## GAME STORYLINES

- THE TITANS OPEN THEIR HOME SLATE TUESDAY EVENING, HOST MID-AMERICAN CONFERENCE FOE KENT STATE FROM CALIHAN HALL. DETROIT MERCY IS COMING OFF A PAIR OF STRONG PERFORMANCES, NEARLY UPSETTING #8-MICHIGAN STATE IN EAST LANSING IN ITS SEASON OPENER ON FRIDAY AND MOST RECENTLY DROPPING A 78-70 CONTEST AT NOTRE DAME ON SUNDAY. IT'S THE THIRD GAME IN THE PAST FIVE GAMES FOR THE RED, WHITE AND BLUE.
- JUNIOR GUARD ANTOINE DAVIS SCORED A GAME-HIGH 24 POINTS AT MICHIGAN STATE, WHILE NEWCOMER MATT JOHNSON ADDED 20 POINTS, HITTING FOUR 3-POINTERS IN HIS TITAN DEBUT. MARQUELL FRASER ADDED 11 POINTS AND 12 REBOUNDS, WHILE BUL KUOL HAD 12 POINTS. KUOL LED DETROIT MERCY IN SCORING AT NOTRE DAME, TOTALING 18 POINTS AND SIX REBOUNDS.
- WITH HIS TWO 3-POINTERS AT NOTRE DAME, DAVIS MOVED INTO A TIE-FOR-SECOND IN SCHOOL HISTORY WITH 235 TRIPLES, TIED WITH FORMER TITAN DESMOND FERGUSON. HE ALSO HAS 1,551 CAREER POINTS, WHICH IS 13TH IN SCHOOL HISTORY JUST 27 POINTS BEHIND BILL EBBEN.
- THE TITANS ARE 180-121 ALL-TIME AGAINST MID-AMERICAN CONFERENCE FOES AND ARE LOOKING TO BREAK AN EIGHT-GAME LOSING SKID AGAINST THE MAC. IT'S THE SEVENTH CAREER MEETING BETWEEN THE TITANS AND KENT STATE. KSU LEADS THE OVERALL SERIES, 4-2.
