BIG GREEN GAME NOTES

THIS WEEKEND

Dartmouth women's hockey will kick off the 2019-20 season at home this weekend, hosting Harvard at 6 p.m. on Friday. This is the third season in a row that the Big Green and the Crimson have faced each other in the first game of the year.

SCOUTING THE CRIMSON

Whereas Dartmouth got to play two preseason contests before officially opening the season, Harvard is starting from scratch. Much like the Big Green, the Crimson play McGill in an annual exhibition game, but this year's contest was cancelled.

LAST TIME AGAINST HARVARD

The Green dropped both of its games to the Crimson in 2018-19, falling by a score of 3-1 on Oct. 19 and 1-0 on Jan. 11.

TEAM BREAKDOWN

The 20-player roster is made up of 14 returnees (three seniors, five juniors, six sophomores) and six freshmen. The team lost solid contributors Alyssa Baker, Tess Bracken, Christine Honor, Kate Landers, Shannon Ropp and Caroline Shaunessy to graduation.

CAPTAINS

As has been the case for the past three years, just one player is wearing the 'C' on her sweater in 2019-20. Senior Christina Rombaut is reprising her role as captain, while classmates Sydney Hill and Bailee Brekke are alternate captains.

 Rombaut ended her junior season tied for second on the team with 12 points (4-8-12). She had her first-ever three-

COACHES CORNER



Laura Schuler is in her third season at the helm of the women's hockey team in 2019-20.

During the 2018-19 season, Schuler led the team to a 5-21-3 season (4-16-2 ECAC Hockey). The Big Green's first victory was a 3-2 overtime defeat of Quinnipiac on the road (Nov. 3), a career first for Jennifer Costa. Three days later, Dartmouth added another win, a 3-1 victory over Vermont (Nov. 6). During the final home weekend, the Green walked away with three points following a 3-2 win over defending national champion Clarkson and a 0-0 tie versus St. Lawrence (Feb. 15-16). At the conclusion of the season, Christie Honor was named All-Ivy honorable mention and Christina Rombaut was tabbed to the Academic All-Ivy Team. Dartmouth also placed 13 players onto the ECAC Hockey All-Academic Team, the most the team had seen selected since 2013.

In May of 2017, Schuler was named head coach of the 2018 Canadian Women's Olympic Hockey Team, helping Canada win a Silver Medal in Pyeongchang.

During Schuler's first season in Hanover in 2016-17, the Big Green had an overall record of 7-21-0 and a 5-17-0 mark in ECAC Hockey play. Dartmouth's first win of the season came in the form of a 3-2 overtime thriller against No. 10 Princeton at home. In the season finale against Yale, the Big Green had a 4-1 victory, defeating the Bulldogs for the first time since 2014. At the end of the season, Robyn Chemago was named Second Team All-Ivy, while Kennedy Ottenbreit was honorable mention. Mackenzie St. Onge was selected to the Academic All-Ivy Team.

Prior to arriving at Dartmouth, Schuler spent the 2015-16 season as head coach of the Canadian national women's hockey team, a role she reprised in 2016-17. This was not her first assignment on the international level. She was a Development Camp Coach for Hockey Canada (2008-13), an assistant with the National Women's Team (2010-11). head coach of the U22 National Women's Team (2011-12), assistant of the U18 National Team (2012-13) and head coach of the U18 National Team (2013-14).

Prior to that, Schuler spent seven years (2008-15) as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Minnesota-Duluth, during which time she successfully recruited 21 U18/senior national/Olympic caliber players, and the Bulldogs advanced to two NCAA Frozen Fours, capturing the National Championship in 2010.

She previously served as head coach at her alma mater, Northeastern (2004-08), and at UMass-Boston (2001-04). She was inducted into the Northeastern Sports Hall of Fame in 2004.

Schuler has an equally impressive resume as a player. She won three gold medals with Canada's National Women's Team at the IIHF World Women's Championship (1990, 1992, 1997), two golds at the Pacific Rim Championships (1995, 1996), and two golds and a silver at the Three Nations Cup (1996, 1997, 1999). She also won a silver medal at the 1998 Olympic Winter Games, the first year that women's hockey was included in the Olympics.

She graduated from Northeastern in 1994 with a degree in cardiovascular heath and exercise, serving as team captain her senior year.
