RMISA CHAMPIONSHIPS & HISTORY

The Rocky Mountain Intercollegiate Ski Association is the official association for college and university NCAA skiing teams in the Rocky Mountain region. It is comprised of 10 institutions, seven NCAA members and three associate members, from six states stretching from Alaska to New Mexico. Member schools in 2017-18 are Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Fairbanks, Colorado, Colorado Mountain College, Denver, Montana State, New Mexico, Utah, Westminster College and Wyoming. The RMISA was founded in 1950, four years before becoming a sanctioned sport by the NCAA. From 1950-82, a men's champion was awarded. In 1977, women's skiing became an RMISA sport, six years before being recognized by the NCAA. Starting in 1983 when women's sports became part of the NCAA, the sport became coed and thus a coed champion was recognized from the RMISA, as well.

The RMISA has recognized a regular season champion since 2006. The regular season champion is determined by the accumulation of meet points for each regular season meet prior to the RMISA Championships/NCAA West Regional.

Since the introduction of the NCAA Skiing National Championship in 1954, schools from the RMISA have captured 56 of the 64 team titles, or 87.3 percent, and 273 of the 383 individual champions are student-athletes from RMISA schools. More information can be found at RMISASkiing.com.
