Senior Day Weekend

Dartmouth is looking to build upon its first victory in a month and a half when it hosts the Big Red to conclude the Ivy League slate. And with this being the final home games of the year, Saturday is Senior Day with the graduating players being honored between games of the doubleheader.

Overall Record vs. Big Red

- Dartmouth owns the advantage in the all-time series at 101-87-1, having won its 100th game against Cornell just last season.
- The Big Green took the series in Ithaca last year, dropping the opener before storming back to win the final two.
- Cornell won the series in 2019 and is 8-11 at Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park. And although it is 9-22 in the last 31 games in Hanover, it is 23-27 in Hanover since 1970.
- Dartmouth head coach Bob Whalen has a 42-29 mark in games against Cornell and posted his 600th career victory against the Big Red in the final game of the 2019 campaign.
- These two teams met in the Ivy Championship Series twice, first in 2009 with Dartmouth winning the best-of-three series, then again in 2012 when the Big Red exacted their revenge.
- The first games in the series took place on April 10-11, 1906, with Cornell winning both games.

Last Year Against the Big Red

- The Big Green outscored Cornell over the three games, 29-22, in winning the series, two games to one.
- The opener went to the Big Red, however, as the hosts jumped out to a 7-0 lead through two innings and cruised to a 12-7 triumph. Cornell slammed four home runs in the contest and Sam Kaplan went 4-for-4 with a long ball and two triples, scoring four times to lead the Big Red. **Connor Bertsch** drove in a pair and was one of eight Dartmouth players with one hit.
- The second game was a lopsided affair in the other direction with the Green taking a 12-2 contest. **Trystan Sarcone** starred on the mound, fanning a career-high 10 batters in eight innings of work. Dartmouth had just a 4-0 lead entering the seventh before erupting for eight runs in the next two stanzas. Kade Kretzschmar was a perfect 2-for-2 with a home

run, three runs and three RBIs and **Tyler Cox** led Dartmouth with three hits, scoring three times as well.

- The Big Green outlasted Cornell in the rubber game, 10-8, after rallying from a five-run deficit, their largest comeback in five years. Four players had three hits for Dartmouth, one of whom was Kretzschmar who broke an 8-8 deadlock in the eighth by sprinting home on a wild pitch. Bertsch and **Max Zajec** both homered for the Green, the first of the latter's career, and reliever Cole Roland earned the win after yielding one earned run over five frames before **Jack Metzger** closed out the win with two scoreless innings for his fifth save.

Scouting Cornell

- The Big Red opened the season losing all 12 games before Ivy League play began, then took two of three from Yale. They have also won a series at Harvard and took a game from both Columbia and Penn.
- Cornell is averaging nearly five runs a game, sixth in the Ivy League, but they are third in the league in homers in conference play (17). The team's overall slash line is .244/.335/.376, giving it the fifth-best OPS in the Ancient Eight.
- Nathan Waugh has been the Big Red's best hitter at .322/.426/.556, leading the team with five homers despite missing seven games.
- Cornell has good team speed with four players stealing at least seven bases, led by Jakobi Davis with 13.
- The pitching staff is essentially tied for sixth in the league with a 6.91 ERA, but seventh with a better 6.06 ERA while walking 5.7 batters per nine in league play.
- Noah Keller has been the top starter on the mound with two of the Big Red's seven wins, while the bullpen is anchored by Carson Mayfield (1-2, 5.11 ERA in 44.0 innings).
- Cornell is tied for sixth in fielding percentage (.962) and has allowed 71 stolen bases while throwing out just 16 (83.5 percent success).
- Dan Pepicelli (SUNY Cortland '89) is in his eighth year as the Ted Thoren Head Coach of Baseball with a record of 82-141-1 entering the weekend. He also spent nine seasons posting a 200-137-1 record at St. John Fisher from 2001-2009.

HEAD COACH BOB WHALEN



A mainstay in Hanover, Bob Whalen is in his 34th year as Dartmouth's head baseball coach. Whalen has guided the Big Green to success both on and off the field since his arrival prior to the 1990 season.

Under his leadership, the Big Green have won 626 games, accumulated two Ivy League crowns, 11 Red

Rolfe Division titles, 80 first-team all-conference selections, eight Rookies of the Year, five Players of the Year and four Pitchers of the Year, plus sent 28 players to the professional ranks. His 348 conference victories are the most ever for an Ivy League coach.

Prior to his arrival at Dartmouth, Whalen was an assistant at his alma mater, Maine, from 1982-89 and was promoted to associate head coach in 1987.

In addition to his collegiate coaching career, Whalen served as the head coach of the Chatham A's of the Cape Cod League in 1988 and 1989. He coached former Houston Astros first baseman Jeff Bagwell, the 1994 National League MVP, and 25 others who signed professionally.

Whalen earned a bachelor's degree in 1979 and his MBA in finance in 1986. Whalen and his wife, Kim, have a son, Matt, and daughter, Katie.

Probable Starting Pitchers

- Dartmouth will kick off the weekend with LHP Devin Milberg (0-2, 4.50) on the mound. The junior has not allowed a run in any of his four starts this season, albeit totaling just 12.0 innings. The Big Red will counter with a south-paw of their own, LHP Spencer Edwards (1-3, 6.45), who is making his fourth start after 14 relief appearances. In his three starts, he has a 6.75 ERA, but did throw four no-hit innings against Harvard.
- For game two, the Big Green double up on the left-handers with LHP **Trystan Sarcone** (0-6, 8.04) looking to rebound from his outing at Brown that was cut short due to illness. Even with that rough start, he leads the team in ERA against Ivy League foes (5.24) with 31 strikeouts in 34.1 innings. Cornell has RHP Ethan Hamill (1-6, 8.00) lined up to take the hill, who has surrendered 12 home runs in 45.0 innings in his rookie campaign.
- The finale on Sunday will feature RHP **Clark Gilmore** (2-4, 6.21) for Dartmouth against LHP Noah Keller (2-5, 5.79) for the Big Red. Gilmore is coming off the Big Green's best start of the year, a complete-game, 2-1 victory at Brown. Keller posted a 2.25 ERA in his first four Ivy starts, but in his last two outings combined to allow eight earned runs in nine innings.

What's Up Next

Dartmouth will end the season with a non-conference doubleheader at Sacred Heart next Saturday, May 13, beginning at 11:30 a.m. It will be the Pioneers' Senior Day.

VICTORY

It should not be surprising that we are highlighting the 2-1 win in the series finale at Brown on April 29. The victory ended a program-record 27-game losing streak that began 45 days prior on March 15. **Clark Gilmore** was outstanding on the mound, throwing the Big Green's first nine-inning, complete game in four years and first one that ended in a victory in seven. The right-hander, who had not thrown more than five frames in any outing in his collegiate career, needed 109 pitches to record the 27 outs, and the only run against him was unearned as he struck out five without issuing a walk. **Tyler Robinson** provided the go-ahead RBI in the seventh when he was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded.

Bats Do Just Enough in Win

The 2-1 win at Brown was quite the pitchers' duel, but thankfully Dartmouth did just enough at the plate to pull out the victory. As a team, the Big Green collected just four hits in the contest, their fewest in a win since a 1-0 triumph at Gardner-Webb on March 5, 2022, when they had just three. Both runs were scored by hitters that drew a walk — **Tyler Robinson** in the first and **Connor Bertsch** in the seventh.

Missed Opportunity

While Dartmouth ended its losing streak in the last game at Brown, it had a good chance of snapping the skid earlier in the day in the first game of the doubleheader. The Big Green had a 2-0 lead through six innings, but when Brown started the seventh with a bloop double, things snowballed on Dartmouth as the Bears rallied for four runs. **Devin Milberg** pitched the first three scoreless innings and **Jack Metzger** threw three more before trouble found him in that fateful seventh.

Double-Triple

No, I'm not talking about basketball or a triple-double. In the second game at Brown, **Tyler Robinson** stroked not one, but two triples in the 4-3 defeat, scoring each of the Big Green's final two runs. He became the 29th player in program history to leg out two three-baggers in a game, and even more astounding is that of his 14 career extra-base hits, 10 have been triples.

Krewson Puts a Bruisin' on the Ball

Dartmouth may have trailed host Brown by eight runs in the eighth when **Elliot Krewson** stepped to the plate, but the sophomore wasn't about to give up. He got into a hitter's count at 3-1, then belted a pitch to deep left-center, just over the fence for his first career home run. It is the Big Green's only long ball in the last 10 games. Over the last month, Krewson has been battering the baseball to the tune of a .364 average (24-for-66) with eight multi-hit games in 16 contests. He leads the team with a dozen games of two or more hits, including a season-high four knocks at Holy Cross on April 25.

Holy Cross-ed Up

Dartmouth jumped out to an early 5-1 lead at Holy Cross on April 25 with its sights set on

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ending its long losing streak. But the Crusaders bounced back with six unanswered runs, beating the Big Green for the second time this year, 7-5, and extending the Big Green's losing streak to 25 games. The lesson from this is don't schedule Holy Cross twice in a season; the last time the two teams played two games was in 1979, the year that had the previous longest losing streak (16 games).

Skid Marks

Now that the interminable losing streak is over at 27 games, here are some facts that we will never speak of again:

- The longest previous streak was 16 games during the 1979 season.
- Dartmouth has 34 losses on the season, tying the 1976 season for the most in team history.
- The Big Green scored first in 10 of the 27 games.
- They also had the lead at the end of 35 innings (out of 212, not including anything past the eighth). That also leaves out taking a lead in the 10th at Columbia.
- Dartmouth held the lead after six innings five times, after seven innings three times and after eight twice.

Meet the Metzger, Control Artist

Senior **Jack Metzger** has been terrific in keeping extra runners off the bases this year. The right-hander not only leads the Ivy League in both fewest walks allowed per nine innings (0.95) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.83), he ranks among the top 10 nationally in both categories as well (4th and 9th, respectively), though he did walk two batters in his start at Columbia, his first outing with more than one base on balls in 26 appearances.

Bats Starting to Come to Life

It has been a long season both at the plate and on the mound for the Big Green, but the bats showed encouraging signs at Columbia on April 22-23. Dartmouth recorded a season-high 18 hits while matching a season-best 13 runs in the second game of the series, then followed that up with 10 more knocks in the finale. And with 10 more hits at Holy Cross, the Big Green had double-digit safeties in three straight games for the first time all year.

Bertsch Shows Old Form

Connor Bertsch was an All-Ivy Second Team selection at third base last year after hitting .331 with five homers and 35 RBIs, plus did not commit an error in any conference game. This year has been more of a struggle, but for one game at Columbia, the senior turned back the clock by going 5-for-6 with a double, walk and three runs. He is the first Big Green player with five hits in a game since Michael Ketchmark '17 was 5-for-6 against the University of Chicago in 2017. The last time Dartmouth had someone with five hits in a league game was in 2016 when Dustin Shirley '18 was 5-for-6 in a 9-8 loss to

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Princeton. So who is the last one with five hits in a win in league play? Matt Parisi '15 just over 10 years ago in an 11-3 win over Brown on April 13, 2013.

Suspended at Columbia

For the second consecutive year, Dartmouth and Columbia had a game suspended in the middle of their series. Last year, lightning forced the second game to be stopped after four innings, and the Lions came back the next day and squeaked out a 6-4 victory. This year, rain and lightning delayed the second game, but after play resumed in the bottom of the eighth, Dartmouth tied the game with a five-run ninth, forcing extra innings. But there was not enough light to continue, so the game was resumed on Sunday, and it turned into another Lion victory, 14-13 in 12 innings.

Extra-Inning Heartbreak

Momentum seemed to be on Dartmouth's side when it scored five runs in the ninth to tie the second game at 11 at Columbia, then escaped a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the bottom half. And when the Big Green took a 13-11 lead in the 10th, it seemed that the losing streak would finally come to an end. But it was not to be as the Lions rallied to tie in the bottom half and walk it off in the 12th. It was the longest game for Dartmouth since the 21-inning marathon against Penn in 2019 that the Quakers won, 21-15. The last Big Green win in a game that lasted more than 10 innings came in 2018 against Brown, a 2-1 triumph in 13 on May 1.

Margin of Defeat

Dartmouth suffered a 20-1 loss at the hands of the Siena Saints on April 19, matching the second-largest margin of defeat since the dawn of the 20th century. Only once has Dartmouth suffered a loss by 20 or more runs since 1900, that coming almost exactly 45 years earlier to the day in a 23-0 defeat handed out by UConn on April 18, 1978.

Sarcone Settling In

Co-captain **Trystan Sarcone** got off to a rocky start in 2023, but since the calendar flipped to April, the left-hander has been more like his All-Ivy League Second Team self from a year ago. In his first four starts in April, the southpaw posted an ERA of 3.67 and left with a lead in the last three of those outings. In 27 innings, Sarcone held the opposition to 24 hits and four walks while striking out 23.

Heartbreaking Losses to Yale

Dartmouth had its chances in each of the three games with Yale on April 15-16, but the Elis were able to deny the Big Green each time. First, Dartmouth closed to within two runs in the eighth of game one, 5-3, before the Bulldogs tallied 11 runs in the ninth. In game two, the Green led 2-0 after seven but surrendered single runs in the eighth and ninth — the second

one unearned — and Yale scored five in the 10th to win, 7-2. And on Sunday, the team locked horns in a classic pitchers' duel with the game's only run crossing the plate in the seventh on a bases-loaded walk in a 1-0 defeat.

Freeman Frees the Ball

Last year, **Kolton Freeman** led the Big Green with eight home runs. But this season, that power stroke had escaped him ... until the opening game against Yale, that is. The senior opened the fifth inning by crushing the first pitch thrown over the left-field fence for his first long ball of the year. It was also the 10th of his career.

Bats Break Out Versus BC

In the 13 games since suffering a demoralizing 12-10 loss at UCF on March 18, the Dartmouth offense had struggled mightily, averaging about 3.4 runs per game while hitting a collective .184. It took a matchup with the 11th-ranked Eagles to snap the lumber out of its slumber as the Big Green scored in seven of the nine innings while putting a 10-spot on the board and matching a season high with 15 hits. Alas, it was not enough to end Dartmouth's losing streak as Boston College escaped Hanover with a 14-10 win.

Hitting the Ball a Country Milo

Freshman **Milo Suarez** returned to the lineup against BC after missing the Harvard series with an injury, and he showed that he healed up nicely by cranking not one, but two home runs in the 14-10 loss. He is the second Big Green hitter to launch two long balls in a game in a three-game span (read on to find out who the other one was). All three of his team-leading three home runs have come against ranked ACC teams with the other coming against Miami.

(Boston) College of Pitchers

I'm harkening back to the old "College of Coaches" that ran the Chicago Cubs in the early '60s, but how many pitchers does it take to get 27 outs? It may sound like the setup for a joke, but against No. 11 Boston College, Dartmouth found out the answer is 11. Only one Big Green pitcher — **Danny Will** — faced more than six batters on the day, and unsurprisingly had the most success, tossing 1.2 scoreless innings in relief. The 11 pitchers are being claimed by me as a school record, but if you can find a game with a dozen, more power to you. Dartmouth did use 10 pitchers in last year's season finale, a thrilling 12-11 victory in 10 innings over Columbia, so using that many pitchers isn't necessarily a bad thing.

Hitting Hoyer-itzers

I told you I would get to the other Big Green player to hit two homers in a game this season. **Jackson Hoyer** entered the second game against Harvard with nary a four-bagger to his

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name in 94 career at-bats. But in his third plate appearance, the sophomore left no doubt about his first career homer, a solo shot. He liked how it felt so much that he belted another bomb his next time up, this one a two-run shot (the first one all season for the Big Green with a runner on base), giving him a career-high three RBIs.

Late Leads Lost to Harvard

Dartmouth had two terrific opportunities to put its losing streak in the rear-view mirror on April 8 against Harvard, but the Crimson rallied late to snatch the games away from the Green. First, **Jack Metzger** tossed a career-long eight innings and yielded just two runs while striking out seven. But the 3-2 lead he enjoyed when he departed was ruined by a grand slam in the ninth, giving Harvard a 6-3 victory. In the night-cap, Dartmouth had a 6-3 lead behind seven strong innings from **Trystan Sarcone** before the Crimson touched the Big Green bullpen for six runs in the eighth en route to a 10-6 triumph.

The Schwartz Is With Him

Ryan Schwartz hasn't seen much playing time in his career, but he certainly has made the most of his opportunities this season. The senior made his first career start in the 6-1 loss to UMass Lowell on April 4 after collecting a pair of hits in four at-bats off the bench coming into the game. His 1-for-3 at the plate was a solid

performance, and he added another single in his only plate appearance against No. 11 Boston College. For his career, Schwartz is now hitting an even .385 with five hits in 13 at-bats.

How'er You Doing?

Sophomore **Jackson Hower** had a slow start to the season, collecting just three hits in his first 25 at-bats. But the outfielder found his stroke in the final game at Princeton, going a perfect 4-for-4 with a double to his credit. It was his first career four-hit game and the third by a Big Green player this season, joining **Tyler Cox** and **Kolton Freeman**.

Four-Hit Freeman

On March 18, senior **Kolton Freeman** matched a career high with four hits in his four official at-bats to go with a walk at UCF. It capped an eight-game hitting streak, the longest of the season thus far by a Big Green hitter, and with two walks the next day, he reached base in seven straight plate appearances.

Going Yard

Dartmouth blasted three home runs in the 12-10 loss to UCF, its most in just over a year (four at Gardner-Webb on March 6, 2022). Two of those long balls were hit by Big Green batters for the first time in their career — freshman **Ivan Hoyt** and sophomore **Luke Carroll**, the latter of whom missed his entire freshman campaign with an injury.

Climbing New Hoyts

Freshman **Ivan Hoyt**, a two-sport athlete who is also a wide receiver on the football team, missed the first weekend of the year with a slight injury but started each of the next nine contests, reaching base at least once in eight of those games. He also showed off his power stroke with his first collegiate home run at UCF, a blast to center field.

First Victory

The Big Green broke into the win column on March 14 in their first game of the spring trip by defeating USF, 6-1. It wasn't just the first win for Dartmouth this year, but also the first for junior **Clark Gilmore** on the mound in just his third career appearance. The right-hander pitched five effective innings of relief, surrendering just one run on four hits and three walks while fanning four. **Tyler Robinson** dealt the initial offensive blow by lining a three-run triple in the third, and RBI singles by **Jackson Hower**, **Tyler Cox** and **Kolton Freeman** added to the cushion.

Walk-Off Woes

Before Wagner produced a two-out, RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to defeat Dartmouth on March 5, 4-3, the Big Green had not suffered a walk-off defeat in nearly five full years. The last team to walk it off against Dartmouth was Penn on April 1, 2018, in the 11th inning of the first game of a doubleheader, 8-7.

Junior first baseman **Max Zajec** played a big role in Dartmouth scoring 13 runs in its first game down in North Carolina, collecting a career-high five RBIs on a pair of singles and two groundouts. He is the first Big Green hitter with five or more RBIs in a game since Kade Kretzschmar had five in a 16-7 win over Princeton last April 17.

Suave Suarez

Launching your first collegiate home run is a moment hitters never forget, and freshman **Milo Suarez** made his memorable by doing so in his own backyard. In just his second career at-bat, the rookie deposited a pitch over the fence in left field on Feb. 26 at 22nd-ranked Miami, fewer than three miles from where he went to high school at Gulliver Prep. He is the first Big Green player to hit a home run in his second career at-bat since Jason Brooks '11 went yard against Navy back in 2008.

150th Season

The first varsity sport at Dartmouth, baseball began its 150th season of competition with this series at Miami. The Big Green played three games in their inaugural season of 1866, beating Concord and Portsmouth before taking it on the chin against Amherst, 40-10 (the game was a little different back then). Dartmouth did exact its revenge the following year, beating the Lord Jeffs (now Mammoths) by a final of 30-24 (like I said, different game). The college did not have

any intercollegiate games in 1870 or from 1873-77, but there have been games every year since 1878 save for 1917 (due to the Great War) and 2021 (due to the COVID-19 pandemic).

Preseason Polls

The Ivy League announced the results of its preseason poll on Feb. 17, and in a shocking development, those results look very similar to last year's final standings. Dartmouth is hoping to continue a trend from last year when it was picked to finish fifth and instead placed third. With some simple extrapolating, this year's third-place prognostication should translate into ... you do the math.

Aiming for More All-Ivy Honors

Dartmouth had three players named to the All-Ivy League First Team last year, boosting head coach Bob Whalen's total during his Big Green career to 80. No other team in the conference has had more than 65 (Penn) in that span (1990-2022). The most first-teamers for Whalen in any one year was eight in 2013, and he has had at least one every season except one — 2010. Oddly enough, Dartmouth won the Ivy League title that year.

Get a Whiff of This

Last year's Dartmouth pitching staff set a team single-season record by striking out 319 batters in 374.0 innings (which is the second most in program history as well). But in terms of strikeouts per nine innings, the 2022 staff ranks fifth; the 1972 squad fanned 9.59 batters per nine innings to set the standard (281 in 263.2 stanzas).

Co-Captains

For the 2023 season, Dartmouth has fifth-year senior and LHP **Trystan Sarcone** and OF **Kolton Freeman** serving as co-captains. Sarcone led the squad in victories (6), ERA (4.85) and fewest walks per nine innings (1.97), while Freeman topped the team in homers (8), walks (25) and hit by pitches (6).

Grad Transfer Updates

There are currently five former Big Green players that graduated from Dartmouth and are continuing their college careers elsewhere as graduate transfers. Here is a quick rundown of those players:

- **Kade Kretzschmar '22:** The 2022 Ivy League Player of the Year is starting in the outfield at

California and is on an absolute tear, earning National Player of the Week honors on April 17 and National Player of the Month honors for April. He leads the 18-23 Bears with a .331 average and 11 home runs, not to mention 28 RBIs, while collecting 31 hits in his last 61 at-bats (.508) with six long balls.

- **Justin Murray '22:** After receiving first-team All-Ivy honors as a utility player and second-team honors as a pitcher last year, Murray is playing first base regularly and closing on the mound for the 26-19 Cougars, hitting .338 with six home runs — including a pinch-hit, two-run shot in the ninth to tie up Minnesota on March 18 — and 37 RBIs. He also has pitched in 16 games, posting a 3-0 record with six saves and a 2.88 ERA, striking out 29 in 25.0 IP.
- **Cole Roland '22:** Due to injuries and the pandemic, Roland didn't actually pitch until his fourth year at Dartmouth, posting a 3.90 ERA in 30.0 innings with a 2-1 record, four saves and 37 strikeouts. He is now pitching at second-ranked Wake Forest (37-6) and has a 1.37 ERA with a 1-0 record and one save, allowing just eight hits and three runs over 19.2 innings while striking out 32 batters.
- **Ubaldo Lopez '21:** The product of Archbishop McCarthy in Florida and 2019 Big Green leader in home runs, doubles and slugging is now in his second season at Georgetown (24-21). Last year he walloped 19 home runs in 48 games, and this year he leads the team in average (.350), homers (15), doubles (12), runs (46), walks (29), OBP (.480), slugging (.713) and OPS (1.193).
- **Jonah Jenkins '21:** This right-hander pitched at San Francisco last year and is now at Ohio State. In 12 relief outings and two starts for the 22-23 Buckeyes, he has recently joined the weekend rotation and posted a record of 4-4 with a 3.98 ERA with two saves while striking out 36 in 43.0 innings, the last of which leads the team.

MLB Watch

In the summer of 2014, Kyle Hendricks '12 made his MLB debut with the Chicago Cubs and finished his rookie year with a 7-2 record over 13 starts with a 2.46 ERA. Nine years later he is an established big leaguer who led both leagues with an ERA of 2.13 in 2016, finishing third in the Cy Young balloting and helping the Cubs win their first World Series in 108 years. In nine seasons in Chicago, Hendricks boasts an 87-61 record with an ERA of 3.46 while striking out 7.4 batters per nine innings. Those 87 victories are the most ever for a Dartmouth alum, as are his 1,079 strikeouts. He began the season on the 15-day IL and has made two rehab starts at the Triple-A level in preparing to start his 10th season in the bigs.

One of Hendricks' classmates, Cole Sulser '12, debuted in September 2019 with Tampa Bay and did not allow a run in seven appearances. He then pitched for two seasons for the Baltimore Orioles before relieving in 39 games for the Miami Marlins last year. For his career, he has a

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record of 7-13 with 15 saves and an ERA of 3.83 over 131.2 inning with 143 strikeouts. He pitched in three games in the first week of the season but was placed on the 60-day IL on April 9.

Sulser's younger brother, Beau Sulser '16, reached the big leagues last year with the Pittsburgh Pirates before getting traded mid-season to the Orioles. He appeared in 10 games, tossing 22.1 innings while recording a 3.63 ERA, but this season he is playing in Korea.

Dartmouth also has one other former player toiling in the minors in 2023 — C Ben Rice '22, who is playing in the South Atlantic League for the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades. After a month of the season, he sports a .341 average with two homers, .559 OBP and .523 slugging percentage for a 1.082 OPS.
