

# ASHLEY MECH

Ashley Meckley has become a mainstay in the Buccaneer lineup from the day she arrived on campus. The Hanahan, South Carolina, native has started all 32 games this season at shortstop after transferring into the program from Coker University.

Meckley is hitting .304 this season, good for second on the team. The junior infielder also leads the team with six doubles, 10 homers, 17 extra-base hits, 19 walks and 20 runs batted in, and also leads the Big South in slugging pct.

Meckley has eight multi-hit games and has at least one hit in 19 of CSU's 32 games. In addition, she has reached base in 27 of the 32 games this season, including each of the Bucs' first 13 contests.

Prior to arriving at CSU, Meckley was a standout for Division II Coker University in Hartsville, South Carolina, where she hit .325 with seven homers and 35 runs batted in across 73 games Despite the jump up to Division I, she is still on pace to put up numbers similar to those she produced during her time with the Cobras.

#### **ONE TO REMEMBER**

Holly Clark struck out six in a complete game performance against Cleveland State, giving head coach Christi Musser her first career win in a 2-1 Buccaneer victory on Feb. 20.

Ashley Meckley provided the offense for CSU with a two-run homer to left in the second innings, while Clark allowed one run on eight hits.

#### **WALK IT OFF**

Brewington hit a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th, scoring Ashley Meckley in the process, as the Bucs earned their first Big South win of the season with a 5-4 extra-inning thriller over Radford.

Annah Junge and Alyssa Heinrich combined to allow just six Radford hits in 11.0 innings of work. Heinrich was credited with the win after tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief. Junge allowed three earned runs in a career-high 8.0 innings while tying her season high with three strikeouts.

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina for the first time since the 2017 season when it took the opening game of a midweek doubleheader over the Chanticleers, 8-7.

Erika Cooper had the go-ahead hit with a solo

home run in the bottom of the fifth inning. Alyssa Heinrich earned her second win of the season with 3.0 innings of relief work, while Annah Junge allowed four runs in 4.0 innings in her fourth start of the season.

The Bucs also earned a doubleheader split with crosstown rival College of Charleston, taking the second game of the twin bill, 6-4. Ashley Meckley homered against the Cougars, while a four-run second inning provided most of the damage for CSU. Baylee Eaton allowed one hit in 4.0 innings for the win.

#### **RUN RULES**

Charleston Southern has a pair of run-rule wins to its name this season, as the Bucs have five-inning wins over both Presbyterian (8-0) and Gardner-Webb (9-1).

The Bucs allowed just four hits and one run in the two games, while recording 20 hits and 15 RBI's in the games.

#### **BAYLEE'S BRILLIANCE**

Baylee Eaton threw the first complete game of her CSU career in a 2-1 win over Winthrop. Eaton allowed just three hits in the win over the Eagles, striking out a pair.

ALL AROUND THE ORDER

Brooklynn Brewington has started every game since she stepped foot on campus prior to the 2019 season. That hasn't changed this year, and the junior is now leading the way at the plate as well.

Brewington has hit all around the batting order for the Bucs this season and has been found anywhere from the leadoff spot to the six spot on head coach Christi Musser's lineup card.

The Andrews, South Carolina, native has rewarded her head coach's trust in her by leading CSU with a .346 batting average through 32 games. Brewington has at least one hit in 25 of the 32 games this season, including a team-leading 11 multi-hit games.

Brewington also delivered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th inning against Radford to give the Bucs their first Big South win of the season.

#### A NEW ERA

Charleston Southern softball ushered in a new chapter in program history in January with the hiring of Christi Musser as the 10th head coach in program history.

Musser comes to the Lowcountry with an extensive coaching background and most recently served as the associate head coach at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Arizona. Musser was previously an assistant coach on the Grand Canyon staff prior to being promoted to associate head coach. During her time at GCU, the Lopes were ranked among the top teams in Division I in batting average and doubles per game. Musser coached three all-conference players during her time with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders.

Musser previously had a three-year stint as an assistant coach at New Mexico, where she was the hitting instructor for the Lobos. Under her tutelage, the Lobos led all of Division I with 96 home runs in 2012.

Musser got her start in coaching at Kansas, her alma mater, where she spent seven seasons as an assistant. She was the hitting instructor and recruiting coordinator during her coaching tenure with the Jayhawks.

#### FAMILIAR FACES IN THE FOLD

While Christi Musser is a new face to the Buccaneer softball program, people familar with CSU softball will recognize the assistant coaches for the Bucs.

Stevi Johnson is in her third season as an assistant coach for the Bucs and is one of the top players in program history. Johnson was a part of CSU's 2014 Big South Championship-winning team and also earned all-conference honors in 2017. She works with the outfielders and as a hitting instructor, with an emphasis on power hitting.

Russell Cooper is also in his third season as an assistant coach, albeit in his second stint with the Buccaneer softball program. Cooper previously spent the 2017-18 seasons on the CSU staff as an assistant coach and works primarily with the pitchers.

#### >>TEAM NOTES

#### Road Swing

Charleston Southern closes its 10-game road trip this weekend when it heads to Longwood for a three-game Big South series.

The series against the Lancers will also serve as the 2021 season finale for the Buccaneers.

#### **All-Time Against Longwood**

Longwood and Charleston Southern have played 33 times prior to this weekend's series. Most of those meetings have come since the Lancers joined the Big South prior to the 2013 season.

Overall, Longwood has a 25-8 advantage in the series, including a 16-2 mark in Big South games. The Lancers are also 10-1 in games played in Farmville and have taken each of the last six series between the teams. Longwood also won the last two games of the series during the 2019 season.

#### **About Longwood**

Longwood enters the weekend at 21-23 overall and 10-5 in Big South play. The Lancers lost their last two games in a midweek doubleheader against James Madison, but have won each of their last two Big South series, taking two-of-three from both Radford and Presbyterian on the road.

Nia Green leads the Lancers at the plate with a .284 batting average. Longwood has no players with an avegage above .300. Lauren Taylor has a team-high seven homers, while Alexis Wayland leads the team with 29 RBI's. Sydney Jacobsen leads Longwood with 19 extra-base hits.

Longwood is aggressive on the basepaths, with 100 stolen bases as a team. Four different Lancers have 10 or more stolen bases this season.

In the circle, Sydney Backstrom is the ace of the Longwood pitching staff and leads the team with 16 wins, a 2.66 ERA and 152 strikeouts across 165.2 innings. Backstrom threw a perfect game last weekend against Presbyterian. Aside from Backstrom, no Lancer pitcher has thrown more than 43 innings this season, and each of Longwood's other four pitchers have an ERA greater than 5.50.

#### **Recapping Tuesday**

Furman scored 10 of its 15 runs in the middle or late innings to sweep a doubleheader from the Bucs at Pepsi Stadium. The Paladins took the first game, 8-6, before rallying with a six-run sixth to win the nightcap, 7-4.

Ashley Meckley had four hits and four RBI's across the two games for the Bucs, including her team-leading 10th home run of the season. Sarah Brown had two hits and three RBI's in the first game for CSU, while Katelyn Norris also had a multi-hit game in the opener.

Holly Clark and Baylee Eaton split the pitching duties in the first game, while Alyssa Heinrich

went 5.2 innings in the second game with Annah Junge picking up the final out.

CSU was tied or ahead in both games, but allowed six extra-base hits in the two games, including a grand slam in the sixth inning of the second game.

The Bucs had eight stolen bases as a team, with Brooklynn Brewington, Katelyn Norris, Sarah Brown and Ashley Meckley swiping two bags apiece in the doubleheader.

Clark had four strikeouts in the first game for the Bucs, marking her third consecutive start with four or more strikeouts.

#### **Recapping Last Weekend**

The Bucs were swept for the first time since the opening weekend of Big South play when Campbell took all three games of a weekend series over the Bucs in Buies Creek.

CSU was limited to just three runs in the series, as Campbell swept the Saturday doubleheader by scorelines of 10-1 and 6-1, then won a pitchers' duel in the series finale on Sunday, 2-1.

Dominique Mannerino led the way for the Bucs at the plate with a pair of multi-hit games against the Camels, while SeaEnna Satcher and Brooklynn Brewington each had one two-hit game against Campbell. Brewington was the only Buc with a hit in all three games of the series, while Mannerino recorded the lone RBI of the weekend for CSU.

Holly Clark and Annah Junge each threw complete games against the Camels, with Clark allowing just two runs in 6.0 innings of work in Sunday's series finale. Junge tossed a career-high 125 pitches in the middle game of the series and tied her season high of three strikeouts in the process.

#### **Friendly Confines**

Charleston Southern began the season with 17 of its first 20 games at home, including each of the first 12 games.

The lone road trip for the Bucs during that span was a three-game Big South series at Presbyterian, where CSU went 1-2.

CSU only plays eight games outside the state of South Carolina this season - all eight are on the Bucs' 10-game road trip to close the 2021 season.

#### **Season Leaders**

Brooklynn Brewington is the Bucs' leader among its regular starters in batting average at .346 and hits with 36. Ashley Meckley leads the team with six doubles, 10 homers, 17 extra-base hits and 20 runs batted in while drawing a team-high 19 walks. 17 of Meckley's 28 hits have gone for extra bases and she also leads the team with a .423 on-base percentage.

In the circle, Holly Clark leads the Bucs in ERA at 4.58, strikeouts with 36 and complete games with three. Annah Junge has tossed a teamleading 59.2 innings in the circle for the Bucs. Baylee Eaton has walked a team-low 17 batters in 54.1 innings.

#### What to Watch For

Charleston Southern leads the Big South in stolen base percentage at 95.2 percent. The Bucs are 40-for-42 on stolen base attempts this season, with Brewington's 14 steals leading the way. CSU was 8-for-9 on stolen base attempts in Tuesday's doubleheader at Furman.

Junge and Clark threw complete games in each of the last two games of the Bucs' weekend series at Campbell. It marked the first time this season that Buccaneer pitchers threw complete games in back-to-back contests.

Despite losing each of their last five games, the Bucs have had a lead in four of those games. CSU had leads in both games of the midweek doubleheader at Furman and opened the scoring in the series opener and series finale at Campbell.

Of the 10 games on this road trip, eight will be played outside the state of South Carolina. Those eight games are CSU's only games outside the Palmetto State this season.

Charleston Southern has at least one stolen base in 13 of its 18 Big South games this season. Brooklynn Brewington leads the Bucs with 14 stolen bases this year, while CSU has only been thrown out twice on the basepaths in 2021.

#### **Thievery on the Basepaths**

Charleston Southern has recorded at least one stolen base in 13 of its 18 Big South Conference games, including a season-high five steals in the first game of a doubleheader against Gardner-Webb.

The Bucs are 40-for-42 on stolen base attempts this season, with Brooklynn Brewington's 12 steals leading the team. The Bucs are a perfect 23-for-23 on stolen bases against Big South foes this season. CSU was successful on each of its first 31 stolen base attempts.

#### **Swing for the Fences**

Charleston Southern nearly doubled its home run total for the season in a midweek doubleheader against Coastal Carolina. The Bucs entered the game with six home runs in 10 games but sent four over the fence in the two games against the Chanticleers.

Erika Cooper and Madison Koger both homered in the first game of the doubleheader, while Ashley Meckley and Sarah Brown went yard in the second half of the twin bill.

In addition, Meckley's 10 home runs lead the team and account for more than half of CSU's home run total through 32 games (19).

#### Adding Local Flavor

CSU took on crosstown rival College of Charleston earlier this season in a doubleheader at the CSU Softball Field.

The Bucs and Cougars split the twin bill at the CSU Softball Field on March 30, with CofC taking the first game, 6-2, and CSU winning the second game, 6-4.

The Bucs and Cougars were scheduled to meet for a second time at the CSU Softball Field on May 4, but that doubleheader has been canceled.

#### **Early Schedule Adjustments**

Charleston Southern had to back out of early season tournaments at Coastal Carolina and Georgia this season due to a COVID-19 pause within the Buccaneer program.

The Bucs also had their three-game series against USC Upstate pushed back by one week to allow for more time for CSU to practice following the pause. The Bucs and Spartans played their three-game set on March 12-13.

Christi Musser became the 10th CSU head softball coach in program history after accepting the position in January 2021. She takes over the Buccaneers' reins bringing 17 years of Division I softball coaching experience with stops at the University of Kansas, the University of New Mexico and, most recently, Grand Canyon University.

A four-star master coach as recognized by the National Fastpitch Coaches Conference, Musser comes to the Buccaneers after a six-year coaching stint at Grand Canyon University where she served as the associate head coach from August 2015-May 2020. Her efforts as both the hitting instructor and outfield coach helped pace GCU to becoming one of the top hitting teams in the NCAA in both batting average and doubles.

From 2016-18, the Lopes were ranked among the top-15 hitting teams in the NCAA Division I in batting average, finishing sixth overall in 2016 (.342). GCU also finished in the top-eight in doubles per game, ranking second overall in the country in 2016 (1.88) and fourth in 2017 (1.62).

During her tenure at GCU, Musser was a part of a staff that earned the program's first Division I era victory over a nationally-No. 1 ranked team of any program at GCU (Florida State, March 6, 2019), while also helping the program tally its eighth 30-win season. She coached three All-Conference players with the Lopes, including a pair of First Team All-WAC outfielders in the 2018 season with Laynee Gomez and Bianca Boling both earning the recognition.

Prior to her time at GCU, Musser served as the New Mexico state director for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Over her year and a half with the organization, she helped create the strategic vision plan for the state, while also training and equipping the staff, volunteers, and board members to carry out the organization's ministry goals.

Musser's first collegiate coaching position came at her alma mater, Kansas, from 2003 to 2010. She assisted the Jayhawks on the field as a hitting instructor and served as recruiting coordinator during her tenure. She then joined the staff at New Mexico in July 2010 and enjoyed a successful three-year run that included serving as the hitting instructor for a Lobo squad that, in 2012, led the nation with 96 home runs.

During her playing career at Kansas. Musser earned All-American honors in 2002 as an outfielder and was a

four-time All-Big 12 selection. In her senior season, she hit .354 with 35 runs, 30 RBI, and nine home runs, while also earning All-Region and All-Big 12 honors.

During the summers of her college career, Musser played three seasons in the Women's Major for the Arizona Storm, winning a national championship in 1999 and finishing as a runner-up in 2000.

Musser graduated from Kansas in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in sports management.
