Emergency Action Plan: CSU Tennis Complex Women's Tennis

In Case of an Emergency:

- 1. Provide immediate care of injured or ill individual
- 2. Activate emergency Medical System (EMS)
 - a. Call 911
 - b. Provide the following information:
 - Your name
 - Address: <u>University Tennis Facility: 2400 Research Blvd</u>, Fort Collins, CO 80526
 - Your telephone number
 - Number of individuals injured; condition; first aid and treatment administered; other information as requested by dispatcher
 - c. *Be the last to hang up*
- 3. Retrieve emergency equipment.
- 4. Direct EMS to scene
 - a. If available designate individual(s) to meet EMS and direct to scene
 - b. Open appropriate doors
 - c. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move teammates, coaches and bystanders away from the area

Venue Directions: The University Tennis Facility is located at the intersection of Drake and Research Blvd.

1. From Drake turn onto Research Blvd. Head north for 100 yards and take a right at the first road available. Proceed straight ahead into the parking lot towards the south Club House entrance.

Emergency Communication:

- Emergency service pole located directly outside of front gate
- Moby Athletic Training Room- (970) 491-6756
- Certified athletic trainer carries cellular telephone
- Ambulance/EMS services response via 911.

Emergency Equipment:

- Emergency Equipment: AED, splint kit, crutches, oxygen, and first aid/biohazard supplies
- Practice: All emergency equipment is accessible from the Moby Athletic Training Room
- Competition: All emergency equipment is accessible under the northwest corner of the clubhouse

Emergency Personnel: Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) will be accessible from the Moby Athletic Training Room during posted hours of operation and on site for all home competitions. All individual practices outside of posted hours Athletic Trainer or Coach will be on call. Additional athletic training staff may be accessible from the Moby Athletic Training Room. The ATC or Coach is responsible for leading emergency care team and summoning additional emergency medical services/care (EMS) as needed.
