STORYLINES

- The DePaul and Northwestern campuses are located just over 11 miles apart.
- DePaul snapped a five-game skid, picking up a necessary win against Louisville last Saturday.
- The win marked DePaul's second-consecutive win in the series against Louisville.
- The Blue Demons rank 36th nationally in three-point percentage, shooting 38.5 as a team.
- Chico Carter Jr. is averaging 14.2 points and 6.4 assists per game across DePaul's last five
 contests
- Carter Jr. was named to the BIG EAST
 Weekly Honor Roll on Monday, Dec. 10 after
 averaging 17.5 points and six assists across
 DePaul's two games last week while shooting
 67.5 percent from the floor.
- Carter Jr. and Jeremiah Oden both rank top-5 in the BIG EAST in minutes played.
- DePaul has had a different leading scorer in four of the team's nine games played.
- DePaul started the season 0-2 for the first time since 2006-07.
- The '06-07 squad went on to a 20-14 record and appearance in the NIT.
- Elijah Fisher had a standout game off the bench for DePaul against Long Beach State with a career-best 25 points.
- His 25 points are the most by a DePaul player off the bench since Cleveland Melvin scored

- 25 against Texas Tech, Nov. 25, 2011. Originally in the Class of 2023, Fisher
- reclassified and played the 2022-23 season at Texas Tech.
- The Blue Demons have eight total newcomers, including five Division 1 transfers
- Chico Carter Jr. entered the 2023-24 season with the second highest career three-point percentage in Division 1 basketball, behind New Orleans' Jordan Johnson.
- This marks the second-straight season Tony Stubblefield has been tasked with replacing his leading scorer from a year ago following the graduation of Umoja Gibson (2022) and Javon Freeman-Liberty (2021).
- DePaul has a total of three games this season against teams ranked in the preseason AP Top 25 poll.

- The award recognizes Northwestern's Waldo Fisher, a former men's basketball coach and longtime administrator, and Frank McGrath from DePaul, a former assistant coach under Ray Meyer and longtime DePaul administrator.
- The award originated with longtime Chicago broadcaster, Les Grobstein, and Hall of Fame Coaches Ray Meyer and Tex Winter.

- A Northwestern player has won the award of a total of 18 times, with a DePaul player winning 14 times
- 1978 and 1975 both feature Co-MVPs with winners from both teams.

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN

- Northwestern is coming off a loss to fellow Chicago school, Chicago State, Wednesday evening.
- Despite shooting 47.1 percent from threepoint rane, the Wildcats fell 75-73 at home against Chicago State.
- Prior to Wednesday, Northwestern was 7-1, including a win against then-No. 1 Purdue on Dec. 1.
- The Wildcats currently rank third nationally in fewest turnovers per game (8.6) and fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.03).
- Boo Buie ranks 42nd nationally with 5.1 assists per game, whil also scoring 18.9 points, which ranks 51st nationally.

- The Blue Demons have won five of their last seven meetings against Chicago schools.
- DePaul faced both Northwestern and Loyola-Chicago schools on the road in the same season for the first time since 1987.

SHARP SHOOTERS

- A season ago, DePaul recorded 273 threepointers on the season, the most in school history.
- Despite the loss of Umoja Gibson and Javan Johnson to graduation, DePaul reloaded with the addition of four players who have all shot over 30 percent in their career (Chico Carter Jr., Jaden Henley, Jeremiah Oden and Keyondre Young).
- The new additions join the likes of Jalen Terry, K.T. Raimey and Da'Sean Nelson - all of whom shot above 30 percent from three a year ago.
- Carter Jr. is a career 44.1 percent three-point shooter, including 47.6 percent across 25 games at South Carolina last season.

- Carter Jr.'s 44.1 three-point percentage leads all active Division 1 players, entering Saturday's game.
- As a team, DePaul ranks 36th nationally with a 38.5 three-point percentage this season.

 The Blue Demons will go up against Northwestern who ranks 26th this season, allowing opponents to shoot 34.9 percent from three against them.

RIM PROTECTORS

- After losing one of the best blocking duos in school history last season (Nick Ongenda and Yor Anei), many expected DePaul's defensive block numbers to drop this season.
- However, DePaul is among the nation's leaders, ranking 81st nationally in blocks per game and fourth in the BIG EAST
- The Blue Demon freshman, Churchill Abass, has recorded 10 blocks this season. All of which have come in three of his eight games played.
- DePaul has played 12 total players this season, 10 of whom have recorded at least one block
- Against South Dakota, DePaul recorded nine blocks which rank as the fourth-most all-time inside Wintrust Arena.
- Abass' four blocks against South Dakota are the most by a DePaul freshman in a singlegame since Nick Ongenda against Xavier Feb. 25, 2020.

LENGTHY GUARDS

- DePaul's guards have an average height of 6'3".
- The Blue Demons guards are on average one inch taller than the guard lineup a season ago.
- DePaul's overall average height is 77.3 inches, up from 77.1 in 2021-22.
- Keyondre Young and Jaden Henley are the Blue Demons tallest guards, listed at 6-9 and 6-7, respectively.
- DePaul has just three players listed under 6-4.

PRIME MINISTER

- DePaul has seen the emergence of true freshman, Churchill Abass.
- Abass joined DePaul over the summer from NBA Africa Academy
- The Nigeria native joined the NBA Academy Africa in Dec. 2022, having played very little organized basketball prior.

COACH STUBBS ON ABASS

Churchill has a lot of potential. He's just now been in a situation where he is getting acclimated and playing. I think the more and more that he gets out there, the better he will be. He is going to get better and better. He is strong, his physicality, his athleticism.

- DePaul's season opener was the first-time Abass played in an arena. He saw just three minutes in the opener.
- Abass scored his first collegiate points in the win against South Dakota, and piled up a total of eight in the first half.
- He ended the game with eight points, seven boards and four blocks.

PORTAL PLAYING

- DePaul had plenty of action in the transfer portal, prior to the 2023-24 season.
- The Blue Demons welcome a total of eight newcomers, including five Division 1 transfers.
- DePaul added former five-star recruit, Elijah Fisher, who came to Lincoln Park from Texas

X'S AND O'S

- DePaul's newcomers didn't end in the transfer portal as head coach Tony Stubblefield added two former Division I head coaches to his bench.
- Tony Harvey joined DePaul as an assistant coach and Matt Brady as special assistant to the head coach.
- Harvey was the head coach at Texas Southern from 2008-12 where he led the Tigers to the 2010 SWAC Championship game and the program's first winning season in seven years.
- Harvey also helped lead a successful program as a part of Quin Snyder's staff at Mizzou from 1999-04 as associate head coach.
- While at Mizzou, Harvey brought in six-recruiting classes that were ranked in the top-10 nationally and went to four-consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including the 2002 Elite Eight.
- Brady has 12 years of head coaching experience combined between Marist and James Madison, including five 20-win seasons and eight with 18 or more victories.
- He won two conference championships with JMU and led the Dukes to the second round of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.
- Brady was also previously at Maryland where he helped the Terps to the 2020 Big Ten Championship title and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

AT THE POINT

- Jalen Terry missed the first eight games of the season for DePaul with an ankle injury before returning against Louisville.
- Caleb Murphy had initially taken the lead at point for DePaul, before missing two of the last three games with an injury.
- Chico Carter Jr., K.T. Raimey and Jaden Henley have all also seen time at the point.
- Carter Jr. has become DePaul's main option at the point, excelling in playing on the ball for the first time in his career.
- Carter Jr. is averaging 4.8 assists per game which ranks 64th nationally and sixth among all players in the BIG EAST.
- Carter Jr. playing on the ball has not come at the expense of his scoring prowess, averaging 14.3 points per game and shooting 50.0 percent

- on the season.
- Carter Jr. recorded 10 assists against Northern Illinois, the most to the day by a DePaul player since Umoja Gibson against Texas A&M (11/25/22).

SCARY TERRY

- DePaul welcomed Jalen Terry back into the lineup last week against Louisville, and he made an immediate impact despite only playing 14 minutes.
- Terry recorded a steal within his first minute of checking in against the Cardinals.
- Terry has struggled with injuries over the last two seasons with the Blue Demons, missing a total of 18 games.
- Terry's impact on the Blue Demons is noticeable as DePaul is 10-15 (.400) with Terry in the lineup and 2-16 (.111) without him over the last two seasons.

BLUE DEMONS PROS

- DePaul had three players on NBA Opening Day rosters, with an additional six currently active in the G League.
- Following outstanding NBA Playoff runs last season, both Paul Reed and Max Strus signed new contracts leading into the 2023-24 season.
- Reed signed a new contract with the Philadelphia 76ers for a 3-year deal.
- Strus made the move to the Cleveland Cavaliers on a 4-year, \$62 million deal.
- Additionally, Javon Freeman-Liberty signed a deal with the Toronto Raptors following an outstanding Summer League run with the Windy City Bulls.

TONY STUBBLEFIELD

COACH

4TH SEASON OVERALL // 29-57 (.367) **3RD SEASON AT DEPAUL // 27-46 (.407)**

Relentless energy and enthusiasm have been evident since Tony Stubblefield was named head coach of the men's basketball program in April 2021. He is the 15th head coach in DePaul history.

Stubblefield made his DePaul debut with a 97-72 win over Coppin State on Nov. 10 at Wintrust Arena and the 97 points were just a view into the style of play that Stubblefield is looking to establish in the South Loop. Overall, the Blue Demons scored at least 84 points in nine games that includes six contests of 90 or more points in a game.

The 15 wins during the 2021-22 campaign were the most by a first-year DePaul head coach since the 2002-03 season. The Blue Demons closed the regular season by winning three of their final four games that included victories over Georgetown, St. John's and Marquette. Stubblefield and the Blue Demons opened the season with a 9-1 record that marked the best start for a first-year head coach at DePaul since Rey Meyer went 13-1 to being the 1942-43 campaign.

Stubblefield came to DePaul after spending the last 11 seasons at Oregon and has over two decades of experience in college basketball and is regarded as one of the nation's top recruiters. He helped the Ducks to 10 postseason appearances that included eight NCAA Tournament berths. The eight NCAA berths saw Oregon reach the Final Four once and Elite Eight once along with three other Sweet 16 appearances. Overall, the Ducks added four regular-season conference championships and three conference tournament championships to the trophy case in Stubbfield's 11 seasons.

In addition to the team success, Stubblefield assisted head coach Dana Altman in building the program through multiple nationally ranked recruiting classes. He helped Oregon assemble five recruiting classes that were ranked among the top 12 nationally (2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021). Included in those classes were future NBA players Troy Brown Jr. and Louis King and NBA Draft choices Brown Jr., Bol Bol and Payton Pritchard.

Prior to Oregon, Stubblefield spent four years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator in the BIG EAST Conference at the University of Cincinnati. He also was on the staffs at New Mexico State (2000-06), UT-Arlington (1996-00), UT-San Antonio (1995-96) and at his alma mater Nebraska-Omaha (1992-95).

Before joining the staff at Cincinnati, Stubblefield served as assistant coach at New Mexico State for six seasons, one of which he served as interim head coach. Prior to the start of the 2004-05 season, he was elevated to interim head coach when Lou Henson's health forced him to miss the season.

As recruiting coordinator for the Aggies, Stubblefield attracted three national Top-100 rated players, including one McDonald's All-American, a junior college all-American, and first-team all-state high school players from six different states.

Prior to his tenure at New Mexico State, Stubblefield was the lead assistant and recruiting coordinator at the UT-Arlington for four seasons. He successfully recruited two Top-10 prospects from the state of Texas along with first-team all-region junior college players from Texas, Louisiana, Alabama, and Mississippi.

Stubblefield began his coaching career as a student assistant for two seasons at the University of Nebraska at Omaha, his alma mater, where he completed his undergraduate degree in 1995.

Stubblefield, who transferred to UNO following two years at Clinton (Iowa) Community College, earned two letters playing guard at Nebraska-Omaha where he was the team captain his senior season.

Upon graduation from UNO, he became an assistant coach at the UT-San Antonio for the 1995-96 season, where he was responsible for coaching the guards and was the program's top recruiter.

After growing up in Clinton, Iowa, Stubblefield was one of the top players in the state of Colorado. He was the runner-up for state Player of the Year honors at Bloomfield (Colo.) High School his senior season, while picking up first-team all-state and Boulder County Player of the Year accolades.
