## OPENING TIP

- Colorado State ended its two-game losing streak with an emphatic 81-52 win over Air Force on Tuesday. Three Rams finished the game in double figures scoring, with six others finishing a basket away from joining them.
- The trio of Josh Pascarelli, Brandon Rechsteiner and Jase Butler each had 11 points, all making multiple 3-pointers.
- Kyle Jorgensen returned to the starting lineup for CSU with a nine points, four assists, two rebounds and two steals performance.
- The Rams forced Air Force into 14 turnovers, 10 of them via steal helping to lead to 21 fast break points.
- The ball was moving for CSU on the offensive end, finishing the night with 17 assists on 28 made baskets.
- Air Force was held to 52 points on 35.8% shooting, the points total was a season-low for any opponent this year and field goal % the second lowest.
- Friday night's game is the second meeting this year between Colorado State and Utah State. The Aggies won the first meeting in Utah a month ago, 100-58.
- CSU ranks 83rd in the nation and third in the Mountain West in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.39.
- The Rams 16.0 assists per game are the third best in the Mountain West and 87 th in the nation.
- Colorado State is assisting on 60.5% of its made field goals on the year, the 27th best mark in the nation.
- The Rams are one of six programs in the nation shooting over 50.0% overall, 35.0% from behind the arc and 75.0% from the free throw line. They rank 20th, fourth and 32nd in the respective categories.
- CSU's effective field goal percentage of 60.2% is fifth in the nation and leads the Mountain West.
- Colorado State has a pair of Mountain West Players of the Week so far this season in Kyle Jorgensen and Josh Pascarelli.
- Jorgensen's performance over the first week earned him Mountain West Player of the Week honors. The sophomore averaged 20.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.0 steal in the first two games of the season.
- Pascarelli earned his honor after his performance against Colorado (12/6/25). The junior scored 26 points connecting on eight 3-pointers for the second straight game.
- CSU earned a second straight trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2024-25 and third in four years.
- Colorado State's 26 wins in 2024-25 tied for the second most in program history. They finished one win behind the record of 27 set by the 2014-15 team.
- The Rams welcomed the best transfer portal class in the Mountain West in 2025 ranking 61st in the nation.
- Colorado State has the longest active streak of having a player on the first team All-Mountain West list at seven years. Nico Carvacho (2019-20), David Roddy (2021-22), Isaiah Stevens (2023-24) and Nique Clifford (2025).
- Nique Clifford became the fourth player in program history to be picked in the first round of the NBA Draft in June. Clifford was the 24th pick overall by Oklahoma City with his rights traded to Sacramento.
- Clifford had one of the best seasons in program history his final year. He earned AP All-America honorable mention, was the MVP for the Mountain West Tournament and helped the program earn its first Mountain West title since 2003 by winning the Mountain West Tournament.

## Ali Farokhmanesh

### Head Coach (12-7 overall & at CSU) First Season Overall, First at CSU

Ali Farokhmanesh was named the 21st head men's basketball coach in program history on March 26, 2025.

He spent seven seasons in Fort Collins as an assistant coach and associate head coach before taking over as the lead man of the Rams.

During his seven years as an assistant, he helped the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances (2022, 2024, 2025) and advanced to the semifinals of the NIT in 2021. Along with bringing home CSU's first Mountain West Tournament title in 22 years.

Over his final four seasons as an assistant coach, Farokhmanesh has played a key role in developing NBA talents David Roddy, Isaiah Stevens and Nique Clifford. That trio, along with Nico Carvacho, has led Colorado State to have the longest active streak of first team All-Mountain West selections, standing at seven years.

Colorado State has won 25-plus games in three of the past four seasons and 20-plus five times since Farokhmanesh arrived on the campus.

Farokhmanesh came to Fort Collins from Drake, where he was also an assistant coach for a season.

Before Drake, he worked as a graduate assistant and then Director of Player Relations and Development at Nebraska. He managed and oversaw the off-the-court responsibilities of the student-athletes, including implementing mentoring programs and community outreach. On campus, he directed recruiting operations, including on-campus hosting duties.

Farokhmanesh's coaching career follows a storied playing career at Northern Iowa. He helped UNI to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances, including the program's first-ever Sweet 16. He hit one of the most memorable shots in March Madness history to send the Panthers to the Sweet 16 with his fastbreak 3-pointer with 34 seconds left to knock off top-seed Kansas.

He went on to play four years of professional basketball in Europe, competing for teams in the Netherlands, Austria and Switzerland.

Farokhmanesh received his degree in finance from UNI in 2010 and earned his master's degree in educational administration from Nebraska in 2016. Ali and his wife Mallory have sons Tai, Liam and Luka and daughter Mila.

His parents Mashallah Farokhmanesh and Cindy Fredrick were long-time college volleyball coaches at Iowa, Washington State and UNLV.

## Last Time Out

Colorado State returned to the win column with a dominate 81-52 victory over Air Force on Tuesday.

CSU had no one score over 11 points, but nine players had seven or more points. Brandon Rechsteiner, Jase Butler and Josh Pascarelli all had 11 points, making multiple 3-pointers.

Defensively, CSU held the Falcons to 52 points and 35.8% shootings. These numbers are the lowest and second lowest by an Rams' opponent this season.

## Scouting the Aggies

Utah State comes into Friday's game looking a to snap a two-game losing streak. The Aggies are 15-3 on the year and 6-2 in Mountain West play, a game behind San Diego State for first place.

USU is led by the duo of MJ Collins and Mason Falslev. Collins is averaging 19.3 points per game and Falslev 16.9. Both are dangerous behind the arc making over 38.0% of their 3-point attempts.

Falslev also leads the team in rebounds (6.3), assists (2.7) and steals (2.4) per game.

Utah State likes to pressure the ball and force opponents into turnovers. They are forcing 15.1 turnovers a game, 9.7 of them via a steal to ignite their offense.

## History against Utah State

Colorado State's win streak in the series was snapped by Utah State in December and the Aggies hold a 64-46 advantage overall.

The Rams have held serve on home court with a 31-21 record in Fort Collins.

## Rams against the Mountain West

Part of the original eight founding members of the conference, CSU has been in the Mountain West since 1999. The Rams are 455-477 all-time against current conference members.

Since the conferences inception, Colorado State is 259-227.

## (U)Nique Talent

Nique Clifford was only in Fort Collins for two seasons but left his finger prints all over it with his development becoming just the fourth first round pick in program history.

In his final year at CSU, Clifford earned AP All-America honorable mention, All-Mountain West selection and the Mountain West Tournament MVP.

Clifford set the program's single-season scoring record and the first player in CSU men's basketball history to record a season of 500 points, 300 rebounds and 100 assists.

Drafted by the Oklahoma City Thunder with the 24th overall pick and rights traded to Sacramento, Clifford is averaging 5.3 points, 3.0 rebound and 1.3 assists for the Kings this season.

## The Mbemba Factor

Rashaan Mbemba provides a big presence for the Rams on the floor.

He missed the first four games of the year due to an ankle injury, but started to find his form at the Battle 4 Atlantis against Virginia Tech. He scored 12 points off the bench including 10 in the second half were he was a perfect 4-for-4 with a pair of free throws.

Mbemba sustained an injury at the end of the Virginia Tech game that kept him out until January 9. In his return, the Austrian scored 11 points and grabbed six rebounds off the bench. He played a key factor down the stretch in the win over UNLV.

He continues to round into form since his return with a strong 17 points, 6-for-7 shooting performance at Boise State. That included making a career-best two 3-pointers in the game.

He has been a big factor when he plays 15-plus minutes in a game for the Rams. Over his career, CSU is 28-8 when Mbemba plays 15 or more minutes.

The Austrian recorded the first 20-point game of his career with 22 at home against UNLV in 2024-25. Mbemba was 8-for-9 from the field in the performance and made all six of his free throw attempts.

Over the nine game stretch from December 14, 2024-January 18, 2025 he averaged 11.1 points on 72.2% (39-54) shooting with 4.8 rebounds.

Mbemba recorded his first career double-double in the home win over Nevada in 2024-25 when he scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds.

## Young Big, Growing Up

Kyle Jorgensen has taken a big second year leap, averaging 12.6 points and 4.7 rebounds per game while shooting 61.5% from the field and 48.6% behind the arc.

The sophomore has shown he enjoys opening week. After winning the Mountain West Freshman of the Week honor to open the 2024-25 season, he added to it with the Mountain West Player of the Week to start his sophomore season.

The Minneapolis native averaged 20.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.0 steal to start the 2025-26 season.

Jorgensen finished a rebound shy of his first career double-double against Incarnate Word. He had career-highs in points (15) and rebounds (9).

He upped that performance with a 25-point effort against Omaha the next time out adding in another nine rebounds. He scored his 25 points on 8-of-12 shooting adding seven made free throws. After battling foul trouble against Cal Poly he responded with a 15 point effort at Loyola Chicago, including making a career-best three 3-pointers.

He looked to put the team on his back in the second half against Denver with 27 of his career-high 29 points coming in the final 20 minutes.

Jorgensen again flirted with his first career double-double against Virginia Tech finishing the game with 11 point and career-high matching nine rebounds and four assists.

He was a perfect 6-for-6 against Wichita State scoring 16 points to go with a career-high tying four assists.

Jorgensen surpassed the 20 point mark in the win over rival Colorado with 21 points. It was a complete game from him matching his career-high in made 3s with three and grabbing a career-best three steals. He added in seven rebounds and three assists.

He missed time after sustaining a knee injury to open conference play at Utah State on December 20. He returned to action on January 16 playing 16 minutes off the bench making a 3-pointer to go with a rebound and assist.

A month after his injury, Jorgensen returned to the starting line up against Air Force scoring nine points to go with four assists, two rebounds and two steals in the win.

## Pa(SCORE)III

Josh Pascarelli can score and score in bunches for the Colorado State. The junior transfer from Marist is averaging 12.1 points per game making 2.63 3-pointers a contest on a mark of 44.2%. The sharp shooting from behind the arc ranks him 93rd in the nation per game and 22st for percentage.

Pascarelli has made at least three 3-pointers in seven games this season.

He opened the 2025-26 season with 18 points against Incarnate Word, connecting four times behind the arc.

The New Yorker started hot against Omaha making his first three 3-pointers and finishing the night with 15 points, four rebounds and four assists.

Pascarelli put on a show behind the arc against Cal Poly with six makes on his way to a team-leading 22 points.

He broke out of shooting slump in a big way against South Florida going a perfect 8-for-8 behind the arc on the way to 28 points.

The eight made 3s was one off tying the program record for 3-pointers in a game.

There was no cooling off or slowing down for him against Colorado. Pascarelli turned in another eight 3s performance going 8-for-10 from the field. His biggest basket was a step-back two inside the final minute to cap off his 26 point game and secure the win for CSU.

The New Yorker surpassed 1,000 career points in the game against UNLV on January 9. He currently sits at 1,036.

## Rec(steiner) 6 Roll

Brandon Rechsteiner and his family are no newcomers to show business and Rechsteiner put on a show his first time on the Moby Arena court.

The junior transfer scored a career-high-tying 19 points including hitting four 3-pointers while adding in six assists in the 2025-26 season-opener against Incarnate Word.

Rechsteiner torched the nets against Wichita State at the Battle 4 Atlantis. His seven made 3s tied for the ninth most in a game in program history. The 21 points were also a career-high.

Against rival Colorado, he turned in a complete performance making a trio of threes on his way to 11 points along side a team-leading six assists.

In conference play, he has reached double figures all seven games, averaging 14.1 points. He has back-to-back games of 14 points against Nevada and Grand Canyon.

Rechsteiner led the team with 15 points and four assists in the win over UNLV.

He continued the hot streak with 17 points at Boise State, making five 3-pointers.

He has become a dynamic play maker for the Rams averaging 12.7 points and 3.1 assists per game. He is shooting 43.0% behind the arc to rank second in the Mountain West and 21st in the nation.

Rechsteiner is the son of "Big Poppa Pump" Scott Steiner.

## Show me the Muniz

Jevin Muniz did a little bit of everything for Colorado State in their season opener. The FGCU transfer had 13 points, team-high seven assists and four rebounds in the win.

Muniz showed off his court vision and ability to dish out the ball again against Cal Poly with seven assists to go along side seven rebounds.

While only scoring four points in the win over Wichita State he added in eight rebounds, six assists and three steals.

Muniz became the first Rams since Isaiah Stevens in 2024 to dish out at least 10 assists in a game when he had 10 against South Florida. He finished the game with the 10 assists, seven points, six rebounds a steal and block.

He had his best scoring game of the year against Nevada, leading the team with 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting. He added in five rebounds, two assists and a steal.

Muniz followed up the performance against Nevada with a strong showing at GCU. The senior scored 14 points, grabbed six rebounds, adding in three steals and two assists.

He had a strong game off the bench scoring 14 points to go with eight rebounds and five assists at Boise State.

The team's lone senior is averaging 8.9 points, 4.5 assists and 4.4 rebounds per game.

## Engelwood, Up to No Good

Carey Booth returned to the Centennial state this year after spending a year at Notre Dame and a year at Illinois. The junior attended Cherry Creek High School for three years before playing his final year of high school ball at Brewster Academy in New Hampshire.

Booth has settled in nicely at CSU averaging 11.3 points and 6.5 rebounds. He is able to stretch the floor shooting 56.9% from the field and 45.5% behind the arc. He has reached double figures scoring in 12 of 19 games this season.

He had a strong start to his season with 11 points and six rebounds against Incarnate Word.

Booth recorded his first career double-double in the win over Omaha with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

He made it two straight double-doubles with a 15 point, 10 rebound game against Cal Poly.

The junior missed out on a third straight double-double by a rebound against Loyola Chicago with 11 points and nine boards.

Booth recorded his third double-double in four games with an 18 points, 10 rebounds game against Denver.

He was flying around the court in the first half against Virginia Tech finishing the game with a team-leading 15 points. Eleven of those 15 game in the first half.

Booth became the first Rams to record five-plus blocks in a game since Stanton Kidd in 2015 with his career-high six against Nevada.

He finished a rebound and point shy of his career-highs with a 19 points, 12 rebounds game against Grand Canyon. It was his fourth double-double of the year.

In the win over UNLV, Booth stuffed the stat sheet with 13 points, six rebounds and three blocks going a perfect 3-for-3 behind the arc.

He had another strong game at Fresno State with 15 points, nine rebounds and a block.

## The Butler

Jase Butler has been a consistent presence for Colorado State all season long, working his way from a rotation player to starter.

The transfer from Washington had a career game against Cal Poly with 13 points, five rebounds and three assists, all career-highs at the time.

He then had a three-game stretch against South Florida, Colorado and Dartmouth where he reached double figures each game scoring 11, 10 and 10, respectively.

The South Florida game, he made a career-best three 3-pointers.

Butler rest his career-high scoring with 14 points off the bench against New Mexico to go with his third straight five rebound game.

He made his first career start at Boise State where he scored five points to go with a rebound and assist.

Butler had his second three 3-point game of his career against Air Force where he finished with 11 points, four rebounds and three assists.

On the year, he is averaging 7.7 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.2 assists in 21.6 minutes of play.

## Sharing is Caring

Ball movement and sharing the ball are key components of Colorado State's offense over the past five years. CSU has ranked in the top 100 in the nation in assists each year since 2021-21 season and top 50 for assist-to-turnover ratio.

## Free for a Reason

Colorado State has taken advantage of its free throws this season making 77.0% of them. That ranks 32nd in the nation.

The Rams eclipsed the 40 free throw attempt mark for the first time since the 2023-24 season with 44 attempts against Denver.

## Sharp Shooters

Colorado State is the best shooting team in the country. The Rams rank in the top 35 the nation in effective field goal percentage (60.2%, 5th), field goal percentage (50.2%, 20th), 3-point field goal percentage (41.0%, 4th) and free throw percentage (77.0%, 32nd).

The Rams are one of six teams in the nation to be shooting at least 50.0% from the field, 35.0% behind the arc and 75.0% from the free throw line.

The other six teams are: Akron, Iowa, Miami (OH), Saint Louis and Yale.

No team has ever ended the year leading the NCAA in field goal, 3-point and free throw percentage and only three times has a team finished first in two of the three categories

Not only is CSU shooting the ball well, but the Rams are making a lot of their 3-point attempts. Colorado State averages 10.5 3-pointers per game, ranking 27th in the nation

Josh Pascarelli and Brandon Rechsteiner have led that charge behind the arc with Rechsteiner averaging 2.89 makes per game each and Pascarelli 2.63, ranking 44th and 88th in the nation for 3-pointers per game.

Pascarelli leads the way for 3-point percentage at 44.2% with Rechsteiner right behind him at 43.0%.

Six Rams have at least 15 3-point makes or more this season.

## Non-Conference Warriors

Colorado State has become non-conference warriors over the past seven seasons. CSU is 57-18 in the regular season non-conference games. Its 15-game win streak was snapped with the loss at College of Charleston in 2022-23.

CSU has a record of 631-256 (.710) all-time at Moby Arena, including 86-20 (.808) the last seven years.

2019-20's 12-4 mark had to do with some significant difference in major categories in favor of the Rams, with similarities returning in a 10-1 mark in 2020-21, tying for the fifth-best single-season win percentage in Moby.

2021-22's 14-1 record at home follows a similar trend, as CSU tied for the second best home win percentage.

Colorado State had a 13-game home win streak that extended from the 2020-21 season to the 2021-22. It tied for the fourth-longest in arena history and sixth-longest in program history.

CSU recorded the second most home wins in program history with 15 last season.

## Lost Production

Colorado State will have to fill some lost production from last season with the loss of Nique Clifford, Jalen Lake, Kyan Evans, Jaylen Crocker-Johnshon, Keshawn Williams, Bowen Born and Ethan Morton from last season's rotation.

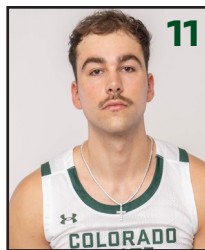

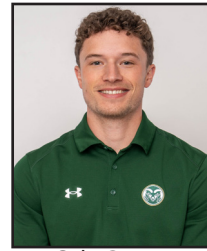
