BIG GREEN GAME NOTES

THIS WEEKEND

The Dartmouth women's basketball team will head to New York for games against Cornell and Columbia. This is just the third time this season that the Big Green have played games on consecutive days.

LAST TIME OUT

Dartmouth put pressure on Princeton in the 70-48 loss at Leede Arena on Saturday afternoon.

- Victoria Page had a career-high 16 points to go with five rebounds and one assist.
- Emma Koch led the Big Green with six caroms, while Mekkena Boyd was perfect at the free throw line, going 4-4.
- As a team, Dartmouth led in defensive rebounds, 25-22, had 23 bench points to Princeton's 15 and outscored the Tigers, 20-16, in the paint.
- The Green kept it close in the first half and were down 19-10 after the first quarter and 29-21 at the half. Page led both teams with 12 points after the first 20 minutes.
- Princeton ran away with it in the third, but Dartmouth got some back in the fourth, winning the quarter with a 19-15 advantage.

SCOUTING THE BIG RED

Since opening Ivy League play against each other on Jan. 2,

Cornell has gone 2-6 in conference play, with both of its wins coming against Brown. The Big Red are 8-12 overall and 3-6 in Ivy action, currently sitting in sixth place.

As a team, they're strongest in blocked shots (third) and offensive rebounds (third). Individually, Theresa Mbanefo is someone to watch. She's second in field goal percentage (.483) and blocked shots (35), fifth in rebounding (7.7 rebounds/game) and offensive rebounding (3.2 rebounds/game) and ninth in defensive rebounds (4.5 rebounds/game).

The day after ringing in the New Year, the Big Green fell to the Big Red at Leede Arena, 45-36. Koch

led the way with seven points after going 2-3 in 3-pointers and was first with a career-high seven rebounds. Allie Harland also had a pair of treys to end the game with six points.

SCOUTING THE LIONS

Columbia is 17-4 and 8-1 with five games to go. The Lions started conference play on an eight-game winning streak before Princeton got in the way with its 57-39 win. With the Tigers sitting alone at the top, Columbia is right behind in second.

The Lions are first among their Ancient Eight opponents in field goal percentage (.406), assists (15.7/game) and defensive rebounds (619, 29.5/game). They have someone in the top 10 in every category, with Abbey Hsu leading in 3-point field goals made (72, 3.4/game) and second in scoring (16.3/game).

LAST TIME AGAINST COLUMBIA

On Jan. 29, the Big Green fell to the ever-tough Lions, 65-46. Boyd and Carrington Washburn both ended the game with eight points, while Doreen Ariik collected eight rebounds and two blocks. Dartmouth outscored Columbia in both the second quarter (16-12) and the fourth (10-6).

Mia Curtis remains the team leader in points with 141 (7.4 points/game), while Boyd isn't far behind with 124 (5.9 points/game). Boyd leads in assists (36), steals (28) and has seen the most playing time of her teammates with 522 minutes (24.9 minutes/game).

Ariik has finally broken her way into the Ivy League top 10 in rebounds and is currently seventh with 52 offensive boards (2.5 rebounds/game).

WHAT'S NEXT?

Dartmouth will play its final road game of the 2021-22 season on Saturday, Feb. 26, at Penn. After that, it's just Harvard for senior day remaining.

Adrienne Shibles, just the fifth Big Green head coach in the program's 48-year varsity history, came to New Hampshire in May of 2021 from Bowdoin College.

Since taking over the Bowdoin program prior to the 2008-09 season, she led the squad to a record of 281-67 (.807) and qualified for the NCAA Tournament 11 times, reaching the Sweet Sixteen eight times (including five of the last six seasons) and the Final Four twice.

Shibles was named the Coach of the Year in the state of Maine four times, in the region three times, by the NESCAC twice and once by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association for all of Division III. In 2019, she also served as a coach for the Team USA U16 squad, and in March was pegged to be that squad's head coach in the summer of 2021.

During the 2018-19 campaign, Shibles became the winningest coach in Bowdoin women's basketball history. After guiding the team to its second-straight NCAA Championship Game appearance to conclude that season, she was named the WBCA Division III Coach of the Year.

Bowdoin had a record of 27-2, won the NESCAC Championship and had hosting rights for an NCAA Division III Sectional when the remainder of the 2019-20 season was canceled due to COVID-19.

Shibles' players have enjoyed numerous accolades with two national players of the year, six All-Americans, 13 all-region performers and 23 All-NESCAC honors — 14 on the first team — during her tenure. She also had the conference Player of the Year three times, Defensive Player of the Year four times and Rookie of the Year on two other occasions.

Prior to taking over at the helm of the Bowdoin program, Shibles was the Dean of Athletics and co-curricular programs at Gould Academy in Bethel, Maine for three years. The athletic program she oversaw at the selective college preparatory school was comprised of 40 teams, including nationally competitive squads.

Shibles took over at Gould after spending nine years as the head women's basketball coach and associate professor of physical education at Swarthmore (1996-2005). She inherited a program at the bottom of the Centennial Conference and built it into a conference champion in five years, guiding the squad to the second round of the NCAA Tournament while being named the WBCA District 4 Coach of the Year. Shibles coached a pair of league Players of the Year and two Kodak All-Americans, then finished her stint with the most career wins in Garnet history, posting a record of 138-96 (.590).

Shibles graduated from Bates in 1991 with a degree in history and American studies. A two-time captain of the Bobcats women's basketball team, she scored over 1,000 points in her career. Shibles went on to get her master's in exercise and sports studies from Smith in 1996, serving as a graduate assistant coach for both the Smith soccer team and the Elms College basketball program.

COACHING STAFF



Asst. Coach Megan PhelpsBowdoin '15

Megan Phelps was named an assistant coach in May of 2021. Like Shibles, Phelps is coming from Bowdoin, where she served as an assistant since the 2017-18 season. The Polar Bears went 87-7 over the following three seasons, making two trips to the NCAA Championship. Phelps

served as interim head coach for the fall semester of 2020 and was responsible for overseeing all aspects of the program.

Before arriving in Maine, Phelps was an assistant coach at Regis in Weston, Massachusetts, from 2015-17. The Pride had a 46-11 record over two campaigns, including two conference championships. Phelps graduated from Bowdoin in 2015 with a degree in government and legal studies. In 2019, she was named a WBCA 30 Under 30 recipient. She completed her master's in communications at Regis in 2017.



Asst. Coach Sarah Assante St. Joseph's '15

Sarah Assante was hired as an assistant coach in June of 2021. Assante spent two years as an assistant coach at Washington and Lee University, where she helped coach the Generals to an 18-8 overall record in 2019-20 and a 15-3 mark in the ODAC, earning the team the No. 2 seed

for the conference championship. That season also included a program-record 10-game winning streak as the team won all but one of its 14 games that ended the regular season. Before that, Assante was an assistant at Regis for the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons, while also serving as the assistant strength and conditioning coach during her second year. A 2015 graduate of Saint Joseph's, Assante was a four-year member of the basketball team and served as captain for her final two seasons. She graduated with a degree in business administration and accounting before getting her master's in organizational and professional communication from Regis in 2019.

Meredith Mesaris was named a volunteer assistant coach in June of 2021.

She arrives in Hanover after spending five seasons as an assistant coach at Williams (2016-21). While there, she helped the Ephs to a 58-45 record, seeing the team make it to the NESCAC

quarterfinals three times before advancing all the way to the NCAA Division III Sweet Sixteen in 2019-20. Before Williams, Mesaris was the assistant coach at Hendrix College in Conway, Arkansas, contributing to the Warriors 19-7 overall record and third-place finish in the Southern Athletic Association. She helped coach both SAA Player of the Year Sara Dylsin and Women's Basketball Coaches Association All-America Honorable Mention Caitlin Kriesel-Bigler. A two-time WBCA All-American and 2015 CoSIDA Academic All-American herself, Mesaris was the leading scorer for the Scranton Lady Royals all three seasons she played there. She graduated magna cum laude in 2015 with a degree in management and a minor in coaching.
