Season Opener

- Dartmouth begins its 149th season of varsity baseball with three games at Louisville, which went to the College World Series four times during the decade of the 2010s.
- Head coach Bob Whalen enters his 33rd year (32nd season due to the cancellation of the 2021 season) with an overall record of 602-591-3. He is one of just five Ivy League coaches in any sport to win 600 games at one school.
- Dartmouth is 14-17 in the first game of the season under Whalen, most recently losing a 1-0 contest to Indiana State in 2020.
- As usual, the Big Green will play the first month of the season outside of Hanover — a total of 15 games — before finally getting the opportunity to play at Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park for the first time since May 5, 2019, when Whalen won his 600th game.
- Dartmouth has played a total of seven games since the end of the 2019 season, going 2-5 in 2020 before the pandemic shut everything down.
- Although the Green was just 8-13 in the Ivy League back in 2019 (the last conference season), it had posted a winning record in the Ancient Eight in each of the previous 11 seasons, tying a program record. Dartmouth also had one of the top three records in the league in 10 of those 11 campaigns and advanced to the Ivy League Championship every year from 2008-15.
- There isn't a lot of experience on the roster, particularly at the plate as the team has fewer than 200 collegiate at-bats combined (197 to be precise) for a slash line of .193/.311/.264.
- On the mound, the Big Green have thrown 166.0 innings, all but 3.1 frames by seniors Justin Murray, Nathan Skinner and Trystan Sarcone, with an ERA of 6.13.

- Despite not playing in 2021, Dartmouth had a player selected in the 2021 draft in junior catcher Ben Rice in the 12th round by the New York Yankees, the program's 36th selection, 25 during Whalen's tenure.
- Dartmouth has two players currently playing in the big leagues. Kyle Hendricks '12 is 83-55 with a 3.36 ERA in 206 career starts, helping the Chicago Cubs win the 2016 World Series and finishing third in the Cy Young voting that year. His classmate, Cole Sulser '12, has pitched out of the bullpen for the Tampa Bay Rays and the Baltimore Orioles over the past three seasons, posting a 3.18 ERA with 13 saves over 93.1 innings.

Overall Record vs. Louisville

- These are the first games between these two schools on the diamond, and this is the first game ever for the Big Green in the state of Kentucky.
- Dartmouth has only played one game against any school from the state, that being Eastern Kentucky in Florida in 2007. That game ended as a 1-1 tie.
- Against current ACC teams, the Big Green sport a 60-84-1 all-time record, most of which have come against Boston College (30-40) and N.C. State (11-41-1).
- Dartmouth has played an ACC opponent three times in an NCAA Regional, losing two-ofthree to BC in 1967, and dropping the opening game in 2009 and '10 to North Carolina and Miami, respectively.
- The Green also faced Florida State in the 1970 College World Series after defeating Iowa State in the first game, but came up short against the Seminoles, 6-0.

Scouting the Cardinals

- Louisville opened the season splitting four games, the first three of which were played at South Florida.
- The Cardinals won the opener over Charlotte, 8-7, before falling to their host the next day, 8-4, and UConn on Sunday, 9-2.
- A quick trip back home and Louisville was back on the field on Monday, defeating Xavier by a 7-6 final thanks to a six-run seventh.

HEAD COACH BOB WHALEN



A mainstay in Hanover, Bob Whalen is in his 31st season as Dartmouth's head baseball coach. Whalen has guided the Big Green to success both on and off the field since his arrival prior to the 1990 season.

Under his leadership, the Big Green have won 602 games, accumulated two Ivy League crowns, 11

Red Rolfe Division titles, 77 first-team all-conference selections, seven Rookies of the Year, four Players of the Year and four Pitchers of the Year, plus sent 28 players to the professional ranks. His 334 league victories are exactly half of the program's all-time total.

Prior to his arrival at Dartmouth, Whalen was an assistant at his alma mater, Maine, from 1982-89 and was promoted to associate head coach in 1987.

In addition to his collegiate coaching career, Whalen served as the head coach of the Chatham A's of the Cape Cod League in 1988 and 1989. He coached former Houston Astros first baseman Jeff Bagwell, the 1994 National League MVP, and 25 others who signed professionally.

Whalen earned a bachelor's degree in 1979 and his MBA in finance in 1986. Whalen and his wife, Kim, have a son, Matt, and a daughter, Katie.

- Cameron Masterman leads the offense with a 1.277 OPS while hitting an even .500 (7-for-14).
- Overall, the Cardinals are hitting .269/.357/.381 as a team with three homers while averaging 5.3 runs a game.
- The pitching staff has posted an ERA of 5.29 but also has struck out 48 batters in just 34.0 innings (12.7 per nine).
- In the field, Louisville has committed nine errors for a .933 fielding percentage, turning one double play.

Probable Starting Pitchers

- The honor of the opening-day start this year goes to senior RHP **Justin Murray** (1-1, 1.35 in 2020). He threw 13 innings in his two starts before the pandemic, allowing eight hits and two earned runs while holding opponents to a .163 average. His opponent will be LHP Tate Kuehner (0-0, 2.45) who surrendered three runs, one earned, on six hits over 3.2 innings in his start against Charlotte, striking out three. Opposing batters have hit just .205 against him in his career over 60.1 innings.
- Another senior right-hander will get the nod on Saturday, senior Nate Skinner (0-1, 5.62), who did not walk a batter over eight innings while striking out seven in 2020. Louisville will counter with RHP Jared Poland (0-1, 4.50) who lasted just two innings agains USF, surrendering six runs (only one earned) on seven hits. This will be his fourth career start and 28th appearance.
- The senior-laden rotation continues for the Big Green on Sunday with LHP **Trystan Sarcone** (1-0, 3.52). His start will be just the sixth by a Dartmouth southpaw since March 21, 2015. And speaking of southpaws, the Cardinals have one lined up for Dartmouth in LHP Riley Phillips (0-0, 0.00) who is making his first collegiate start after seven appearances out of the pen, including four shutout innings against UConn last weekend.

What's Up Next

The Big Green will head to North Carolina next weekend for four games at Gardner-Webb, another first-time opponent. Following a single game on Friday, the two will play two seveninning contests on Saturday and the finale on Sunday.

Kentucky Dreaming

This is the 149th baseball season at Dartmouth and 32nd under head coach Bob Whalen, but the first games to be played by the Big Green in the Bluegrass State. Dartmouth still has a ways to go to play a game in all 50 states; a cursory check of the games show that the Green are barely halfway there with this just the 26th state (plus Washington D.C.). Before this trip, the most recent addition had been Minnesota in 2013 when Dartmouth won the Dairy Queen Classic, beating host Minnesota, Northern Illinois and Utah.

Preseason Polls

The annual preseason polls for this season are likely as accurate as putting the team names on darts and throwing them at a board. Only Penn played any games in 2021 (14), and no one played more than 12 back in 2020. Experience is lacking across the board. D1Baseball picked Dartmouth fourth. Baseball America called ranking the teams a fool's errand. So let's look at the fools who created the Ivy League Media Poll (me being one of those fools):

before the 2009 campaign. In the last season, however, the Big Green suffered its first losing record at the renovated facility, going 3-11.

Aiming for More All-Ivy Honors

The last time All-Ivy League teams were named was in 2019, and Dartmouth had four players receive honors, including two on the first team. During head coach Bob Whalen's first 32 years at the helm, he has coached 77 first-teamers, 18 more than any other program in the Ivy League. And since 2000, he has 56 of them to his credit, at 15 ahead of any other Ivy team.

Co-Captains

For the 2022 season, Dartmouth will feature a pair of senior pitchers serving as co-captains — RHP **Nathan Skinner** and RHP **Cole Roland**. While Skinner joined the starting rotation as a freshman, Roland has yet to throw a pitch in a college game due to injuries and the pandemic.

Not Settling for Spares

Well, this isn't bowling, but if there is one thing the Big Green pitching staff does, it is throw strikes. For the past decade-plus, the staff has been one of the stingiest in the country in terms of issuing free passes. In both 2009 and 2010, the Big Green hurlers walked fewer batters per nine innings than any other Division I team. In each of the next three years, they ranked among the top 15, placing third in 2011 at 2.24 behind only Florida (1.82) and Dayton (2.18), eighth in 2012 at 2.33, and 13th in 2013 at 2.52. After two years in the top 50 at fewer than three per game, the Big Green were back near the top in 2016 (11th, 2.66). 2017 (9th, 2.63) and 2018 (6th, 2.75). In the last full season, Dartmouth had its worst ranking in the stat - 61st at 3.88 per nine.

MLB Watch

In the summer of 2014, Kyle Hendricks '12 made his MLB debut with the Chicago Cubs and finished his rookie year with a 7-2 record over 13 starts with a 2.46 ERA. Eight years later he is an established big leaguer who led both leagues with an ERA of 2.13 in 2016, finishing third in the Cy Young balloting and helping the Cubs win their first World Series in 108 years. In eight seasons in Chicago, Hendricks boasts an 83-55 record with an ERA of 3.36 while striking out 7.4 batters per nine innings. And those 83 victories are tied for the most by any Dartmouth alum — Leon Viau won 83 games between 1888-92 (not a typo).

One of Hendricks' classmates, Cole Sulser '12, debuted in September 2019 with Tampa Bay and did not allow a run in seven appearances. For the past two seasons, he has thrown out of the Baltimore Orioles bullpen, and for his career he has posted a record of 6-9 with 13 saves and an ERA of 3.18 over 93.1 inning with 101 strikeouts.
