OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jake Retzlaff • Sr. • QB • Tulane

Retzlaff registered 356 yards of total offense and had four rushing touchdowns as Tulane remained undefeated with a 34-27 win against Duke. Retzlaff rushed for a game-high 111 yards on 17 carries and completed 15 of 23 passes for 245 yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Shane Whitter • Sr. • LB • North Texas

Whitter led a defense that limited Washington State to 275 total yards and 10 points in a 59-10 win. He had a game-high eight tackles and had a hand in two key turnovers in the first half, helping North Texas build a 42-3 halftime lead.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Solomon Beebe • So. • RB/KR • UAB

Beebe finished with 190 all-purpose yards, including 154 yards on kickoff returns, to help UAB to a 31-28 win against Akron. Beebe opened the game with a 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown.

Had a sack, 2.0 tackles for loss and a forced fumble in a 38-0 win at Coastal Carolina.

Had a career-high 11 tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss and a half-sack in a 42-23 win at Tulsa.

Drew Mestemaker • RFr. • QB • North Texas

AMERICAN NOTEBOOK

Four Score

Four teams from the American sit at 3-0 through three weeks of the season – Memphis, Navy, North Texas and Tulane. The only other conferences with at least four 3-0 teams are the ACC, the Big 12, the Big Ten and the SEC. No other conferences have more than two 3-0 teams.

Streaking

Memphis enters Week 4 with a seven-game winning streak, which is tied with Ohio State and Illinois for the nation's longest active streak. Navy has won six straight, which ties Missouri, TCU and LSU for fourth.

20/20

Memphis and Army are both 17-3 in their last 20 games. Among FBS teams, only Oregon (18-2) has a better record over its last 20 games.

In The Books

North Texas is 11-0 under head coach Eric Morris when leading after three quarters.

Orwellian

North Texas, which ranked 118th nationally in scoring defense last season, has allowed only 40 points through three games this year – the fewest for the Mean Green through three games since 1984 (37).

Gauntlet

South Florida is the only team in college football to have opened the 2025 season with three consecutive games against top-25 teams. The Bulls defeated No. 25 Boise State in Week 1, No. 13 Florida in Week 2 and fell to No. 5 Miami last Saturday.

Millennial

East Carolina's 38-0 win at Coastal Carolina was the Pirates' first road shutout since a 38-0 win at Duke in 2000.

A Lot To A Little

East Carolina has outscored its three opponents by a 104-10 margin since halftime of its season opener against NC State.

Us Vs. Them

Memphis has won 10 consecutive nonconference games.

Hardware

The American Conference won the 2024 Bowl Challenge Cup as the FBS conference with the best winning percentage in Bowl Season. American teams were a combined 6-2 in bowl games in 2024, including wins against teams from the SEC, Big 12, ACC, Mountain West, Sun Belt and Conference USA.

The American had the FWAA National Defensive Player of the Week in each of the first two weeks of the season. South Florida LB Jhalyn Shuler was the Week 1 winner, while Army S Collin Matteson won in Week 2.

Oh Henry

UTSA RB Robert Henry has registered five consecutive 100-yard games. Henry leads the nation in rushing at 160 yards per game in 2025.

We're Available

The American will issue player availability reports in advance of all conference games in the 2025 season. Reports will be published to the American website and on social media two hours prior to kickoff.

Thursday Prime

This week marks the first of seven weeks in the 2025 season that will feature an American Conference game in prime time on ESPN platforms on Thursday nights. The series begins with Rice at Charlotte Sept. 18 and will feature pregame coverage on the 2 p.m. ET edition of SportsCenter. The Thursday night series remains in North Carolina in Week 5 as East Carolina hosts Army.

People Watching

More than 52 million viewers watched American Conference football on television in 2024. The American had 17 games that drew at least one million viewers.

National Brand

In the first year with both Army and Navy in the American, the annual Army-Navy game on CBS drew 9.4 million viewers, the largest television audience for the game since at least 1990 and a 31% increase over the 2023 game.

Must See TV

The 2024 American Championship Game between Army and Tulane drew more than 2 million viewers on ABC, marking the eighth time in 10 years that the game surpassed 2 million viewers.

Soar is a multi-platform brand symbol designed to personify our values and story. In fact, we are the first collegiate conference to unveil both a live and animated character to represent its brand.

From Day 1, he's been engineered to engage a wide range of audiences and to bridge the gap between the physical and digital realms of fandom.

The Bracket

The format of the College Football Playoff is built on a 12-team bracket. The five highest-ranked conference champions will earn a place in the Playoff, but will no longer include a bye for the four highest-ranked champions.

The 12-team bracket will now be seeded directly based on the final ranking of the CFP Selection Committee, with the four highest-ranked teams receiving a first-round bye. If one or more of the five highest-ranked conference champions are ranked outside the top 12, that team or teams would move up to the 12th seed, 11th seed, etc., based on the number of conference champions outside the top 12.

- The 12 participating teams will be the five conference champions ranked highest by the CFP selection committee, plus the next seven highest-ranked teams.
- The ranking of the teams will continue to be done by a selection committee.
- The eight teams seeded No. 5-12 will play in a first round with the higher seeds hosting the lower seeds either on campus or at other sites designated by the higher-seeded institution (No. 12 at No. 5, No. 11 at No. 6, No. 10 at No. 7 and No. 9 at No. 8).
- The four highest-ranked teams will be assigned to Playoff Quarterfinals bowls on Selection Day in ranking order and in consideration of current contract bowl relationships (for example: if the highest-ranked team is from the Big Ten, that team would be assigned to the Rose Bowl Game).
- The highest seed will receive preferential placement for the Playoff Semifinal bowl assignment.
- All 11 games will be under the CFP umbrella with the administrative policies determined by the CFP.

Selection Committee
