>>ON THE ROAD AGAIN

This weekend's three-game series at Campbell is part of a 10-game road trip to close the regular season for Charleston Southern.

CSU's last six Big South games of the season are a part of this road swing. In addition to the Campbell series, the Bucs play three games at Longwood next weekend, with a midweek doubleheader at Furman sandwiched in between.

>>CALL IT A WIN STREAK

Charleston Southern has won three straight games after sweeping both ends of a doubleheader at Georgia Southern. The win streak marks the first time this season the Bucs have won consecutive games.

The Bucs last had a four-game win streak when they swept the 2020 Holy City Showdown. The last win streak of five or more games for CSU was a six-game win streak from March 24-April 6, 2019.

>>KNOW THE SCHEDULE

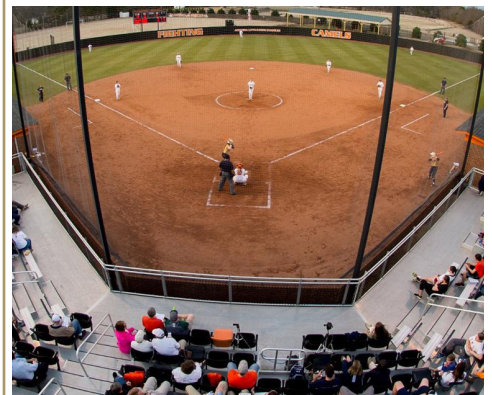

THE TRANSFER EFFECT

ASHLEY MECKLEY

Ashley Meckley has become a mainstay in the Buccaneer lineup from the day she arrived on campus. The Hanahan, South Carolina, native has started all 25 games this season at shortstop after transferring into the program from Coker University.

Meckley is hitting .295 through the first 25 games of this season. The junior infielder also leads the team with five doubles, nine homers, 15 extra-base hits, 18 walks and 16 runs batted in, and also leads the conference in slugging %.

Meckley has five multi-hit games and has at least one hit in 16 of CSU's 27 games. In addition, she has reached base in 23 of the 27 games this season, including each of the Bucs' first 13 contests.

Prior to arriving at CSU, Meckley was a standout for Division II Coker University in Hartsville, South Carolina, where she hit .325 with seven homers and 35 runs batted in across 73 games. Despite the jump up to Division I, she is still on pace to put up numbers similar to those she produced during her time with the Cobras.

ONE TO REMEMBER

Holly Clark struck out six in a complete game performance against Cleveland State, giving head coach Christi Musser her first career win in a 2-1 Buccaneer victory on Feb. 20.

Ashley Meckley provided the offense for CSU with a two-run homer to left in the second innings, while Clark allowed one run on eight hits.

WALK IT OFF

Brewington hit a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th, scoring Ashley Meckley in the process, as the Bucs earned their first Big South win of the season with a 5-4 extra-inning thriller over Radford.

Annah Junge and Alyssa Heinrich combined to allow just six Radford hits in 11.0 innings of work. Heinrich was credited with the win after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief. Junge allowed three earned runs in a career-high 8.0 innings while tying her season high with three strikeouts.

SPLITS

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina for the first time since the 2017 season when it took the opening game of a midweek doubleheader over the Chanticleers, 8-7.

Erika Cooper had the go-ahead hit with a solo

home run in the bottom of the fifth inning. Alyssa Heinrich earned her second win of the season with 3.0 innings of relief work, while Annah Junge allowed four runs in 4.0 innings in her fourth start of the season.

The Bucs also earned a doubleheader split with crosstown rival College of Charleston, taking the second game of the twin bill, 6-4. Ashley Meckley homered against the Cougars, while a four-run second inning provided most of the damage for CSU. Baylee Eaton allowed one hit in 4.0 innings for the win.

RUN RULES

Charleston Southern has a pair of run-rule wins to its name this season, as the Bucs have five-inning wins over both Presbyterian (8-0) and Gardner-Webb (9-1).

The Bucs allowed just four hits and one run in the two games, while recording 20 hits and 15 RBI's in the games.

BAYLEE'S BRILLIANCE

Baylee Eaton threw the first complete game of her CSU career in a 2-1 win over Winthrop. Eaton allowed just three hits in the win over the Eagles, striking out a pair.

ALL AROUND THE ORDER

Brooklynn Brewington has started every game since she stepped foot on campus prior to the 2019 season. That hasn't changed this year, and the junior is now leading the way at the plate as well.

Brewington has hit all around the batting order for the Bucs this season and has been found anywhere from the leadoff spot to the six spot on head coach Christi Musser's lineup card.

The Andrews, South Carolina, native has rewarded her head coach's trust in her by leading CSU with a .352 batting average through 27 games. Brewington has at least one hit in 21 of the first 27 games this season, including a team-leading 10 multi-hit games.

Brewington also delivered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th inning against Radford to give the Bucs their first Big South win of the season.

A NEW ERA

Charleston Southern softball ushered in a new chapter in program history in January with the hiring of Christi Musser as the 10th head coach in program history.

Musser comes to the Lowcountry with an extensive coaching background and most recently served as the associate head coach at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Arizona. Musser was previously an assistant coach on the Grand Canyon staff prior to being promoted to associate head coach. During her time at GCU, the Lopes were ranked among the top teams in Division I in batting average and doubles per game. Musser coached three all-conference players during her time with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders.

Musser previously had a three-year stint as an assistant coach at New Mexico, where she was the hitting instructor for the Lobos. Under her tutelage, the Lobos led all of Division I with 96 home runs in 2012.

Musser got her start in coaching at Kansas, her alma mater, where she spent seven seasons as an assistant. She was the hitting instructor and recruiting coordinator during her coaching tenure with the Jayhawks.

FAMILIAR FACES IN THE FOLD

While Christi Musser is a new face to the Buccaneer softball program, people familiar with CSU softball will recognize the assistant coaches for the Bucs.

Stevi Johnson is in her third season as an assistant coach for the Bucs and is one of the top players in program history. Johnson was a part of CSU's 2014 Big South Championship-winning team and also earned all-conference honors in 2017. She works with the outfielders and as a hitting instructor, with an emphasis on power hitting.

Russell Cooper is also in his third season as an assistant coach, albeit in his second stint with the Buccaneer softball program. Cooper previously spent the 2017-18 seasons on the CSU staff as an assistant coach and works primarily with the pitchers.

>>TEAM NOTES

Road Swing
Charleston Southern continues its 10-game road trip this weekend with a three-game Big South series at Campbell. The series with the Camels will be the fifth, sixth and seventh consecutive games in the series that will be in Buies Creek.

Campbell hosted the Big South Tournament in 2019, eliminating CSU that season, and also played host to a three-game series against the Bucs that year. The Camels have not made the trip to Charleston since 2018.

All-Time Against Georgia Southern
Charleston Southern and Campbell have met 93 times on the diamond prior to this weekend. The series dates back to 1987. The teams have not met since the 2019 Big South Tournament in Buies Creek.

Campbell has a 55-37-1 advantage in the all-time series, including a 28-19 lead in games played in Buies Creek. The Camels have also won each of the last two series and won the last meeting between the teams in the Big South Tournament. CSU won the last regular season matchup between the programs.

About Campbell
Campbell enters the weekend at 17-11 overall and 8-1 in Big South play. The Camels had a 10-game win streak snapped in their last game against UNCW.

Destini England leads the Camels with a .377 average and six triples. Bri Bryant has seven doubles, while Kayla Freeland has five homers and 19 RBI's for Campbell. The Camels have 53 stolen bases as a team this season. With Bryant and England accounting for nearly half of those.

In the circle, Campbell leads the Big South in ERA at 2.35 while limiting opposing hitters to a .232 average. Georgeanna Barefoot leads the team with 60 strikeouts in 72.1 innings, posting an 8-4 record with a 2.03 ERA. Megan Richards leads the Camels in ERA at 1.73 in 60.2 innings pitched, while amassing a 6-3 record with 46 strikeouts.

Recapping Tuesday
Charleston Southern rallied for a pair of road wins at Georgia Southern. The Bucs took the first game of the doubleheader, 8-7, before a come-from-behind 4-1 win in the nightcap.

CSU hit two homers in the doubleheader, with both coming in clutch situations. Ashley Meckley broke a 7-all tie in the seventh inning of the first game with a solo homer into the bleachers beyond the left field wall and Madison Koger gave the Bucs the lead in the second game with a three-run homer down the left field line in the sixth inning.

Holly Clark tied her season high with six strikeouts in the first game and earned her third win of the season, while Alyssa Heinrich had a season-high five strikeouts in her first complete game of the season in the nightcap, earning her

third win of the year.

The Bucs' win in the second game marked the first time CSU won this season when trailing after five innings. Charleston Southern was facing a 1-0 deficit in the sixth inning prior to Koger's three-run home run.

Katelyn Norris extended her on-base streak to 12 games in the doubleheader, while Sarah Brown now has a five-game hit streak. Brooklynn Brewington recorded her 10th multi-hit game of the season in the second game of the twin bill.

Recapping Last Weekend
The Bucs won their first Big South series of the season over the weekend, taking two-of-three from Gardner-Webb at the CSU Softball Field.

Charleston Southern rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the series opener with three runs across the fourth and fifth innings. Sarah Brown had the lone RBI for the Bucs on a single in the fourth inning, while CSU scored its last two runs on a pair of Runnin' Bulldog fielding errors.

GWU scored four runs in the final three innings of Saturday's first game to take the middle game of the series in eight innings, 6-3. A SeaEnna Satcher solo home run and an Ashley Meckley two-run homer accounted for all of the Bucs' offense in that game.

CSU responded in a big way in the series finale, taking the rubber match in run-rule fashion, 9-1, in five innings. Ashlyn Cribb had a career-high three hits, two doubles and four RBI's in the contest, including the game-ending hit. Holly Clark allowed just three hits in 5.0 innings for her second complete game win of the season.

Satcher and Meghan Gagliano had hits in all three games of the series for the Bucs, while Clark and Annah Junge earned the wins in the circle. Nine different Bucs had at least one hit in the series.

Friendly Confines
Charleston Southern began the season with 17 of its first 20 games at home, including each of the first 12 games.

The lone road trip for the Bucs during that span was a three-game Big South series at Presbyterian, where CSU went 1-2.

CSU only plays eight games outside the state of South Carolina this season - all eight are on the Bucs' 10-game road trip to close the 2021 season.

Season Leaders
Brooklynn Brewington is the Bucs' leader among its regular starters in batting average at .352 and hits with 31. Ashley Meckley has nine homers and five doubles to lead CSU in extra-base hits (15) and also has 16 runs batted in to lead the team in that category as well. Sarah Brown has 11 RBI's, while SeaEnna Satcher and Ashlyn Cribb

In the circle, Annah Junge leads the Bucs with a 4.46 ERA in a team-high 53.1 innings. Holly Clark, Alyssa Heinrich and Baylee Eaton have three wins each to lead CSU in that category, with Clark's 28 strikeouts leading the way for the Bucs. Opposing batters are hitting .265 against Eaton, the lowest mark on the team.

What to Watch For
Ashley Meckley has homered against each of Charleston Southern's last five opponents (College of Charleston, Winthrop, South Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Georgia Southern).

Six of the Bucs' regular starters are hitting above .250, with Brewington, Brown and Koger each hitting over .300.

Of the 10 games on this road trip, eight will be played outside the state of South Carolina. Those eight games are CSU's only games outside the Palmetto State this season.

Charleston Southern has at least one stolen base in 13 of its 15 Big South games this season. Brooklynn Brewington leads the Bucs with 12 stolen bases this year, while CSU has only been thrown out once on the basepaths in 2021.

Thievery on the Basepaths
Charleston Southern has recorded at least one stolen base in 13 of its 15 Big South Conference games, including a season-high five steals in the first game of a doubleheader against Gardner-Webb.

The Bucs are 32-for-33 on stolen base attempts this season, with Brooklynn Brewington's 12 steals leading the team. The Bucs are a perfect 23-for-23 on stolen bases against Big South foes this season.

Swing for the Fences
Charleston Southern nearly doubled its home run total for the season in a midweek doubleheader against Coastal Carolina. The Bucs entered the game with six home runs in 10 games but sent four over the fence in the two games against the Chanticleers.

Erika Cooper and Madison Koger both homered in the first game of the doubleheader, while Ashley Meckley and Sarah Brown went yard in the second half of the twin bill.

In addition, Meckley's eight home runs lead the team and account for half of CSU's home run total through the first 25 games (16).

Adding Local Flavor
CSU took on crosstown rival College of Charleston earlier this season in a doubleheader at the CSU Softball Field.

The Bucs and Cougars split the twin bill at the CSU Softball Field on March 30, with CoFC taking the first game, 6-2, and CSU winning the second

game, 6-4.

The Bucs and Cougars were scheduled to meet for a second time at the CSU Softball Field on May 4, but that doubleheader has been canceled.

Early Schedule Adjustments
Charleston Southern had to back out of early season tournaments at Coastal Carolina and Georgia this season due to a COVID-19 pause within the Buccaneer program.

The Bucs also had their three-game series against USC Upstate pushed back by one week to allow for more time for CSU to practice following the pause. The Bucs and Spartans played their three-game set on March 12-13.

Christi Musser became the 10th CSU head softball coach in program history after accepting the position in January 2021. She takes over the Buccaneers' reins bringing 17 years of Division I softball coaching experience with stops at the University of Kansas, the University of New Mexico and, most recently, Grand Canyon University.

A four-star master coach as recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Conference, Musser comes to the Buccaneers after a six-year coaching stint at Grand Canyon University where she served as the associate head coach from August 2015-May 2020. Her efforts as both the hitting instructor and outfield coach helped pace GCU to becoming one of the top hitting teams in the NCAA in both batting average and doubles.

From 2016-18, the Lopes were ranked among the top-15 hitting teams in the NCAA Division I in batting average, finishing sixth overall in 2016 (.342). GCU also finished in the top-eight in doubles per game, ranking second overall in the country in 2016 (1.88) and fourth in 2017 (1.62).

During her tenure at GCU, Musser was a part of a staff that earned the program's first Division I era victory over a nationally-No. 1 ranked team of any program at GCU (Florida State, March 6, 2019), while also helping the program tally its eighth 30-win season. She coached three All-Conference players with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders in the 2018 season with Laynee Gomez and Bianca Boling both earning the recognition.

Prior to her time at GCU, Musser served as the New Mexico state director for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Over her year and a half with the organization, she helped create the strategic vision plan for the state, while also training and equipping the staff, volunteers, and board members to carry out the organization's ministry goals.

Musser's first collegiate coaching position came at her alma mater, Kansas, from 2003 to 2010. She assisted the Jayhawks on the field as a hitting instructor and served as recruiting coordinator during her tenure. She then joined the staff at New Mexico in July 2010 and enjoyed a successful three-year run that included serving as the hitting instructor for a Lobo squad that, in 2012, led the nation with 96 home runs.

During her playing career at Kansas, Musser earned All-American honors in 2002 as an outfielder and was a four-time All-Big 12 selection. In her senior season, she hit .354 with 35 runs, 30 RBI, and nine home runs, while also earning All-Region and All-Big 12 honors.

During the summers of her college career, Musser played three seasons in the Women's Major for the Arizona Storm, winning a national championship in 1999 and finishing as a runner-up in 2000.

Musser graduated from Kansas in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sports management.
