### Trip to Sunshine State

Dartmouth would love to continue the success it had last year when playing in the state of Florida having won eight of its 12 games down there, including series wins over two nationally ranked teams in Miami and UCF. This time, the Big Green take on Villanova, Northeastern and Georgetown in search of their first win of 2018.

### Last Week in Review

- Georgia Tech handed Dartmouth three losses in the Big Green's opening weekend of action, starting with a 10-0 shutout before rallying for 12-9 and 11-5 victories in a Saturday twinbill.
- This is the fifth time in the last 10 seasons that Dartmouth has started 0-3. In the other four years, the Big Green won an Ivy title, three other Rolfe Division crowns and lost a divisional play-off. Certainly not the time to panic.
- It had been four years since Dartmouth surrendered 10 or more runs in three consecutive games.
- Junior **Sean Sullivan**, who had started just three games in his first two seasons, made the most of his opportunity by going 6-for-12 with a double, stolen base, three runs and an RBI.
- Whoever had senior **Justin Fowler** in the pool as the player to hit the first home run of the 2018 season can claim their prize. Fowler hit a long home run in the second game, matching his season total of each of the last two seasons.
- Speaking of matching a home run total, junior **Nate Ostmo** hit his second career four-bagger in the same game as Fowler. It was a three-run shot, also matching the number of long balls the Green hit last year with at least two men on base.
- The three rookies started at least one game in the field — **Oliver Campbell**, **Ubaldo Lopez** and **Bennett McCaskill** — but the only rookie to rap out his first collegiate hit was **Logan Adams** as a pinch hitter in the final inning of game three.
- A pair of freshman pitchers climbed the hill in relief at Georgia Tech in **Sai Davuluri** and **Carson Seymour**. Davuluri faced just one batter before departing with an injury, while Seymour retired two of the three batters he faced.
- Mike Concato** made his first pitching appearance in 1,021 days, tossing two shutout innings of relief before running into trouble in his third.

### Overall Record vs. Opponents

- Villanova sports a 9-4 record over Dartmouth, winning the last game two years ago at the Snowbird Classic, 14-1.
- The series with the Wildcats dates back to the 1906 season, but since 1955, the two teams have split eight games.
- It has been a little longer since the Big Green took on Northeastern on the diamond, losing a pair of games in 2002.
- Dartmouth still holds the all-time lead against the Huskies with a 13-11 record, dating back to 1929.
- The series with Georgetown is the oldest among these three teams as the Green won the first two meetings in 1892, though the Hoyas lead the overall series, 11-7.
- It has been more than 50 years since the last games, however, with Dartmouth dropping a doubleheader to Georgetown in 1966.

### Quick Scout of the Opponents

- Villanova swept a three-game series at Norfolk State to start the year, then dropped three straight at USC to even its record at 3-3.
- While the bats have produced just one home run, the offense has put up seven runs a game with Timothy Lilly (.417 BA) and Ryan Toohers (.412) leading the way.
- The pitchers have a 5.47 ERA, striking out 48 batters in 51 innings, but the defense behind them have committed 10 errors (.955).
- Northeastern enters the weekend with a 4-3 record with a series win against Creighton and a split of a four-game set with Missouri.
- The Huskie offense has provided more than six runs a game, and while the staff ERA is above 8.00, two blowout losses of 15-7 and 20-1 are to blame.
- Charlie McConnell (.467) and Jake Farrell (.464) are tearing it up at the plate.
- Like Dartmouth, Georgetown comes to Florida in search of its first win, but the Hoyas have lost seven straight to start the year, including a three-game sweep at Davidson last weekend.
- The offense has struggled out of the gate with just 19 runs and a .220 team average, led by Austin Shirley (no relation to Dustin) who is hitting .318.
- Opponents have scored 9.3 runs per game, and the staff has walked 43 batters in 53 innings.

## HEAD COACH BOB WHALEN



A mainstay in Hanover, Bob Whalen is in his 29th season as Dartmouth's head baseball coach. Whalen has guided the Big Green to success both on and off the field since his arrival prior to the 1990 season.

Under his leadership, the Big Green have accumulated two Ivy League

crowns, 11 Red Rolfe Division titles, 74 first-team All-Ivy and All-EIBL League selections, and sent 28 players to the professional ranks.

Prior to his arrival at Dartmouth, Whalen was an assistant at the University of Maine from 1982-89 and was promoted to associate head coach in 1987. From 1982-87, he worked mainly with infielders and outfielders while serving as the strength and conditioning coach and the recruiting coordinator.

In addition to his collegiate coaching career, Whalen served as the head coach of the Chatham A's of the Cape Cod League in 1988 and 1989. He coached former Houston Astros first baseman Jeff Bagwell, the 1994 National League MVP, and 25 others who signed professionally.

Whalen earned a bachelor's degree in 1979 and his MBA in finance in 1986. Whalen and his wife, Kim, have a son, Matt, and a daughter, Katie.

## Snowbird Classic — March 3-4, 2018

### Probable Starting Pitchers

- For Dartmouth, junior RHP and co-captain **Cole O'Connor** (0-1, 3.60) will start against Villanova having surrendered fewer than four earned runs in all but two of his 18 career starts. The Wildcats will send RHP Jonathan Rosero (0-1, 4.82) who has walked eight and fanned seven in 9.1 innings over his first two starts.
- The second game on Saturday against Northeastern will find senior RHP **Jack Fossand** (0-1, 6.00) on the bump for the Big Green. Last week he was saddled with the loss out of the bullpen in game two against the Yellow Jackets. Northeastern will counter with RHP Tyler Brown (1-0, 2.45), a New Hampshire native whose transition to starting after two years in the pen has gone well, with one walk and 11 whiffs in 11 innings over his two starts.
- Senior RHP **Clay Chatham** (0-0, 10.38) will look to earn his first collegiate victory in his 14th career start when Dartmouth takes on Georgetown, while the Hoyas will go with RHP Kevin Superko (0-2, 9.00) who owns a career 9-11 record and has walked just two but surrendered four homers in nine innings this season.

### What's Up Next

Dartmouth has some time away from the diamond for winter exams, not playing again for 10 days when it opens up a 10-game, 11-day trip to California with a single contest at UC Santa Barbara on March 14.

### Welcome Back Concato

Senior **Mike Concato** missed both the 2016 and 2017 seasons with an injury after earning All-Ivy Second Team honors as a sophomore in 2015. The right-hander finally returned to the mound for the Big Green, pitching out of the bullpen in the season opener, his first appearance in 1,021 days. Only one other player at the Division I level has suffered through a longer time between games before playing again this season, that being Clay Conaway, a pitcher for Delaware (1,041 days).

### Sullivan Streaks to Hot Start

After starting just three games over his first two seasons in Hanover, junior **Sean Sullivan** made his case to remain in the lineup following his performance at Georgia Tech. Starting at second base all three games, Sullivan rapped out six hits in 12 trips to the plate with a double, stolen base, three runs and an RBI to lead the Big Green offense.

### Lefties Can Start?

When sophomore **Michael Parsons** climbed the hill at Georgia Tech on Feb. 24, it was the first start by a Big Green lefty since March 21, 2015, with 114 contests in between the two games. The pitcher that started the game against 16th-ranked UC Santa Barbara on that date you ask? Why, that would be current senior **Marc Bachman**, the only start of his career. Dartmouth did have two other games started by a southpaw earlier that year, both courtesy of Adam Frank '15.

### Welcome to College

Freshman **Logan Adams** may not have started any of the games at Georgia Tech, but he was the first rookie to collect his first collegiate hit with a pinch single in the ninth of the final game. In the first game of the series, RHP **Carson Seymour** recorded his first career strikeout to end the eighth inning. Three other rookies cracked the starting lineup as well — **Oliver Campbell** as the DH in the first and third games, **Ubaldo Lopez** as the DH in game two and **Bennett McCaskill** behind the plate in the series finale.

### Opening Day Defeat

Dartmouth was shut out at Georgia Tech on opening day, 10-0, its first blanking in the first game in four years and 11th ever in 146 seasons. Overall, the Big Green sport a record of 67-78-1 in their season opener and are 13-16 under head coach Bob Whalen.

### Back in Georgia 31 Years Later

With the series at Georgia Tech, Dartmouth made its first return to the state of Georgia for a baseball game since it played in the 1987 NCAA Northeast Regional at Chandler Stadium. The starting pitcher in a loss to Fordham (and the first baseman in the other two games) was none other than Mark Johnson, who enjoyed a seven-year MLB career and whose son, **Trevor Johnson**, started all three games for the Big Green, the first two in center field, the other as the DH.

### Rough Opening Weekend for Ivies

Dartmouth wasn't the only Ivy League team to struggle over the opening weekend of play for the league. Conference teams went just 2-19 over the three days with the lone victories belonging to Harvard (5-3 at Samford) and Penn (8-5 at Northwestern State).

### New Look for Ivy League

After 25 seasons of two four-team divisions, the Ivy League has scrapped that to set up three-game weekends against every opponent in conference play. That makes for 21 league games instead of 20, and all games will be nine innings in length instead of doubleheaders of seven and nine innings. The biggest change will be no make ups of games beyond the scheduled weekend, so the standings will be determined strictly by winning percentage with the top two teams advancing to the best-of-three Ivy League Championship Series.

### Big Green Are Road Warriors ...

As is custom for Dartmouth, it will begin the season on the road for an extended period. The first 16 games (and 19 of the first 20) are scheduled to be played away from Hanover with the home opener slated for March 28 when Quinnipiac comes to town. The first Ivy League games at Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park will take place the weekend of April 7-8 with a three-game series against Columbia.

### ... But Love the Homestead

Dartmouth enters the 2018 season with a 98-31 record (.760) at its home venue, Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park, since the stadium was constructed and turf was added before the 2009 season. Last year the Big Green went 7-5 in the games they hosted, beating Boston College and going 6-4 in league contests.

### Preseason Polls

For the first time ever, the Ivy League conducted a preseason media poll for the baseball season, and Dartmouth was picked to finish third, though it did receive one of the 16 first-place votes. Over the last decade, the Big Green finished first in the Rolfe Division eight times, tied for first another and second last year, plus had one of the three best records across the league all but once in that span, twice winning the league title (2009, '10).

Baseball America also has Dartmouth pegged for third, while D1Baseball pegs the Green in second and Perfect Game (which did not get the memo on the new schedule format) has them second in the Rolfe Division.

### Preseason Freshman of the Year

Freshman **Ubaldo Lopez** has garnered some preseason mentions from various publications, getting chosen as the Freshman of the Year by Perfect Game and the top impact freshman by D1Baseball. Lopez played at Archbishop McCarthy, which won a Florida State championship each of the last three years. He was an all-region player as a senior captain and all-county as a junior when he drove in three runs in the title game.

### Other Preseason Honors

After earning a spot on the All-Ivy League Second Team as a junior, OF **Kyle Holbrook** was the lone Big Green player named to the preseason team by Perfect Game. D1Baseball listed top prospects in the league for this year's MLB Draft with senior **Dustin Shirley** 10th on that list, while sophomore **Trevor Johnson** headed up the list for next year's draft-eligible crop. And Lopez had company on the group of freshman to make an impact this year with catcher **Bennett McCaskill** fourth and RHP **Carson Seymour** fifth.

### 2017 All-Ivy Honors for the Green

Of the six players that received recognition as All-Ivy League players from the conference coaches, only two remain on the roster — senior **Kyle Holbrook** (second team) and DH **Michael Calamari** (honorable mention). Gone are Ivy League Pitcher of the Year **Beau Sulser** (6-1, 1.40), second-team selections **Michael Danielak** (7-2, 2.64) and reliever **Chris Burkholder** (0-1, 2.20, 8

saves), as well as honorable mention first baseman Michael Ketchmark (.329/.408/.527).

During head coach Bob Whalen's first 28 years at the helm, he has coached 74 first-teamers, 21 more than any other program in the Ivy League. And since 2000, he has 53 of them to his credit, at least 15 more than the other Ivies.

## Two Taken in MLB Draft

Ivy League Pitcher of the Year Beau Sulser and All-Ivy second team pitcher Michael Danielak were both chosen in the MLB Draft as fifth-year seniors at Dartmouth. Sulser was taken in the 10th round by the Pittsburgh Pirates, while Danielak was selected in the 19th round by the Oakland A's, one year after the Pirates picked him in the 28th round. Sulser is the seventh Big Green player taken in the top 10 rounds during Whalen's tenure and 14th since the inception of the draft in 1965.

## Not Settling for Spares

Well, this isn't bowling, but if there is one thing the Big Green pitching staff does, it is throw strikes. For the past nine years, the staff has been one of the stingiest in the country in terms of issuing free passes. In both 2009 and 2010, the Big Green hurlers walked fewer batters per nine innings than any other Division I team. In each of the next three years, they ranked among the top 15, placing third in 2011 at 2.24 behind only Florida (1.82) and Dayton (2.18), eighth in 2012 at 2.33, and 13th in 2013 at 2.52. After two years in the top 50 at fewer than three per game, the Big Green were back near the top in 2016 (11th, 2.66) and again last year (9th, 2.63).

## Big League Bloodlines

Over the past decade-plus, Dartmouth has had five players that had a father with big league ties. First was first baseman Mike Pagliarulo '09 whose father of the same name manned the hot corner with the Yankees, Padres, Twins, Orioles and Rangers over 11 seasons (1984-93, '95), hitting 134 homers in his career. Then came catcher Chris O'Dowd '13, son of Dan O'Dowd who served as the general manager for the Colorado Rockies for 15 years through 2014. Next up was Adam Charnin-Aker, whose father Jack Aker pitched as a reliever in the big leagues for 11 years (1964-74) with the Kansas City (then Oakland) Athletics, Seattle Pilots, Yankees, Cubs, Braves and Mets, going 47-45 with a 3.28 ERA and 124 saves in 495 appearances.

The current team has two such players. Sophomore **Trevor Johnson** is the son of former Big Green first baseman/pitcher/quarterback Mark Johnson '90, who enjoyed a seven-year stay in the bigs with the Pittsburgh Pirates, Anaheim Angels and New York Mets (1995-2002), hitting .232 with 38 homers. This year, **Bennett McCaskill** joined the roster after playing at Torrey Pines for his father, Kirk, who pitched for 12 seasons in the majors, winning 106 games while posting a 4.12 ERA for the California Angels and Chicago White Sox (1985-96).
