KICKOFF

For the second straight season, the Concord University football team opens up its season against West Virginia Wesleyan when the two teams clash at WVWC's Cebe Ross Field 12:00 p.m. Saturday in Buckhannon, West Virginia.

AMONG THE BEST

Senior linebacker Zach Malone begins the season ranked ninth in school history in total tackles with 230. Additionally, the Charleston, West Virginia native is slotted 17th among active Division II players in career tackles. Over the last two seasons, Malone has registered at least 10 tackles in 12 games including the last four of the 2017 season. Last season, CU's middle linebacker had 11 stops versus West Virginia Wesleyan. Since finishing the 2016 contest at WVWC with four tackles, Malone has double-digit tackles in 12 of his last 18 games.

FINDING A WAY

In last season's 23-18 loss to West Virginia Wesleyan, the Mountain Lions scored two defensive touchdowns. Sophomore defensive back Jonathan Roebuck ran back an interception for a score in the game's opening minutes before a fumble return for a touchdown by former Concord standout Jeremiah Johnson in the third quarter. For Roebuck, it was one of two defensive touchdowns he would score last season as the Leesburg, Virginia native also had an interception for a touchdown against UNC-Pembroke. Roebuck is just one of two players to have two interceptions for touchdowns in the same season joining Travis Preston during the 2000 campaign.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

The last two contests between Concord and West Virginia Wesleyan haven't been decided until the game's final minutes. After the Bobcats jumped out to a 20-6 halftime lead last season, Concord got to within 23-18 with seven minutes in the fourth quarter, but a late CU drive stalled out with under 90 seconds to go as the Mountain Lions dropped a five-point decision. Two seasons ago at Wesleyan, record-setting Concord quarterback Brian Novak led a late Mountain Lion drive that covered 90 yards over 10 plays to propel Concord to a 20-17 win on the road. Junior wide receiver Brandon Plyler recorded one of his two career multi-touchdown games with two scoring receptions. Overall, Plyler has caught seven passes for 87 yards and two touchdowns in his career versus WVWC. The Fort Mill, South Carolina native enters the season as Concord's active leading receiver with 665 yards on 59 receptions.

SPECIALIZING IN SPECIALIZING

Saturday's contest will feature the two leading kickoff returners in the Mountain East Conference from last season in sophomore wide receiver Tywan Pearce of Concord and Wesleyan's Jajuan Linzy. Linzy led the league in return average at 25.2 yards per return. Meanwhile, Pearce averaged 22.4 yards per return on his way to being named First Team All-MEC as a returner in 2017. Last season, Pearce had four kickoff returns of at least 40 yards. In a year in which Concord graduated placekicker Zack Keaton and All-American punter Garrett Lee, Pearce and senior long snapper and tight end Mark Large are the only returning specialists for the Mountain Lions.

EXPERIENCE IN THE TRENCHES

With eight freshmen listed on the two deep for the Mountain Lions in the skill areas, Concord has veteran-laden offensive and defensive lines. Senior offensive lineman Derek Dressler has started 22 consecutive games between guard and center while playing in 28 career games. Meanwhile, sophomore offensive lineman Nathan Toney started in all 11 games in 2017 and senior Jack Skidmore started 10 contests in his first season as a full-time starter last season. Defensively, senior Justin Noble leads the defensive line for CU. The Nutter Fort, West Virginia native, who will play 24 miles from where he grew up on Saturday, needs five tackles for 100 for his career. Opposite of Noble on the defensive line is junior Ryan Gatrell who saw spot starts in 2017 and was a pass rush specialist.

RESTARTING A STREAK

Last year's loss against WVWC snapped a string of six straight victories for Concord over the Bobcats. The overall series record belongs to CU 19-15, but there's been a couple lengthy winning streaks for both sides. From 2000-05, Wesleyan won six straight games. Concord owns the longest winning streak in the series as it won eight straight games from 1976-83.

WEST VIRGINIA WESLEYAN AT A GLANCE

The Bobcats return a couple of their top defensive linemen from the 2017 season in Harry Lewis and Aman Speed. The duo combined for nine sacks and 16 tackles for loss last season. WVWC also welcomes back its leader rusher in Devin Montgomery who ran for nearly 900 yards in his first season at Wesleyan. Montgomery rushed for 238 yards against Concord last season. Current Wesleyan head coach Del Smith played for CU head coach Paul Price when Price was an assistant coach at his alma mater during the early 2000s.



Concord Director of Athletics Kevin Garrett named former Concord defensive coordinator Paul Price as the new head coach January 14, 2016.

"Paul has been an integral part of our turnaround here at Concord over the last seven years," Concord Director of Athletics Kevin Garrett said. "As the defensive coordinator, he helped make our defense one of the best in the region."

"Most importantly, Paul cares about the kids on the team and he wants to see them succeed not only on the field, but wants each player to do well in life," Garrett continued.

Price is 19th coach in program history dating back to 1898.

Price has been at Concord since 2009 where he coached linebackers from 2009-2011 before taking over as defensive coordinator prior to the 2011 campaign.

"I've been preparing myself for an opportunity like this for a while now," Price said. "It's been a process through the years for me. It's an exciting opportunity to be able to lead this program, but at the same time I understand there's a lot of great coaches out there that would want an opportunity like this."

"I've really become a Concord man when it comes to develop-

ing a philosophy for our players," Price continued. "It's a tall order trying to duplicate what we did over the last seven years, but I would like to get it to where it's a little bit better. I take great pride in what we've been able to accomplish over the last seven years. It's not just a coach or player thing. It runs through the whole staff and even the cafeteria ladies take great pride in our football program. People are appreciative of a good football program because when we got here seven years ago the football program was down."

Under Price's guidance, the Mountain Lions' defense has been a regular near the top of the Mountain East Conference/West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference statistical categories. This past season, the Mountain Lions had the second-best scoring defense in the MEC (20.8). Concord ranked second in rushing defense (115.9) and fourth in passing defense (226.4).

In 2014, Price's defense was first in the MEC in takeaways (32) and second in sacks (23). Additionally, Concord ranked in the top among all Division II teams in interceptions (22).

Concord's ability to create turnovers and put pressure on the opponents' offense helped the Mountain Lions make an appearance in the NCAA Division II national semifinals. Along the way, Concord won the Super Region One Championship and MEC Championships.

During the 2013 campaign, Concord may have had its best defense in Price's tenure as defensive coordinator as they finished top-10 nationally in scoring defense (third / 14.2), total defense (third / 268.1), third in third-down conversion defense (.258) and fourth in passing defense (159.7).

Price has coached 28 all-conference players, 13 all-region players, two conference defensive players of the year and one academic All-American in his tenure at Concord.

In addition to coordinating the stout defense of CU since 2011, Price has also coached linebackers at Concord since arriving in Athens prior to the 2009 season and served as the football team's academic coordinator. This past season, the Mountain Lions had their first academic All-American in program history in senior linebacker Cade Rogers.

Along with coaching some of the best defenses in the MEC, Price also has extensive knowledge coaching the offensive side of the ball. Price coordinated West Virginia Wesleyan's offense from 1989-1993 and had two different stints as defensive coordinator (1994-1995, 1999-2008).

Price has been a part of five conference-winning coaching staffs (1995, 2002, 2003 at Wesleyan, 2011 and 2014 at Concord).

Between coaching stints at West Virginia Wesleyan, Price was the head coach at West Virginia Tech from 1996-1998. Price coached 28 all-conference players and graduated 92 percent of his players over a three-year period.

After exhausting his eligibility as an offensive lineman at West Virginia Wesleyan and receiving his diploma in 1984, Price started his coaching career at Hudson Valley Community College in New York, where he received his master's degree.

Price resides in Athens. He has one daughter, Erin.
