Setting the Scene

The Dartmouth football team returns home on Saturday to welcome Yale for a Homecoming showdown in a game presented by The Richards Group. The Big Green will look to bounce back from a tough 36-24 defeat at Penn on Saturday when they face a Bulldogs' team that has an identical 2-1 overall record, but stands 1-0 in the Ivy League. Dartmouth and Yale were picked second and third in the preseason Ivy League poll.

Saturday will be a rematch from last season's historic 23-point second-half comeback win for the Big Green at Yale. Dartmouth trailed 30-7 at one point before coming back to win, 44-43, in overtime. The Big Green also scored touchdowns with 7:30, 6:34 and 1:22 remaining in regulation to force overtime.

Last weekend, Dartmouth led 17-10, but Penn scored 16 straight points and 26 of the final 33 points to pull away, 36-24. Mistakes hurt the Big Green, with two interceptions, a fumbled punt return and high snap on a punt that led to a safety. Dartmouth actually held a 326-323 edge in total yards.

Grayson Saunier made things happen with 142 yards passing and 50 rushing, along with two rushing scores, but two interceptions hurt. **D.J. Crowther** had 86 more yards rushing on 17 carries to reach 315 through three games, the most by a Dartmouth running back through three games since **Dominick Pierre** had 368 through three games in 2013. Crowther had a rushing score, giving him six on the season, already the most by any Big Green running back in a season since **Rashaad Cooper's** six in 2018. **Chris Corbo** finished with five catches for 52 yards through the air. Defensively, **Zyion Freer-Brown** and **Thaddeus Gianaris** posted career highs in tackles with 10 and nine, respectively. **Harrison Keith** had an interception on the first play from scrimmage, becoming the first Big Green player since **Isiah Swann** in 2018 to record an interception in two of the first three games of the season.

Following Saturday's game, the Big Green travel to Fordham next Saturday to close out nonleague play before hosting Columbia (Friday, Oct. 24) to wrap up the month.

Notables

With a Win on Saturday...

- Dartmouth would improve to 3-1 overall and 1-1 in the Ivy League.
- The Big Green would win their second straight against Yale and sixth in their last eight tries.
- Dartmouth would beat Yale at home for the first time since the 2021 season.
- The Big Green would pull within 56-46-6 in the all-time series but improve to 35-32-1 against Yale since Ivy League play began in 1956.

Scouting Yale

Yale stands 2-1 on the young season, beating Holy Cross (28-10) and Cornell (41-24) at home before falling at No. 8 Lehigh, 31-13.

Dante Reno has taken every snap at quarterback, as he's 52-of-79 for 552 yards with four touchdowns and three interceptions. **Josh Pitsenberger** comes in at 332 yards on the ground on 72 carries for a 4.6 average. He's tied for the Ivy League lead (with the Big Green's **D.J. Crowther**) in rushing touchdowns, rushing yards and rushing yards per game (110.7). Three receivers are over 100 receiving yards, led by **Nico Brown's** 204 on 12 catches and Ivy-League leading three touchdown receptions. **Inumidun Ayo-Durojaiye** leads the defense in tackles with 40, his 7.33 solo tackles per game are tied for first in the league, while **Abu Kamara's** two interceptions and four pass breakups lead the way.

Last Season vs. Yale

(Oct 12, 2024)

- Dartmouth picked up a historic 44-43 overtime win at Yale, as the Big Green posted their largest comeback victory in program history, coming back from down 23 points in the third quarter and 21 points midway through the fourth.
- The comeback was also the largest comeback in NCAA FCS football to that point of the season and moved the Big Green to 2-0, all alone in first place in the Ivy League.
- Dartmouth found itself trailing 30-7 and later 37-16. That's when the Big Green had receiving touchdowns from **Paxton Scott** and **Daniel Haughton** with 7:30 and 6:34 left in the fourth quarter. In between was a perfectly-executed onside kick. After Dartmouth's defense came up with a stop, which ended with a long missed field goal from Yale, the Big Green put together an eight-play, 71-yard drive in less than two minutes. After Haughton made a sensational one-armed grab, quarterback **Grayson Saunier** ran it in from 32 yards away on the ensuing play to even the score at 37. Each team scored a touchdown in the extra session, but the Bulldogs went for two and were unsuccessful.
- Saunier finished with 276 yards passing and 84 rushing, accounting for 360 yards. That marked the highest combined passing and rushing yards by a Dartmouth quarterback since **Jack Heneghan's** 379 on Oct. 21, 2017 against Columbia. Meanwhile, Saunier's 276 pass yards were most by a Big Green quarterback in an Ivy League game since **Derek Kyler** had 303 against Brown on Nov. 23, 2019. Saunier accounted for 111 pass yards and 50 rush yards in the fourth quarter alone.
- Scott finished with six catches for 100 yards, his second 100-yard effort of the season and fifth of his career. He also moved from eighth into seventh place in program history for career receiving yards (1,858). **Q Jones** ran for 84 yards, highlighted by a 31-yard run in overtime to erase a couple penalties and set the Big Green up inside the 5-yard line.
- Haughton made a major impact with four catches for a career-high 69 yards, with each catch seeming more critical than the last. Several Big Green posted career highs in tackles (setting or tying): **Micah Green** (11), **Zach Farris** (8), **Ejike Adele** (7), **Jordan Washington** (6), **Derrell Porter** (6), **Tyson Grimm** (5) and **Jamal Cooper** (3). Farris entered the Penn game with 19 career tackles then followed with a career high of eight in back-to-back weeks, upping his career total to 35.

Thriller at CCSU

- **Grayson Saunier** found **Ky'Dric Fisher** for 50 yards with 16 seconds remaining to break a 28-28 tie and give the Big Green a thrilling 35-28 win at CCSU on Sept. 27. It capped off a stretch of three touchdowns (two by Dartmouth) in the game's final 5:56.
- It was Fisher's first-career touchdown catch and just his second reception overall.
- Saunier finished 30-for-44 for 407 yards, throwing for two touchdowns. The completions, attempts and yards all marked career highs. His yard total tied for the fifth most in program history and tied for the most yards a Dartmouth quarterback has ever thrown on the road. He became the first 400-yard passer in nine seasons (since **Jack Heneghan** vs. Brown in 2016).
- **Grayson O'Bara** was another big story offensively, posting seven catches for 128 yards, becoming the first Big Green player with back-to-back 100+ yard receiving games since **Hunter Hagdorn** on October 22 and October 29 of 2016.

The Series

YALE LEADS 56-45-6

- The Big Green have won nine of the last 12 meetings overall, but Yale has won two of the last three.
- Since Ivy League play began in 1956, Dartmouth holds a 34-32-1 advantage in the all-time series.
- Dartmouth's last two wins have come in overtime, including a historic comeback 44-43 double overtime victory last year at the Yale Bowl.

- **Chris Corbo's** 68 yards receiving at CCSU marked a career high.

- Meanwhile, **D.J. Crowther** finished with 86 yards on 24 carries and two touchdowns.

- Defensively, **Zyion Freer-Brown** enjoyed a stellar game with five tackles, one sack, 1.5 tackles-for-loss and a fumble recovery. It marked his first-career sack and tackle-for-loss.

- A number of Big Green tied career highs in tackles: **Tyson Grimm** (8), **Cameron Best-Alston** (5) and **Freer-Brown** (5). **Nico Schwikal's** seven tackles marked a career high, with **Dakota Quiñonez's** six also a new high.

- As a team, Dartmouth held a 524-289 edge in total yards.

400-Yard Club

Grayson Saunier joined an elite club when he passed for 407 yards in Dartmouth's 35-28 win over CCSU. He became just the fifth different Big Green quarterback to reach 400 yards in a game, with his total tied for fifth in program history and tied for the most by any Dartmouth quarterback on the road ever. He was the first to reach that plateau since **Jack Heneghan** passed for a school-record 440 yards in 2016 against Brown. The full list of 400-yard passers can be found below.

Saunier's yard total marked the most yards by an Ivy League quarterback in a regulation game since **Cole Smith** of Princeton in October of 2021.

Grayson O'Bara eclipsed 100 yards in each of the first two games of the season, posting 106 vs. New Hampshire and 128 at Central Connecticut State. He became the first Big Green player with back-to-back 100+ yard receiving games since **Hunter Hagdorn** on October 22 and October 29 of 2016.

Granite State Champs

- Dartmouth took down No. 25/23 New Hampshire to open the season on Sept. 20 to capture the Granite Bowl over the visiting Wildcats.

- UNH jumped out to a 10-0 lead, but Dartmouth outscored the Wildcats 27-10 the rest of the way to win its 14th season opener in the last 15 tries.

Notables

- **D.J. Crowther** was the story offensively, rushing for 143 yards on 20 carries with three touchdowns, all shattering previous career highs. He added three catches for 32 yards to finish the day with 175 yards from scrimmage. He was named Ivy League Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts. The touchdown runs came from four, 16 and 33 yards away.

- Quarterback **Grayson Saunier** finished 22-for-30 for 244 yards, along with a rushing touchdown. **Grayson O'Bara** had six catches for 106 yards, marking his second straight game with 100+ yards (he finished 2024 with 124 vs. Brown). **Chris Corbo** added five receptions for 40 yards.

- Defensively, Harrison Keith and **Sean Williams** each had interceptions. **Thaddeus Gianaris** was stellar with six tackles, including two tackles-for-loss, and a sack, with both tackles-for-loss and the sack coming in the fourth quarter.

- Following the game, the Big Green began receiving votes in both national polls.

Sensational 2024 Season

The Big Green began last season 6-0, reaching as high as No. 22 in the national polls. Dartmouth began the season with a dominant 45-13 win against Fordham, then won the next five games by four points or less. In there was a historic comeback win at Yale in overtime. The Big Green trailed 30-7 late in the third quarter and 37-16 midway through the fourth before winning 44-43 in overtime.

Losses vs. Harvard and Cornell hurt, but the Big Green dominated Brown, 56-28, coupled with a Harvard loss to Yale, which led to a three-way tie for first place and the Ivy League Championship (seeing Dartmouth, Columbia and Harvard sharing the title).

Quick Hitters

- **Chris Corbo's** seven touchdown receptions last season were the most by a Big Green player since **Drew Estrada** had eight in 2019.

- **Owen Zalc's** 34-yard field goal at Princeton ran his streak of consecutive games with at least one FG to 17 (all but his first collegiate game a year ago at New Hampshire). The previous Ivy record was 11 consecutive games, originally set by Brown's **Steve Morgan** almost 20 years ago. Zalc didn't have any field goals the following two weeks, at Cornell or vs. Brown.

Still All-Time Ivy Champs

Since the Ivy League began play in 1956, no other school in the conference has won more football titles than Dartmouth with 20. The last time an Ancient Eight squad had more crowns than the Big Green was in 1961 when Yale had a grand total of two. The next season, Dartmouth equaled that amount and has never looked up at another team since. But Penn isn’t far behind with 18 titles, while Harvard and Yale both have 17.

Notables

Award Announced in BT's Honor

Prior to the FBS National Championship Game in January of 2024, **Peyton Manning** revealed on ESPN's College GameDay that a new award will be given out for the first time following the 2024 college football season in honor of the late Dartmouth football coach **Buddy Teevens**.

The Buddy Teevens Award will go to a coach who makes a lasting impact on the game of football, on and off the field. Manning detailed some of the innovations Teevens made to preserve and improve college football, including the elimination of tackling from practices to reduce injuries, inspiring the development of a robotic tackling dummy and the hiring of women coaches, two of whom are currently coaching in the NFL — **Callie Brownson** (Cleveland Browns) and **Jennifer King** (Chicago Bears).

A Decade-Plus of Success

Dartmouth football returned to prominence throughout the 2010s decade, recording a record of 70-30 (.700) over the 10 years. Only eight teams enjoyed a higher winning percentage in that span. And with a third consecutive 9-1 season in 2021, the Big Green enjoyed more victories over a span of three seasons (27), four (35), five (39), six (48) and seven (56) than at any point in their history. Dartmouth has also added five Ivy League titles since 2015 to boost its conference-record total to 22 crowns since the league first officially formed for the 1956 season.

Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach Sammy McCorkle



Sammy McCorkle, who had been on Buddy Teevens' staff since the head coach's return to Hanover in 2005, was filling in as the interim head coach for the 2023 season following Teevens' bicycle accident in March of 2023 and subsequent passing on Sept. 19. On Oct. 19 of 2023, McCorkle had the interim tag removed as he became the Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach.

McCorkle enters his third season in 2025. In 2024, the Big Green won their second straight Ivy League Championship, sharing the title with Columbia and Harvard, and fourth in the last five seasons. Dartmouth began the season 6-0, beginning with a convincing 45-13 win over Fordham then five straight wins by four points or fewer. In that stretch was a historic come-back win at Yale. Despite trailing 30-7 late in the third quarter and 37-16 midway through the fourth, the Big Green scored touchdowns with 7:30, 6:34 and 1:22 remaining in regulation before topping Yale in overtime, 44-43. In the season finale, Dartmouth dominated Brown, 56-28, to help earn a share of the championship and up the program's leading Ivy League Championship total to 22.

The Big Green had 15 All-Ivy honorees in 2024, including Defensive Player of the Year Ejike Adele and Special Teams Player of the Year Owen Zalc. Adele became the Big Green's first Bushnell Cup winner since the Big Green won back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2018 (Isiah Swann) and 2019 (Jack Traynor). Adele was also later named a College Sports Communicators first team Academic All-American, among a number of honors. Adele, Chris Corbo and Delby Lemieux all received postseason All-America recognition from various outlets, with Corbo, Lemieux and Zalc earning preseason first team All-America honors from Phil Steele. It marked the most first team honorees in the nation.

As a team, the Big Green finished seventh nationally and tops in the Ivy League in rushing defense (105.7) and fifth in the country in winning percentage (80.0).

During the 2023 season, he went on to be named the Ivy League Coach of the Year, as the Big Green earned a share of the Ivy League Championship for the third time in four seasons. It upped Dartmouth's Ivy League best mark of championships to 21. The Big Green won their final three games of the season, beating Princeton (23-21), Cornell (30-14) and Brown (38-13) to finish tied with Yale and Harvard at 5-2 in league play. Dartmouth had a total of 18 honors bestowed upon its players, most of any team in the league. Three Big Green made the first team, six more earned a spot on the second team and eight were honorable mentions, plus one member of the Academic All-Ivy Team.

As a team, Dartmouth led the nation in fewest sacks allowed (0.50 per game) and was fourth in first down defense (allowing just 170 all season).

McCorkle, a 1996 graduate and three-time letter winner at the University of Florida is in his 20th year on the Big Green staff, helping Dartmouth to the program's 20th Ivy League championship in 2021. In the seven seasons of 2013-19, the Big Green were first or second in passes defended in the Ivy League, and his secondary was instrumental to the team's top-12 ranking in passing efficiency defense from 2018-21.

McCorkle's special teams have excelled as well, ranking among the top 25 nationally in each of the four seasons in punt returns between 2017-21, including a pair of top-10 rankings. In his first season as head coach, the Big Green ranked seventh nationally in blocked punts with three.

McCorkle has coached 11 players who have earned All-Ivy League First Team honors a total of 15 times, including two-time All-American CB Isiah Swann. No fewer than 26 of his defensive backs have received All-Ivy honors a combined 41 times, most recently safety Sean Williams '26 (first team) in 2023.

The Dartmouth defense was 14th nationally in scoring defense in 2023 and 13th in 2022 after placing among the top three in the previous three seasons. The 2021 squad also ranked fourth in fewest passing yards. And in the previous campaign of 2019, McCorkle's players were quite opportunistic during the season with four pick-sixes among the five defensive scores, fourth among FCS programs.

In 2018, the defense ranked second nationally in fewest points allowed and red zone defense, and fourth in total defense as Dartmouth finished the season ranked 15th in the coaches' poll. Three years prior, the squad led the nation in those first two categories and was also fourth in total defense as the Big Green won a share of its first conference crown in 19 years. Cornerback Vernon Harris '16 earned a spot on the All-Ivy First Team in 2014 and '15, and two-time co-captain Garrett Waggoner garnered first-team honors as a safety in both 2012 and '13.

McCorkle also mentored one of the finest cornerbacks and return men in Dartmouth history in Shawn Abuhoff '12, who earned first-team All-Ivy honors at both positions in 2010 and 2011.

In his first season on staff, three members of the Green's defensive secondary in 2005 — Steve Jensen, Mike Ribero and Ian Wilson — earned All-Ivy recognition as Dartmouth ranked first in the league in pass defense and 14th in the FCS.

In 2003-04, McCorkle was the head coach at Martin County High in Stuart, Florida. In 2003, he led Martin County to its best record in 10 years.

McCorkle previously coached at the University of Tennessee-Martin from 2000-02. He coached the defensive secondary in 2000 and

was defensive coordinator in 2001-02.

From 1997-99, McCorkle was a graduate assistant at his alma mater, assisting the secondary and special teams coaches while also scouting opponents.

During the 1996-97 academic year, McCorkle taught PE while coaching the defensive backs and linebackers, and coordinating special teams at Spanish River High School in Boca Raton, Fla.

McCorkle was a standout defensive back at Florida. He played on four SEC championship teams, competed in four bowl games (Gator, Sugar twice and Fiesta) and a national title game. McCorkle graduated with Florida's single-season and career records for blocked punts. He twice was named Florida's special teams player of the year.

McCorkle, was the football staff's academic liaison, as coordinator of the Mentoring Program that brings Big Green football players and successful Dartmouth alumni together to introduce the players to business and professional opportunities when they graduate.

He and his wife, Vicki, have three daughters, Madison, Allie and Campbell.
