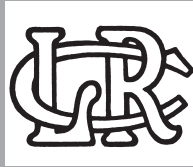

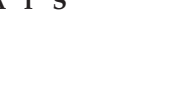

The 2007 season marks the 15th year for the Pioneer Football League, which returns to a non-divisional format for the first time since the 2000 season, the year before Davidson joined the league.

After five seasons playing a North-South divisional format, the league saw its numbers reduced to eight after the 2005 season, and those remaining members

voted to adopt a full-round-robin scheduling format



for 2006. Additionally, the PFL champion will participate in the Gridiron Classic versus the champion of the NEC.

The PFL, a non-scholarship NCAA FCS football conference, is one of only three conferences that sponsor football as its only sport. However, the PFL is a truly national conference with members on each coast and throughout the nation's heartland — Butler, Dayton, Drake, Jacksonville, Morehead State, San Diego and Valparaiso.



In 2006, Tripp Merritt was named PFL Co-Coach of the Year and became the first Davidson bench boss to earn league Coach of the Year honors since Homer Smith in 1969.
