PATRIOT POINTS

- ► Mason begins a five-game road stretch with a contest at Charleston Southern on Tuesday night in Charleston, S.C. Tipoff is scheduled for 6 p.m. on ESPN+.
- ▶ Mason fell to 24th-ranked Virginia Tech, 81-52, in its home opener on Sunday inside EagleBank Arena. Virginia Tech made 13 three-pointers (.448), including nine in the first half (.529). The Hokies finished 47.8 percent from the floor overall (32-67) and were +18 on the glass (46-28).
- ▶ Junior Jordan Wakefield led the Patriots once again on offense with a team-high 16 points, one shy of her career high. She made a career-high four three-pointers on five attempts (.800) and was a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line.
- ▶ Junior Tamia Lawhorne added 14 points on 5-of-9 shooting (.556) to go along with two steals and two rebounds. She's averaging 8.7 points per game coming off the bench for the Patriots.
- ► Mason made eight three-pointers against the Hokies, having only made four total the previous two games.
- ► The Patriots posted a season-best nine steals against the Hokies. Wakefield, Ephraim, Lawhorne and Jameson each recorded a pair of steals.

- ▶ Wakefield averaged 15.3 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game in a strong opening week for the Patriots, earning a spot on the A-10's weekly honor roll. She shot 42.9 percent from the floor (12-28) and 46.7 percent from deep (7-15). She also went a perfect 15-for-15 from the free throw line which currently leads the A-10.
- ► Senior Amaya Scott started her Patriot career with a pair of strong performances. She tabbed 16 points (8-10 FG) vs. FIU and nearly notched a double-double vs. Loyola (14p/9r). She's 190 points away from 1,000 in her career.
- ► Wakefield ranks 12th in the A-10 in scoring (15.0) and 11th in 3-point field goal percentage (.467).
- \blacktriangleright Scott ranks 19th in the A-10 in scoring (13.0) and 17th in rebounding (6.7).
- ► Redshirt sophomore Jayla Adams leads the team in assists (4.0) good for seventh in the A-10. She tied her career high in assists (7) vs. FIU.
- ▶ Mason won back-to-back away games for the first time since the 2019-20 season when the Patriots defeated College of Charleston (Nov. 6) and Penn State (Nov. 14) on the road. Mason will look to win three straight road games for the first time since 2017-18 (Jan. 30-Feb. 15).
- ▶ Mason will play seven road games in the month of November.

FAIRFAX, Va. – The George Mason women's basketball team ran into a three-point shooting buzzsaw on Sunday afternoon at EagleBank Arena.

Mason (2-1) fell to 24th-ranked Virginia Tech, 81-52, in its home opener.

Virginia Tech (3-0) made 13 three-pointers (.448), including nine in the first half (.529). The Hokies finished 47.8 percent from the floor overall (32-67) and were +18 on the glass (46-28).

Junior Jordan Wakefield led the Patriots once again on offense with a team-high 16 points, one shy of her career high. She shot 80.0 percent from three-point range (4-5 3FG) and was a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line.

Junior Tamia Lawhorne added 14 points on 5-of-9 shooting (.556) to go along with two steals and two rebounds.

Mason shot 30.7 percent from the floor (16-52) and made eight three-pointers (.364). Mason received valuable minutes from its bench, outscoring the Hokies' bench 25-14.

2021-22 PROSPECTUS

Mason returns nine letterwinners including five players who started at least 10 games during the 2020-21 campaign. That group consists of five players who averaged at least 5.0 points per game last season: Marika Korpinen (9.3), Jordan Wakefield (6.4), Jazmyn Doster (5.7), Taylor Jameson (5.7) and Rachel Balzer (5.6).

In addition, Mason welcomes four transfers to the 2021-22 roster: Amaya Scott and Jayla Adams from Bethune-Cookman, J-Naya Ephraim from Illinois, and Angelee Rodriguez from USF. Spanish native Paula Suarez is Mason's lone true freshman on the 2021-22 roster.

BLAIR-LEWIS ERA

George Mason Vice President/Director of Athletics Brad Edwards named Vanessa Blair-Lewis as the ninth head coach in the history of the Patriot women's basketball program on April 6, 2021. Blair-Lewis, who led Bethune-Cookman to its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2019, arrives in Fairfax following a 13-year stint as the head women's basketball coach of the Wildcats. The four-time MEAC Coach of the Year, Blair-Lewis led Bethune-Cookman to a 196-168 (.538) overall record and six winning seasons, rebuilding a program that had only had two winning seasons in the 19 seasons prior to her arrival. Over the previous five seasons (2015 to 2020), the Wildcats posted four 21+ win seasons, four MEAC Regular Season Championships, one MEAC Tournament Championship, and five postseason berths.

NEWCOMERS TO NOTE

Mason welcomes five new faces to the 2021-22 season. That group features four transfers: Amaya Scott and Jayla Adams from Bethune-Cookman; J-Naya Ephraim from Illinois; and Angelee Rodriguez from USF. In addition, Spanish native Paula Suarez joins the Patriots as their lone true freshman.

IT'S A FAMILY THING

Coach Blair-Lewis comes to Fairfax with her coaching staff from Bethune-Cookman: associate head coach/recruiting coordinator Chandler McCabe, associate head coach/director of analytics Niki Washington and assistant coach Demetria Frank. She also reunites with her former B-CU assistant, Andre Bolton, who will serve as special assistant to the head coach. Coach Blair-Lewis is also joined by B-CU transfers Amaya Scott and Jayla Adams.

CHAMPIONSHIP MENTALITY

Coach Blair-Lewis brings a wealth of championship experience to the George Mason women's basketball program. Over her 22-year coaching career, she has won six conference regular season championships and one conference tournament championship — earning five straight postseason tournament berths (2015-20).

As bench boss, she has recorded six 20-plus win seasons, and nine overall winning seasons.

THE REAL DEAL

Six-foot-one transfer Amaya Scott looks to bring experience and leadership in the post. She appeared in 88 games, making 56 starts, in three seasons at Bethune-Cookman.

During her time at Bethune-Cookman, Scott led the Wildcats to an overall record of 66-22, a MEAC mark of 41-7, two regular season championships and a MEAC Tournament Championship. She earned postseason bids in each of her three seasons — one NCAA, two WNIT.

She was named the 2020-21 MEAC Preseason Player of the Year before B-CU suspended athletics for the academic year due to the Covid-19 pandemic. She has posted 10 double-doubles, seven coming in 2019-20, and has scored in double figures 42 times. She's 190 points away from surpassing 1,000 points in her career.

A First Team All-MEAC honoree, she led the MEAC in field goal percentage in 2019-20 — hitting 52.5 percent of her shots from the floor. She also ranked top-10 in the league in scoring (8th, 12.9 ppg) and rebounding (10th, 6.6 rpg). She garnered Second Team Boxtorow All-American honors for her impressive junior campaign.

INTERNATIONAL PATS

The Patriots have four student-athletes on their roster who were born outside of the United States: graduate student Marika Korpinen (Turku, Finland), senior Livija Kaktaite (Sveksna, Lithuania), redshirt senior Milica Manojlovic (Tivat, Montenegro), and freshman Paula Suarez (Pamplona, Spain). Korpinen, Kaktaite and Manojlovic finished their schooling in the United States, but all have spent most of their lives in Europe.

In addition, a pair of Patriots hail from U.S. territories. Senior J-Naya Ephraim is from the U.S. Virgin Islands while sophomore Angelee Rodriguez was born in Puerto Rico.

KORPINEN'S BACK

Graduate student Marika Korpinen is back for the Patriots after returning with the extra year of eligibility given by the NCAA due to COVID-19. She has appeared in 113 games for the Green & Gold, and has registered 26 double-digit scoring performances.

She returns as the team's leading scorer (9.3) and assister (2.4). She led the team in scoring in six games in 2020-21, as well as in rebounding five times. She also posted the first two double-doubles of her career: Longwood (19p/12r) and Navy (11p/12r).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Mason will play seven road games in the month of November, beginning with back-to-back away contests against Florida International (Nov. 9) and Loyola Md. (Nov. 12). The Patriots will also face Charleston Southern (Nov. 16), William & Mary (Nov. 19) and American (Nov. 23) on the road as well as Navy and Bowling Green in the Navy Classic (Nov. 27-28).

The lone home matchup for the month will take place on Sunday, Nov. 14 against No. 24 Virginia Tech.

With a 69-67 win over FIU in Miami, the Patriots earned their first road win since Feb. 22. 2020.

With its following win at Loyola (53-51), Mason won back-to-back away games for the first time since the 2019-20 season when the Patriots defeated College of Charleston (Nov. 6) and Penn State (Nov. 14) on the road. Mason will look to win three straight road games for the first time since 2017-18 (Jan. 30-Feb. 15).

RECORD WATCH

Senior Marika Korpinen enters the season in sole possession of 19th in program history in three-point field goals made with 83. She is two three-pointers shy of tying Jill Bartley in 18th with 85. She also sits 22nd in Patriot history in assists with 180.

BOARD MEETING

The Patriots finished third in the A-10 in rebounds per game in 2020-21, pulling down 39.5 boards per contest. Mason was also second in the league in offensive boards per game (13.4).

The Patriots had three players rank in the top-25 in rebounding in the A-10 last season, including returners Doster (17th, 6.1) and Korpinen (25th, 5.1). Doster led the team in rebounding in a team-high nine games, and posted two double-digit rebounding performances.

JUNIOR TRIO

Mason's 2021-22 roster features junior trio Jazmyn Doster, Jordan Wakefield and Tamia Lawhorne. That group has appeared in a combined 132 games over the past two seasons, making a combined 52 starts.

Doster averaged 5.7 points and 6.1 rebounds per game while Wakefield added 6.4 points and 3.9 rebounds per contest in 2020-21. After opting out of the remainder of the 2020-21 season, Lawhorne is back for the Patriots. She posted two 20-spots as a freshman in 2019-20.

NEW YORK, NEW YORK!

Three Patriots finished their high school playing careers at Long Island Lutheran in New York — Marika Korpinen, Livija Kaktaite and Tamia Lawhorne. Korpinen and Kaktaite stayed with host families during their time in the states.

FIRST TIME OUT

Head coach Vanessa Blair-Lewis became the third Mason women's basketball head coach to earn a victory in their Mason coaching debut, joining Jim Wolfe/Jim Conklin (1974-75) and Becky Burch (1976-77). She also improved to 3-0 in her head coaching debuts, with previous first wins at Mount St. Mary's in 1998 (67-45 vs. UMBC) and Bethune-Cookman in 2008 (68-56 vs. North Florida).

Mason improved to 19-30 all-time in season openers, and 5-6 in its last 11 openers.

WEEKLY HONOR ROLL FOR WAKEFIELD

Junior Jordan Wakefield averaged 15.3 points, 4.3 rebounds, 1.0 blocks per game in a strong opening week for the Patriots, earing a spot on the A-10 weekly honor roll. She shot 42.9 percent from the floor (12-28) and 46.7 percent from deep (7-15). She went a perfect 15-for-15 from the free throw line which currently leads the A-10.

In Mason's season-opening win over FIU (Nov. 9), she scored a career-high 17 points on 4-of-9 shooting. She went 8-of-8 from the charity stripe which set a new personal-best for Wakefield and currently leads the A-10 in FT percentage in a game.

She added 13 points and five rebounds in Mason's 53-51 win over Loyola (Nov. 12). Against No. 24 Virginia Tech, she scored a teamhigh 16 points with four three-pointers. She finished 4-of-5 from deep (.800) - setting a new career-high.

BIG IMPROVEMENTS EARLY ON

Juniors Jordan Wakefield and Tamia Lawhorne have come out of the gates strong for the Patriots, increasing their offensive outputs from a season ago.

Wakefield has improved her shooting line in every category from 2020-21 to 2021-22 -- FG% (.323 to .429), 3-PT FG% (.273 to .467), FT% (.771 to 1.00) and PPG (6.4 to 15.3).

Lawhorne has also made big improvements from a season ago: FG% (.222 to .500) and 3FG% (.250 to .333). She has quadrupled her scoring output, averaging 2.4 ppg in 2020-21 to now 8.7 ppg in 2021-22.

WELCOME BACK

Redshirt sophomore Rachel Balzer and redshirt senior Milica Manojlovic returned to the hardwood against Virginia Tech (Nov. 14). Balzer underwent shoulder surgery in the offseason while Manojlovic returns from an ACL injury sustained in 2020-21.

Balzer led the Patriots in three-pointers made last season with 35 while Manojlovic made 57 starts in two seasons at Furman.

First Season at Mason; 23rd overall

- Blair-Lewis, who led Bethune-Cookman to its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2019, arrives in Fairfax following a 13-year stint as the head women's basketball coach of the Wildcats. She was announced as the ninth head coach in the history of the Patriot women's basketball program on April 6, 2021.
- The four-time MEAC Coach of the Year, Blair-Lewis led Bethune-Cookman to a 196-168 (.538) overall record and six winning seasons, rebuilding a program that had only had two winning seasons in the 19 seasons prior to her arrival.
- Over the previous five seasons (2015 to 2020), she guided Bethune-Cookman to a 107-48 (.690) overall and 68-12 (.850) MEAC record. The Wildcats posted four 21+ win seasons, four MEAC Regular Season Championships, one MEAC Tournament Championship, and five postseason berths.
- In 2019-20, the Wildcats finished 23-6 overall and 15-1 in MEAC play for its fourth regular season championship in the last five years. The team earned a bid to the WNIT before the remainder of the season was canceled due to COVID-19. Bethune Cookman's scoring offense finished first in the MEAC in 2019-20.
- In 2018-19, she led Bethune-Cookman to the MEAC Tournament Championship and its first NCAA Tournament berth in program history. The Wildcats defeated Norfolk State to clinch the program's first tournament championship since 1984 and earned a No. 16 seed in the NCAA Tournament.
- Blair-Lewis became the first women's head coach in MEAC history to win the award three consecutive years and four times overall.
- As a Division I Head Coach, she has recruited and coached 37 all-conference team selections, as well as three Players of the Year, one Rookie of the Year, and six Defensive Players of the Year.
- A 22-year coaching veteran, Blair-Lewis previously served as the head women's basketball coach of her alma mater, Mount St. Mary's. From 1998 to 2007, she led Mount St. Mary's to 120 overall wins and a 97-67 (.591) NEC record, two 20+ win seasons, and two NEC Regular Season Championships.
- As a player, she set the Mount's single-game, season and career records in blocked shots. A two-time NEC Player of the Year, she was inducted into the Mount St. Mary's Sports Hall of Fame in 2002, NEC Hall of Fame in 2013 and her playing jersey was retired in 2019.
