OUICK HITS

- The Titans opened their 43rd season as a program on Tuesday, hosting old Horizon League foe Loyola and falling to the Ramblers, 89-60, from Calihan Hall in Detroit, Senior Zoev Oatis led Detroit Mercy in scoring with 17 points, while Titan newcomer Maxine Moore added nine boards.
- Detroit Mercy is in its fifth season under head coach Bernard Scott and has two top-four finishes in the Horizon League during his tenure. The Titans placed ninth in the HL last season and has eight new faces in the program in 2019-20, five freshmen and three Division I transfers (Aly Reiff - Xavier, Maxine Moore - Western Michigan, Nicole Johanson - Valparaiso), who were each granted waivers to play this season by the NCAA.
- Detroit Mercy opens the season with six of eight games away from Calihan Hall, which includes a Thanksgiving weekend trip to Las Vegas for the South Point Shootout on Nov. 29-30. The Titans open a four-game road trip at MSU on Friday.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

The Spartans won in their season opener Tuesday night at home, topping Eastern Michigan, 85-50, from the Breslin Center. MSU used a big second half, scoring 54 points after the halftime break in the victory over the Eagles. Michigan State reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament a season ago, topping Central Michigan in an 88-87 thriller in the opening round before falling to the eventual champion, Notre Dame.

Four Spartans were in double figures in the opener, led by Nia Clouden, who hit six 3-pointers and had 23 points. Alyza Winston added 14 points, while Taryn McCutcheon and Tory Ozment each had 10 points. Shay Colley led the team with eight rebounds. The Spartans had 17 steals in the contest, four by Clouden.

SERIES HISTORY

The Titans are 7-21 all-time against Michigan State in the series history. Detroit Mercy is 1-15 in East Lansing and last earned a victory over the Spartans in 1994, picking up a 75-70 win.

The two teams have met twice in head coach Bernard Scott's tenure and once in East Lansing, with #24/22-MSU earning an 81-42 victory in his first season at the helm in 2015-16.

ACCOLADES & ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Bernard Scott has led the Titans to two winning campaigns in four seasons as head coach and an appearance in the title game of the 2017 Horizon League Championship. He has 27 Horizon League victories across four seasons at the helm of Detroit Mercy.
- The Titans went 9-0 at home in 2016-17 in Horizon League contests, which included a win over #21-ranked Green Bay. The Titans went 10-2 overall at Calihan Hall in 2016-17 and have 19 victories at home across his three seasons as head coach.
- In the 2017 HL Championship, the Titans earned victories over sixth-seeded Cleveland State, before topping No. 2 seed Wright State in the semifinals. In the title game, Detroit Mercy fell to Green Bay, 64-52.
- In coach Scott's first season, the Titans recorded a schoolrecord mark of 7-2 on the road in league play, playing the season primarily with eight players.
- Detroit Mercy has finished as one of the top four teams in the league in his first two seasons -- placing fourth in his first season and third place in 2016-17.
- The Titans broke the school-record for 3-pointers made in a season in each of coach Scott's first two seasons (259 in 2016-17; 234 in 2015-16). Detroit Mercy has 702 triples across three seasons under Scott's direction, averaging 7.6 treys per game.
- The Titans set a new school record for defensive boards (29.4 per game) in 2016-17, ranking No. 9 in the NCAA.
- Under Scott's coaching, Rosanna Reynolds was a two-time First Team All-League player and became just the second

- player in school history to earn three All-League laurels in her Titan career. Reynolds, who broke the career mark in assists and finished No. 3 all-time in scoring with 1,745 points, signed a professional contract in Scotland, where she played the 2017-18 season.
- Brianne Cohen was All-Horizon League in 2016-17 and the year before was the Sixth Player of the Year in the conference. Cohen had the largest scoring jump from one year to the next in school history (12.1 ppg).
- The Titans have also got it done in the classroom and the community during coach Scott's tenure, sporting a 3.0 GPA or better in five semesters. Overall, the squad had a GPA of 3.34 in 2017-18.
- Detroit Mercy nearly set an attendance record in 2016-17, totaling 10,914 fans in 12 home games for an average of 909 fans a game. It was the second-best mark all time and best since the 1985-86 season.
- The Titans jumped more than 100 RPI spots in coach Scott's first season (257-147) and in the 2016-17 campaign finished the season with an RPI of 142.
- Scott was named the 11th head coach of Titan women's basketball on May 5, 2015. He earned his first victory vs. Niagara on Nov. 29, 2015.
- Prior to joining the Titans for his first head coaching gig, Scott spent 15 years as an assistant coach at various schools. He started his career at his alma mater Toledo (2001-05), and has also coached at Dayton (2005-07), Arizona (2007-08), Youngstown State (2008-10) and Cleveland State (2010-15).
- Scott has two daughters, Lily and Chloe.

TITAN NEWS & NOTES

Detroit Mercy enters its 43rd season of women's basketball and fifth under head coach Bernard Scott. The Titans are a young team with just two seniors and three upperclassmen overall and features eight newcomers --- five freshmen and three transfers.

Last Time Out

Detroit Mercy opened the 2019-20 season Tuesday, dropping an 89-60 game against visiting Loyola in a battle of Jesuit programs. It was the home opener as well from Calihan Hall. Senior wing Zoey Oatis had a team-high 17 points for the Titans and every single player that played for the red, white and blue scored.

Five freshmen made their collegiate debuts in the contest and eight players overall made their first Titan appearances. Freshman guard Markyia McCormick led all newcomers with eight points, while transfer forward Maxine Moore had a team-high nine boards. McCormick and freshman guard Annika Corcoran each had three assists and freshman forward Bridgid Fox added six points and two steals for the Titans.

The red, white and blue had eight steals in the game and had just 11 turnovers.

Strong Debuts

Eight Titans made their debuts in Tuesday's opener -- five freshmen and three transfers. All eight scored in their debuts. Freshman guard Markyia McCormick had the most points for a freshmen in their first collegiate game as a Titan since Darianne Seward scored 19 points at Michigan in her freshman season in 2014-15. Junior guard Aly Reiff, a transfer from Xavier, had seven points and three steals, sinking her only shot from deep, in her first Titan apperance. Maxine Moore, a sophomore transfer from Western Michigan, pulled down a teamhigh nine boards in her debut, starting for the Titans.

Freshman forward Bridgid Fox had six points and two steals in her first collegiate action. Freshmen guards Sylare Starks and Annika Corcoran each started for the red, white and blue in their first collegiate games with Starks scoring three points and Corcoran dishing out three assists against no turnovers for the Titans.

Freshman guard Abbie McDowell had three points in her first college minutes and redshirt sophomore forward Nicole Johanson had four rebounds for the Titans in her Titan debut after transferring in from Valparaiso.

Zoey Enters Senior Year

Senior wing Zoey Oatis returns for her fourth season in the red, white and blue and made her prescence known last season as one of the top defensive players in the Horizon League. She led Detroit Mercy with 49 steals, ranking second with 18 blocks and was one of four players in the HL to finish in the top-15 in both steals (4th, 1.8) and blocks (14th, 0.7). She also led the squad with 56 offensive rebounds and was second in scoring at 8.1 points per game. She was the team's Defensive Player of the Year.

Oatis, a Detroit native, tallied 14 games of multiple steals in 2018-19 and five games of four or more thefts. One of her best games of the season came in a 16-point, 13-rebound and six-steal effort in a road win at UIC. She scored in double figures a team-best 11 times, including 15 or more points five times.

Trio of Transfers

Three Division I transfers joined the Titans prior to the 2019-20 campaign in local product Maxine Moore (Southfield, Mich. / Detroit Country Day), who transferred in after one season at Western Michigan, as well as junior guard/foward Aly Reiff (Xavier) and 6-foot-5

forward Nicole Johanson (Valparaiso). All three players were granted waivers by the NCAA to play immediately in the 2019-20 season.

Moore won three Class B state championships in high school with Detroit Country Day and played in 29 of 30 games with WMU during her freshman season and was named the team's Sixth Player of the Year following the season. She averaged 4.1 points and 2.1 rebounds, shooting 44.1 percent from the field.

Reiff, a native of South Whitley, Ind., played two seasons at Xavier, playing in 57 games total and all but one game a season ago. The junior averaged 2.3 points and 1.5 rebounds in 13.7 minutes per game as a sophomore for the Musketeers, sinking 37.8 percent of her 3-point shots.

Johanson, a redshirt sophomore, enters her third season of college basketball and saw time in three games with Valparaiso last season under a new coaching staff. She was a 1,000-point scorer at Herscher High School in Illinois, where she led them to a 25-2 mark as a senior.

Freshmen Five

The Titans feature five new freshmen from four different states for the 2019-20. The five hail from Michigan, Ohio, Indiana and Pennsylvania and all are set to see their first playing action this season.

Guards Annika Corcoran (Chardon, Ohio), Markyia McCormick (Pickerington, Ohio), Abbie McDowell (Tecumseh, Mich.) and Sylare Starks (Fort Wayne, Ind.) are joined by forward Bridgid Fox (Altoona, Pa.).

Corcoran was named the North Coast League Offensive Player of the Year as a senior for Gilmour Academy and was Division II All-Ohio First Team. McCormick was First Team All-Conference as a junior, averaging 14.8 points per game. McDowell was two-time Division 2 All-State Honorable Mention and four-time All-Conference for Tecumseh High School in Michigan. Starks was a two-time Second Team Indiana All-State honoree and Honorable Mention Indiana Basketball Coaches Association All-State selection as a senior for Homestead HS in Fort Wayne. Fox averaged double-doubles as a junior and senior for Altoona Area HS in Pennsylvania and was a two-sport athlete, also playing volleyball.

Titan Returners

A trio of Titans return for their second seasons in the red, white and blue in guards Jess Bicknell and Jiera Shears and forward Alex Burr. Bicknell led all Titans in scoring during league contests as a freshman, scoring at a 8.2 points per game clip in 17 HL games. Bicknell finished seventh among HL freshmen in scoring at 7.6 ppg and scored in double figures seven times.

Burr started the final seven games of her freshman campaign and was named Most Improved after the season. She averaged 2.7 points and 1.9 boards and shot 49-percent, while blocking 15 shots in 2018-19. She averaged 6.4 points over final nine games of the season and had 14 games of multiple rebounds.

Shears played in 27 games and finished at 4.6 points per game, while also sinking 77-percent of her free-throw shots. She finished second on the team with 19 made 3-pointers and averaged 7.2 points per game across the final 10 games of the season.

Defensive Front

The Titans finished the 2018-19 campaign fourth in the Horizon League in steals with 232, which was the most since the 2010-11 season, when Detroit Mercy had 236 thefts. Zoey Oatis was fourth in the Horizon League in steals per game (1.8), finishing with a career-best 49 steals. The red, white and blue finished with 10 or more steals in a contest 10 different times in 2018-19. The Titans also held opponents under 60 points 10 times last season.


