NEED TO KNOW

► DePaul opens a two-game homestand with a Saturday afternoon game against Seton Hall. The Blue Demons host Connecticut on Monday to conclude the quick stretch at Wintrust Arena before traveling to Georgetown for a Wednesday night matchup.

► Saturday is the 27th all-time meeting between the two programs and the first this season. Seton Hall holds an 18-8 advantage in the series including two wins last season. The 2018-19 campaign saw DePaul sweep the season series.

► DePaul opened the season on Dec. 23 with a 91-72 win over Western Illinois at Wintrust Arena. Five players scored in double figures while the team shot .590 (36-61) from the field and .500 (10-20) from three-point range. The start of the season was delayed due to COVID-19 protocols.

► DePaul is playing its fourth season at Wintrust Arena in Chicago's South Loop. The award-winning facility features 10,387 seats including 22 suites and 479 premium club seats. The state-of-the-art facility hosted NBA All-Star Weekend festivities in February 2020 and is the home of the WNBA's Chicago Sky.

► Head coach Dave Leitao is in his sixth season of his second stint at DePaul. He led the program from 2002-05 before returning in March 2015.

DEPAUL IN THE NBA

Paul Reed - Philadelphia 76ers

Drafted by the 76ers on Nov. 18... picked in second round (58th overall)... first Blue Demon since 2007 to be selected in the NBA Draft... 54th NBA draft pick for the program since 1947 and the 20th DePaul player to be selected in the first or second round... signed two-way contract with 76ers.

Max Strus - Miami Heat

Played in one game for the Heat (7 pts vs. Milwaukee - Dec. 29)... signed free agent contract with Miami before converting to two-day contract... played last season for the Chicago Bulls on two-way contract before season-ending knee injury... played in two games with the Bulls... averaged 18.2 points, 5.9 rebounds and 3.2 assists in 34.9 minutes per game in 13 games for the Windy City Bulls.

WHY BLUE DEMONS?

In 1900, when the first athletic team to represent DePaul University was organized, the monogram "D" was selected for the uniforms. This originated the nickname "D-men" which evolved into "Demons." The blue, which combines with Demons, signifies loyalty and was chosen in 1901 by a vote of the student body.



Starters: DePaul opens a busy stretch in the schedule of three games in five days with a Saturday afternoon game against Seton Hall. The Blue Demons were originally scheduled to open the week with a Tuesday night game against No. 3/3 Villanova before COVID-19 related issues in the Wildcats' program postponed the matchup. Following Saturday's game, the Blue Demons host Connecticut on Monday evening before traveling to Georgetown for a Wednesday night game.

Saturday's game can be seen on FS1 starting at 1 p.m. with Jeff Levering (play-by-play) and Tim Miles (analyst) handling the broadcast duties. The game can also be seen online at foxsports.com/live and via the FOX Sports app. DePaul's radio tandem of Zach Zaidman (play-by-play) and Dave Corzine (analyst) can be heard on WIND (560 AM) and online on DePaul All-Access at depaulbluedemons.com/live. In-game updates can be followed on Twitter at @DePaulHoops and live stats are available at depaulbluedemons.com.

Seton Hall enters the game at 8-5 overall and 5-2 in the BIG EAST after an 89-53 loss at No. 7/5 Creighton on Wednesday. The Blue Demons are 1-2 overall and 0-2 in the BIG EAST following an 82-61 loss at Connecticut on Dec. 30.

Demon Doings: Notes following DePaul's 82-61 loss at Connecticut on Dec. 30:

- ▶ The loss drops DePaul's record to 1-2 and 0-2 in the BIG EAST... Connecticut is now 4-1 and 1-1 in league play.
- ▶ DePaul entered Wednesday night making 10 three-pointers in each of its first two games... the Blue Demons shot just .235 (4-17) from the behind the arc.
- ▶ Darious Hall recorded his 11th career game in double figures... fourth game of at least 10 points at DePaul... the 14 points match his career high set twice while at Arkansas.
- ▶ Nick Ongenda scored a career high 13 points and grabbed a career high eight rebounds... it also marked his third career game in double figures and second in three games this season.
- ▶ The game was the 12th all-time between programs... Connecticut holds a 11-1 lead in the series... the two teams are scheduled to meet again on Jan. 11 at Wintrust Arena.

Noting the Blue Demons: The men's basketball program is 1,484-1,042 (.588) all-time... the Blue Demons have knocked down at least one three-pointer in 841 straight games... DePaul's last game without a three was over 25 years ago on Feb. 16, 1993 against UAB at Allstate Arena... the current streak started against Notre Dame on Feb. 21, 1993... over the last 10 seasons (since start of 2010-11 season), DePaul is 21-6 against Chicagoland opponents (Chicago State, UIC, Loyola-Chicago, Northern Illinois, Northwestern)... in the last 20 seasons (since the start of 2000-01 season), the record against locals is 35-12... the Blue Demons defeated UIC and Northwestern during the 2019-20 season.

Trendy: The 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games against Western Illinois and Providence marked the first time with consecutive games with at least 10 three-pointers since the 2018-19 season... DePaul made 11 against Chicago State on Dec. 12 and 12 against UIC on Dec. 14... the last time the Blue Demons opened the season with at least 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games was the 2011-12 season... that included 12 against UT-Pan American and 10 against Mississippi Valley State... the Blue Demons made at least 10 three-pointers in two total games during the 2019-20 season... Nick Ongenda has scored in double figures in two of three games after totaling just one game of at least 10 points in one game during freshman season (27 games).

It Could Happen: Charlie Moore (212 assists) needs eight assists to move into 29th on DePaul's all-time assist list... Randy Ramsey (1974-78) is currently 29th with 219 assists... Moore is playing in his 105th career game (34 at California/35 at Kansas/35 at DePaul)... Ray Salnave is playing in his 99th career game (95 at Monmouth/3 at DePaul).

Moore Closed 2019-20 with Milestone: Charlie Moore concluded the shortened 2019-20 campaign by eclipsing the 1,000-point plateau for his collegiate career in what ended up as the final game of the season. His 18 points in the 71-67 win over Xavier on March 11 pushed his career scoring total to 1,013 points. Over the 102 games in his collegiate career, Moore scored 414 points at California (2016-17), 102 points at Kansas (2018-19) and 519 points at DePaul (2019-present) for a total of 1,035 career points.

Freeman-Liberty Started 2020-21 with Milestone: With his eighth point in the first half against Western Illinois, Javon Freeman-Liberty reached the 1,000-point plateau for his career. He scored 992 points in 66 career games over his first two seasons at Valparaiso. The junior enters the Seton Hall game with 1,033 points.

GAME FOUR VS. SETON HALL

Season-Opening Notes: DePaul is 85-13 all-time in the first game of the season... Wednesday's win over Western Illinois started the 98th recognized season of DePaul basketball (since 1923-24)... DePaul competed in basketball prior to the 1923-24 season, but season records and results are incomplete... DePaul has won 13 of its last 14 season openers.

Home Openers: The Blue Demons are 90-8 all-time in the first home game of the season... the Blue Demons have won 14 of the last 15 home openers and posted victories in 53 of the last 56 first games on their home floor... at Wintrust Arena, DePaul is 3-1 in the first game of the season.

Late Starts: The Dec. 23 date for the first game of the season was the latest start since the 1979-80 beginning of the season on Dec. 5. That 90-77 win over Wisconsin at Alumni Hall marked Dick Vitale's debut as a college basketball analyst on ESPN.

The last time DePaul opened the season in December was on Dec. 1, 1992 when the Blue Demons defeated Chicago State, 103-68, at Alumni Hall.

Non-Conference Notebook: Over the last two-plus seasons, the Blue Demons are 25-6 against non-BIG EAST opponents... a season ago, DePaul's 12-1 non-conference record was the best regular-season mark since DePaul joined the Great Midwest Conference... prior to the 1991-92 season, the Blue Demons were an independent before competing in the Great Midwest (1991-95), Conference USA (1995-05) and now the BIG EAST since the 2005-06 season... DePaul's 9-0 record to begin the 2019-20 season was one of eight streaks of at least nine consecutive wins to open a season... it was the longest streak since the 1986-87 squad started with a 16-0 record... the 1979-80 team won its first 25 games for the longest season-opening streak in program history.

Moore Named Preseason First Team All-BIG EAST: DePaul guard Charlie Moore was selected as a first team preseason All-BIG EAST honoree as the league kicked off the 2020-21 season with a virtual media day in November. The 11 head coaches in the BIG EAST voted on the preseason poll and individual honors.

In addition to the preseason all-conference teams, the league's coaches ranked the teams with DePaul coming in at No. 10. Villanova garnered nine of 11 first-place votes as the league preseason favorite ahead of Creighton. The Bluejays picked up two first-place votes and were followed by Providence in third and Connecticut in fourth place. Seton Hall was picked for fifth followed by Marquette and Xavier. Butler was slotted in eighth place ahead of St. John's, DePaul and Georgetown.

Moore is the BIG EAST's second leading returning scorer after he averaged 15.5 points last season, which ranked eighth in the conference. Playing in his first season for the Blue Demons, the Chicago

Jared Rhoden adds a scoring average of 15.4 with a team-high 7.2 rebounds per game... head coach Kevin Willard is in his 11th season leading the Pirates... DePaul head coach Dave Leitao is 3-10 all-time against Seton Hall.

native ranked first in the league in assists with a 6.1 mark and eighth in steals with a 1.5 average. He was only BIG EAST player to be among the league's top 10 in all three categories.

Moore was on pace to become the second player in program history with at least 500 points and 200 assists in a season before cancellation of BIG EAST Tournament. He finished the 2019-20 season with 497 points and 196 assists. Only Rod Strickland has reached those plateaus with 521 points and 202 assists in 26 games during the 1987-88 season.

Creighton's Marcus Zegarowski was named the BIG EAST Preseason Player of the Year while Marquette's Dawson Garcia was selected as the Preseason Freshman of the Year. The preseason first team All-BIG EAST selections included Moore along with Providence's David Duke, Sandro Mamukelashvili from Seton Hall and the Villanova tandem of Collin Gillespie and Jeremiah Robinson-Earl.

The second team has six members due to a tie in the voting and consists of Butler's Bryce Nze, Connecticut's James Bouknight, Mitch Ballock from Creighton, Nate Watson from Providence, Villanova's Justin Moore and Xavier's Paul Scruggs. D.J. Carton from Marquette and Seton Hall's

Bryce Aiken picked up honorable mention honors.

Edwards Arrives Early: After signing a National Letter of Intent in November, Keon Edwards joined the program for the 2020-21 season after enrolling at DePaul for Winter Quarter. Edwards is a 6-7 forward that played last season at Hillcrest Prep in Phoenix.

When he signed in November, Edwards was a consensus top 100 recruit and four-star prospect. The Pasadena, Texas native was ranked No. 41 by ESPN, No. 75 by 247Sports and No. 80 by Rivals. He was slotted as the eighth-best small forward by ESPN, ranked No. 20 at the position by Rivals and No. 21 by 247Sports.

Edwards averaged 14.3 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 2.4 steals and 1.9 blocks in 18 games last season at Hillcrest Prep. He's also participated in the USA Basketball program that included the 2019 USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team October minicamp and the 2019 USA Basketball Men's Junior National Team July minicamp.

DAVE LEITAO

HEAD COACH // 9TH SEASON AT DEPAUL

Dave Leitao was named DePaul's head coach on March 29, 2015 and returned to Chicago following a very successful three-year stint with the Blue Demons from 2002-05. Leitao's three-year run saw three postseason appearances that included a 2004 Conference USA

title and trip to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

The New Bedford, Mass., native left DePaul following the 2004-05 season and accepted the head coach position at Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he made three postseason appearances in four seasons and was the 2007 ACC Coach of the Year.

In 14-plus career seasons as a collegiate head coach, Leitao holds a record of 208-229. Of the 14 seasons as a head coach, he has led teams to seven postseason tournaments including advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament at both DePaul (2004) and Virginia (2007). In his ninth season at DePaul, Leitao holds a record of 123-134.

Upward momentum has continued in his second stint at DePaul as the Blue Demons produced 19 victories in 2018-19. The 19 wins and appearance in the College Basketball Invitational marked the most wins and first postseason appearance for the Blue Demons since the 2006-07 season. In addition to the team success, BIG EAST individual honors were awarded to Paul Reed as the league's Most Improved Player and Max Strus as a second team All-BIG EAST honoree.

The 2019-20 season opened with a 9-0 start before the Blue Demons won 12 of 13 non-conference games for the best non-conference record since joining the Great Midwest Conference in 1991. Overall, the Blue Demons recorded six wins against teams ranked as a Quad 1 opponent in the NET during the season. Those six victories put DePaul on a list of just 23 programs in the nation to record at least six Q1 wins during the 2019-20 season. The Blue Demons were one of six BIG EAST programs on the 23-team list while the league was the top-ranked conference in the country.

Most recently, Leitao was an assistant coach at Missouri and Tulsa under Frank Haith. Following the 2014-15 season, Leitao was ranked No. 20 in the Basketball Times list of the top 50 assistant coaches in the nation.

Before making the first move to DePaul in 2002, Leitao spent six seasons as the associate head coach at Connecticut. During those six campaigns, the Huskies experienced unprecedented success compiling a 156-51 (.754) record highlighted by capturing the 1999 NCAA Championship. He also helped guide the Huskies to three other appearances in the NCAA Tournament, reaching the Elite Eight twice and the second round once. Connecticut also reached the NIT semifinals and NIT second round in that time span.

Leitao got Connecticut's run to the 1999 NCAA title off on the right foot when he filled in for head coach Jim Calhoun, who had taken ill prior to the game, in the 91-66 opening round win over Texas-San Antonio.

Leitao spent two seasons as the head coach at his alma mater, Northeastern. In his first year (1994-95), he directed the Huskies to a record of 18-11, which was the biggest one-season turnaround in the nation, and into the North Atlantic Conference Tournament Championship game.

Leitao graduated from Northeastern in 1983 with BS degree in Business Administration. He and his wife Joyce are the proud parents of three sons, David III, Reese and Tyson. David played for the Blue Demons while Reese is a sophomore tight end at Texas who has played tight end and on the defensive line for the Longhorns. Tyson is a senior at Chicago's Whitney Young High School.
