BACK HOME

The #20/#13 Daemen University men's basketball team returns to Lumsden Gymnasium for their toughest test so far on the young season when they face #4/#6 California (Pa.). Tip-off against the Vulcans is set for 5 p.m.

BIG ONES TO NUMBER ONE AS THE COUNTDOWN CONTINUES

For the second consecutive week, Daemen was tabbed first in the D2CSC East Region Poll. The 'Cats received all six first place votes and amassed 60 points as well. Breathing down the Wildcats neck is Northeast-10 foe Pace who remains undefeated at 6-0 and garnered 50 points. Longtime ECC rival St. Thomas Aquinas moved to third place after sitting in second last week. The Spartans notched 49 points. Nationally, the Wildcats were ranked 20th in the NABC poll and 13th in the D2CSC national poll. New national polls are expected to be released prior to the Wildcats meeting with the Vulcans.

DRIVE FOR FIVE

The Wildcats four wins to open the 2023-24 campaign are the most since they started the regular season 5-0 during the 2016-17 campaign. During the '16-17 run, the Wildcats averaged 73.6 points per game and like this season, went 2-0 during the East Region Challenge. Through four games this year, Daemen has averaged 77.3 ppg compared to 56.5 for opponents. The 'Cats have also scored 70-or-more points for three consecutive games, highlighted by a 96 point outing against Saint Anselm on Nov. 9.

PUSHING PSAC

Last season, Daemen went a perfect 3-0 against teams from the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference. The Blue and White defeated then Division II #25 Mercyhurst on the road, 64-63, Slipper Rock at home, 86-62, and Clarion in the Quaker State, 97-76. In all three games, Daemen was leading at the end of the first half and put up a minimum of 35 points, highlighted by a 52 points opening stanza against Clarion. This season, Daemen will once again face a trio of PSAC schools with California (Pa.), Gannon and a rematch with Clarion once again taking place in Clarion, Pa.

BENJAMIN BILL (IONAIRE)

Redshirt sophomore **Benjamin Bill** (Hamburg, N.Y.) has begun the 2024-25 campaign on fire as he is the only member of the Wildcats to finish with 10-or-more points each game. The Hamburg native dropped a career-high 18 points in Daemen's season-opening win against Chestnut Hill (Nov. 8). He followed that with 10 points versus Saint Anselm (Nov. 9) and 12 against Charleston (Nov. 16). In his last game against Post (Nov. 23), the center tallied 16 points on an extremely efficient seven-of-eight (.875) shooting performance from the floor.

DEADEYE

Against Post (Nov. 23), graduate student guard **Andrew Mason** (Webster, N.Y.) was a perfect three-of-three from beyond the arc against the Hawks. The longtime Wildcat finished the afternoon with 11 points, the first time during the 2024-25 campaign he finished in double figures.

NEW IN BLUE AND WHITE

Along with 11 returning players, the Wildcats gained the services of freshman **Santana Sinvilcin** (Port Chester, N.Y.), **Ivan Yhomby** (Quincy, Mass.), **Benjamin Guy** (Jersey City, N.J.) and **Anthony Follett** (Bellmore, N.Y.). Daemen also welcomed two transfers to the fold with the additions of former Saint Anselm College standout guard **Matt Becker** (Fairfield, Conn.) and **Ronnie Williams** (Tampa, Fla.) who played at Division I Coppin State University last season. Becker and Williams each made their debut for the Blue and White on Nov. 8 against Chestnut Hill as well. For Becker, his 18 points against the Hawks are tied with **Benjamin Bill** (Hamburg, N.Y.) for the most points by a Daemen player in a game this season.

FAMILY OF HOOPERS

Redshirt sophomore forward **Josh Haskell** (West Seneca, N.Y.) is not the only member of his family currently playing their college hoops in Western New York as his sister Dani is a redshirt senior guard currently playing at St. Bonaventure. Both had successful prep careers as Dani finished her high school career with the second-most points by a female in New York State High School history with 3,227 points while Josh was an All-Catholic Third Team as a sophomore and All-Catholic Second Team as a junior. He also earned All-Western New York honorable mention twice. The 716 connection runs deep in the Haskell family as his father, Jeff, played basketball at RIT while his mother, Jill, played basketball at Houghton.

HOME COOKIN'

The Wildcats open the season with four of their first five games taking place at home in Lumsden Gymnasium with their one road trip taking them to Post University where they won, 79-58. The last time Daemen opened the year with four of their first five games at home was during the 2022-23 campaign. That year, the 'Cats first road trip of the year took them to PSAC foe Slippery Rock.

CHART TOPPER

For the second time in three seasons, Daemen was tabbed first in the East Coast Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Coaches' Poll, the league office announced on Oct. 21. The Wildcats were tied with longtime ECC rival St. Thomas Aquinas College for first place in the poll with both teams garnering 72 points. The Spartans earned four first-place votes while the Wildcats received three. The College of Staten Island rounded out the top three with 64 points and the remaining two first place votes. Sitting atop the poll for the first time since the 2022-23 campaign, Daemen will look to make their fifth consecutive trip to the ECC Championship and qualify for the NCAA Division II Championship for the second year in a row and fifth instance since the 2018-19 season.

BUFFALO HUNTING

For the second time in program history, the Daemen University men's basketball team defeated a Division I program as they stunned the University at Buffalo, 67-61, in a men's basketball exhibition contest on Oct. 30. The victory over the Bulls is the first win for the Wildcats over a Division I program since they defeated Canisius University, 83-81, in overtime on Nov. 11, 2014. Daemen led for most of the contest, but the Bulls attempted one last comeback and used a 12-6 spurt late in the second half to cut the Wildcats lead to just three, 61-58, with 1:18 to play. Still, Daemen weathered the storm and secured the upset win with four late free-throw makes with two tallies each from **Ryan Salzberg** (Manlius, N.Y.) and sophomore guard **Zach Philipkoski** (New Hartford, N.Y.) at the line.

OLD AND NEW ON THE SIDELINE

Head coach **Mike MacDonald** enters his 11th season at the helm of the Daemen University men's basketball program. MacDonald has guided the Wildcats to a 204-82 overall record, an East Coast Conference (ECC) regular season championship, four NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 NCAA Division II East Region championship. Daemen ranks second for total wins among New York State's Division II programs since MacDonald came to Main Street. Joining MacDonald on the sideline will be **Ryan Grandits** who returns for his ninth season with the Wildcats and first as associate head coach. The Blue and White also announced the additions of UAlbany letterwinner and team captain **Nick Fruscio**, former NBA guard **Jaylen Morris** who played for the Atlanta Hawks, Milwaukee Bucks and San Antonio Spurs and Houghton standout **Zach Fahey**, who was named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court his senior season, as assistant coaches ahead of the 2024-25 campaign.

ALL IN THE WILDCAT FAMILY

Redshirt senior **Justin Hemphill** (Buffalo, N.Y.) is not the only Hemphill at Daemen as his sister, **Summer**, is currently an assistant on the women's basketball staff. Both siblings were forwards and played their collegiate ball in the Queen City with Summer playing at the University at Buffalo from 2016-2022. Both Hemphill siblings played at Cardinal O'Hara during their prep days and helped lead the Hawks to Monsignor Martin Association championships as seniors while earning All-Western New York honors as seniors. For Justin, he left O'Hara as the program's all-time leader in points (1,676) and rebounds (1,138) and was a part of more wins (61) than any player in program history.

HEAD COACH - MIKE MACDONALD



A fixture in the college basketball coaching fraternity, Mike MacDonald has been roaming sidelines, mentoring players and giving the occasional earful to referees for the last 36 years, all within Western New York. With previous stops at Canisius University and Medaille University, MacDonald has worked across all three NCAA divisions, racking up 461 victories in 27 seasons as a head coach. His coaching success aside, MacDonald's personable nature and his willingness to give back to the local community have made him one of the most highly thought of people in the WNY sports community.

The 2024-25 season marks MacDonald's 11th at Daemen. Since being introduced as the sixth head coach in the modern history of the program, MacDonald has guided the Wildcats to a 204-82 overall record, an East Coast Conference (ECC) regular season championship, four NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 NCAA Division II East Region championship. Daemen ranks second for total wins among New York State's Division II programs since MacDonald came to Main Street.

The veteran bench boss has presided over Daemen's emergence as a power within the NCAA Division II East Region, a period that's been one of the most successful in program history. The 2023-24 team posted 25 wins, setting the benchmark for victories during the program's NCAA Division II era. The team's 89 wins from the start of the 2016-17 season through the 2019-20 campaign is tied for the most in any four-year stretch dating back to the 1986-87 season. More than half of those wins came during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons as MacDonald led Daemen to back-to-back 24-win campaigns. Since the start of the 2018-19 season, the Wildcats have spent a combined 33 weeks ranked in top-25 national polls conducted by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA), rising as high as No. 8 in both. Daemen has reached the 20-win plateau in six of the last seven seasons (Daemen only played 16 games during the COVID-19 shortened 2020-21 season) and a total of seven times during his tenure. The two years they did not reach 20 wins was in 2015-16 and 2016-17 when the Wilcats only won 19.

The positive momentum has led to numerous opportunities not otherwise afforded to teams from similar institutions, with MacDonald playing a central role. In recent years, MacDonald has taken teams to play exhibition contests against Division I opponents such as Buffalo, Siena, Syracuse and Penn. The Wildcats were invited participants at the prestigious Small College Basketball National Hall of Fame Classic to start the 2019-20 season. Daemen also played their first-ever game at Downtown Buffalo's KeyBank Center on November 23, 2019, defeating Wilmington (Del.) in a thriller, 83-81. It was MacDonald's 18th win in the building - the most of any basketball coach in the venue's 24-year history. At the start of the 2023-24 season the Wildcats headed to Western Canada to take part in the CCA Division II Canadian Tip-Off Classic.

Before arriving at Daemen, MacDonald spent eight years (2006-14) leading the NCAA Division III program at Medaille where he transformed the Mavericks into a regional contender. Inheriting a program that went 4-46 in the two years prior to his arrival, MacDonald's version of the Mavericks averaged 18 wins per

season, while advancing to the postseason six times.

Medaille's emergence as a Division III power in the Northeast was cemented in MacDonald's final five seasons there, as he led the Mavericks to more wins (101) than any other Division III team in New York State, while ranking 17th nationally in wins during the same time frame. MacDonald was named the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions (2006-07, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2011-12). He left as the school's all-time leader in wins (149) and winning percentage (.671).

Prior to his time at Medaille, MacDonald spent 18 years at Canisius, including a nine-year stint (1997-2006) as head coach. In that time, MacDonald guided the Golden Griffins to 108 wins which ranks him third in program history for coaching victories. While there, he was one of only five coaches in that program's storied history to orchestrate a 20-win season, and was named the 2000-01 BCANY Division I Co-Coach of the Year.

Before being elevated to the head coaching post at Canisius, MacDonald worked as an assistant on the Griffis' coaching staff, first under Marty Marbach and later under John Beilein. As Beilein's top assistant, MacDonald helped Canisius reach the 1996 NCAA tournament in addition to two National Invitational Tournament appearances.

In addition to his coaching accomplishments, MacDonald brings a strong connection to the local community. His teams have been active with a number of community organizations in the greater Buffalo community and beyond, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Buffalo, Blessed Sacrament Athletic Club and Coaches vs. Cancer. In August of 2020, MacDonald received the Jim Satalin Inspiration Award from the American Cancer Society of Western New York in recognition of his dedication and work on behalf of the Coaches vs. Cancer program.

MacDonald and several of his players have also worked with the Drug Enforcement Administration and Mayor Byron Brown's office on Game Changers, a nationally awarded program that provides academic and athletic opportunities for inner-city youths during the summer months.

A 1988 graduate of Saint Bonaventure University, MacDonald additionally serves Daemen as the Senior Associate Athletics Director for External Relations. In that role, MacDonald has raised more than \$500,000 for the College. He resides in Amherst with his wife, Maura (nee Heary). The couple has raised four children - Matt, Patrick, Nick and Mark. Matt served as team captain during his collegiate career at the University of Pennsylvania and works for the Brooklyn Nets as general manager of their G-League affiliate the Long Island Nets. Patrick was a Division III All-American while playing at the State University of New York Maritime College, and is now a lieutenant in the United States Navy. Nick played two seasons at Division I Niagara University before playing his final three seasons under the guidance of his father at Daemen.
