CONCORD TAKES NO. 2 REGIONAL RANKING ON ROAD TO WISE

The accolades continue to roll in for the Concord University football team, and this week the Mountain Lions are ranked second in the initial Division II Super Region One rankings that were released Monday afternoon.

- CU is ranked number two in the region after a 24-20 win over the University of Charleston in week number eight of the season.
- Bloomsburg out of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) is ranked number one in the region, sporting an 8-0 mark like the Mountain Lions.
- California (Pa.), West Chester, Winston-Salem State, American International, Shepherd, Virginia State, Slippery Rock and West Liberty rounded out the regional rankings.
- The top six teams in each of the four super regions will earn a spot in the NCAA Division II playoffs with the top two teams in each region earning a bye into the second round. However, a conference champion from an automatic bid league that is ranked inside of the top eight, but not inside the top six, can bump the lowest ranked at-large team from the playoffs. The Mountain East Conference champion will not have an automatic bid into the NCAA playoffs until next season.
- In addition to its regional ranking, CU moved up four spots in the AFCA Coaches' Poll this week to number 15 and is just one of seven teams to begin the season 8-0 in the nation.
- Furthermore, the Mountain Lions are 16th in the latest D2football.com poll.

Mountain Lion Notes

- Against Charleston, junior running back Calvinaugh Jones rushed for a season-high 171 yards while still averaging 7.4 yards per carry.
- Perhaps, the biggest differences in the game came from freshman wide receiver T.J. Smith who caught three passes for 96 yards and two touchdowns and redshirt freshman defensive back and reigning Mountain East Conference Defensive Player of the Week Jeremiah Johnson intercepted his third pass of the season.
- After Charleston had cut into the CU lead of 10-3 with a field goal, sophomore quarterback Brian Novak found Smith for a 72-yard touchdown strike with less than a minute to go before halftime to give the Mountain Lions a 17-6 lead at intermission.
- Heading into play against UVa.-Wise, Smith is CU's leading receiver with 30 receptions for 553 yards and seven touchdowns.
- Smith's seven scoring receptions is third in the MEC and his 553 yards are fourth in the league.
- As for Johnson, he snared his interception with less than a minute in regulation as Charleston was driving inside Concord territory, sealing the game for CU.
- The Baltimore, Maryland native's pick was preceded by the go-ahead touchdown score from Novak to sophomore wide receiver Davon McGill with 1:51 left in the game.
- The victory over the UC was the first time Concord had trailed in a game in the fourth quarter this season.
- Before last Saturday's contest, the last time the Mountain Lions came from behind in the fourth quarter to defeat a team was last season on the road when they beat Charleston 9-3 after entering the fourth quarter down 3-0.

Mountain Lion Notes

- With his performance against Charleston, Jones surpassed the 1,000-yard mark for the second straight season and now has 1,004 yards this season, which ranks second in the MEC and 13th nationally.
- In fact, Jones is just three yards shy of matching the entire UVa.-Wise squad in rushing.
- After tossing three touchdowns against the Golden Eagles, Novak sits ninth nationally in touchdown passes (23).
- Novak and the rest of the CU offense is second nationally in scoring averaging 48.4 points per game.
- By throwing for 279 or more yards against UVa.-Wise, Novak would become the seventh signal caller in CU history to pass for 4,000 or more yards in his career.
- Concord enters play Saturday with the best turnover margin in the MEC (+11) which also places nationally (ninth).
- Not only has the CU offense committed the second fewest turnovers in the league (11), but the Mountain Lion defense has been relentless as they have intercepted a league-best 16 passes.
- The 16 picks also rank third in Division II.
- Along the front-seven of the defense, Concord has totaled 23

- sacks, second best in the MEC with senior defensive end Anthony Pyle leading the way with five.
- Concord has more than doubled its total in sacks from last season through eight games.
- The Mountain Lions had just 11 sacks after eight contests in 2013.
- CU tallied 15 sacks all season, but this season with Pyle leading the team, four other Concord players have at least three sacks including junior linebacker Nick Ortiz (four), senior defensive lineman Keith Ferguson (three), junior defensive lineman Ervin Moore (three) and junior linebacker Cade Rogers (three).
- Last season in a 44-6 win over UVa.-Wise, Novak had his best game of the 2013 season with 271 passing yards and three touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Tiko Henderon hauled in 109 yards and a score.
- Concord leads the brief five-game series over UVa.-Wise 3-2.
- The Cavaliers will return to Carl Smith Stadium coming off its first win of the season, a 16-13 win at West Virginia State.
- UVa.-Wise possesses the fourth-leading tackler in the league in Zack Blair who has 70 tackles this season.
- The Cavaliers are the third in the MEC in time of possession as they average over 32 minutes of possession per game.

Garin Justice enters his fourth year as Concord University's head football coach in 2014. He was named the 18th Mountain Lion head coach on January 7, 2011.

Since coming to Concord, Justice has led the rejuvenation of a program that had gone 0-11 as recently as 2008. Over his three year reign as head coach Justice has compiled a record of 22-11 (.667), already the third highest winning percentage and eighth most wins by a head coach in CU history.

Additionally, Justice has led the Mountain Lions to one conference championship and a subsequent NCAA Division II playoff appearance.

"Garin's pedigree in college football is fantastic," Concord Director of Athletics Kevin Garrett said. "He played at West Virginia for Rich Rodriguez and Rick Trickett. He worked for Bobby Bowden, Jimbo Fisher and Trickett at Florida State. He had a chance to learn from some outstanding coaches and he's done great work here.

"Garin is a man who grew up in southern West Virginia and is now coaching in southern West Virginia. That means a lot to everyone here," said Garrett. "Garin Justice and Concord football have a bright future."

At Concord, Justice's teams have been known for their nationally-ranked defense as well as an offensive strategy that has provided the Mountain Lions the opportunity to win through an aerial attack or via a ground-based offense depending upon personnel.

On Justice's watch 50 players have been All-West Virginia Athletic Conference or All-Mountain East Conference selections while two athletes earned WVIAC Defensive Players of the Year accolades in addition to 18 all-region selections and eight All-Americans honorees.

2013 was one of his finest seasons to date; Concord went 8-3 and narrowly lost out on winning the inaugural MEC title and earning a playoff bid. Concord tallied three-year highs under Justice on offense in points per game (26.6) and rushing yards per game (167.9). Just as impressive was Justice's defense which posted three-year lows in points allowed per game (14.2), rushing yards allowed per game (108.4) and passing yards allowed per game (159.7).

Defensively, the Mountain Lions ended the season ranked third in the nation in points allowed, third in total defense, third in third down conversion defense, third in first downs

allowed, fourth in passing yards allowed and 27th in turnovers forced. For their efforts Jake Lilly and Davon Marion were named third team and honorable mention All-Americans by Don Hansen's Football Gazette and the Beyond Sports Network, respectively.

CU's special teams unit also excelled in 2013 under Justice by ranking sixth in the country in blocked kicks, seventh in punt return defense and ninth in net punting.

Offensively, CU recorded the 24th best time of possession total in all of NCAA Division II thanks in part to a bruising rushing attack that saw lead back Calvinaugh Jones rush for 1,031 yards, the most for a Mountain Lion running back since 2010.

In 2012, Justice's second season in Athens, Concord registered a 7-4 overall record and a 6-2 WVIAC record despite being forced to deal with a magnitude of injuries to key starters on both offense and defense.

Concord once again had one of the top rated defenses in the country in, ranking 14th in the nation in total defense, 11th in scoring defense and seventh in passing defense. CU's offense managed to withstand the loss of perennial all-conference quarterback Zack Grossi to a season-ending injury in week three to go to rank fifth in the WVIAC in both passing yards and rushing yards.

Justice's first season as a head coach was one for the record books. He led Concord to its first WVIAC title since 1990 as well as the school's first appearance in the NCAA Division II playoffs after CU finished 7-4 overall and 7-1 in WVIAC competition. For his efforts, Justice was named the 2011 WVIAC Coach of the Year.

A native of Gilbert, W. Va., Justice originally came to Concord in January of 2009 as the offensive line coach and strength & conditioning coordinator on former coach Mike Keller's staff. Justice played a prominent role in Concord's remarkable turnaround after its 0-11 season in 2008.

In 2009, Justice's first year on the CU staff, the Mountain Lions went 6-5. In 2010, Concord was 8-3, winning eight games in a season for the first time in 19 years.

Prior to his arrival in Athens, Justice spent two seasons at Florida State University as an offensive graduate assistant, offensive videographer, and weight room graduate assistant. Justice helped develop four freshmen All-Americans and two All-Atlantic Coastal Conference performers. He completed his master's degree from Florida State in sports administration in 2008.

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at West Virginia University in 2006 where he worked with the offensive line and helped Dan Mozes win the Rimington Award as the nation's best center.

Justice became known in his home state as a three-year starting offensive tackle at West Virginia University. He was cap



tain of the 2005 Mountaineer squad that went 11-1, defeated Georgia in the Sugar Bowl and ended the season as the fifth best team in the country according to the final AP Poll.

That season, Justice earned All-Big East honors and was a Sporting News second team All-American. He was also the Big East Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Justice graduated from West Virginia University in 2006 with a bachelor of regents degree.

Justice grew up in Mingo County, roughly 80 miles from the CU campus in Athens. His mother and brother are both proud Concord alums.

Justice married the former Casie Coughlin at Concord University on July 7, 2012. The couple's first child, Juliet Blake, was born on May 20, 2014.

"It's an honor and a privilege to be head coach at Concord," Justice said "I have a great sense of pride to be able to coach at the university my family holds in such high regard. I'm thrilled and excited for the opportunity."
