Setting the Scene

The Big Green return home to open Buddy Teevens Stadium at Memorial Field on Saturday, Sept. 26, hosting Monmouth for Dartmouth's home opener and Family Weekend, with kickoff set for 1 p.m. It marks the first-ever meeting between the two programs. Dartmouth will be aiming for a fifth Ivy League title in the past seven years in 2026, and returned a talented roster headlined by Phil Steele Preseason All-Ivy honorees **Grayson Saunier** and **Harrison Keith**.

Dartmouth owns the most all-time Ivy League Championships, with 22, and has won a title in four of the past six seasons. The Big Green opened the season on the road and almost knocked off a top-10 opponent, falling 24-20 at No. 7 Lehigh on Saturday, Sept. 19, despite a go-ahead touchdown from Myles Craddock in the third quarter.

Sammy McCorkle, the Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach, enters his fourth season at the helm in 2026. The Big Green won Ivy League titles in 2023 and 2024 under McCorkle.

Core contributors return throughout the lineup for the Big Green, including quarterback **Grayson Saunier**, who threw for 2,143 yards and 9 touchdowns, while also rushing for 413 yards and a team-high 11 rushing touchdowns last season. **Ky'Dric Fisher** will be the top returning pass catcher, with 21 catches for 341 yards and 2 touchdowns as a sophomore in 2025.

Harrison Keith, a Third Team Associated Press (AP) All-American last season, returns and led the team with four interceptions as a junior. **Cameron Best-Alston** enters his senior year after a 40-tackle 2025 season and is up to 59 career tackles over 20 games. **Bruce Williams** and **Joshua Johnson** combined for four sacks and 37 tackles as juniors last year and will look to take their production to the next level in 2026.

Notables

Last Time Out

Dartmouth opened its season on the road against #7 Lehigh and came within a possession of the winning, falling 24-20 at Goodman Stadium. Lehigh, the two-time defending Patriot League champion riding a 20-game regular-season win streak, needed a late touchdown with 8:46 left, aided by a pass interference call, to reclaim the lead for good after Dartmouth had grabbed its first advantage of the game, 20-17, on a **Myles Craddock** touchdown run late in the third quarter. It was Lehigh's closest game of the season. Dartmouth outgained the Mountain Hawks, 324-291, in total yards and held Lehigh to a season-low 218 rushing yards, while converting 9-for-14 third downs. The game was Lehigh's closest all season, with the Mountain Hawks earning wins over Holy Cross (35-10), Georgetown (45-14), and #16 William & Mary (44-20).

Grayson Saunier went 17-for-30 for 262 yards and a touchdown, with **Nick Lemon** catching five passes for a career-high 102 yards. Kicker **Owen Zalc** nailed both his field goal attempts, a 50-yarder and a 51-yarder, and moved into second on Dartmouth's all-time scoring list. On defense, **Steve Simpkins Jr.** had a career-best 10 tackles. Dartmouth mounted one last drive in the closing seconds, highlighted by catches from Lemon and **James Elliott** that pushed the ball to Lehigh's 26-yard line, but couldn't complete the comeback.

Receiving Votes

The Big Green received six votes in the Monday, Sept. 21, American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) poll

With a Win on Saturday...

- Dartmouth would improve to 15-2 at home over its last 17 games, dating back to the 2022 season finale.
- The Big Green would win a seventh consecutive home game.
- Dartmouth would win its first game in history against Monmouth.

Scouting Monmouth

Monmouth enters Buddy Teevens Stadium at Memorial Field under first-year head coach Jeff Gallo and comes in off a 28-20 win at UAlbany. The Hawks opened the 2026 season ranked #23 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll and #22 in the STATS Perform FCS Poll, one of only two Coastal Athletic Association programs in either preseason Top 25. Monmouth is coming off a 9-3 campaign in 2025 and returns quarterback Frankie Weaver along with receivers Gavin Nelson and Tra Neal from what was the top offense in FCS football a year ago. All-America safety Jaeden Jones, the CAA Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, anchors the Hawks' defense.

In the most recent AFCA FCS Coaches Poll Monmouth earned five votes in the most recent STATS Perform FCS Top 25, the Hawks received nine votes.

Weekly Honors For Zalc

On Monday, Sept. 21, Zalc was named Ivy League Special Teams Player of the Week for the seventh time in his career.

An Active Career Leader

Zalc is the FCS active career leader in field goals made-per-game (1.32) and ranks second among active players in made field goals (41), ninth in PATs (91) and tenth in points (214).

Zalc In The Record Book

- **Single-season field goals:** 17 made on 21 attempts (2023) — program record.

- **Career field goals:** 41 made on 58 attempts — Dartmouth record.

- **Career field goals (Ivy League context):** 41 — tied 5th all-time in Ivy League history; needs 11 to tie and 12 to pass Brown’s Steve Morgan (2004-07), the conference record holder.

400-Yard Club

Grayson Saunier joined an elite club when he passed for 407 yards in Dartmouth’s 35-28 win over CCSU on Sept. 27, 2025. He became just the fifth different Big Green quarterback to reach 400 yards in a game, with his total tied for fifth in program history and tied for the most by any Dartmouth quarterback on the road ever. He was the first to reach that plateau since **Jack Heneghan** passed for a school-record 440 yards in 2016 against Brown. The full list of 400-yard passers can be found below.

Saunier’s yard total marked the most yards by an Ivy League quarterback in a regulation game since **Cole Smith** of Princeton in

2025 Quick Hitters

- Dartmouth finished 5-0 at home, its first undefeated home season since 2019.

- The Big Green beat three teams who qualified for the NCAA FCS Playoffs (Yale, New Hampshire and CCSU)

- **Grayson O'Bara** and **Chris Corbo** each ended the season with over 500 receiving yards (590 and 516, respectively), marking the first time a Big Green duo was each over 500 since 2015 with **Victor Williams** (845) and **Ryan McManus** (598)

- The Big Green picked up a dominant 49-3 win over Columbia on Friday, Oct. 24 in a nationally-televised game on ESPN, marking Dartmouth's largest margin of victory since a 56-0 win over Columbia on Oct. 26, 2013

- The Big Green's 35 first-half points vs. Columbia marked their most since scoring 38 against Columbia at home on Oct. 25, 2019. The 35-point halftime lead marked Dartmouth's largest since also leading Marist 35-0 on the road on Oct. 19, 2019.

- **Grayson Saunier** and **D.J. Crowther** are one of just two duos in the nation to have 10+ rushing touchdowns apiece (the other being Barika Kpeenu and Cole Payton from North Dakota State).

- **Harrison Keith** and **Sean Williams** tied for the Ivy League lead in interceptions with four apiece.

30 Years From Perfection

This season marks the 30th anniversary of Dartmouth's perfect 1996 campaign, one of the finest in program history. Led by fifth-year head coach John Lyons, the Big Green went a perfect 10-0 overall and 7-0 in the Ivy League, finishing the year ranked No. 17 in the national rankings and capturing the program's 17th Ivy League title. The championship run featured signature wins over Cornell and Harvard, a dominant 40-0 shutout of Columbia, and a title-clinching victory at Brown, before the Big Green closed the year at Princeton, beating the Tigers 24-0 to complete the undefeated season. Thirty years later, that 1996 squad remains a touchstone for Dartmouth football and a fitting piece of history to celebrate this season.

Captains Named

At halftime of the spring game, Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach **Sammy McCorkle** announced the team captains for the fall of 2025, which were senior quarterback **Grayson Saunier**, senior defensive back **Harrison Keith** and senior defensive linemen **Joshua Johnson**.

Award Announced in BT's Honor

Prior to the FBS National Championship Game in January of 2024, **Peyton Manning** revealed on ESPN's College GameDay that a new award will be given out for the first time following the 2024 college football season in honor of the late Dartmouth football coach **Buddy Teevens**.

The Buddy Teevens Award will go to a coach who makes a lasting impact on the game of football, on and off the field. Manning detailed some of the innovations Teevens made to preserve and improve college football, including the elimination of tackling from practices to reduce injuries, inspiring the development of a robotic tackling dummy and the hiring of women coaches, two of whom have coached in the NFL — **Callie Brownson** (Cleveland Browns) and **Jennifer King** (Washington Commanders, Chicago Bears).

Still All-Time Ivy Champs

Since the Ivy League began play in 1956, no other school in the conference has won more football titles than Dartmouth with 22. The last time an Ancient Eight squad had more crowns than the Big Green was in 1961 when Yale had a grand total of two. The next season, Dartmouth equaled that amount and has never looked up at another team since. But Harvard isn't far behind with 20 titles, while Yale has 19.

Notables

A Decade-Plus of Success

Dartmouth football returned to prominence throughout the 2010s decade, recording a record of 70-30 (.700) over the 10 years. Only eight teams enjoyed a higher winning percentage in that span. And with a third consecutive 9-1 season in 2021, the Big Green enjoyed more victories over a span of three seasons (27), four (35), five (39), six (48) and seven (56) than at any point in their history. Dartmouth has also added five Ivy League titles since 2015 to boost its conference-record total to 22 crowns since the league first officially formed for the 1956 season.

Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach Sammy McCorkle



Sammy McCorkle, who had been on Buddy Teevens' staff since the head coach's return to Hanover in 2005, was filling in as the interim head coach for the 2023 season following Teevens' bicycle accident in March of 2023 and subsequent passing on Sept. 19. On Oct. 19 of 2023,

McCorkle had the interim tag removed as he became the Robert L. Blackman Head Football Coach.

The 2025 season saw the Big Green play to a 7-3 overall record, a perfect 5-0 record at Buddy Teevens Stadium at Memorial Field for their first undefeated home record since 2019, and a 3-0 record against nonconference opponents. Dartmouth opened the season with a 27-20 win over No. 20/18 New Hampshire as the Big Green picked up their first nationally ranked victory since defeating the same Wildcats in 2021. The Big Green also posted a dominant victor over Columbia on ESPNU, 49-3, Dartmouth's largest victory margin since 2013.

Individually, the Big Green saw impressive seasons from multiple players, including Chris Corbo and Delby Lemieux. Corbo finished the season with four All-American honors and a First-Team All-Ivy tab for the second straight season. Lemieux earned three All-American recognitions and was also named First-Team All-Ivy for the second consecutive season.

In 2024, the Big Green won their second straight Ivy League Championship, sharing the title with Columbia and Harvard, and fourth in the last five seasons. Dartmouth began the season 6-0, beginning with a convincing 45-13 win over Fordham then five straight wins by four points or fewer. In that stretch was a historic comeback win at Yale. Despite trailing 30-7 late in the third quarter and 37-16 midway through the fourth, the Big Green scored touchdowns with 7:30, 6:34 and 1:22 remaining in regulation before topping Yale in overtime, 44-43. In the season finale, Dartmouth dominated Brown, 56-28, to help earn a share of the championship.

The Big Green had 15 All-Ivy honorees in 2024, including Defensive Player of the Year Ejike Adele and Special Teams Player of the Year Owen Zalc. Adele became the Big Green's first Bushnell Cup winner since the Big Green won back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2018 (Isiah Swann) and 2019 (Jack Traynor). Adele was also later named a CSC first team Academic All-American, among a number of honors. Adele, Chris Corbo and Delby Lemieux all received postseason All-America recognition from various outlets, with Corbo, Lemieux and Zalc earning preseason first team All-America honors from Phil Steele. It marked the most first team honorees in the nation.

As a team, the Big Green finished seventh nationally and topped in the Ivy League in rush-

ing defense (105.7) and ranked fifth in the country in winning percentage (80.0).

During the 2023 season, he went on to be named the Ivy League Coach of the Year, as the Big Green earned a share of the Ivy League Championship for the third time in four seasons. The Big Green won their final three games of the season, beating Princeton (23-21), Cornell (30-14) and Brown (38-13) to finish tied with Yale and Harvard at 5-2 in league play. Dartmouth had a total of 18 honors bestowed upon its players, most of any team in the league. Three Big Green made the first team, six more earned a spot on the second team and eight were honorable mentions, plus one member of the Academic All-Ivy Team.

As a team, Dartmouth led the nation in fewest sacks allowed (0.50 per game) and was fourth in first down defense (allowing just 170 all season).

McCorkle, a 1996 graduate and three-time letter winner at Florida in his 20th year on the Big Green staff, helped Dartmouth to the program's 20th Ivy League championship in 2021. In the seven seasons of 2013-19, the Big Green were first or second in passes defended in the Ivy League, and his secondary was instrumental to the team's top-12 ranking in passing efficiency defense from 2018-21.

McCorkle's special teams have excelled as well, ranking among the top 25 nationally in each of the four seasons in punt returns between 2017-21, including a pair of top-10 rankings. In his first season as head coach, the Big Green ranked seventh nationally in blocked punts with three.

McCorkle has coached 11 players who have earned All-Ivy League First Team honors a total of 15 times, including two-time All-American CB Isiah Swann. No fewer than 26 of his defensive backs have received All-Ivy honors a combined 41 times, most recently safety Sean Williams '26 (first team) in 2023.

The Dartmouth defense was 14th nationally in scoring defense in 2023 and 13th in 2022 after placing among the top three in the previous three seasons. The 2021 squad also ranked fourth in fewest passing yards. In 2018, the defense ranked second nationally in fewest points allowed and red zone defense, and fourth in total defense as Dartmouth finished the season ranked 15th in the coaches' poll. Three years prior, the squad led the nation in those first two categories and was also fourth in total defense as the Big Green won a share of its first conference crown in 19 years. Cornerback Vernon Harris '16 earned a spot on the All-Ivy First Team in 2014 and '15, and two-time co-captain Garrett Waggoner garnered first-team honors as a safety in both 2012 and '13.

McCorkle also mentored one of the finest cornerbacks and return men in Dartmouth history in Shawn Abuhoff '12, who earned first-team All-Ivy honors at both positions in 2010 and 2011.

In his first season on staff, three members

of the Green's defensive secondary in 2005 — Steve Jensen, Mike Ribero and Ian Wilson — earned All-Ivy recognition as Dartmouth ranked first in the league in pass defense and 14th in the FCS.

From 1997-99, McCorkle was a GA at his alma mater, assisting the secondary and special teams coaches while also scouting opponents.

McCorkle was a standout defensive back at Florida. He played on four SEC championship teams, competed in four bowl games (Gator, Sugar twice and Fiesta) and a national title game. McCorkle graduated with Florida's single-season and career records for blocked punts. He twice was named Florida's special teams player of the year.

McCorkle, was the football staff's academic liaison, as coordinator of the Mentoring Program that brings Big Green football players and successful Dartmouth alumni together to introduce the players to business and professional opportunities when they graduate.

He and his wife, Vicki, have three daughters, Madison, Allie and Campbell.
