# AT A GLANCE

### **KEY STORYLINES** >>ROAD TRIPPIN

Tuesday's doubleheader at Georgia Southern begins a 10-game road trip for Charleston Southern. Two-thirds of the Bucs' road games this season take place during this road trip, with eight of the 10 games being played outside the state of South Carolina.

CSU's last six Big South games of the season are also a part of this road swing. The Bucs will play at Campbell this weekend and at Longwood next weekend, with a midweek doubleheader at Furman sandwiched in between.

# >>GAME BY GAME

Charleston Southern won its first conference series of the season when it took two-of-three from Gardner-Webb over the weekend.

The Bucs are 2-4 in midweek doubleheaders this season, splitting against Coastal Carolina and the College of Charleston, while being swept by South Carolina.

### >>KNOW THE SCHEDULE

As is customary in most seasons, the Bucs will play everyone in the Big South Conference for one three-game series. CSU will play four home series and three road series against Big South competition. Those making the trip to Charleston this season are USC Upstate, Radford, Winthrop and Gardner-Webb. The Bucs will play at Presbyterian, Campbell and Longwood. Hampton elected to not play a spring sports season for the 2020-21 academic year.







# ASHLEY MECI

Ashley Meckley has become a mainstay in the Buccaneer lineup from the day she arrived on campus. The Hanahan, South Carolina, native has started all 25 games this season at shortstop after transferring into the program from Coker University.

Meckley is hitting .274 through the first 25 games of this season. The junior infielder also leads the team with five doubles, eight homers, 13 extra-base hits, 16 walks and 15 runs batted in.

Meckley has four multi-hit games and has at least one hit in 15 of the first 25 games. In addition, she has reached base in 21 of the first 25 games this season, including each of the Bucs' first 13 contests.

Prior to arriving at CSU, Meckley was a standout for Division II Coker University in Hartsville, South Carolina, where she hit .325 with seven homers and 35 runs batted in across 73 games Despite the jump up to Division I, she is still on pace to put up numbers similar to those she produced during her time with the Cobras.

# **ONE TO REMEMBER**

Holly Clark struck out six in a complete game performance against Cleveland State, giving head coach Christi Musser her first career win in a 2-1 Buccaneer victory on Feb. 20.

Ashley Meckley provided the offense for CSU with a two-run homer to left in the second innings, while Clark allowed one run on eight hits.

#### **WALK IT OFF**

Brewington hit a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th, scoring Ashley Meckley in the process, as the Bucs earned their first Big South win of the season with a 5-4 extra-inning thriller over Radford.

Annah Junge and Alyssa Heinrich combined to allow just six Radford hits in 11.0 innings of work. Heinrich was credited with the win after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief. Junge allowed three earned runs in a career-high 8.0 innings while tying her season high with three strikeouts.

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina for the first time since the 2017 season when it took the opening game of a midweek doubleheader over the Chanticleers, 8-7.

Erika Cooper had the go-ahead hit with a solo

home run in the bottom of the fifth inning. Alyssa Heinrich earned her second win of the season with 3.0 innings of relief work, while Annah Junge allowed four runs in 4.0 innings in her fourth start of the season.

The Bucs also earned a doubleheader split with crosstown rival College of Charleston, taking the second game of the twin bill, 6-4. Ashley Meckley homered against the Cougars, while a four-run second inning provided most of the damage for CSU. Baylee Eaton allowed one hit in 4.0 innings for the win.

#### **RUN RULES**

Charleston Southern has a pair of run-rule wins to its name this season, as the Bucs have five-inning wins over both Presbyterian (8-0) and Gardner-Webb (9-1).

The Bucs allowed just four hits and one run in the two games, while recording 20 hits and 15 RBI's in the games.

# **BAYLEE'S BRILLIANCE**

Baylee Eaton threw the first complete game of her CSU career in a 2-1 win over Winthrop. Eaton allowed just three hits in the win over the Eagles, striking out a pair.

# ALL AROUND THE ORDER

Brooklynn Brewington has started every game since she stepped foot on campus prior to the 2019 season. That hasn't changed this year, and the junior is now leading the way at the plate as well.

Brewington has hit all around the batting order for the Bucs this season and has been found anywhere from the leadoff spot to the six spot on head coach Christi Musser's lineup card.

The Andrews, South Carolina, native has rewarded her head coach's trust in her by leading CSU with a .350 batting average through 25 games. Brewington has at least one hit in 19 of the first 22 games this season, including nine multi-hit games.

Brewington delivered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th inning against Radford last week to give the Bucs their first Big South win of the season.

#### A NEW ERA

Charleston Southern softball ushered in a new chapter in program history in January with the hiring of Christi Musser as the 10th head coach in program history.

Musser comes to the Lowcountry with an extensive coaching background and most recently served as the associate head coach at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Arizona. Musser was previously an assistant coach on the Grand Canyon staff prior to being promoted to associate head coach. During her time at GCU, the Lopes were ranked among the top teams in Division I in batting average and doubles per game. Musser coached three all-conference players during her time with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders.

Musser previously had a three-year stint as an assistant coach at New Mexico, where she was the hitting instructor for the Lobos. Under her tutelage, the Lobos led all of Division I with 96 home runs in 2012.

Musser got her start in coaching at Kansas, her alma mater, where she spent seven seasons as an assistant. She was the hitting instructor and recruiting coordinator during her coaching tenure with the Jayhawks.

## **FAMILIAR FACES IN THE FOLD**

While Christi Musser is a new face to the Buccaneer softball program, people familar with CSU softball will recognize the assistant coaches for the Bucs.

Stevi Johnson is in her third season as an assistant coach for the Bucs and is one of the top players in program history. Johnson was a part of CSU's 2014 Big South Championship-winning team and also earned all-conference honors in 2017. She works with the outfielders and as a hitting instructor, with an emphasis on power hitting.

Russell Cooper is also in his third season as an assistant coach, albeit in his second stint with the Buccaneer softball program. Cooper previously spent the 2017-18 seasons on the CSU staff as an assistant coach and works primarily with the pitchers.

#### >>TEAM NOTES

#### Hitting the Road

Charleston Southern is playing its first games outside the state of South Carolina when it plays at Georgia Southern Tuesday.

The Bucs begin a season-long 10-game road trip with Tuesday's doubleheader against the Eagles, with eight of those 10 games being played outside the state of South Carolina. The only games left in the Palmetto State for CSU are doubleaders at Furman and against College of Charleston at home.

#### **All-Time Against Georgia Southern**

This will be the 62nd and 63rd all-time meetings between the Bucs and Eagles in a series which started during the 1988 season.

Overall, Georgia Southern has a 46-15 advantage in the all-time series, including an 24-5 lead in games played in Statesboro. Georgia Southern has won each of the last two meetings, with both taking place in a neutral-site tournament last year. Charleston Southern won the last game between the teams in the Lowcountry during the 2010 season. The last time the teams played in Statesboro was in 2009.

#### **About Georgia Southern**

Georgia Southern enters Tuesday's contest at 9-18 overall and 2-9 in Sun Belt Conference play. The Eagles won their first conference series of the season over the weekend, taking two-of-three from Coastal Carolina.

Georgia Southern is 5-3 against common opponents this season. The Eagles took two-of-three from both Winthrop and Coastal Carolina, swept the College of Charleston in a doubleheader and lost to South Carolina.

Dejah Mills leads the Eagles with a .395 batting average. Bailee Wilson is one of three Eagles to have started all 27 games this season and is hitting .393. Faith Shirley leads Georgia Southern with 11 doubles, six homers and 19 runs batted in.

Kyleigh Richardson and Rylee Waldrep each have a team-high nine starts and three wins in the circle for Georgia Southern. Waldrep and Harlee Rewis lead the team with 14 appearances each, while Richardson has a team-best 3.75 ERA. Aaliyah Garcia leads the Eagles with 27 strikeouts.

#### Recapping Last Weekend

The Bucs won their first Big South series of the season over the weekend, taking two-of-three from Gardner-Webb at the CSU Softball Field.

Charleston Southern rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the series opener with three runs across the fourth and fifth innings. Sarah Brown had the lone RBI for the Bucs on a single in the fourth inning, while CSU scored its last two runs on a pair of Runnin' Bulldog fielding errors.

GWU scored four runs in the final three innings

of Saturday's first game to take the middle game of the series in eight innings, 6-3. A SeaEnna Satcher solo home run and an Ashley Meckley two-run homer accounted for all of the Bucs' offense in that game.

CSU responded in a big way in the series finale, taking the rubber match in run-rule fashion, 9-1, in five innings. Ashlyn Cribb had a career-high three hits, two doubles and four RBI's in the contest, including the game-ending hit. Holly Clark allowed just three hits in 5.0 innings for her second complete game win of the season.

Satcher and Meghan Gagliano had hits in all three games of the series for the Bucs, while Clark and Annah Junge earned the wins in the circle. Nine different Bucs had at least one hit in the series.

#### Recapping Wednesday

Charleston Southern opened the scoring in Wednesday's doubleheader at South Carolina, but the Gamecocks swept both games from the visiting Bucs.

South Carolina won the first game, 9-2, and won the second game in run-rule fashion, 8-0, in five innings.

Ashley Meckley accounted for both of Charleston Southern's runs batted in with a two-run homer, her team-leading seventh of the season. Meckley, Madison Koger and Sarah Brown each had hits in the first game, while Meghan Gagliano had a hit in the second game.

South Carolina had a five-run inning in each game to break both games open. The Gamecocks had a 4-2 lead in the first game prior to scoring five in the fifth and led 2-0 in the second game before scoring four in the fourth.

### **Friendly Confines**

Charleston Southern began the season with 17 of its first 20 games at home, including each of the first 12 games.

The lone road trip for the Bucs during this span was a three-game Big South series at Presbyterian, where CSU went 1-2. CSU has still not played a game outside the state of South Carolina and will not do so until April 13.

#### **Season Leaders**

Brewington is the Bucs' leader among its regular starters in batting average at .350 and hits with 28. Katelyn Norris is hitting .291 and has hits in each of her last five games, along with a careerhigh 10-game on-base streak. Ashley Meckley leads the team with five doubles, eight homers, 13 extra-base hits and 15 runs batted in while drawing a team-high 16 walks. Seven of the Bucs' nine regular starters are hitting at least .250 this season.

In the circle, Junge leads the Bucs in ERA at 4.23 and innings pitched with 51.1. Eaton has a teamhigh three wins while limiting opposing hitters

to a .265 average, the lowest mark on the team. Junge and Clark each have 22 strikeouts to lead the team in that category, while Eaton has 21.

#### **What to Watch For**

CSU remains perfect on the basepaths through the first 25 games of the season. The Bucs are 31-for-31 on stolen base attempts this season, with Brewington's 12 steals leading the team.

The Bucs had seven extra-base hits in Saturday's doubleheader, the most in a two-game stretch this season since recording nine extra-base hits in a midweek doubleheader against Coastal Carolina.

Saturday's run-rule win was the second run-rule win for the Bucs this season, with both coming in Big South play.

Junge has a 2.40 ERA in 35.0 innings against Big South opposition, while Eaton's ERA sits at 3.32 in conference play.

This will be Charleston Southern's first game outside the state of South Carolina since a 7-1 neutral-site win over North Carolina A&T in Longwood, Florida, on March 8, 2020.

#### Thievery on the Basepaths

Charleston Southern has recorded at least one stolen base in 13 of their 15 Big South Conference games, including a season-high five steals in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader against Gardner-Webb.

The Bucs are a perfect 31-for-31 on stolen base attempts this season, with Brooklynn Brewington's nine steals leading the team. The Bucs are the only team in the Big South to have not been caught stealing this season.

## **Swing for the Fences**

Charleston Southern nearly doubled its home run total for the season in a midweek doubleheader against Coastal Carolina. The Bucs entered the game with six home runs in 10 games but sent four over the fence in the two games against the Chanticleers.

Erika Cooper and Madison Koger both homered in the first game of the doubleheader, while Ashley Meckley and Sarah Brown went yard in the second half of the twin bill.

In addition, Meckley's eight home runs lead the team and account for half of CSU's home run total through the first 25 games (16).

#### **Adding Local Flavor**

CSU will take on local rival College of Charleston in a pair of doubleheaders this season, with both set to take place at the CSU Softball Field.

The Bucs and Cougars split the first doubleheader at the CSU Softball Field on March 30, with CofC taking the first game, 6-2, and CSU winning the second game, 6-4.

The Bucs and Cougars will meet for a second time at the CSU Softball Field on May 4.

### **Early Schedule Adjustments**

Charleston Southern had to back out of early season tournaments at Coastal Carolina and Georgia this season due to a COVID-19 pause within the Buccaneer program.

The Bucs also had their three-game series against USC Upstate pushed back by one week to allow for more time for CSU to practice following the pause. The Bucs and Spartans played their three-game set on March 12-13.



Christi Musser became the 10th CSU head softball coach in program history after accepting the position in January 2021. She takes over the Buccaneers' reins bringing 17 years of Division I softball coaching experience with stops at the University of Kansas, the University of New Mexico and, most recently, Grand Canyon University.

A four-star master coach as recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Conference, Musser comes to the Buccaneers after a six-year coaching stint at Grand Canyon University where she served as the associate head coach from August 2015-May 2020. Her efforts as both the hitting instructor and outfield coach helped pace GCU to becoming one of the top hitting teams in the NCAA in both batting average and doubles.

From 2016-18, the Lopes were ranked among the top-15 hitting teams in the NCAA Division I in batting average, finishing sixth overall in 2016 (.342). GCU also finished in the top-eight in doubles per game, ranking second overall in the country in 2016 (1.88) and fourth in 2017 (1.62).

During her tenure at GCU, Musser was a part of a staff that earned the program's first Division I era victory over a nationally-No. 1 ranked team of any program at GCU (Florida State, March 6, 2019), while also helping the program tally its eighth 30-win season. She coached three All-Conference players with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders in the 2018 season with Laynee Gomez and Bianca Boling both earning the recognition.

Prior to her time at GCU, Musser served as the New Mexico state director for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Over her year and a half with the organization, she helped create the strategic vision plan for the state, while also training and equipping the staff, volunteers, and board members to carry out the organization's ministry goals.

Musser's first collegiate coaching position came at her alma mater, Kansas, from 2003 to 2010. She assisted the Jayhawks on the field as a hitting instructor and served as recruiting coordinator during her tenure. She then joined the staff at New Mexico in July 2010 and enjoyed a successful three-year run that included serving as the hitting instructor for a Lobo squad that, in 2012, led the nation with 96 home runs.

During her playing career at Kansas, Musser earned All-American honors in 2002 as an outfielder and was a

four-time All-Big 12 selection. In her senior season, she hit .354 with 35 runs, 30 RBI, and nine home runs, while also earning All-Region and All-Big 12 honors.

During the summers of her college career, Musser played three seasons in the Women's Major for the Arizona Storm, winning a national championship in 1999 and finishing as a runner-up in 2000.

Musser graduated from Kansas in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sports management.
