

## Emergency Action Plan: Soccer Field

### In Case of an Emergency:

1. Provide immediate care of injured or ill individual, remove patient from the scene for further evaluation if needed.
2. Activate Emergency Medical System (EMS)
  - a. Call 911
  - b. Provide the following information:
    - Your name
    - Address: **Softball/Soccer Complex, 961 Moby Drive, Building B or C, Fort Collins, CO 80521**
    - Your telephone number
    - Number of individuals injured; condition; first aid and treatment administered; other information as requested by dispatcher
  - c. **\*Be the last to hang up\***
3. Retrieve emergency equipment.
4. Direct EMS to scene
  - a. If available designate individual(s) to meet EMS and direct to scene
  - b. Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move teammates, coaches, and bystanders away from the area

**Venue Directions:** The Softball/Soccer Complex is located at the intersection of Shields and West Elizabeth (see aerial map).

- Enter the Moby Parking lot. On the right is the soccer field. Proceed to the gate opening on the north side of the fenced in field. Additional gate entrance on the south side of the fenced in field.

### Emergency Communication:

- Certified athletic trainer carries cellular telephone
- Additional fixed telephone line in Moby Athletic Training Room - (970) 491-6756
- Ambulance/EMS services response via 911.

### Emergency Equipment:

- Fixed **AED** located on the south side of the press box, Building B
- Emergency equipment will be on sight for all CSU team practices and games: orange emergency kit (includes **AED**, digital thermometer, rapid cooling tarp, vital signs equipment), oxygen, splint kit, crutches, and first aid/biohazard supplies
- Additional emergency equipment located in the Moby Athletic Training Room
- Game: emergency equipment is accessible behind the home team's bench
- Conditioning session: orange emergency kit and oxygen

**Emergency Personnel:** Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) on site for all practices and competitions; additional athletic training staff may be accessible from the Moby Athletic Training Room. The ATC is responsible for leading emergency care team and responsible for summoning additional emergency medical services/care (EMS) as needed.
