## THE PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE

- Sam Bassett's 68th minute penalty pulled Denver within one after the Pioneers dug themselves a 2-0 hole, but a few shots off the woodwork kept Denver from equalizing at No. 6 SMU in the second round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament last November.
- Denver opens the 2024 season on Thursday when the Pioneers begin a six-match road swing at California. Opening kickoff at the site of one of the ACC's newest programs is set for 4:30 p.m. PT. Denver is 11-13-2 in season openers in its Division I history, including 2-6-1 on the road. The Pios are 4-7-2 in season openers decided by a goal or less.
- The Pioneers will stay on the west coast for a Sunday clash at Stanford. Opening kickoff to wrap-up the opening weekend of the season is set for 4 p.m. PT.

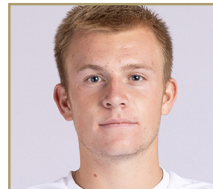

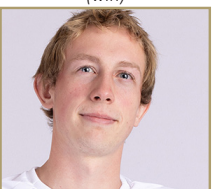

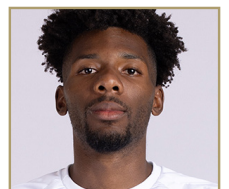

**BERKELEY, Calif.** – The University of Denver men’s soccer team earned its first victory of the 2019 campaign, keeping its second cleansheet of the season in a 1-0 win at [RV/-] California on Sunday afternoon at Edwards Stadium.

“I’m really proud of the guys,” head coach Jamie Franks said. “Adversity found us again today with two calls that we disagreed with setting up great chances for them, but our guys stayed resilient and persevered through the moment. After this road swing, there’s no one in the country that’s gone through more adverse moments than our group. I’m proud and happy of how the group responded today. It’s been a tough 17 days of the past 21 on the road, but we were rewarded with a result.”

With the victory, Denver is now 9-9-2 against teams listed as “others receiving votes” in the United Soccer Coaches’ Poll, including 8-2-1 under Franks.

Just shy of the half hour mark, junior Preston Judd (Henderson, Nev.) got his first goal in Crimison and Gold, heading a feed from junior winger Josh Drack (Chandler, Ariz.) to put the visitors in front. The goal is the 23rd of the three-year career of Judd, who transferred from California Baptist in the offseason. Drack picked up his first assist of the campaign and the eighth of his career that includes seven in his two years at Grand Canyon.

Since Franks joined the staff as an assistant in 2012, Denver has now outscored opponents 80-29 in the opening 30 minutes of matches.

Cal outshot Denver 10-4 in the opening 45 minutes, but Denver’s defense controlled the quality of the chances, limiting the Bears to just two shots on goal in the first half.

Redshirt-junior Will Palmquist (Denver, Colo.) made eighth saves in his eighth career shutout, including denying Taylor Davila from the penalty spot in the 79th minute to keep the Pioneers in front. The cleansheet is the 69th since Franks joined the staff in 2012 (61-0-8).

The Pioneers victory pushed their RPI up to 55th in the country in the early stages of the season.



## NOTES (CONTINUED)

### TOP-10 SINCE 2015

- Denver is 109-36-28 since the start of the 2015 season.
- That record ranks 10th in the country in wins, behind Wake Forest (140), Indiana (131), Clemson (126), Georgetown (122), Stanford (117), New Hampshire (115), Kentucky (113), Washington (112) and Seattle (110) (games entering the 2024 season).
- Of the 16 teams that had at least 100 wins in that span entering the year, Denver has the seventh-fewest losses at 36.

### THE FRANKS FOUNDATION

- Jack and Sheila Weinberg Head Men's Soccer Coach Jamie Franks is in his 10th season as the bench boss and his 13th with the program overall in 2024.
- Franks and his staff were named the 2016 National Coaching Staff of the Year after taking Denver to its first College Cup appearance in program history.
- Franks is 109-36-28 in his time as a head coach, 144-53-36 in his time at Denver overall and 243-80-53 in his time as a player and a coach in college soccer.
- Franks is 6-8-1 in the NCAA Tournament at DU (6-7-0 as HC). As a player and coach, Franks is 22-12-3 in the NAAs.
- In addition to National Coaching Staff of the Year, Franks is a five-time Summit League Coach of the Year (2015-18, 2023).
- Franks was the youngest head coach in Division I soccer when he was hired in 2015, and the second youngest in 2016 when he took the program to the College Cup. .
- Franks led the Pioneers to back-to-back unbeaten regular seasons in his first two years in charge, the first program to go unbeaten in back-to-back regular seasons since Clemson in 1977-78.
- In his first nine seasons, Denver has qualified for the NCAA Tournament eight times and received a bye into the second round three times. Denver has played in the second round six times.
- Prior to the 2023 season, Franks signed a multi-year contract extension to remain Denver's head coach.

### LIMITING CHANCES

- Denver has held opponents to two shots or less 13 times in its DI era.
- The Pioneers have held opponents without a shot on goal 23 times in their Division I history, including three times during the 2023 season.
- Denver held San Diego State and Grand Canyon to just one combined shot on target in the opening weekend of the 2023 campaign, and posted a stretch of 170 minutes without allowing a shot on goal.
- The Pioneers first goal allowed last season came in the second half of Denver's 3-1 upset over No. 11 SMU on Sept. 1, breaking a stretch of 235:19 of shutout soccer to start the season.
- In the Summit Semi, KC broke a DU shutout streak that lasted 565:23.

**DENVER** – The University of Denver men’s soccer team hit three posts late in the second half looking to equalize but fell to No. 6 SMU, 2-1, on Sunday night at Washburne Soccer and Track Stadium in the second round of the 2023 NCAA Men’s Soccer Tournament.

### Significant Stats:

Denver finished the 2023 campaign 12-3-5 with a Summit League regular-season championship, the program’s ninth since joining the league in 2013.

The Pioneers have reached the second round of the NCAA Men’s Soccer Tournament in each of the last three seasons, falling to 7-11-1 in the program’s NCAA Tournament history on Sunday night.

Denver finished 6-3-5 in 2023 against teams that finished in the top 100 in the RPI a year ago and 5-3-4 against teams in this season’s RPI top 100.

Aidan O’Toole closed out his Pioneer career first in career matches played with 87 and second in career starts with 80.

Sam Bassett scored from the penalty spot in the second half, his eighth goal of the season and the 15th of his career. The Summit League Midfielder of the Year improved to 5-for-5 in his career in penalty shots (not including shootouts).

- Bassett’s eight goals are a career high for the junior.
- Bassett pushed his career points total to 43, moving him into a tie with Karsten Hanlin for ninth most in Denver’s Division I history.
- Bassett’s 15 career goals pushed him to eighth in Denver’s Division I history in that category.

### First Half:

3’ SMU got an early chance with a crafty touch around Denver’s defensive midfield, but Niv Berkovitz’s shot was wide of Isaac Nehme’s post and out for a goal kick.

16’ Denver’s first shot of the night came just after the quarter hour mark. Dylan Akau from his right back position played the diagonal run of Holger Olsson. Olsson took a touch to his right but pulled his shot wide of the far post.

18’ Bailey Sparks had a bouncing ball come to him at the top of box, but Jason Belloli wore the shot on his thigh, and the Denver defense cleared it out for a throw.

23’ Sparks earned the breakthrough off a long throw from the SMU Mustangs. The header bounced off the turf and got through the hands of Nehme and into the back of the net.

23’ Bassett looked for the instant response for the Pioneers, but Denver’s first shot on target of the night bounced right in the keeper’s stomach.

33’ Alexander Petraeus had an attempt to double the home side’s advantage, but his shot towards the upper 90 was wide of the far post.

40’ Jose Ortiz doubled the SMU advantage before the intermission, taking a shot from just inside 25 yards and banking it off the post and into the back of the net.

### Second Half:

53’ Oje Ofunrein got on the end of a dangerous Bassett free kick from the right channel, but the Denver striker couldn’t get his right foot on top of the attempt, and it flew over the bar.

68’ Bryce Willoughby bravely attacked a long ball to the far post crossed in from deep down the Denver right. Willoughby beat the keeper to the spot and was taken out by the SMU keeper in a brutal clash of the two bodies, and the referee pointed to the spot. Bassett converted the penalty, sending the keeper the wrong way for his eighth goal of the season.

86’ Ian Smith got in behind the SMU defense and to the end line, but his cross couldn’t find a Denver head, and the bouncing ball was cleared away by SMU.

87’ After scoring his first goal as the game winner in the NCAA First Round on Thursday, Tyler Schommer had the best chance at the Denver equalizer, beating the SMU keeper to a cross from the left but en-route to the empty net, Schommer’s header rattled off the woodwork.

88’ Lukas Fisher played in Denver’s second corner of the night, but the SMU keeper tipped it off the crossbar and kept it in play for the Mustangs to clear.

90’ Ofunrein had the final chance for Denver, getting free in the box for a header, but the glancing attempt hit the right woodwork again, and the Mustangs were able to clear again and hold on to win.

### DENVER AND THE NEW POWER 4

- Jamie Franks signed nine freshmen to the 2024 roster who are joined by four redshirt-freshmen from last year to give the Pioneers 13 players with four years of eligibility remaining.
