## UTEP CONTINUES ROAD SWING, PLAYS AT COLORADO STATE FOR TIME IN 10 SEASONS SATURDAY AFTERNOON ON TRUTV

UTEP will take on Colorado State for the first time in 10 seasons and for the 36th time overall when the Miners travel to Fort Collins to battle the Rams on Saturday afternoon. UTEP and CSU are set for a 3 p.m. MT kickoff in Canvas Stadium. The contest will be televised on truTV and returns to "The Home of UTEP Football" 600 AM ESPN.

### » LEAST PENALTIES SINCE 2018

UTEP committed two penalties at Liberty, the least since two vs. Southern Miss in '18 (Scotty Walden was on USM staff).

QB Skyler Locklear is the CUSA leader in QB rating completion percentage (66.3).

### » KAM WITH A PURPOSE

MB Kam Thomas leads CUSA in receptions (20), all-purpose yards (380) and all-purpose yards per game (126.7)

### » JEVON THE WORKHORSE

RB Jevon Jackson leads CUSA in total plays (50).

## » FIRST TD AS A MINER

WR Kenny Odom used his burners to find the end zone on a career-long 60-yard TD reception at [RV] Liberty.

# WHERE TO WATCH & LISTEN

The Miners and Flames will be nationally televised on truTV with JB Long (play-by-play), Mike Golic Jr. (analysis) and Jared Greenberg (sideline) on the call. The action returns to "The Home of UTEP Football" 600 AM ESPN with with "The Voice of the UTEP Miners" Jon Teicher calling play-by-play in his 44th season. Teich', who called his 500th game last season on Oct. 11, is joined by former UTEP WR Cole Freytag (2012, 2014-16) in the booth providing analysis in his third season. El Paso native and long-running member of the local media Mando Medina will be reporting from the sidelines. The contest can also be heard on the UTEP Miners app.

## **SERIES VS. COLORADO STATE**

Colorado State leads the all-time series 25-10 as the series dates back to 1963. The Miners and Rams have not faced each other in 10 seasons. Colorado State won the contest 59-42 on Sept. 28. 2013. The Miners are 3-14 all-time in Fort Collins as the two programs were once Western Athletic Conference Rivals (1968-1998). The Miners were 7-22 versus the Rams during league play. The two squads last met as WAC foes in 1998 during CSU 20-17 victory. In the previous meeting, QB Jameill Showers went 26-of-43 for 365 yards and five touchdowns. WR Jordan Leslie tallied 130 yards on three receptions and two TDs. RB Aaron Jones, who was a true freshman, led the way with 94 yards on the ground. UTEP last won in Fort Collins on Sept. 19, 1987, during a 45-6 thrashing. QB Pat Hegarty threw for 317 yards and three touchdowns on 21-of-33 passing. TE Arnie Adkison recorded 110 yards on four receptions and punted six times for 216 yards (36.0 avg.). UTEP's last win against CSU came on Oct. 22, 2011, in a 31-17 victory during the Miners' 80th Homecoming Game in Sun Bowl Stadium. RB Vernon Frazier ran for 167 yards on seven carries and two touchdowns. QB Nick Lamaison found RB Nathan Jeffery on a 36-yard touchdown.

## ABOUT COLORADO STATE

The Rams fell to 1-2 after losing to Colorado 28-9 on Sept. 14 in Fort Collins. CSU chalked up a win against Northern Colorado 38-17 in Canvas Stadium. The Rams opened the season with a loss at no. 4 Texas on Aug. 31. Colorado State averages 15.7 points per game and gives up 32.3 per game. CSU is averaging 319.3 yards on offense and yielding 420.7 per contest. RB Justin Marshall is leading the ground game with 227 yards and has a rushing TD. WR Tory Horton leads with 10 receptions and 120 yards. LB Buom Jock is the team leader with 28 tackles. LB Chase Wilson has an interception and 16 tackles (second on the team). The Rams' defense has tallied only two sacks.

# **CLEANING UP THE MISCUES**

The Miners only committed a season-low two penalties for 25 yards at [RV] Liberty after piling on 14 for 122 yards against SUU on Sept. 7. There were only four flags accepted as the Flames were also only penalized twice. They were the least penalties committed by a UTEP team since Nov. 25, 2018. That contest was against Southern Miss in the Sun Bowl where **Scotty Walden** was on the Golden Eagles' staff. That game also saw only four total penalties committed.

# SKYLER CAREER HIGHS

QB **Skyler Locklear** recorded career highs in pass attempts (43) and completions (26) at [RV] Liberty. Locklear completed a 60-yard touchdown pass to WR Kenny Odom while throwing for 244 yards (second most during collegiate career).

# WHERE LOCKLEAR RANKS

**Skyler Locklear** leads Conference USA in completion percentage (66.3). The redshirt sophomore ranks third in CUSA in passing yards per game (218.0) and total passing yards (654). Locklear's completions (59) and attempts (89) rank second in CUSA. His 132.4 rating ranks fifth in the league. Locklear's completion percentage ranks 43rd in the nation.

# TRIPLE CROWN

QB **Skyler Locklear** did something unique on Sept. 7 against Southern Utah in his first appearance at Sun Bowl Stadium in front of over 41,000 fans. Locklear completed a trifecta as he threw for a touchdown, rushed for another and caught a game-tying score against the Thunderbirds.

## FIRST IN THE MODERN ERA

**Skyler Locklear** is the first Miner player in the modern era (post 1965) to throw a touchdown, rush for a touchdown and catch a touchdown in the same game.

# RARE ACHIEVEMENT

The last Miner to rush, pass and catch a TD in the same season was RB **Aaron Jones** in 2016. Jones threw a TD pass on Oct. 29 against Old Dominion. He also rushed for a touchdown against ODU that night. RB **Marcus Thomas** did so in 2006, and QB **Mike McCall** achieved it in 1977.

# FIRST TIME IN FBS SINCE 2015

**Skyler Locklear** is the first FBS player since Stanford's QB Kevin Hogan on Dec. 5, 2015, versus USC to pass for a touchdown, rush for a touchdown and catch a touchdown in the same game. Coincidentally, Stanford's RB Christian McCaffery did the same thing in the same contest. Rice's James Casey did it twice during the 2008 season.

## CAREER NIGHT FOR LOCKLEAR VS. SUU

**Skyler Locklear** racked up a career-high 342 yards of total offense. He threw for a career 295 yards on 22-of-29 passing (75.9 percent), 47 rushing yards and a four-yard touchdown reception. Locklear's passing yards and rushing yards were also career highs. Locklear completed a career-long 65-yard pass during the first quarter. He also completed passes of 44 and 41 yards.

# KAM WITH A PURPOSE

MB **Kam Thomas** has done it all so far. Thomas leads Conference USA in all-purpose yards per game (126.7) and total yards (380). His 12.7 yards per play rank fourth. Thomas has hit triple digits in his first three games as a Miner. The Austin Peay transfer opened the season with 132 all-purpose yards at national power Nebraska, followed by 119 against SUU, and registered 129 all-purpose yards at [RV] Liberty.

# KAM'S ALL-PURPOSE YARDS RANKINGS

**Kam Thomas** ranks first in CUSA in all-purpose yards (380), third in punt return yards (47), fourth in kickoff return yards (96), and fourth in receiving yards (238).

# **CUSA LEADER IN RECEPTIONS**

**Kam Thomas** leads Conference USA with 20 receptions in the first three games. He opened his UTEP career with seven receptions for 71 yards and a TD at national power Nebraska. Thomas followed up that performance with a season-high 99 yards on five catches. Recently, Thomas hauled in a season-best eight passes for 68 yards at [RV] Liberty. Thomas ranks fourth with 238 receiving yards.

# **JEVON THE WORKHORSE**

RB **Jevon Jackson** leads Conference USA with 50 plays. He's rushed the ball 45 times, ranking second in CUSA.

# MORE ON JEVON

**Jevon Jackson**, UTEP's leading rusher, ranks fifth in Conference USA in rushing yards (179) and rushing yards per game (59.7).

# **KENNY'S GOT BURNERS**

WR **Kenny Odom**, in his first start in a UTEP uniform, scored his first touchdown as a Miner on a collegiate career-long 60-yard reception at [RV] Liberty. Odom hauled in a pass down the middle at the LU 36 and raced by multiple Flames' defenders on his way to pay dirt.





## **ODOM'S NUMBERS**

Kenny Odom ranks second on the team and eighth in Conference USA with 161 receiving yards on seven receptions in the first three games played. Last week against SUU, he set a collegiate career best with 97 yards receiving and followed with a career-long 60-yard touchdown reception at [RV] Liberty. Odom's 23.0 yards per catch leads the team and ranks fourth in CUSA.

# FIRST CAREER TD PASS

WR Jaden Smith, a senior transfer from EKU, threw his first collegiate touchdown pass against Southern Utah. It was a four-yard pass into the end zone to QB Skyler Locklear during the fourth quarter that helped tie the contest with no time remaining.

# A LITTLE MORE ON JADEN'S TD PASS

Jaden Smith is the first UTEP wide receiver to complete a pass play since WR **Tyrin Smith** did so in 2022. Smith is the first non-UTEP quarterback to throw a touchdown pass since RB **Aaron Jones** did so in 2016.

# **OVER 2K**

Jaden Smith hit over 2,000 yards receiving after tallying 56 on Sept. 7. Smith now has 2,053 receiving yards in his career after gaining 42 at [RV] Liberty. Smith recorded 1,922 while playing at EKU the previous three seasons.

# SEASON HIGHS FOR GOODMAN

WR Trey Goodman set season highs in receiving yards (54) and receptions (six) at [RV] Liberty. Goodman has tallied 88 yards on nine receptions in the first three games.

## GOODMAN ON EARL CAMPBELL TYLER ROSE AWARD WATCH LIST

WR **Trev Goodman** was selected to the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List on Aug. 21. Goodman, a senior transfer wide receiver, brings stellar numbers to the 915 after following new UTEP head coach Scotty Walden from Austin Peay. The product of Atlanta, Ga., started in all 12 games at Austin Peay in 2023, helping to lead the Governors to a 9-3 overall record, a 6-0 mark and championship title in the United Athletic Conference, and an FCS playoff berth. Goodman was dynamic in Walden's offense as he led the Govs with seven touchdown receptions and yards per catch (21.2 avg.). Overall he tallied 721 yards (second best on the team) on 34 catches (third best) and earned All-UAC first team honors.

## SHAY SEEING PLAYING TIME

True freshman QB Shay Smith, a graduate from Franklin High School, saw action late in the game at Nebraska. Smith completed his two pass attempts for 14 yards with a long pass of 11 yards to redshirt freshman RB Joshua Dye. Smith also ran a play at [RV] Liberty.

## FIRST CAREER START

RT Luka Matamoros started his first career game on Sept. 14 at [RV] Liberty. The true freshman has played in two games after making his collegiate debut against SUU on Sept. 7 in Sun Bowl Stadium.

# **CUSA LEADERS IN TACKLES**

Spur Kory Chapman and LB Dorian Hopkins are tied first in Conference USA with Jax State's Antonio Carter II in total tackles (34) and tackles per game (11.3).

# **CHAPMAN & HOPKINS IN FBS**

Kory Chapman and Dorian Hopkins are ranked tied for seventh in FBS in total tackles (34) and tackles per game (11.3).

# LUKE #LiveLikeLuke LAUFENBERG

The UTEP football team will continue to pay tribute to the late Luke Laufenberg throughout the 2024 season. Laufenberg passed away at the age of 21 on Thursday, Aug. 22, 2019 after battling cancer for two years. A tight end from Argyle, Texas, Laufenberg joined the Miners for 2019 spring ball after playing at Mesa Community College in 2017. UTEP players have worn black "LUKE" stickers on their helmets since the start of the 2019 season. Redshirt sophomore WR Javoni Gardere will wear his #2 Laufenberg jersey throughout the season. WR Justin Garrett was the first Miner to don the #2 jersey during the 2020 season and continued the trend in 2021. QB Gavin Hardison was the second Miner to don the #2 jersey (2022-23). Laufenberg played his senior season at Argyle Liberty Christian High School in Argyle, Texas, where he was named 2016 Offensive Newcomer of the Year and honorable mention All-District. He initially walked on at Texas A&M before continuing his football career at Mesa Community College, where he appeared in six games prior to being diagnosed with Burkitt lymphoma.





The "Trench Warrior" is a single digit that is assigned to the most deserving D-Lineman. They are a leader, and they embody UTEP's culture on and off the field. It is something head coach Scotty Walden created to signify that wearing a single digit on the DL means you're a "bad dude." On Aug. 26, Walden announced that senior nose tackle Sione Tonga'uiha will don the no. 3 number in 2024.



# **CHAPMAN THE HITMAN**

**Kory Chapman** led the UTEP defense with 11 tackles at [RV] Liberty. Chapman added a sack (six yards) and a TFL against the Flames. It's Chapman's third consecutive double-digit tackle effort while he's totaled 34 tackles (16 solo) in the first three games. It's also Chapman's seventh double-digit tackle performance in his collegiate career after tallying four at his previous school (Austin Peay). Chapman leads UTEP with 3.5 tackles for loss and ranks tied for fourth in CUSA.

# FIRST SACK IN A UTEP UNIFORM

**Kory Chapman** recorded his first sack as a Miner at Liberty. Chapman got to Liberty QB Kaidon Salter for a six-yard loss during the second quarter. For Chapman, it was his first full sack since 2022, and his fifth career sack after tallying 4.0 at Austin Peay.

## **D-HOP SWARMING**

LB **Dorian Hopkins** has also been impressive to start 2024, as he gathered another nine tackles at [RV] Liberty, and upped his total to 34 stops – tied most in CUSA with two other players including teammate Kory Chapman. Hopkins is averaging 11.3 tackles per game, ranked tied for seventh in FBS. The graduate senior transfer has added 2.0 tackles for loss, a fumble recovery, and a forced fumble in his first and only season with the Miners.

# HOPKINS'S STELLAR DEBUT

LB **Dorian Hopkins**, a graduate transfer from Tulsa, racked up a collegiate career-high 16 tackles (six solo) along with a tackle for loss and first career fumble recovery at Nebraska on Aug. 31. Hopkins is the first Miner since LB **AJ Hotchkins** to lead the team in tackles in their UTEP debut. Hotchkins tallied 13 stops against Northern Arizona on Sept. 1, 2018, in his first game as a Miner.

# MOST TACKLES IN A SEASON OPENER SINCE 2009

**Dorian Hopkins's** 16 tackles were the most during a season opener in 15 seasons. DB **Da'Mon Cromartie-Smith** racked up 19 stops to open the 2009 campaign against Buffalo on Sept. 5.

## X MARKS THE STOP

S **Xavier Smith** recorded a season-high 10 tackles and recovered his first collegiate fumble at [RV] Liberty. It's Smith's fourth double-digit tackle effort in his collegiate career after registering three at Austin Peay last season. Smith has 25 tackles, ranking third in the team.

# TAFUNA'S FIRST SACK/FORCED FUMBLE

NT **Tevita Tafuna**, a redshirt senior, recorded his first career quarter-back sack and forced fumble during the second quarter at [RV] Liberty.

# DYMAN IN THE ROUGH

LB **Nate Dyman**, in his second consecutive start, registered a career-best nine tackles and recorded his first career fumble recovery at [RV] Liberty. Dyman in his first career start against SUU on Sept. 7, recorded his first career tackles for loss (1.5) and pass breakup. Overall in his first full season, Dyman has tallied 17 tackles (fifth most on the team), while his 2.5 tackles for loss ranks second on the defense.

## JUMP ON THE BALL

UTEP has recovered three fumbles in 2024, ranking second in CUSA behind Kennesaw State (four). LB **Dorian Hopkins**, S **Xavier Smith** and LB **Nate Dyman** have each recovered fumbles so far.

# FORCING THE ISSUE

Three Miners have each forced a fumble as S Landon Hullaby, NT Tevita Tafuna and LB Dorian Hopkins are three of 19 CUSA players who have forced a fumble in 2024.

CB AJ Odums has started in 15 consecutive games since transferring to UTEP before the 2023 season. It's tied for the longest active streak by a Miner. The senior started all 12 games last year and all three in '24. For his career, Odums has started in 28 straight games dating back to the 2022 season while playing at New Mexico. Since the beginning of the '22 campaign, Odums has started in 26 of 27 games played and 26 of 32 games during his college career.

# MO'S 15 STRAIGHT STARTS

Bandit Maurice Westmoreland has also started in 15 consecutive games, tied for the longest active streak by a Miner. Westmorland played in all 12 games in 2022 and started in all 12 last year. Overall, Westmoreland has started in 15 of 27 games since transferring to UTEP from Kilgore College.

## KEEPING LIBERTY'S RUSHING ATTACK IN CHECK

UTEP allowed a season-low 187 rushing yards at [RV] Liberty. The Flames went into the ball game averaging 248.0 per contest.

# FIRST CAREER SACKS FOR KD

DT KD Johnson, who was picked as one of UTEP's CUSA Preseason Players to Watch, registered his first career sack in the third quarter during the Southern Utah contest. Johnson got to the QB again, recording his second sack during the overtime period. It was Johnson's first multi-sack game since getting 2.0 at Blinn College on Sept. 11, 2021, while playing at Kilgore College. Johnson recorded 9.0 sacks in 22 career games at Kilgore.

# KD'S SECOND SEASON SO FAR

**KD Johnson** ranks tied second in Conference USA with four other players with his 2.0 sacks. He's added eight total tackles and 2.0 tackles for loss in 2024.

## FIRST CAREER FULL SACK

Spur **Josiah Allen** recorded his first career full sack during the second quarter against Southern Utah. He previously had recorded a 0.5 sack at Northwestern last season.

# MO ON A TRIO OF WATCH LISTS

Maurice Westmoreland was named to the Bronko Nagurski Watch List on July 30, the Lombardi Award Watch List on Aug. 15, and Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List on Aug. 21. The product of Houston put up big numbers in 2023, racking up a team-high 7.5 sacks. Westmoreland earned the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week after the tremendous effort.

P Adam Jacklin stayed in the state of Texas and transferred from North Texas to boot balls at UTEP in 2023. The redshirt freshman is a 27-year old native of Melbourne, Australia. Jacklin will be the third consecutive Aussie punting at UTEP following P Joshua Sloan (2020-2023) and P Mitchell Crawford (2018-2019).

# HIS FIRST CLASS IS FIRST CLASS

UTEP Head Coach Scotty Walden's first ever signing class included multiple three-star rated student-athletes by 247Sports, while his first class ranked no. 1 in Conference USA according to Rivals.com and no. 2 according to 247Sports.

# QUICK RUNDOWN OF NSD 2024

During the early signing day period, 23 players were inked in December before revealing nine midyear transfers during the month of January. On Feb. 7, 2024, National Signing Day, Scotty Walden added 14 freshmen to the roster.

# INSTILLING THE BRAND AND CULTURE

Eleven players from Austin Peay transferred the UTEP following Scotty Walden's hire. SPUR Kory Chapman, WR Trey Goodman, RB Jevon Jackson, QB Skyler Locklear, WR Ashton Nickelberry, WR Kenny Odom, OL Brennan Smith, S Xavier Smith, RB Marquez Taylor, MB Kam Thomas and OL Isaiah Wright are now Miners and have been vital in helping the spread Walden's style and culture in the program.

## GO WEST. YOUNG MAN

The Miners' coaching staff is the third youngest in the nation at 34.7 years old. UTEP ranks behind Old Dominion (34.5) and Georgia Southern (33.2). Indiana (38.2), Sam Houston (38.9), UTSA (39.2) and Iowa State (40.0) round out the top seven youngest staff.

## YOUNG GUNS

UTEP football assistants running backs coach Jourdan McNeill and wefense coordinator Joe Pappalardo were recognized to the prestigious 247Sports annual 30Under30 list on Aug. 7. The initial list in 2017 included multiple future FBS head coaches including current head coach Scotty Walden.

# **UP NEXT**

# **SUL ROSS STATE '12** FIRST SEASON AT UTEP SEVENTH SEASON AS A HEAD COACH

Scotty Walden, native Texan and one of the most dynamic young head coaches in the country, was named UTEP Football's 27th head coach on Dec. 4, 2023.

Walden, 34, joins the Miners after four seasons as the head coach at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tenn. This year, he led the Governors to a 9-3 record, a perfect 6-0 mark in the United Athletic Conference, and a no. 13 FCS national ranking. It marked the first undefeated conference season in school history. He was named a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, presented by FedEx Ground and Stats Perform to the FCS National Coach of the Year. Austin Peav has won four conference titles since 1977 - with two coming under Walden's watch. He is the only coach to lead Austin Peay to two conference championships.

The Cleburne, Texas, native led the Governors to a 26-14 mark with four winning seasons (4-2 in COVID-shortened 2020-21 campaign, 6-5 in 2021, 7-4 in 2022, 9-3 in 2023). The Governors hadn't enjoyed back-to-back winning campaigns since 1983-84 prior to Walden's arrival. His career head coaching record is 34-20, including 7-3 in one season heading up the program at East Texas Baptist University in 2016. Walden was also interim head coach at Southern Miss for four games in 2020.

The 2023 Austin Peay squad ranked fourth nationally in passing efficiency (162.17), ninth in scoring offense (34.1 ppg), 11th in passing completion percentage (.667), 13th in passing offense (274.1 ypg) and 15th in total offense (426.8 ypg). The Governors set school

records for scoring offense, total offense and passing offense. Austin Peay also rated seventh in the country in third down conversion defense with a stingy .303 percentage, and the Governors' three defensive touchdowns ranked 12th nationally. Austin Peay's special teams unit was equally stellar, leading the country in punt returns with a 21.3-yard average.

Austin Peay rattled off a school-record nine consecutive wins after opening the season 0-2, including a 30-13 setback at then-ninth ranked Tennessee on Sept. 9. Playing before over 100,000 hostile fans, the Governors were tied with the Vols, 6-6, shortly before halftime and trailed by 10 points (23-13) midway through the fourth quarter.

In 2022, Walden led the Governors to the third conference title in program history. Austin Peay was the top defense in the ASUN Conference, ranking fourth in the FCS in third down conversion percentage defense (.308), 12th in total defense (317.2 ypg), 19th in passing defense (188.7 ypg) and 20th in rushing defense (128.5 ypg). Offensively, Austin Peay averaged 202.3 rushing yards and

243.3 passing yards per game, marking the first time in program history that the Governors averaged 200-plus rushing and passing yards per game in the same season.

In 2021, the Governors tied a school record with seven First Team All-OVC selections and 14 total All-OVC picks.

While at Austin Peay, Walden has coached four consensus All-America honorees - Kordell Jackson (2020), DeAngelo Wilson (2020), Johnathon Edwards (2021) and Koby Perry (2021). Bucky Williams was an American Football Coaches Association Second Team All-American and a HERO Sports Sophomore All-American in 2020. Draylen Ellis and Terrell Allen received Sophomore All-America honors in 2021. Drae McCray was also tabbed a HERO Sports All-America in 2021.

Walden has also coached 28 All-Conference players and four league All-Newcomer selections during his time at Austin Peay.

His teams have also excelled academically. In five of six semesters since Walden's arrival, the Governors posted a 3.0 cumulative team grade point average, including a program record 3.28 GPA during the spring 2022 semester. The Governors also claimed the 2020-21 and 2021-22 OVC Team Academic Achievement Awards.

After joining the Southern Miss staff as wide receivers coach in 2017, he was promoted to co-offensive coordinator for the 2019 season. In 2019, the American Football Coaches Association tabbed Walden as a Top 35 coach under 35 years of age. He coached first team All-Conference USA selection wideout Quez Watkins, who led the league with 64 catches and 1,178 receiving yards (17th in the FBS). Watkins' 107.1 receiving yards per game also ranked sixth in the FBS. He was selected in the sixth round of the 2020 NFL Draft by Philadelphia, and has appeared in 45 games for the Eagles with 23 starts since then.

Walden took over for Jay Hopson as interim head coach at Southern Miss in September of 2020, and was hired by Austin Peay as head coach shortly thereafter.

Walden was the youngest head coach in the NCAA (26 years old) at the time of his hiring at East Texas Baptist. He directed the Tigers to a national ranking in a school-record nine consecutive weeks, climbing as high as no. 15. East Texas Baptist also generated the no. 1 scoring offense (49.9 points per game) for all levels of the NCAA and the no. 2 total offense in Division III (school-record 564.3 yards per game).

Walden was offensive coordinator at East Texas Baptist for three years (2013-15) prior to being elevated to head coach. In his time as an assistant, ETBU football players broke a combined 26 individual and team records. One of his protégés was wide receiver Jamaine Sherman, a first team All-Conference honoree who became the first player in school history to sign an NFL contract with the St. Louis Rams in 2014.

He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Sul Ross State, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the 2012 season. His team broke 16 offensive school records in 2012, including most yards in a game (800) and points in a game (75). The Lobos ranked no. 1 in Division III in total offense (581.9 ypg), no. 2 in first downs (271), no. 3 in scoring offense (48.8 ppg), no. 9 in passing efficiency (164.30), no. 11 in passing offense (333 ypg) and no. 19 in rushing offense (248.9 ypg). Walden coached six All-Conference players, two D3football.com All-Americans and one Beyond Sports Network All-American.

He began his college playing days at Dordt College in Sioux Center, Iowa (2008), where he was named the starting quarterback as a freshman. His career continued at Hardin-Simmons University (2009-10), where he doubled as a quarterback and defensive back, before concluding at Sul Ross State as a quarterback and team captain in 2011.

He earned his Bachelor of History, graduating Magna Cum Laude, from Sul Ross State in 2012. He added a Master of Education, graduating Summa Cum Laude, from Sul Ross State in 2014.

Walden and his wife, Callie have two sons, Luca and Maverick.



# **UTEP FOOTBALL 2024 RECAPS**

## Game #1



# Lincoln, Neb. • Memorial Stadium (86,072) Aug. 31, 2024

UTEP tied the game at seven apiece however Nebraska would go on to score 33 unanswered points to down the Miners 40-7 in Memorial Stadium on Tom Osborne Field on Aug. 31.

The Cornhuskers (1-0) ran up 507 yards on 83 plays, including 223 yards on the ground with three rushing scores. Nebraska added 30 first downs, was only penalized three times (35 yards) and finished 11-of-17 on third-down conversions. The Miners (0-1) tallied 205 yards while being penalized nine times (76 yards).

Nebraska struck first with a 72-yard touchdown drive on 12 plays, resulting in a Dante Dowdell five-yard touchdown run.

Following UTEP's first possession where it was forced to punt, the Miners' defense settled in and stopped the Cornhuskers on a fourth-and-5 to get the ball back at their own 37.

UTEP took advantage and went 63 yards on only three plays to score its first touchdown in the Walden era. Skyler Locklear, in his first career collegiate start, found Kam Thomas for a 38-yard touchdown strike to tie the game 7-7 with 2:24 left in the first quarter.

Locklear started the game 5-for-5 with 59 yards and a TD. He finished 11-of-17 with 115 yards a touchdown and an interception. Thomas opened his UTEP debut with 71 yards on seven receptions and a score.

On Nebraska's fourth drive, the Cornhuskers drove the ball down inside the 20 but Dowdell fumbled the ball following a 12-yard rush. Landon Hullaby was credited with a forced fumble while Dorian Hopkins recovered the ball at the UTEP 3 at the 10:48 mark of the second quarter.

# El Paso, Texas • Sun Bowl Stadium (41,609) Sept. 7, 2024

The UTEP football team came up short in Scotty Walden's home debut as Southern Utah used a strong second half to down the Miners 27-24 in overtime in front of 41,607 rowdy fans at Sun Bowl Stadium on Sept. 7.

The Miners (0-2) tallied 423 yards of total offense, including 299 in the air. However, 14 penalties for 122 yards and the Thunderbirds' (1-1) rushing attack (268 yards) were too much for UTEP to overcome.

SUU's Targhee Lambson ran downhill, picking up 183 yards on 20 carries (9.2 avg.) and two touchdowns. Lambson's first TD got the T-Birds within three points (17 14) while his second score put his squad up 21-17 at the 13:15 mark of the fourth

UTEP starting quarterback Skyler Locklear did a little of everything in his Sun Bowl debut. The redshirt sophomore threw for 295 yards on 22-of-29 passing and a touchdown. Not only did he toss one, but he also rushed for a score and caught another. Locklear added 47 yards on the ground.

Locklear's touchdown reception was off a four-yard pass from Jaden Smith with no time left on the clock. The Miners tied the game at 24 apiece following Buzz Flabiano's PAT to take the contest into overtime.

SUU got the ball first and Danny King converted a 33-yard field goal to take a three-point advantage. The Miners came up short on their possession in the extra period. Flabiano attempted to tie the game with a 38-yard attempt that was missed. The Miners were fortunate as an offsides penalty was called that extended the game. UTEP, behind a loud fan base urging their Miners, came up short again as Flabiano missed a 32-yard attempt that ended the contest.

# Lynchburg, Va. • Williams Stadium (21,805) Sept. 14, 2024

UTEP cleaned up the penalties and scored on a long pass play to get within four points while the Miners' defense stepped up and made plays, however, Liberty scored two touchdowns late in the contest to pull away 28-10 in Williams Stadium on Sept. 14.

The Miners (0-3, 0-1 Conference USA) held the Flames (3-0, 2-0 CUSA) to only 187 rushing yards as LU came into the ball game averaging 248.0 per game. The UTEP defense also held Liberty under 100 yards of its season average (503.0 ypg).

After last week's 14 penalties, UTEP only committed two all game for a total of 25 yards. Liberty started the game 2-for-3 on third downs, but the Miners' D stopped the Flames on the next six third-down plays. Liberty finished the game 5-of-13.

Skyler Locklear finished with 244 yards on career bests of attempts (43) and completions (26). He also found Kenny Odom on a 60-yard touchdown pass in the third quarter to make the score 14-10 early in the third quarter. For Odom, it was a career-long reception and his first score in a UTEP uniform.

Kam Thomas finished with 129 all-purpose yards, his third consecutive triple-digit game. Thomas added 68 yards on eight receptions, while Jaden Smith tallied 42 yards on seven catches and Trey Goodman recorded 54 yards on six grabs.

Defensively, Kory Chapman registered his third consecutive double-digit tackle effort (11) to lead the Miners and posted his first full sack in two seasons. Xavier Smith tallied 10 tackles, his most in a UTEP uniform, and his fourth collegiate career double-digit tackle performance. Smith added his first collegiate fumble recovery. Nate Dyman added a career-high nine stops, a TFL and recovered his first career fumble. Tevita Tafuna recorded his first career sack and forced fumble.
