent on all fronts. 21 different players have seen playing time this season, nine of them finding the back of the goal at least once in Creighton's eight matchups.

Manning the net for the Bluejays is Blake Gillingham. The junior is fresh off of two consecutive shutouts against Grand Canyon and Tulsa, while claiming a season average 0.667 save percentage, tallying 630 minutes and starting every one of Creighton's matches.

Scouting #18 Providence (6-2-1, 1-0-0 BIG EAST)

The No. 18 ranked Friars have found success on the pitch over the last several matches, claiming five victories in their last six contests. Heading into their second conference duel against the visiting Bluejays, the Friars have a three-game win streak against the likes of Bryant, No. 8 Seton Hall and, most recently, Brown.

Set to take on the Bluejays at home, the Friars performed well at Chapey Field at Anderson Stadium so far this season, putting up a 4-1 record when surrounded by their home crowd. In those five home matches, the Friars have tallied a combined six goals.

Recording an average of 15.1 attempted shots per game throughout the season, Providence has seen 11 goals come to fruition in nine matches. Out of the double-digit goals scored this season, seven different Friars have contributed one or more goals.

Heading up the roster is Bruno Rosa, who found the back of the net twice this season, tallying three assists and leading the team with seven points. Close behind in point efficiency is Pepe Lora, whose three goals have yielded him six points on the season.

Between the posts for Providence, and the Friars' only goalkeeper with minutes this season, is Lukas Burns. Tallying a 0.781 save percentage and allowing just seven goals on the season, the goalkeeper has managed to keep most of the Friars' opponents at bay, allowing an average of 0.78 goals per game.

Time to Get Used to The Road

After opening the season with seven of eight matches in the friendly confines of Morrison Stadium, Creighton's will travel for four of its next five contests. Beginning at No. 18 Providence on Saturday, the Bluejays will face (RV) Missouri State in a neutral site match in Kansas City, then host DePaul. The following two contests send the Bluejays to road match with Omaha and finally against Xavier in Cincinnati on Oct. 12. Ironically Creighton's most complete match of the season was the 1-0 win at (RV) Grand Canyon on September 9.

Spreading Out the Offense

Though eight matches the Bluejays have delivered 15 goals, getting goals from 10 different players. Two additional Creighton players have at least one point via an assist. The three leading scorers are captain Jackson Castro (three goals and three assists) with nine points, two goals and three assists from Miguel Arilla and three goals from freshman Gavrilo Civric.

Just a Corner Kick Away

Through eight matches of the 2024 season, Creighton has built a sizeable edge in corners created. The Bluejays have a 59-26 edge on corners. Entering play on Saturday, September 28, Creighton is eighth in in corners per game at 7.38.

National Ranking Recap

Creighton sits fourth in total attendance with a combined 16,448 fans and eighth in average attendance at 2,350 per game. Offensively Creighton ranks 40th in the NCAA with 15 goals. See the entire breakdown of the Bluejays' national rankings on page 13. The Bluejays are sixth the nation with 132 total fouls and sit fourth with 16.50 fouls per game. Conversely Creighton's women's soccer squad leads the nation in fouls per game at 18.00, yet is ninth in overall fouls at 126.

Scoring In Super Sonic Fashion

Creighton's 3-0 win over Tulsa on September 14 got off to a rocketing start as junior Roman Torres pressured the Golden Hurricanes into a misstep in the opening minute. Torres beat his Hurricane defender to the pass from Tulsa goalkeeper Saylor Carliot, then chipped it over the his head to net the first point of the match 48 seconds into play. The quick score marks the first goal of the season for Torres and the fastest goal to begin a match since Jackson Castro scored at the 37 second mark against San Diego State on Sept. 5, 2022. It is the seventh fastest goal in Creighton history. The quickest strike came in 1992 as Brian Kamler scored in the 16th second against Bradley on October 9.

The Bluejays followed up minutes later with another explosive play and struck again as Castro stole the ball off a Tulsa header and slid left of the goalie to laser the ball to the bottom right of the net in the 8th minute (7:36) to extend the lead to 2-0. It is the first time Creighton has scored twice in the first 10 minutes of a match since November 17, 2016. That match ironically was against Tulsa in the NCAA Tournament.

Creighton In Conference Openers

Since joining the BIG EAST prior to the 2013 season, Creighton is 8-3-1 during the first conference match of the season, including a 2-1 win over No. 13 Marquette last season. All-time the Bluejays are 21-7-6 in conference openers and 27-4-3 in home conference openers.

Creighton is 9-2-1 during the first home BIG EAST match of the season. The Bluejays own a 53-33-14 record during regular-season BIG EAST contests. The Bluejays owns a total of 14 regular-season conference titles (most recent in 2018) and 14 conference tournament titles (including 2022).

Creighton has captured two BIG EAST regular-season titles (2014, 2018) and finished runner-up at the conference tournament twice (2015, 2016).

Shimonishi's First Goal Comes in Unconventional Manner

An unconventional goal proved to be the game winner as junior Ryusei Shimonishi headed in his first goal of the season in the 20th minute (19:20). Shimonishi's volley was blocked by Grand Canyon goalkeeper Leon Schmidt, but he was two feet inside the goal box. The deep position allowed the entire ball to cross the goal line and put the Bluejays ahead. Senior Jackson Castro and sophomore Miguel Arilla earned assists on the sequence by forcing the Lopes defense to pull toward them and create an opening for Shimonishi.

Gillingham and Shimonishi Earn BIG EAST Weekly Honors

Creighton's Blake Gillingham and Ryusei Shimonishi claimed BIG EAST Goalkeeper and Defensive Player of the Week honors, as announced by the league office on Monday, September 16. Junior midfielder Jackson Castro also earned a spot on the BIG EAST's weekly honor roll.

It is the first weekly honor for Shimonishi, while Gillingham collected the Goalkeeper of the Week nod following a 0-0 draw with Tulsa in 2023 (Sept. 25).

Gillingham posted consecutive shutout victories as the Bluejays bested (RV) Grand Canyon (1-0) and Tulsa (3-0). It marked the first time a Creighton keeper has recorded consecutive shutouts since the 2022 BIG EAST Tournament against Seton Hall (6-0) and Georgetown (3-0). Gillingham faced 21 shots in the two matches, notching eight combined saves. He also made three critical stops that did not result in saves, yet prevented goals.

Shimonishi opened the week by heading in the game-winning goal in the Bluejays' 1-0 road win over (RV) Grand Canyon, then delivered an assist in Creighton's 3-0 win over Tulsa. The Creighton defender helped the Bluejays deliver its second and third shutouts of the season. Creighton limited Grand Canyon to 12 shots, including five in the second half, and four corner kicks. In the following contest Shimonishi and the Bluejay defense limited Tulsa to 10 shots and six corners.

In addition, Castro earned a spot on the BIG EAST Honor Roll. The Bluejay captain set the Bluejays' game-winning goal in motion at (RV) Grand Canyon, earning an assist for the 1-0 win. Jackson followed the performance against the Lopes by delivering an unassisted goal in the eighth minute (7:36). Castro stole the ball off a Tulsa header and slid left of the goalie to laser the ball to the bottom right of the net. Later in the match he set Creighton's third goal in motion with his third assist of the season. Junior Roman Torres hustled to send a pass into the box. Freshman Gavrilo Civric lowered his head to push the pass into the back of the net with just one second remaining on the clock at 44:59.

Civric Earns BIG EAST Freshman of the Week

Gavrilo Civric wasted little time making an impact on his new squad as the newcomer earned the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week honor during his first opportunity on Monday, August 26. Civric delivered a pair of goals in the opening five minutes of the second half to push Creighton to a 5-3 win over the Bulldogs.

Inserted into the starting unit at halftime against Drake on Sunday, Civric lifted the Bluejays from down 2-1 to leading 3-2 with a pair of goals in less than five minutes. Civric began the half by converting a penalty kick in the 47th minute (46:51), then stole a crossing pass in the box for an unassisted goal in the 49th minute (48:51). The Serbian National closed the contest with six shots, including three on goal in 31 minutes on the pitch. He added 22 minutes in Creighton's season-opener on Thursday to log a combined 53 minutes during his opening weekend as a Bluejay.

Jackson Castro Named To Preseason All-BIG EAST Team, Men's Soccer Picked To Finish Third in Midwest Division

Creighton men's soccer senior Jackson Castro claimed a spot on the 2024 Preseason All-BIG EAST team, while the Bluejays were selected to finish third in the Midwest Division of the BIG EAST Preseason Coaches' Poll.

Castro is the only returning player to start all 17 matches for the Bluejays in 2023, where he earned All-BIG EAST First Team honor after leading the Bluejays with six assists while adding a pair of goals. The Plano, Texas native owns 13 career goals and 16 helpers during 56 matches over three seasons as a Bluejay.

Creighton received 50 points and one first-place vote in the 2024 Preseason Coaches' Poll to place third in the Midwest Division, while Akron led the way with 62 votes and seven first-place tallies.

Following Akron, Xavier and Creighton, Butler checks in at fourth in the Midwest Division with 35 points. Rounding out the rankings, Marquette has been picked fifth with 25 points, while DePaul ranks sixth with 18 points.

Georgetown, the 2023 BIG EAST championship runner-up and East Division champion, topped the East Division preseason poll with 66 points and all 11 possible first-place votes.
