## >>OPENING TIP

- Charleston Southern opens Big South play with the first of 10 league series as they host Hampton. The Pirates are the first of three home series with the Virginia-based Big South schools followed by Radford (Jan. 9 & 10) and Longwood (Feb. 11 & 12).
- All three meetings in Big South play between the Bucs and Pirates have been high-flying, fast-paced affairs with the winner scoring at least 85 points each contest. Hampton's 72 points in the last meeting were the fewest scored in a regular season meeting by either side.
- Monday and Tuesday mark the first-ever back-to-back Charleston Southern will play in regular season Big South history (1985-86) and makes it three-straight home bouts with Hampton after playing the first three contests (2019 CIT included) at the Convocation Center in Hampton, Va.
- Dec. 21 & 22 are also the earliest Charleston Southern has opened Big South play since a Dec. 2 matchup with Winthrop in 2015, an 83-82 Eagle victory inside the Buc Dome.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Charleston Southern saw six players reach double figures Tuesday night as they ran away in the second half for a 94-59 home win over Carver from Buccaneer Field House.
- Charleston Southern (1-3) senior guard and Preseason Big South Player of the Year **Phlandrous Fleming** got the scoring started early and often on their way to a season-high 94 points. Fleming had 15 points in his season debut as **Jamir Moore** poured-in a career-high 16 to pace all scorers.
- Carver (0-11) hung around in the early stages of the game, but the athleticism and size of the Bucs took center stage in the early part of the second half. **Melvin Edwards Jr.** added 11 points in his first collegiate start, **Ja'Quavian Florence** scored 14 and had a team-high seven rebounds, **Malik Battle** had a career-high 15 and **Sean Price** added 10 off the bench for the victorious Bucs.
- CSU got season-highs in scoring, shooting percentage, steals and assists while knocking down nine treys and shooting 15-of-20 from the free throw line.
- Carver was paced by 17 from Bryson Scott including 3-of-4 from downtown while Antwon Ferrell added 11 and Devin Ervin scored 10 for the Cougars.

### SCOUTING THE PIRATES

- Hampton enters the 2020-21 season replacing 73.9% of its scoring load from the 2019-20 campaign. That total ranks 13th amongst NCAA Division I schools in highest percentage of points to replace and second in the Big South behind only Radford.
- Among scoring lost for the Pirates, Jermaine Marrow and Ben Stanley averaged 15-plus points last season and finished top-4 for Big South Player of the Year.
- Davion Warren has stepped up in their absence sitting among the tops in the Big South in scoring at 15.8 ppg good for 4th in the Big South. Chris Shelton has been a 3-point threat for the Pirates knocking down 19 already on the season and averaging 14.0 points a night while Edward Olive-Hampton scores 11.6 points per contest.
- Despite the loss of two stars, Hampton is still a high-flying, fast-paced attack dishing out 14.4 assists and rank 46th in the NCAA in pace (possessions per game). Their 77.6 possessions per game rank 4th in the Big South just behind Winthrop (79.6), USC Upstate (77.9) and Charleston Southern (77.8).
- Hampton also stands the tallest in the Big South at 6-4.92 average with seven players listed at 6'5 or taller and player listed at 7-0 tall.

### SERIES HISTORY

- In the young series history, the home team has dominated with Hampton holding a 3-0 record in the Convocation Center and Charleston Southern sitting at 1-0 inside Buccaneer Field House.
- The first four matchups came at a neutral site or in Hampton, Va. before last season's February meeting finally saw the Pirates visit the Buc Dome.
- Including postseason play, the first three matchups since Hampton joined the Big South saw the Bucs head north to the Commonwealth. Starting last season and including this year's back-to-back scheduling model sees the Pirates play three-straight in Charleston.

### AMONG ELITE COMPANY

- Charleston Southern senior guard Phlandrous Fleming Jr. enters his final campaign as a Buccaneer racking up numerous accolades in the preseason, and with the numbers to back them.

- The Athens, Ga., native earned Big South Preseason Player of the Year honors from many media outlets (Blue Ribbon, Lindy's Sports) including the official conference vote by head coaches and media members.
- Fleming has a chance to etch his name in the program record book in multiple statistical categories after becoming just the second player ever with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists, 100 steals and 50 blocks.
- Fleming, the Big South 2020 Defensive Player of the Year, was also the first Buccaneer to ever earn Preseason POTY honors and is the favorite to become the fourth player to win the regular season award (Eric Burks, T.L. Latson and Saah Nimley).

### VETERAN PRESENCE

- For the first time in a few seasons, Head Coach Barclay Radebaugh and the Bucs are laced with veteran presence as well as exciting underclassmen.
- The class of **Deontaye Buskey, Phlandrous Fleming Jr., Ty Jones** and **Sean Price** have been staples in the CSU lineup since stepping foot on campus before the 2017-18 season.
- Junior class member **Sadarius Bowser** also has two seasons of starting experience under his belt making CSU one of the most battle-tested rosters in the Big South with five upper-classmen.
- The three seniors - Fleming, Buskey and Jones - combined for nearly 39.0 points per game last season and look to anchor the offense.

### DECEMBER LEAGUE HISTORY

- Charleston Southern has only played 10 Big South league games all-time in the month of December boasting a 6-4 record including a 4-game win streak across the 2010-11 and 2011-12 seasons.
- Of the 10 contests, only four have come against current Big South members (High Point 2x, Radford and Winthrop) with CSU holding a 3-1 margin in those contests.
- Monday also marks just the third time CSU will open league play at home in the month of December with wins over High Point and Radford and an 83-82 loss versus Winthrop.
- All 10 league contests in CSU's program history have come under head coach Barclay Radebaugh's tenure starting in the 2008-09 season. Monday is the first December league game for CSU since the 2015-16 season.

Barclay Radebaugh has presided over one of the most successful stretches in Charleston Southern history during his 15 years as head coach. Radebaugh is the winningest coach in school history and one of only eight coaches to win multiple Big South Coach of the Year awards. He directed CSU to NIT berths in 2013 and 2015 as well as a trip to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) in 2019 with a win over Florida Atlantic inside the Buc Dome.

Despite battling injuries down the stretch, Radebaugh led the Bucs to another Big South Conference quarterfinals run and came within minutes of defeating the top-seeded Radford Highlanders on their home floor. Under his tutelage, the Bucs also collected another Power 5 win over Missouri of the SEC taking down the Tigers 68-60 with stifling defense and clutch shooting from the floor. Phlandrous Fleming Jr. also became just the second Buccaneer to be named the Big South Defensive Player of the Year joining CSU Hall of Fame player Kelvin Martin.

For the second-straight season, the Bucs made a late-season charge to capture a top-six Big South Tournament seed as they took care of No. 10 USC Upstate in the Opening Round then proceeded to upset No. 3 Winthrop to reach the semifinals. The Bucs finished with an 18-16 overall record and 9-7 Big South mark and made their CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) debut taking down Florida Atlantic from Conference-USA before battling with Big South foe Hampton. The Bucs' push as well as individual performances helped lead to two student-athletes earning All-Big South honors - highlighted by Christian Keeling making All-Big South first team and Dontrell Shuler earning All-Freshman honors.

Radebaugh delivered one of his best coaching jobs in 2017-18 as the Bucs won eight of their final 11 games and twice pushed UNC Asheville, the league's regular season champion, to the brink. Powered by Christian Keeling and a young nucleus featuring freshmen Phlandrous Fleming Jr. and Ty Jones, among others, CSU rallied from a 2-7 start to conference play to finish 9-9. CSU's 7-2 record during the second half of league action tied Asheville for the Big South's best mark. Included in that run was a win at eventual Big South Tournament champion Radford and the Bucs' first win at Winthrop since 2002. CSU also defeated Illinois State in overtime in November, knocking off a Redbirds squad that would go on to advance to the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title game. Keeling collected Second Team All-Big South honors, while Fleming was named to the All-Freshman Team and was runner-up for Freshman of the Year.

In 2016-17, a young team with eight newcomers gelled late in the year under Radebaugh's guidance. CSU went 8-8 over its final 16 games to rebound from an 0-4 start to Big South play and build momentum for the coming season. Keeling led the way with one of the best freshman seasons in Big South history. Keeling set a CSU freshman scoring record with 539 points, becoming the sixth freshman in league history to tally 500 points. He was named to the Big South All-Freshman Team and was an honorable mention all-conference pick.

Radebaugh has established CSU as a perennial Big South contender thanks in part to its ability to protect the Buc Dome. CSU went 13-2 at home in 2014-15, improving its mark in the building over a six-year stretch (2009-10 to 2014-15) to 67-18 overall, and 39-13 in Big South play.

Radebaugh led CSU to the National Invitation Tournament in 2015. The Bucs made the most of the experience just as they did in 2013, leading Old Dominion by six points at halftime before falling to the top-seeded Monarchs.

The postseason bid was CSU's second in three years after the program had just one in its first 47 years.

Saah Nimley capped off a brilliant playing career under Radebaugh's guidance by capturing Big South Player of the Year accolades. He was also named an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American, making him the first player in program history to receive the honor. Only 63 players in the entire country were recognized by the AP. Nimley finished the year ranked 5th nationally in scoring and three-pointers per game, had 17 20-point games, seven 30-point games, and was the only player in the country to record four consecutive 30-point efforts.

Will Saunders garnered 2nd Team All-Conference accolades under Radebaugh's tutelage, while Arlon Harper was named Honorable Mention All-Conference.

In 2012-13 the sophomore backcourt of Saah Nimley (All-Big South 1st Team) and Arlon Harper (All-Big South 2nd Team) led CSU to an NIT berth for just the second postseason appearance in program history. Radebaugh and a still young squad made the most of the experience, giving top-seeded Southern Miss all it could handle in a 78-71 loss before a raucous partisan crowd in Hattiesburg.

Radebaugh earned Big South Conference Coach of the Year honors for his efforts in 2011-12, as the Bucs went 19-12 and advanced to the conference tournament semifinals behind a starting lineup which featured three freshmen and a junior college transfer. CSU's 19 wins were the program's most since 1994-1995, as the Bucs secured their first winning season since 1996-1997. Senior Kelvin Martin led the way for Radebaugh's young group, as the forward played his way onto the all-conference first team while earning a nod as the league's defensive player of the year for a second consecutive season. The freshmen duo of Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper helped power a CSU offense which featured outstanding balance and had four players in double figures for the majority of the season (Martin, Nimley, Harper, and Mathiang Muo). As a team, CSU finished the season 22nd nationally in scoring (76.9 ppg), 20th in three-point field goals per game (8.4), 30th in three-point field goal percentage (38.0%), 40th in steals per game (8.1) and 27th in turnover margin (+2.7).

The Bucs opened the season in style when they led Big 12 power Kansas State by 14 at halftime, before taking the Wildcats all the way to the wire in a 72-67 loss. Radebaugh's squad also enjoyed a home-and-away sweep of Atlantic Sun foe Stetson, a 33-point home victory over VMI, an 18-point blowout of then first-place Campbell, a triumph at Big South regular season and tournament champion and previously undefeated UNC Asheville, and a conference tournament win over Liberty.

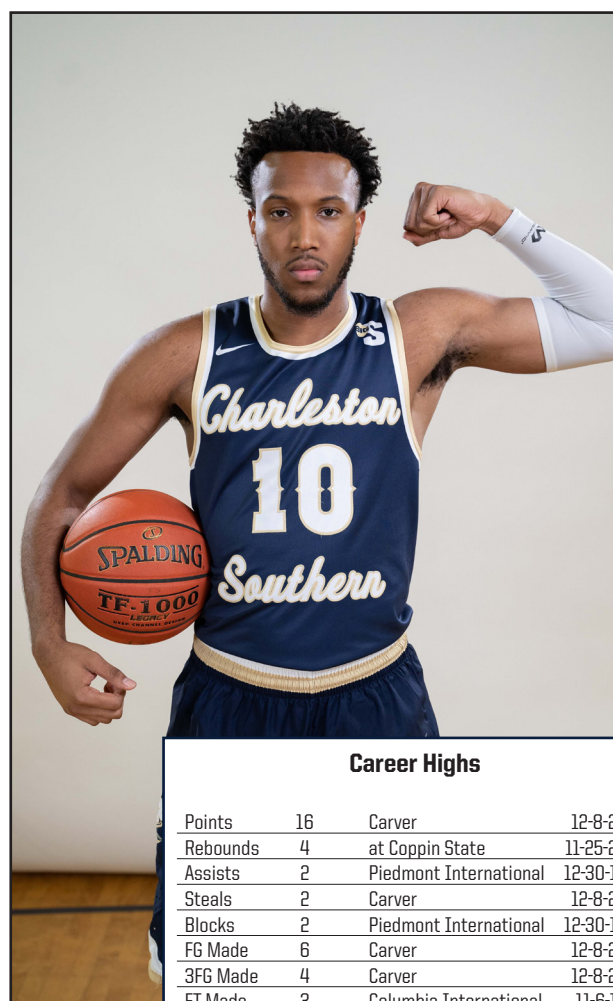

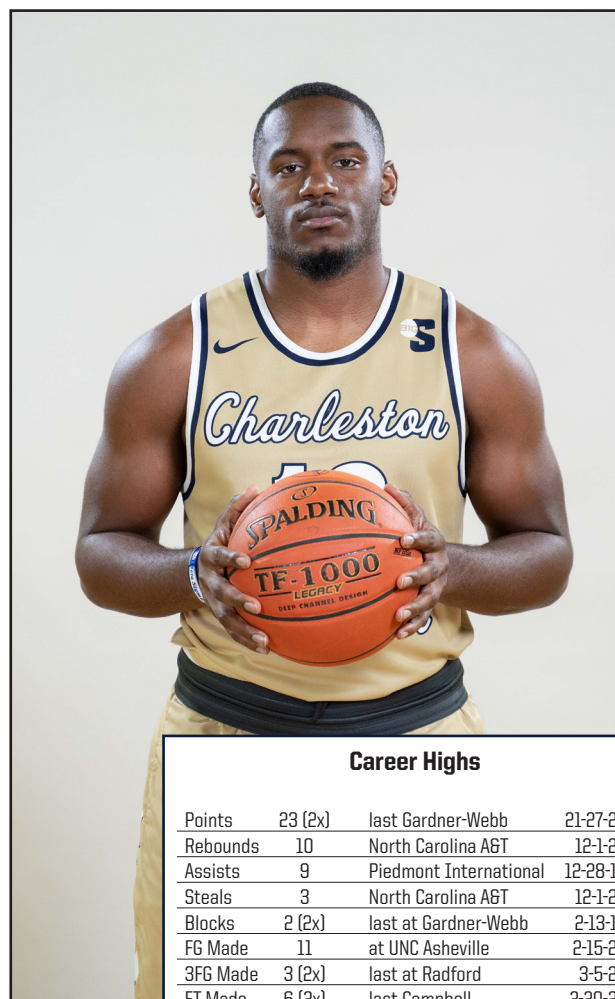
