## 16TH-RANKED BUFFS OPEN PAC-12 PLAY AT HOME VERSUS UTAH, ARIZONA

**STARTING OFF:** Colorado will open Pac-12 play at home this week, hosting Utah and Arizona at Coors Events Center. The Buffs start the week against the Utes on Wednesday, Sept. 21, at 7 p.m. On Sunday, Sept. 25, the Buffs will welcome Arizona to Boulder for a 1 p.m. match.

**HOW TO WATCH:** Both matches will be televised live. Pac-12 Mountain will carry Wednesday's match against Utah, while Pac-12 Network, Mountain and Arizona will broadcast the Arizona game. Thad Anderson and Dain Blanton will have the call against Utah, while Chris Marlowe and Blanton will call the Arizona match.

### PROMOTIONS

- Approximately 40 minutes prior to the Utah match, CU head coach Jesse Mahoney will hold a chalk talk in the Coors Club room on the second floor of the CEC, located behind section 3. It is open to all fans.
- There will also be a post-match autograph session following the Utah match on the concourse above section 4.
- CU will host a post-match youth clinic on Sunday afternoon following CU's match against Arizona. Fans are encouraged to RSVP at [CUBuffs.com/VBClinic](http://CUBuffs.com/VBClinic).

**CONFERENCE OPENERS:** Colorado is 14-16 in all-time conference openers. It had a record of 7-8 in the Big 12 era and was 5-5 in the Big Eight. CU is 2-3 in Pac-12 openers, all against Utah.

**ABOUT THE BUFFS:** The Buffs moved up to 16th in the latest AVCA Poll and head into action this week with an 8-2 record. CU is also a perfect 5-0 at home this season. As a team, CU ranks seventh in the NCAA in hitting percentage (.301) and is 10th in blocks per set (3.01).

Individually, the Buffs are led by Alexa Smith, who is averaging 3.47 kills per set. At the net, the Buffs have two players posting over 1.00 blocks per set. Sophomore Naghede Abu is averaging the 20th best total

in the country at 1.49 blocks per set, while junior Joslyn Hayes is second on the team with 1.29 blocks per set (45th in the NCAA). Abu ranks sixth in the Pac-12, while Hayes is ninth.

Junior Gabby Simpson and senior Kiara McKibben have been running a very successful 6-2 offense, as seen in CU's hitting efficiency which is the second highest in the league. Simpson is averaging 5.77 assists per set, but also adds 1.96 kills per set as well. McKibben is recording 6.77 assists per set, the ninth best mark in the Pac-12.

**ABOUT UTAH:** Utah enters Wednesday's match with a 9-2 record, which includes a 3-2 win over then-No. 9 BYU in Provo, Utah. The Utes have done well on the road early this season and are a perfect 3-0. They are averaging 14.44 kills per set, which leads the Pac-12 and ranks 11th in the nation. Adora Anae is a huge part of that as she is recording the nation's ninth best kills per set average at 4.73. Carly Truman is second on the team with 2.98 kills per set. Utah is attacking at a .292 clip and holds its opponents to a .198 hitting efficiency. UU leads the all-time series against the Buffs at 8-7. Colorado has won the last four matches at Coors against the Utes.

**THE SERIES CLARIFICATION VS. UTAH:** The first varsity season for Colorado was 1986, but prior to that, CU, like many schools, had a club program. That club program had a match against Utah's varsity team, which started competition in 1975. Utah defeated CU and counts that win in the all-time series, which the Buffs do not since it was against the club program. Therefore, CU lists the all-time series as 7-8.

**ABOUT ARIZONA:** The Arizona Wildcats are 8-4 heading into Pac-12 play. They will host Arizona State on Wednesday prior to heading to Boulder and are currently on a five-match win streak. The Wildcats are 0-3 this season against ranked opponents. Kendra Dahlke is the top offensive weapon, averaging 4.10 kills per set, the third best mark in the Pac-12, and Kalei Mau adds 3.41, which is 10th in the Pac-12. As a team, the Wildcats lead the conference with 1.66 aces per set and individually Penina Snuka is first in the Pac-12, 13th in the NCAA, with 0.54 aces per set. Arizona leads the all-time series 6-5, but has struggled in Boulder in recent years, dropping its last three matches in straight sets.

**UNDEFEATED AT COORS:** Jesse Mahoney's home tenure with the Buffs is off to a great start as CU has not lost on its home court this season. The Buffs have won all five matches at Coors Events Center this season, which includes wins over #13 Penn State, #17 Illinois, Chicago State, New Orleans and instate rival Colorado State.

**RENEWING THE RIVALRY:** For the first time since 2010, Colorado and Colorado State faced each other during the regular season. The Buffs hosted the Rams as part of the Omni Invitational and defeated them in four sets (25-22, 25-20, 23-25, 25-21) on Sept. 17. It was the first meeting for the two teams in Boulder since 2008.

**OMNI INVITATIONAL WRAP-UP:** Colorado won its own Omni Invitational, Sept. 16-17, with a 3-0 record. The Buffs started the tournament with a 3-0 win against Chicago State on Friday night. On Saturday, CU started the day off with another 3-0 win, this time against New Orleans. The final match of the tournament was against Colorado State, which CU won 3-1.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The Buffs will wrap-up a seven-match home stand next week, hosting Southern California and UCLA. CU will face USC on Sept. 30 and UCLA on Oct. 2.

**FIFTH TIME IS A CHARM:** CU head coach Jesse Mahoney had met Colorado State four times while a head coach at Denver, but each time his team came out on the losing end. That changed for him on Sept. 17 when his Colorado Buffaloes took down Colorado State 3-1 (25-22, 25-20, 23-25, 25-21) in Boulder to win the Omni Invitational.

**SAN DIEGO INVITATIONAL WRAP-UP:** Colorado went 1-1 at the San Diego Invitational, Sept. 9-10. The Buffs started the weekend off with a three-set loss to USD, which was ranked 15th at the time. CU rebounded the following day against UC Irvine, sweeping the Anteaters easily with set scores of 25-15, 25-22, 25-11.

**AFTER A LOSS, WE SWEEP:** CU has only lost twice this season, and after each loss, the Buffs have rebounded with a sweep against their next opponent. After dropping their first match to Portland State (August 27), the Buffs came back to sweep Long Beach State the evening.

The second loss was against then-No. 15 San Diego on Sept. 9. CU responded on Sept. 10 with a sweep against UC Irvine.

**FIVE ERRORS BACK-TO-BACK:** Since 2001, the start of the rally scoring era, the least amount of hitting errors committed by the Buffs in a single match was six, which they did twice, once against Florida (2009) and once versus Robert Morris (2014).

But 2016 has been a good year and in back-to-back matches, the Buffs committed just five errors. They first did it against UC Irvine on Sept. 10 and in the following match against Chicago State on Sept. 16, they did it again.

**PAC-12/BIG TEN CHALLENGE WRAP-UP:** The Buffs had an outstanding weekend, winning both of their matches at the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge, Sept. 3-4.

They started the tournament against No. 13 Penn State, and didn't back down from the perennial powerhouse. CU dropped the first set (25-22), but rallied to take the next two (25-20, 25-19), going up 2-1 in the match. The Nittany Lions fought back and took set four (25-20), but the Buffs were not going to give up. In the fifth set, the Buffs won easily, 15-3.

It would have been easy for CU to take it easy the following night against No. 17 Illinois, but again the Buffs came out ready to battle, taking the first set 25-17. The Illini came back and won the second set (25-18) and CU rallied back to win the third set (25-15). Set four (25-18) belonged to Illinois and again the Buffs were going to play five sets. It was a tight back and fourth battle, but the Buffs were able to grind out the 19-17 victory.

**PAC-12/BIG TEN CHALLENGE REDEMPTION:** CU competed in the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge for the second straight year in 2016 and were looking for redemp-

**HIGHEST DEBUT:** The Buffs' debut at No. 18 in the second poll of the season was both the highest debut of any team in the third coaches poll of the 2016 season and the highest debut for the Buffs in program history aside from a preseason poll. Previously, the highest the Buffs debuted was No. 21 in 2014 after beating No. 14 Arizona and No. 18 Arizona State on the road the previous week.

**PAC-12 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK; SEPT 5:** Sophomore middle blocker Naghede Abu was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 5 after helping CU upset No. 13 Penn State and No. 17 at the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge.

Abu's presence at the net was felt by both opponents. She posted eight blocks, two solo and six assists, against the Nittany Lions and added four more in the victory against the Fighting Illini. Abu averaged 1.20 blocks per set to lead the Buffs at the net, but she also had a strong showing on offense. Abu recorded nine kills against PSU and added another 13 kills against Illinois. She hit an impressive .476 with three errors on 21 attacks against the Illini.

**A NEW ERA:** The Buffaloes are starting a new era as Jesse Mahoney was named the fifth head coach in CU history in December of 2015. Mahoney joined the Buffs after spending four seasons as the head coach at Denver, where he guided the Pioneers to an 88-41 mark and back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2014-15).

He is joined by assistant coaches Lee Maes and Evan Sanders.

**AN EPIC HOME START:** Colorado head coach Jesse Mahoney recorded his first two wins against NCAA Division I ranked opponents, Sept. 3-4, in his first two matches at the Coors Events Center. Mahoney's team defeated then-No. 13 Penn State in a five-set thriller to earn his first win at the CEC, and followed it up the following night with another five-set win, this time against then-No. 17 Illinois.

**A FIFTH-SET LOW:** When the Buffs defeated No. 13 Penn State on Sept. 3, they held the Nittany Lions to just three points in the fifth set, which set a CU record for the fewest points allowed by an opponent in a fifth set (in the rally scoring era).

**PORTLAND STATE TOURNAMENT WRAP-UP:** The 2016 season started for the Buffs at the Portland State Tournament. On the very first day, CU went five set with Texas Tech, coming up with the victory, 20-25, 25-19, 24-26, 25-18, 15-8.

The following day CU had two matches, starting off against Portland State. The Buffs lost a hard-fought match, again going five set, with set scores of 26-28, 25-18, 25-17, 19-25, 14-16. Colorado was able to rebound well after the loss, sweeping Long Beach State 25-21, 25-18, 25-22.

**31 SEASONS OF CU VOLLEYBALL:** The University of Colorado volleyball program is celebrating its 31st season in 2016. Since debuting as a varsity program in the fall of 1986, the Buffs have recorded an overall record of 508-412 including one conference title (Big Eight in 1993).

**CAPTAINS:** Senior libero Cierra Simpson and junior Joslyn Hayes are the 2016 captains. This is Simpson's second stint as a captain, while it is Hayes' first.

**BLOCKS, BLOCKS, BLOCKS:** The Buffs did not waste time this year, breaking records in the second match of the season. CU posted 44 block assists in its five-set loss to Portland State, breaking the five-set record of 42 from Oct. 17, 2007 against Iowa State.

In that same match, sophomore Naghede Abu recorded 15 blocks, tying the CU record which was set in 1989 by Lisa Soulliere against Texas.

tion after getting swept by both Penn State and Illinois in the 2015 tournament. That is exactly what the Buffs did, upsetting both PSU and IU in five sets.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** For the first time in CU history, the Buffs defeated a pair of ranked non-conference opponents on back-to-back nights.

Only 10 times previously have the Buffs beat two ranked opponents in a row, but that accomplishment has never happened on back-to-back days.

**PAC-12/BIG TEN CHALLENGE SWEEP:** For the first time in the three year history of the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge, a conference won all four matches as Colorado and Stanford both took down Illinois and Penn State. In 2014, the Pac-12 won three of the four matches and in 2015, the Big Ten came back to go 3-1.

**IN THE POLLS:** The Buffs are ranked 16th in the latest AVCA Division I Coaches Poll. Since earning a ranking, the Buffs have recorded a 4-1 record.

**POLL HISTORY:** CU has been ranked a total of 120 weeks. In that time, the Buffs have accumulated a 168-88 record.

Both marks (22.0 blocks/44 block assists and 15 blocks in a single match) lead the Pac-12 Conference.

**LEADING THE NCAA:** After the first weekend of play, Naghede Abu's 15 blocks against Portland State is the most by any player in a five-set match. Teammate Joslyn Hayes posted 11 blocks in that same match, which is tied for 10th in the NCAA.

**PAIR OF BLOCKERS:** Two Buffs are ranked in the top 10 of the Pac-12 in blocks per set. Naghede Abu is sixth (1.49) and Joslyn Hayes is 10th (1.28).

**200 WINS:** Colorado head coach Jesse Mahoney earned his 200th career victory on Sept. 10 after the Buffs swept UC Irvine in San Diego.

He has also won 96 matches as a Division I head coach.

**MOVING UP:** Senior Cierra Simpson looks to become CU's all-time career digs leader this season, and doesn't have far to go. Karrie Downey currently holds the record at 1,540, but Simpson is right behind with 1,519, which ranks third all-time. She is already the rally-scoring era leader.

**PAC-12 NETWORKS:** The Pac-12 Network will televise 15 of CU's matches this season, 13 conference contests and two nonconference tilts.

**CONNECTIONS:** Several of Colorado's 2016 opponents have connections to the CU coaching staff.

- **Jesse Mahoney** was an associate head coach and an assistant coach at Colorado State.
- **Lee Maes** spent time at California, working with both the men's and women's programs, and he also graduated from Long Beach State.
- **Evan Sanders** played at both Colorado State and Washington.

**30 MOMENTS:** In honor of the 30th Anniversary of Colorado Volleyball, every week, two of the top 30 moments in CU history will be highlighted at CUBuffs.com. Check back every Tuesday and Thursday to see what moments helped make CU Volleyball one of the best programs in the country.

**PRESEASON PAC-12 RANKING/TEAM:** The Buffs were picked to finish seventh in the Pac-12 Preseason Poll, while junior Gabby Simpson was selected to the Preseason All-Pac-12 Team.

**CLEAR BAG POLICY:** In an effort to provide a safer environment for fans, the University of Colorado will be implementing a clear bag policy at the Coors Events Center for all CU volleyball matches, men's basketball and women's basketball games this season (2016).

Beginning this season, fans may bring one clear bag no larger than 12 inches x 6 inches x 12 inches, or a one-gallon reseal-able clear plastic storage bag, into the arena. Fans will also be allowed one small clutch purse, no larger than 4.5 inches by 6.5 inches.

Bags that will no longer be allowed into the CEC include backpacks, large purses, oversized tote bags, camera bags and binocular cases, diaper bags, fanny packs and printed plastic bags.

**BUFFS AT HOME:** Colorado will call the Coors Events Center home for the 29th straight season this year. The Buffs are 262-134 all-time at the CEC for a winning percentage of .662.

**ATTENDANCE:** The Buffs have averaged 1,745 fans per home match this season, which ranks 19th in the NCAA. Overall, 8,724 fans have made it through the gates at Coors to watch the Buffs.

The 1,745 leads the Pac-12 in attendance.

**DEFEATING THE LEAGUE:** Since joining the Pac-12 Conference, the Buffs have earned a win against all but one team in the league, Southern California. CU will look to change that on Sept. 30 when USC comes to Boulder.

**USOTC TRAINING:** The Buffaloes trained again at the United States Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo. this year during the preseason camp, August 14-18.

**CNT PROGRAM:** Four Buffs were selected to train with the USA Volleyball Collegiate National Team program this summer. Cierra Simpson and Taylor Joachim were selected to the team that competed in Indianapolis. Gabby Simpson was named to the European tour and Alexa Smith was a member of the China team.

**MORE USA VOLLEYBALL:** Assistant coach Lee Maes was also involved with USA Volleyball this summer as he was named the head coach of the USAV Women's Junior Continental Team program, which ran July 14-23.

**PAC-12 ALL-STARS:** Junior Gabby Simpson had a busy summer. Besides traveling to Europe with USA Volleyball, she went to China as a member of the Pac-12 All-Star Team.

**HOME OPENERS:** The Buffs are 21-10 in home openers. CU recorded a pair of wins, Sept. 3-4, to start the season off on a high note, defeating No. 13 Penn State and No. 17 Illinois at the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge.

**SEASON OPENERS:** The Buffs are 20-11 in season openers, which includes a 7-4 record in the last 11 season openers.

**SEASON TICKETS:** Season tickets start at just \$25 for general admission and are on sale now at CUBuffs.com or by calling 303-49-BUFFS. Reserved seats are \$40 for the season.

Single match tickets are also available. General admission seats for most matches are \$5, reserved seats are \$8. Kids 12 and under are free. For the Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge and the second day of the Omni Invitational, general admission is \$8 and reserved seats are \$12.

# HEAD COACH JESSE MAHONEY



Jesse Mahoney was named the fifth head volleyball coach in University of Colorado history on December 17, 2015.

Mahoney, a Boulder native, spent the previous four seasons at the University of Denver, where he guided the Pioneers to an 88-41 mark, including back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances (2014, 2015).

The Pioneers finished with a 27-8 mark in 2015 after falling to No. 5 Washington in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. In 2014, DU was 27-7, its season ending in the first round of the tournament, on that occasion to No. 13 Colorado State, also in the first round.

The Pioneers accumulated a 46-18 conference mark with Mahoney at the helm, winning the Summit League regular season championship the last two seasons with identical 13-3 league records; Denver also claimed the postseason tournament title both years. The 2014 crown was the school's first in the sport after joining the league in 2013, in which Mahoney coached the Pioneers to a 10-4 league mark and runner-up finishes in both the regular season and in the postseason tourney. That team was 17-13 overall, as was his first team at DU in 2012, when the Pioneers were members of the Western Athletic Conference (with a 10-8 mark in conference play).

While at Denver, Mahoney coached 17 all-conference selections, including a pair of 2014 AVCA Division I Honorable Mention All-Americans. His 2014 recruiting class was tabbed No. 28 by prepvolleyball.com. Nationally, the Pioneers' offense was ranked in the top 25 in hitting efficiency three times (2013-15) and in 2015 the defense cracked the top 25 in opponent hitting efficiency. Mahoney also helped the

Pioneers to the AVCA Team Academic Award from 2012-14.

Prior to his success at DU, Mahoney served as an assistant head coach at Colorado State (2005-11), including four as the associate head coach. In his time there under head coach Tom Hilbert, the Rams participated in seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments and won five Mountain West titles. CSU compiled a 162-51 record during his time on the staff.

While with the Rams, he helped to assemble three recruiting classes ranked in the top 25 by prepvolleyball.com. His primary responsibility in practice was working with the middle blockers and CSU was ranked nationally in the top 10 in blocking five of his seven seasons. He tutored two All-American middle blockers as well as multiple All-Conference and All-Region performers.

Mahoney joined the staff at CSU after six seasons as the head coach at Fort Hays State, where the Tigers recorded a 107-82 overall record under his direction. FHSU tallied an impressive 56-12 record over his last two years there (2003-04), which included a 31-5 mark and No. 11 final national ranking in 2004.

His first varsity coaching position was as an assistant coach at Colorado Christian, which followed

his first foray into the profession – the head coach of the CU men's club volleyball team from 1995-98. Mahoney has also coached in the club circuit as a member of the Front Range Volleyball Club, guiding the 18-Black to the 1998 USA Junior Rocky Mountain Region title.

Mahoney is no stranger to the University of Colorado, having earned a bachelor's degree in Psychology in 1995 and a Juris Doctorate degree from CU's Law School in 1999. He is married to the former Gwen McEntyre and the couple has three children: Macy, Griffin and Declan.
