 member Charleston Southern will face. CSU has wins over Ole Miss (2014-15) and South Carolina (1996-97) and seek
 another signature win as conference play gets closer.
- Dontrell Shuler has been a scoring machine for the Bucs tallying double digits in every contest including two 20-point
 efforts while Preseason Big South All-Conference First Team member Phlandrous Fleming Jr. has been crashing the
 boards turning in a pair of double-doubles, both coming on the road.

Home to CSU's men's and women's basketball and volleyball programs, the Buc Dome offers one of the most intimate settings for NCAA Division I sports in the nation. The Buc Dome is regularly packed with overflow, standing-room only crowds for men's basketball games, allowing CSU a distinct home court advantage.

The Bucs have hosted multiple postseason competitions in recent years including a home win for the men's basketball team over Florida Atlantic in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT).

CSU has finished .500-or-better inside the Buc Dome in 42 of the building's 52 seasons including an 18-year stretch spanning from 1981-82 through the 2002-03 season. The Bucs enter the 2019-20 season with three-straight winning campaigns in the Buc Dome including back-to-back 10-win efforts and .613 winning percentage all-time in the building.

LAST TIME OUT

- Charleston Southern held Delaware State without a field goal for nearly nine minutes down the stretch turning a 50-44 deficit into a 57-50 lead, one they would hold down the stretch to take a 71-61 victory and close their stay at the Maui on the Mainland games.
- Junior guard and All-Big South member Phlandrous Fleming Jr. recorded his second double-double and season-best 19 points in the comeback effort while grabbing 12 rebounds and finishing a perfect 12-for-12 from the free throw stripe to help ice the win.
- The Hornets saw a game-high 23 points from John Crosby, but the Buccaneer defense held Delaware State incheck over the final 10:53 of the contest and close the ballgame with a 27-11 run.
- Dontell Shuler added 18 points and tied his season-high with six assists in the win while Travis Anderson provided a spark off the bench knocking down a career-best four treys for 12 points. Sadarius Bowser added nine key rebounds while the trio of Deontaye Buskey, Sean Price and Ty Jones added 20 points combined with each hitting key baskets during offensive cold stretches.

A WIN ON TUESDAY WOULD...

- Be the first over a Power 5 or SEC team since Nov. 14, 2014 when the Bucs defeated Ole Miss 66-65 in Oxford, Miss
- · Be the third win versus and SEC foe all-time
- Give the Bucs a 1-0 record to begin a second-straight month
- Be the first true road win of the season after defeating Delaware State in a neutral site bout
- Give the Bucs a win over a top-40 program in the Ken-Pom rankings.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

- Missouri finished 5-13 in the SEC last season and was slated 13th in the preseason poll at SEC Media Days, but the Tigers have size and athleticism.
- Missouri boasts seven players taller than 6'7 on the roster and are led offensively by Dru Smith and Mark Smith who averaged 12.8 and 12.0 points per contest.
- The Tigers enter Tuesday's contest 4-3 after a 2-2 showing in the Hall of Fame Classic from Kansas City. Butler grabbed an 18-point first half lead and held on down the stretch to defeat the Tigers before...
- The Tigers are sixth in the SEC in steals per contest with 7.3 but have struggled to score at times averaging 68.0 points a contest. In their three losses, Missouri is averaging just 58.7 points a contest including a 63-58 0T loss at Xavier. In their four wins, the Tigers are averaging nearly 20-more points at 74.5 a contest.

CHALLENGING NOVEMBER SLATE

- Four of Charleston Southern's nonconference opponents sit inside the KenPom top-100 rankings headlined by No. 1 Michigan State.
- Of the four top-100 teams CSU plays, three come in a three-game stretch between Nov. 12 and Nov. 18.
- CSU begins that daunting stretch with Furman (98) at home followed by a trip to Dayton (56) Nov. 16 and a visit to East Lansing for the preseason No.1 team in America, Michigan State (1) just 48 hours later on Nov. 18.

 Missouri (38) also looms on the Buccaneer schedule to open the December slate while Southern Utah (207), James Madison (223) and Eastern Kentucky (260) all sit within 40 spots of the Bucs in the KenPom rankings.

MARCH MADNESS TASTE

- In one road trip, Charleston Southern will get to play in Dayton, Ohio and East Lansing, Mich. - the homes of two NCAA mainstays. On Nov. 16, the Bucs will take on the Dayton Flyers in UD Arena, the site of the NCAA First Four Round, the first four games of March Madness. The NCAA adopted the First Four model of the tournament prior to the 2010-11 season with Dayton as the designated host for the Opening Round, hosting four games across two nights.
- Two days laters, CSU heads to East Lansing to take on one of the most storied programs in the country in Michigan State and head coach Tom Izzo. The Spartans enter 2019-20 fresh off another Final Four run and have high expectations once again as the Big Ten favorites and a preseason No. 1 ranking.
- The Nov. 18 matchup with the Spartans also makes it the second time under head coach Barclay Radebaugh that the Bucs take on a Final Four team from the prior season - the last time it happened the Bucs traveled to Gainesville, Fla. to take on the back-to-back champion Gators in 2007-08.
- Both Dayton and Michigan State will head to the 2019
 Maui Invitational the following week as part of a loaded
 field. It will also be the first time CSU faces either program.

SHULER SHINES IN DEBUT SEASON

- Dontrell Shuler impressed in 2018-19 during his freshman campaign earning All-Freshman honors from the Big South Conference. A native of Columbia, S.C., Shuler quickly emerged as one of the best on-ball defenders in the league grabbing steals in clutch defensive situations throughout the season.
- Shuler also posted 10.9 points per game, 2.7 rebounds, 62 assists, 33 steals and shot .432 from the floor show-casing his versatility.
- He was one of three Bucs to average double figures last season and gave CSU their third-consecutive freshman to average double figures joining Christian Keeling and teammate Phlandrous Fleming Jr.

FLEMING NAMED ALL-CONFERENCE

- Phlandrous Fleming Jr. was named to the Big South's Preseason All-Conference First Team, as announced at Big South Media Days.
- The junior guard makes it back-to-back seasons the Bucs have a Preseason First Team member after Christian Keeling earned the nod last season.
- Fleming looks to step into a bigger scoring role as he leads all returners after averaging over 12.0 points per game as a sophomore.
- Fully healthy entering the preseason, Fleming looks to lead the Bucs and provide the same production from his rookie campaign that earned him a spot on the All-Freshman Team in the Big South. Fleming missed most of the nonconference slate last season before returning and providing over 12.0 points per contest.

Players of the Week

PLAYING BOTH ENDS

- Under the direction of Barclay Radebaugh, Charleston Southern has been known to turn up the pressure defensively forcing turnovers and getting out into transition. The Bucs ranked 11th in the NCAA in turnovers forced last season and have been among the tops in the Big South in scoring defense and offense during Radebaugh's tenure.
- Charleston Southern also took care of the rock last season finishing with the No. 18 turnover margin in the NCAA while placing a top-35 performance in total steals.
- The Bucs paced the Big South in offensive rebounds, steals, turnover margin and turnovers forced in 2018-19 on their way to another semifinals appearance.

TELL ME, WHO ARE YOU?

- Head coach Barclay Radebaugh and the Bucs will take on five programs for the first time in school history during nonconference play including Final Four mainstay Michigan State, SEC foe Missouri and Dayton from the A-10.
- CSU will also take on North Carolina A&T and N.C. Central from the MEAC for the first time in school history as they travel to Greensboro Nov. 8 in their second contest of the season to play the Aggies, then host the Eagles of NCCU Dec. 7 before the Christmas break.
- The five new teams on the schedule marks the most first-time matchups for CSU since the 2014-15 season when the Bucs played Ole Miss, Wright State, Central Arkansas, Colorado State and Johnson (Tenn.).
- Of the five first-time matchups on the schedule, three finished among the top-75 of the 2018-19 NET rankiings (Michigan State - 5, Dayton - 70, Missouri - 74).

POSTSEASON BOUND

- Charleston Southern has participated in three different postseason tournaments in program history, earning four postseason bids - all coming since the 1996-97 season.
- CSU has been to the NCAA Tournament (1996-97), NIT (2012-13 & 2014-15) and CIT (2018-19) all coming within the last 20 seasons.
- Of their four postseason appearances, the Bucs are 1-4 overall with a win over FAU (2018-19) of Conference-USA.
 Three of their five postseason opponents are current C-USA members inclusing Southern Miss (2012-13) and Old Dominion (2014-15). CSU has also taken on UCLA of the Pac-12 (1996-97) and fellow conference member Hampton (2018-19).
- The Bucs are one of five programs across the Big South Conference - Campbell, Gardner-Webb, Hampton and UNC Asheville - to appear in at least three seperate postseason basketball tournaments.
- CSU is also one of 31 programs across Division I to reach the exact same three postseason tournaments (NCAA, NIT, CIT) - Austin Peay, Ball State, Bowling Green, Bradley, Buffalo, Campbell, Chattanooga, Creighton, CSU Bakersfield, ETSU, George Washington, Georgia State, Hampton, Hawai'i, Holy Cross, Louisiana Tech, Loyola Marymount, Mercer, Missouri State, Norfolk State, Penn, San Francisco, South Albama, Stony Brook, Toledo, UNC Asheville, UNCW, Utah State, Weber State, Wright State.

Barclay Radebaugh has presided over one of the most successful stretches in Charleston Southern history during his 14 years as head coach. Radebaugh is the winningest coach in school history and one of only eight coaches to win multiple Big South Coach of the Year awards. He directed CSU to NIT berths in 2013 and 2015 as well as a trip to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) in 2019 with a win over Florida Atlantic inside the Buc Dome.

For the second-straight season, the Bucs made a late-season charge to capture a topsix Big South Tournament seed as they took care of No. 10 USC Upstate in the Opening Round then proceeded to upset No. 3 Winthrop to reach the semifinals. The Bucs finished with an 18-16 overall record and 9-7 Big South mark and made their CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) debut taking down Florida Atlantic from Conference-USA before battling with Big South foe Hampton. The Bucs' push as well as individual performances helped lead to two student-athletes earming All-Big South honors - highlighted by Christian Keeling making All-Big South first team and Dontrell Shuler earning All-Freshman honors.

Radebaugh delivered one of his best coaching jobs in 2017-18 as the Bucs won eight of their final 11 games and twice pushed UNC Asheville, the league's regular season champion, to the brink. Powered by Christian Keeling and a young nucleus featuring freshmen Phlandrous Fleming Jr. and Ty Jones, among others, CSU rallied from a 2-7 start to conference play to finish 9-9. CSU's 7-2 record during the second half of league action tied Asheville for the Big South's best mark. Included in that run was a win at eventual Big South Tournament champion Radford and the Bucs' first win at Winthrop since 2002. CSU also defeated Illinois State in overtime in November, knocking off a Redbirds squad that would go on to advance to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title game. Keeling collected Second Team All-Big South honors, while Fleming was named to the All-Freshman Team and was runner up for Freshman of the Year.

In 2016-17, a young team with eight newcomers gelled late in the year under Radebaugh's guidance. CSU went 8-8 over its final 16 games to rebound from an 0-4 start to Big South play and build momentum for the coming season. Keeling led the way with one of the best freshman seasons in Big South history. Keeling set a CSU freshman scoring record with 539 points, becoming the sixth freshman in league history to tally 500 points. He was named to the Big South All-Freshman Team and was an honorable mention all-conference pick.

Radebaugh has established CSU as a perennial Big South contender thanks in part to its ability to protect the Buc Dome. CSU went 13-2 at home in 2014-15, improving its mark in the building over a six-year stretch (2009-10 to 2014-15) to 67-18 overall, and 39-13 in Big South play.

Radebaugh led CSU to the National Invitation Tournament in 2015. The Bucs made the most of the experience just as they did in 2013, leading Old Dominion by six points at halftime before falling to the top-seeded Monarchs.

The postseason bid was CSU's second in three years after the program had just one in its first 47 years.

Saah Nimley capped off a brilliant playing career under Radebaugh's guidance by capturing Big South Player of the Year accolades. He was also named an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American, making him the first player in program history to receive the honor. Only 63 players in the entire country were recognized by the AP. Nimley finished the year ranked 5th nationally in scoring and three-pointers per game, had 17 20-point games, seven 30-point games, and was the only player in the country to record four consecutive 30-point efforts.

Will Saunders garnered 2nd Team All-Conference accolades under Radebaugh's tutleage, while Arlon Harper was named Honorable Mention All-Conference.

In 2012-13 the sophomore backcourt of Saah Nimley (All-Big South 1st Team) and Arlon Harper (All-Big South 2nd Team) led CSU to an NIT berth for just the second postseason appearance in program history. Radebaugh and a still young squad made the most of the experience, giving top-seeded Southern Miss all it could handle in a 78-71 loss before a raucous partisan crowd in Hattiesburg. 13033

Radebaugh earned Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors for his efforts in 2011-12, as the Bucs went 19-12 and advanced to the conference tournament semifinals behind a starting lineup which featured three freshmen and a junior college transfer. CSU's 19 wins were the program's most since 1994-1995, as the Bucs secured their first winning season since 1996-1997. Senior Kelvin Martin led the way for Radebaugh's young group, as the forward played his way onto the all-conference first team while earning a nod as the league's defensive player of the year for a second consecutive season. The freshmen duo of Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper helped power a CSU offense which featured outstanding balance and had four players in double figures for the majority of the season (Martin, Nimley, Harper, and Mathiang Muo). As a team, CSU finished the season 22nd nationally in scoring (76. 9 ppg), 20th in three-point field goals per game (8.4), 30th in three-point field goal percentage (38.0%), 40th in steals per game (8.1) and 27th in turnover margin (+2.7).

The Bucs opened the season in style when they led Big 12 power Kansas State by 14 at halftime, before taking the Wildcats all the way to the wire in a 72-67 loss. Radebaugh's squad also enjoyed a home-and-away sweep of Atlantic Sun foe Stetson, a 33-point home victory over VMI, an 18-point blowout of then first-place Campbell, a triumph at Big South regular season and tournament champion and previously undefeated UNC Asheville, and a conference tournament win over Liberty.

CSU took a step forward in 2010-2011 as well, as it went 16-16 overall and 9-9 in the Big South, finishing sixth in the conference. The Bucs went 12-3 at home, highlighted by a second straight win over The Citadel, and conference victories over the likes of rivals Winthrop and UNC Asheville.


