

# COLORADO STATE RAMS

#### **COLORADO STATE**

- Colorado State returns home to face Illinois State in the annual Ag Day with 4H, and Orange Out, game at Canvas Stadium
- CSU ranks 11th in FBS in passing offense, averaging 336.8 yards per game through the air, against opposition that has included one Pac-12 and two SEC programs in the Rams' four games.
- Graduate transfer QB K.J. Carta-Samuels ranks seventh in FBS in completions per game (26.25) and 10th in passing yards per game (329.8).
- In just four games as a Ram, Carta-Samuels has already set the school single-game passing record (537 yds, vs. Hawai'i, 8/25/18) and posted the 2nd and 3rd highest marks for single-game completions in program history (34, vs. Hawai'i, 8/25/18 and 32, vs. Arkansas, 9/8/18).
- In four games, Carta-Samuels has completed 64.4% of his passes (105-163) for 1,319 yards and 9 touchdowns with 3 interceptions.
- Junior WR Preston Williams ranks 3rd in FBS in receptions per game (9.0) and 7th in receiving yards per game (124.3), and has four touchdown receptions in four games. He has topped the 100-yard receiving mark in three of his four games as a Ram, including a game-high 106 yards on 9 receptions at Florida Saturday.
- Williams 12 receptions in the Sept. 8 win over Arkansas tied for second-most in a game in CSU program history.
- Sophomore punter Ryan Stonehouse ranks 2nd in FBS in gross punting average (50.3). Thirteen of his 21
  punts have traveled 50 or more yards, and has placed seven punts inside the 20-yard line, had three fair
  caught, and just two touchbacks.
- Down in The Swamp on Saturday, CSU held Florida to just 27 total yards in the first quarter (13 total plays, 2.1 yds/play). This came after the Rams held Arkansas to just 16 yards in the fourth quarter on Sept. 8, meaning over two consecutive quarters of play versus SEC teams, CSU surrendered just 37 total yards.

#### CSU-ILLINOIS STATE-MATCHUP NOTES

- · This will be the first meeting between CSU and Illinois State, and the first time CSU has played a team from the Missouri Valley Football Conference.
- This will be CSU's fourth and final non-conference game of the season. CSU has its first of two bye weeks following this contest.
- Since 2006, CSU is 9-1 against FCS opponents with its only loss coming against North Dakota State in 2012. NDSU would go on to win the FCS national title that year.
- · CSU's last victory over an FCS opponent came last year when the Rams defeated Abilene Christian 38-10.

#### SCOUTING THE REDBIRDS

- · Illinois State went 6-5 last season with a 4-4 record in MVFC play.
- The Redbirds are 2-0 to begin the season with wins over Saint Xavier (III.) and Eastern Illinois. Both games were home affairs for Illinois State.
- Brock Spack is in his 10th season as head coach for the Redbirds. He led the Redbirds to consecuative MVFC championsips in 2014 and 2015, and has appeared in the FCS playoffs four of the previous five seasons.
- Illinois State advanced to the 2014 FCS national title game, losing in a back-and-forth battle with the Carson Wentz-led North Dakota State squad.
- · The Redbirds retrurn their top passer, rusher and receiver from the 2017 season.
- Senior QB Jake Kolbe passed for 2,138 yards and 12 touchdown passes last season.
- Junior RB James Robinson rushed for 933 yards and 12 touchdowns on 165 attempts last season.
- Senior WR Spencer Schnell caught 51 passes for 697 yards and four touchdowns in the 2017 season
- Illinois State's most recent game against an FBS program was on Sept. 10, 2016, when the Redbirds defeated Northwestern 9-7 in Evanston,

#### **GRAD TRANSFER TAKEOVER**

Colorado State has four graduate transfers on its roster, which is tied for the fourth-most in the FBS.

QB K.J. Carta-Samuels (Washington): Carta-Samuels ranks third in the MW and 10th nationally in passing yards per game (329.8)... He set the single-game passing yardage record at CSU in his debut, throwing for 537 yards against Hawai'i on Aug. 25; he broke the previous record by 88 yards (Scooter Molander, 449, Nov. 7, 1989)... He registered the second- and third-highest single-game completion marks in school history in just his first three games as a Ram:

#### STANDOUTS IN THE SECOND HALF

Senior quarterback K.J. Carta-Samuels and junior wide receiver Preston Williams have been standouts over the first three games of the season for the Rams. The duo have been particularly productive in the second halves of games.

#### BRYAN NOW CSU'S ALL-TIME SCORING LEADER

Senior kicker Wyatt Bryan has scored more points wearing a CSU uniform than any other player in the 126-year history of the school's football proaram.

Bryan now has 300 career points. He broke the record in the second quarter of CSU's Sept. 8 contest versus Arkansas on a 44-yard field goal with 32 seconds remaining in the first half. Bryan passed legendary running back Steve Bartalo (294), who had held the record for more than 30 years.

#### LONG DRIVES UNDER BOBO

Colorado State has recorded a 99-yard touchdown drive in each of the last two seasons, and thus far in 2018 also has a touchdown drive of 96 yards. In head coach Mike Bobo's three-plus seasons at CSU, the Rams have a remarkable five touchdown drives of 96 or more yards, one coming in 2016, two in 2017 and two in 2018.

#### **GOING FOR 500 (AND 600)**

CSU posted 653 yards in its season opener against Hawai'i on Aug. 25. It was the most yards that a Rams team has had under fourth-year head coach Mike Bobo and the fifth-most in a single game in program history. It also further illustrated a trend that Bobo has set since taking charge of the program in 2015.

CSU eclipsed 500 yards of total offense seven times in 2017, and reached 600-plus yards a school-record four times. Under Coach Bobo, the Rams have exceeded 500 yards of total offense 17 times (4 in 2015, 5 in 2016, 7 in 2017, 1 in 2018).

#### PRENTICE THE NATION'S HIGHEST-GRADED FULLBACK

Redshirt sophomore Adam Prentice was the highest-graded fullback in the FBS in 2017, according to Pro Football Focus. He rated at an 82.5 for the season -- the highest rating of any returning Ram.

Prentice is also known for his off-the-field efforts. He is on the 2018 Wuerffel Trophy watch list and is a nominee for the 2018 Allstate Good Works Team.

#### WR U?

The Colorado State football team has groomed several incredible talents at the wide receiver position over the last five years. Rashard Higgins, a fifth-round draft selection of the Cleveland Browns in 2016, set multiple program records during his three seasons at CSU. Higgins was a Biletnikoff Award finalist and consensus All-American in 2014 following a season where he totaled 1,750 yards receiving and 17 touchdowns. Michael Gallup earned the same national accolades last season, producing 1,413 yards on a school-record 100 catches. Gallup was a third-round draft choice by the Cowboys this year, and is competing to be a starter in year one.

Since 2014, seven different Rams receivers have posted at least one 100yard receiving outing -- Higgins, Gallup, Joe Hansley, Charles Lovett, Elroy Masters, Jr., Olabisi Johnson and Preston Williams (plus tight end Cameron

#### **NEW STAFF ADDITIONS FOR 2018**

The Rams added six new full-time assistant coaches into the fold before spring ball started, including three new coordinators. The defense will be led by defensive coordinator John Jancek, who brings 10 years of experience as a defensive coordinator at the FBS level, most recently a three-year stint at Tennessee. Four other new assistant coaches join Jancek on that side of the ball, including special teams coordinator and linebackers coach Chase Gibson. Dave Johnson was also added to the staff to be the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. The six new full-time assistant coaches boast over 100 years of combined experience on Division I coaching staffs.

#### **GREEN AND GLOBAL - SERVICE AND LEARNING EXPERIENCE IN JAMAICA**

- 12 student-athletes and four staff members traveled to Petersfield, Jamaica from May 17-27.
- The athletes experienced cultural immersion, social action and community-based learning. Students were hosted by local families, with 2-4 students per home.

- CSU's student-athletes have seen their opportunities expand dramatically in recent years. The most visible

#### GOING BOWLING

For the 17th time in school history and fifth year in a row, the Rams went bowling in 2017, facing Marshall in the Gildan New Mexico Bowl. It marked the first time CSU qualified for a bowl game in five consecutive seasons since 1999-2003. All-time, CSU has played in 17 bowl games, including 16 since 1990.

The Rams finished with a 7-6 record for the third consecutive year, and have now posted winning records in five straight seasons.

#### **CSU SETS TOP ATTENDANCE MARKS**

Colorado State set single-season records for total home attendance (192,369) and per game average (32,062) last season, its first in its new on-campus football stadium.

CSU saw its total attendance increase 16.2 percent from 2016 - the eighth-highest per-game attendance increase in the FBS for 2017.

Other attendance facts:

- Second year in a row with an increase in attendance -- the seventh-highest two-year per-game attendance increase among all FBS schools (7.145: 28.7%)
  - 149,500/24,917 in 2015
  - 165,598/27,600 in 2016
  - 192,369/32,062 in 2017
- One of only two MW schools (San Diego State) to experience an attendance increase in each of the past two seasons.
  - Colorado State: 10.8% from 2015-16; 16.2% from 2016-17

#### THIS WEEK IN CSU HISTORY -- LOOKING BACK ON THE 70TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE 1948 CINDER-ELLA RAMS AND THE RAISIN BOWL TEAM

Frank Faucett sat in his seat at Canvas Stadium as the 2018 season kicked off against Hawaii on August 25th. At 90 years old, Faucett and his wife of 67 years, Barb, have had season tickets to CSU football for over half a century at the last three stadiums the Rams have called home. He was also a sophomore on the 1948 Colorado A&M Football team playing in the school's first bowl game on January 1, 1949. It has been 70 years this week since one of the most celebrated CSU football teams ever assembled took the field for a very memorable season.

The 1948 season opener took place at Colorado Field on September 18, 1948 with a brand-new set of lights as the Aggies played the first night game at their storied gridiron against the Colorado College Tigers. Kickoff was at 8 p.m. and the A&M fans packed the stadium on College Avenue excited to see what kind of team coach Bob Davis presented for the season.

The Rams took the field that night with such legendary names as Bob Hainlen, Dale Dodrill, Eddie Hanna, Lee Walters, Jack Christiansen, Oliver Woods, Tuffy Mullison, the immortal Fum McGraw and of course halfback, Frank Faucett. The Aggies allowed an early six points in the first half and seemed to struggle until Pat Green scored the Rams' first touchdown to tie the game 6-6 in the third. Eddie Hanna put the Aggies ahead with a 44-yard touchdown run late in the third quarter and Pat Green scored another TD in the fourth quarter with Carl Cox scoring another TD late in the game. The season opener against the Tigers ended in a 25-6 route and paved the way for a season that has become legendary to Rams football. The next week at Colorado Field they pounded New Mexico State 41-6 and then went on the road for a grudge match against Utah State that ended in a 9-7 victory for the Aggies thanks to the leg of Bob Hainlen and the running of Eddie Hanna.

In the fourth week, A&M traveled to Denver to take on a tough Pioneers team at DU Stadium that saw 24,000 fans packed into every corner of the old stadium. Eddie "Twinkletoes" Hanna helped save the game late in the third quarter with an 83-yard run that tied the game and gave momentum for a 14-10 victory over their long-time conference foe.

Then came what could be considered the true birth of the Border War in a game played at Corbett Field in Laramie, Wyoming. The Aggies and Cowboys were both undefeated and looking for the conference championship title. With light snow fluttering down and a packed house of both Rams fans and Cowpokes, the game was one that would go down in history as one of the greatest in the long and storied rivalry. With Wyoming up 14-0, quarterback Bob Hainlen guided his team down the frozen Laramie turf for two touchdowns scored by Keith Thompson and Jim Abshire.

Late in the fourth quarter with the score tied at 14, Joe Folsom returned a Wyoming punt to the Cowboy 16 yard-line where after a series of plays Keith Thompson ended up in the end zone to put the Aggies ahead 21-14. Cowboy all-star halfback Eddie Talboon was not done yet and drove Wyoming to pay dirt with 30 seconds left in the game to seemingly lock the score at the end of the day. However, Aggie lineman Dale Dodrill became the greatest hero in green and gold when he blocked the extra point and ended the game 21-20 in favor of Colorado A&M.



It was at that moment when Aggie fans stormed the field and tore down the Wyoming goal posts. Former Colorado Governor Roy Romer, then a student at A&M, wrote in the Collegian, "Aggie Fans soared down from windy perches with jubilant cheers. For with a heave, and a ho, the mighty muscular manhood from Colorado toppled this system of elevated plumbing to earth."

The Rams would have their first loss against Drake on Homecoming day the next week, bounce back with a shutout over Mines the next week and then a loss to Utah for their only conference defeat of the year finishing second in the Skyline Conference. They would end their season with another exciting rivalry against Colorado in Boulder where the Aggies beat the Buffs in an exciting 29-25 victory that propelled them to national attention.

On Monday November 22, 1948, two days after beating CU in Boulder, the Colorado A&M Aggies were invited to the 1949 Raisin Bowl to play against undefeated Occi-

dental College. It was the first time in school history a team had been invited to a bowl game and after Skyline Conference Coach of the Year Bob Davis asked his players if they wanted to play in a New Year's Day Bowl Game, (Nearly half the team were WWII veterans and married with families) they all agreed to accept the invitation.

After a harrowing airplane ride to Fresno, California, the Rams were treated like stars when they arrived in the raisin growing capitol of California. In a way they were movie stars because Universal Pictures filmed parts of the Raisin Bowl action for an upcoming movie called "Yes Sir, That's My Baby" starring Donald O'Connor.

Although the Jan. 1, 1949 Raisin Bowl was a very close 21-20 loss for the Rams, Eddie Hanna stunned the crowd with two 70-plus yard touchdown runs. Today, 70 years later we can still be proud of these Aggies and their accomplishments on the field in 1948. Looking up at the façade at Canvas Stadium we still see the names of #21 Eddie Hanna and #48 Fum McGraw, the only retired numbers for CSU football.

Frank Faucett is not the only member of the 1948 team still cheering CSU to victory each week, but he is the only Raisin Bowl alum who has done it at Colorado Field, Hughes Stadium and Canvas Stadium as a season ticket holder for well over 50 years.



#### CANVAS STADIUM

Canvas Stadium is the new name for Colorado State University's 41,000-capacity multipurpose stadium that opened on the school's Fort Collins campus in 2017. The newly re-branded Canvas Credit Union received naming rights to the facility through a \$37.7 million partnership agreement announced in April 2018. The agreement, which stands as one of the largest collegiate athletic venue naming agreements in history, was part of an ambitious re-branding initiative being undertaken by the previously branded Public Service Credit Union, under the direction of company President and CEO Todd Marksberry.

Canvas Credit Union is a not-for-profit, state-chartered, member-owned financial cooperative that has been in business since 1938. Today, the credit union has more than \$2.3 billion in assets and more than 238,000 members — and a mission to help individuals and families make better decisions and grow stronger financially. Learfield's Rams Sports Properties and their Campus+ business brokered the agreement as part of its ongoing support for Colorado State University athletics.

The \$220 million, 727,000-square-foot stadium proved immensely popular and attractive to fans in its inaugural season of 2017, and drew rave reviews from local and national media, as well national television networks that broadcast Colorado State's games to large audiences. The Rams set an all-time attendance record with a total of 192,369 fans and a per-game average of 32,062, representing a 16-percent attendance increase from 2016—eighth-highest in all of college football. Season ticket sales also reached an all-time high of 15,477, a 40-percent increase from the 2016 total of 11,054.

The return of CSU football games to campus from Hughes Stadium in 2017 brought the pageantry and celebration of Rams game days back to the heart of the university for the first time in 50 years, providing countless new engagement opportunities for the entire university. The stadium's design embraces Colorado's natural beauty, topography and visual connections to the Rocky Mountains from campus and ensures functionality for both gameday and non-game day usage.



The agreement with Canvas Credit Union combined with \$20 million given in 2016 to name Sonny Lubick Field brings the total naming rights revenues at Colorado State to \$57 million for the stadium. This compares favorably with the recently announced \$69 million United Airlines Memorial Coliseum at University of Southern California and the \$41 million Alaska Airlines Field at Husky Stadium at the University of Washington. The Colorado State agreement with Canvas Credit Union is for 15 years and includes annual escalator clauses for inflation, as well as a signing bonus, in recognition of the visibility and success of the stadium.



### COLORADO STATE FOOTBALL MEDIA COVERAGE GUIDELINES

• We appreciate your coverage of Colorado State Athletics, and look forward to working with you to accommodate you and your organization within the framework of the following media policy. The policies are jointly established by Head Coach Mike Bobo and the Athletics Communications office. Please take a few minutes to read through and familiarize yourself with these guidelines. Failure to comply with these policies could result in revocation of credentials or limitations on access. Please feel free to contact Associate A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk at (970) 988-3482 or via email at paul.kirk@colostate.edu with any questions.

Interview access to players and coaches throughout the calendar year is as follows:

#### **GENERAL POLICIES**

- All interviews with any member of the football program, including Mike Bobo, the coaching and football staffs, and student-athletes, must be coordinated through the Athletics Communications office.
- True freshmen and other student-athletes in their first year in the program are not eligible to be included on the regular interview list.
   Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, mem-
- Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, members of the media are welcome to approach the Communications office at least 48 hours in advance with requests to interview any member of the program, provided the requested individual is not a true-freshman player. Requests approved by Coach Bobo will be facilitated by the Athletics Communications staff.
- Members of the media are strictly prohibited from directly contacting any coach, staff member or student-athlete by any means, including by text message, e-mail, phone (cell, office or home) or social media, without first approaching the Athletics Communications office.
- For all practices, no live reporting of practice details is permissible, nor live streaming of any method. Upon conclusion of practice, questions based on observations made during practice may be asked of Coach Bobo, and reported on as answered.
- Designated student-athletes from the interview list will be made available on specified days during the spring and preseason practice periods, and on Tuesdays and Wednesdays during the regular season.
- Assistant coaches will be made available to media one time each during spring practice on a schedule provided Athletics Communications.
- Head Coach Mike Bobo will be available following most practices.
   Exceptions include night practices and certain practice days during spring and preseason.
- All interviews take place in the interview room of the stadium, located
  at field level, one level down from the media entrance on the west side
  of the stadium. Media are not permitted to enter the football offices, or
  the training room, locker room, weight room or meeting rooms unless
  arrangements have been made through the Communications office.
- Media may not photograph or report on individuals or groups participating in workouts outside of organized team sessions within campus practice or competition locations.

#### PRESEASON CAMP

 Coordinators will be made available on Media Day. No other assistant coach access is available during preseason camp.

#### REGULAR-SEASON GAME WEEKS

- On Mondays, Head Coach Mike Bobo will conduct a weekly press
  conference in the stadium interview room. Bobo will begin speaking at
  12 p.m. and the press conference will end at approximately 12:30-35.
   The press conference is livestreamed at CSURams.com/live, and the
  archive will be available on YouTube and on CSURams.com. Audio from
  the press conference also is made available to media.
- Following practice on Tuesday and Wednesday, student-athletes on the interview list will be made available, with either offensive or defensive players being available Tuesday and those from the other side of the ball on Wednesday, Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, members of the media are welcome to approach the Communications office at least 48 hours in advance with requests to interview any member of the program, provided the requested individual is not a true-freshman player. Approved requests will be granted, but those interviews need to take place on Tuesday following practice.
- On Wednesday, Bobo will be available following practice.

  Following Wednesday availability there is no further media a
- Following Wednesday availability, there is no further media availability with members of the program until the end of the game on Saturday, with the exception of contractual obligations with broadcast partners.

#### GAMEDAY

- Every member of the program must report to the locker room following the game before conducting interviews. Other than network TV and radio obligations, CSU does not allow on-field interviews in the minutes following the game's conclusion.
- Postgame press conferences take place in the home and visiting team interview rooms, located just off the elevator from the press box at field level. From the field, enter the southwest tunnel and proceed right and down the hall to reach the interview rooms on your left.
   Head Coach Mike Bobo and requested players will be available to
- Head Coach Mike Bobo and requested players will be available to the media in the interview room after a reasonable cooling-off period. Coach Bobo will conduct his postgame press followed by requested players from the interview list being made available in the interview room. Assistant coaches and true freshmen players are not available.
- The visiting team press conference and media availability will take

place in the visiting team interview room adjacent to the home team interview room, down the hall from the visitors' locker room.

#### RECRUITING PERIOD

 Access to Head Coach Mike Bobo will be less regular during this time, from the end of the regular season through the second signing day, the first Wednesday in February, due to recruiting responsibilities. Assistant coaches are not available during this period.

#### ALL OTHER TIMES

- Head Coach Mike Bobo is available either in-person or by phone, by appointment through Assoc. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk (paul kirk@colostate.edu).
- Assistant coaches do not have regular availability throughout the year. Requests for their participation in interviews must be made through Assoc. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk, and will be granted only by approval of the head coach.
- Phone calls (cell, office or home) to any coach, staff member, or student-athlete are strictly prohibited, unless previously arranged through the Athletics Communications office.
- Media should contact the Athletics Communications office, rather than
  the individual coaches and/or student-athletes, when needing personal
  contact information, such as phone numbers or e-mail addresses, or
  contact information for family members and friends where such interviews will enhance a feature story.

#### INJURIES

- At all times throughout the calendar year, including spring practice, Head Coach Mike Bobo will serve as the sole source for injury information. All questions related to injuries should be directed to Bobo, and not to any other member of the program, including athletic trainers, doctors, the injured student-athlete, or his teammates.
- · If Coach Bobo is unavailable, please contact Paul Kirk

#### PRACTICE GUIDELINES

- Most Colorado State football practices are open to media for the first few periods unless otherwise noted.
- Videography, provided it is not live-streamed, is allowed during the media viewing period, but no sound may be recorded.
- No live reporting of practice details is permissible, nor live streaming of any method. Upon conclusion of practice, questions based on observations made during the media viewing period may be asked of Coach Bobo, and reported on as answered by the coach.
- During the spring, most regular practices (excluding scrimmages) are open to the media during the media viewing period as specific by Athletics Communications.
- All media should remain on the sidelines, standing a safe distance from the boundary to prevent collisions. Also for safety reasons, media are asked to stand rather than sit or kneel, and should either hold personal bags or set them behind a barrier, so they are not a potential injury source for players or the media.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY GUIDELINES

- Cameras are restricted from shooting/filming any 11-on-11 period, as well as selected other periods (Athletics Communications staff will notify). Photography must be tight, "iso" shots that do not reveal alignments or strategy.
- No sound may be captured during the shooting of practice video.
- Photographers are allowed to shoot individual drills and group activity as directed by the Athletics Communications staff. No photography is allowed of players receiving treatment from medical staff, or of injured players, whether participating in individual workouts or observing practice.
- Photographers and videographers are not allowed to bring tripods onto the practice field.
- Photographers and videographers should remain on the sidelines, or behind the end lines. They are not permitted in any drill or in close proximity to any team or position-group huddles at any time.
   Photographers should stand a safe distance from the boundary to
- Photographers should stand a safe distance from the boundary to prevent collisions. Also for safety reasons, photographers are asked to stand rather than sit or kneel, and should either hold personal bags and/or camera equipment, or set them behind a barrier, so they are not a potential injury source for players or the media.
- All posed photo shoots must take place at times arranged prior to the beginning of practice, working through the Athletics Communications office. Posed photo shoots are not permitted during any practice.

#### TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS

- Head Coach Mike Bobo is available for phone interviews as time permits. Media should call to make an appointment through Paul Kirk (paul.kirk@colostate.edu).
- Phone calls (cell, office or home) to any coach or student-athlete are strictly prohibited, unless previously arranged through the athletic Communications office.
- Media should contact the Athletics Communications office, rather than the individual coaches and/or student-athletes, when needing personal contact information, such as phone numbers or e-mail addresses.

#### CSURAMS.COM/SOCIAL MEDIA

• The official Web site of Colorado State athletics, CSURams.com, features the latest news, information, statistics and rosters for all of the Rams' 16 athletic programs. Rams fans worldwide can also listen to the live play-by-play coverage offered by the Colorado State Sports Network through the website or the Tuneln app, and can watch livestreamed video of most home events. Fans can click on www. CSURams.com,then click on the schedule pages to access the radio

broadcast for live radio coverage of football, volleyball and men's and women's basketball. For video, click the "Fans" tab at the top, and scan the menu under Multimedia, or directly access the URL CSURAms.com/watch. News also will be disseminated via the Colorado State football program's official twitter account, @CSUFootball, as well as the general athletics account, @CSUAthletics, and Assoc. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk (@PaulKirk\_CSU).

#### MEDIA CREDENTIALS

 Credentials must be requested through Paul Kirk in writing at least seven days in advance of an event. Approved requests will be mailed or can be picked up in the Communications office, or at the game.
 Season credential applications will be made available in mid-July, and the online single-game credential request link can be found at http:// www.csurams.com/sb\_output.aspx?form=20.

#### PHOTOGRAPHER CREDENTIALS

 Photo credentials are issued only to accredited photographers. Passes must be displayed at all times. All photographers must remain outside the 25-yard lines on both sides of the field, or behind each end zone in a kneeling position.

#### GAME-DAY SERVICES

- A pregame meal is served 90 minutes prior to kickoff in the press box. Colorado State provides reliable WiFi in the press box, photographers' workroom and interview rooms, and access to live statistics through StatBroadcast. We have greatly reduced the amount of information distributed on paper at our home games in favor of full digital offerings of game notes, statistics, postgame audio and postgame notes. All credentialed media will receive an email the day before a game with all pertinent coverage and team information directly or via links embedded in the email.
- Colorado State's stadium offers complimentary wireless Internet access in the press box, interview room and photo workroom. Ethernet lines also are available in the photo workroom, located just inside the southwest tunnel at field level, near the visiting team locker room. Check the seat-assignment label on press row for wireless access information.

#### PARKING

- Media parking on game days is generally available in the Lake Street Garage (Lot 570), located near the intersection of Prospect Road and Center Avenue in the south area of campus. Denver TV stations have space allotted for one vehicle per station in front of the connection panels on the west side of the stadium. Please contact the Athletics Communications office to request a game day parking pass.
- Parking in all campus parking lots requires a permit from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays. A limited number of single-day passes are available through the Communications office, and pay-to-park stalls are located on the north side of the stadium, on Pitkin Street, in front of the Ram Zone store and ticket office. Annual permits can be purchased through the Office of Parking Management Web site: http://pts.colostate.edu, and many lots offer a payment klosk to purchase a daily pass.
- The CSU Athletics Communications office will provide complimentary annual passes to the Moby/McGraw Center lot and Lot 240 near the stadium for select media organizations and members of the press who consistently cover the Rams. Those passes are not replaceable and should be treated like cash.

#### STADIUM DIRECTIONS/WILL CALL

- Colorado State's on-campus stadium is located between Pitkin and Lake Streets, just west of Shields Street in Fort Collins. The mailing address is 751 W. Pitkin Street. From I-25, media should take the Prospect Road exit, turn left, and proceed west toward the mountains. To access Lot 570 with a game day parking permit, please turn right onto Center Ave., from westbound Prospect Road. The entrance to the garage will be on your right. The stadium's media entrance, and Media Will-Call, is located on the west side of the stadium through the door marked "Media & Staff Entry," and press box access is via elevator just inside that entrance.
- Ticket will call is located at the main stadium ticket windows on Pitkin Street, at the Northwest corner of the stadium.
