## Red Storm Open Season Against Toros

**TONIGHT:** Dixie State College of Utah opens the 2009-2010 Basketball Season tonight hosting the Toros of Cal State University, Dominguez Hills. Tip is scheduled for 7:30pm inside the Burns Arena. This will mark the first D-II meeting between the schools and the first of two games scheduled this year.

**THE RECORDS:** The Red Storm are playing their first regular season game after winning two of three games in preseason exhibitions.. CSU Dominguez Hills (0-1) dropped their season opener Tuesday night to Grand Canyon at home 67-57.

**BROADCAST INFORMATION:** Dixie State College basketball games, both home and away, can be heard live on KXDS 91.3 FM and Network1Sports.com with the voice of the Red Storm, John Potter. Home games can be seen live online at B2LiveTV.com and on tape delay on DTV. All access video passes for Dixie State can be purchased on the B2 Networks site.

**RED STORM WATCH:** Dixie State College is trying to build off the most successful season since transitioning from a junior college to Division-II institution. DSC finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pacific West Conference last season with an overall record of 16-11, 8-4 in the league. The Storm were denied a bid to the NCAA Tournament in their first year of eligibility. The club returns a pair of starters – Andy Palmer and Nick Howard. Palmer was a second-team all-league selection last year and was the only DSC hoopster on this year's Pac West Preseason All-Conference Team. Added to the team are two other returning players (Tom Whitehead and Kevin Lindquist), four junior college transfers, one returning redshirt freshman and four true-freshmen. Jon Judkins, the Pac West Coach of the Year in 2008-09, returns to the bench for a fifth season. Judkins is 61-51 over his first four years and guided the Storm to their highest conference finish a year ago.

### STORM FAST BREAK TIDBITS:

- Dixie State is 2-2 in season openers under Coach Judkins. Last year, the Storm lost to Western Oregon 79-71. The last season opening win was on Nov. 4, 2005 in a 100-54 victory over the CEU All-Stars.
- DSC protected their home court last year very well. In 13 games inside the Burns Arena, Dixie State was 11-2. The blemishes were against BYU-Hawaii (77-92) and Fort Lewis (78-90).
- Career Scoring Ranks: #8 Andy Palmer (237; 25 points behind #7 Johnny Little), #9 Kevin Linquist (222), #10 Tom Whitehead (215)

**SCOUTING CSU-DOMINGUEZ HILLS:** Cal State Dominguez Hills is coming off a season in which they made the D-II Tournament with a 22-8 mark and a conference-best 15-5 in the CCAA. The Toros lost in the First Round of the tournament to BYU-Hawaii 84-71 in Laie, HI. Including last year, CSUDH has made four appearances in the D-II tourney - their last appearance before that was in 1989. They enter this season projected to finish fourth in the CCAA according to the preseason coaches' poll. The team returns two starters – senior guards Jamel Ward and Tim McGrath. Head coach Damaine Powell is in his sixth season at the helm of the Toro program. He has compiled a 69-70 record, one regular-season conference championship and one trip to the D-II dance.

## HEAD COACH – JON JUDKINS



Jon Judkins enters year number five at the helm of the Dixie State Red Storm Men's Basketball program. A former Dixie hoopster himself, he previously spent 12 seasons as the head coach of the men's basketball team at Snow College in Ephraim, Utah.

In the past four years at Dixie State, Judkins has compiled a 61-51 record and a second place finish last season in the Pacific West Conference. He was honored as the Pac West Coach of the Year in 2009.

Judkins red-shirted for the DSC Rebels during the 1982-83 season and played in 1983-84, just one year prior to the program winning its first national championship in 1985. The program has since gone on to win a second national championship in 2002. Coach Judkins continues that rich basketball tradition while building the team's reputation in Division-II.

Over the course of his 12 years at the helm of the Snow College Badgers, Coach Judkins has compiled an overall record of 284-128. Within the Scenic West Athletic Conference (SWAC), he has posted a 147-91 record. He first began coaching at Snow College as an assistant in 1988 after wrapping up his final three years of collegiate eligibility at Utah State University. In his first year coaching at Snow, Judkins was an assistant to Larry Andersen. The next three seasons he worked with Elliott Anderson before taking over the Badger's basketball program at the top of the 1992-93 season.

Since that time, Judkins has emerged as one of the top junior college coaches in the nation. He led his teams to back-to-back SWAC Championships and the Coaches Coach of the Year in 98-99 and 99-2000.

While a player at Utah State, Judkins became the first Aggie to record a triple-double in a game. During the 1987-88 season he helped the Aggies win their conference tournament and a bid to the NCAA Tournament.

Judkins is originally from Salt Lake City, Utah. He is married to the former Lanette Gregory, also a former Dixie student. Together they have four children, Jaelle, Janessa, and twins Justin and Jillian.

He graduated from USU with a bachelor's degree in physical education. In between his years at USU and Dixie, Judkins served an LDS mission to Ohio.

## RED STORM ON THE RADIO

The 2009-10 season is Dixie State College's first with the Dick Nourse Center for Media Innovation and 91.3FM. It will be the second year streaming online audio with Network1Sports.com.

John Potter (potter@dixie.edu) enters his first year as the official voice of Red Storm Athletics. He is in his fifth year of professional broadcasting. Prior to joining Dixie State, Potter has been the voice for the St. George RoadRunners and the Mesa Miners of the independent Golden Baseball League. He was also the radio voice at Cerritos College while in school.

### BEHNKEN FIELD HOUSE - SALT LAKE CITY, UT

SALT LAKE CITY - The Dixie State men's basketball team had a lot of questions heading into the season's first exhibition Friday at Westminster College. Who will become the major scoring threat? Have last season's injuries healed with no lingering effects? Can a team that finished 2nd in the Pacific West Conference a year ago get off to a fast start with 12 new players?

With a two-point lead at the half, the Red Storm shot under twenty-percent and were outmatched on the offensive boards in the second half en route to a 68-53 loss to the Griffins inside Behnken Field House.

Andy Palmer (St. George, UT/Pine View), a preseason all-Pac West selection, and Tom Whitehead (St. George, UT/Dixie) each had 17 points in defeat. Whitehead added a game-high eight rebounds. DSC newcomer Donovan Plunkett (Oroville, CA/Las Plumas) chipped in 10 points.

Senior Nick Howard (Sandy, UT/Jordan) had four points and joined Palmer, Whitehead and Plunkett as the only DSC players to score in the game. The remaining shooters combined on a 0-for-22 performance.

The Storm opened up a four-point lead with 10:36 left on a Palmer three-pointer, his only make in four long-distance attempts. Westminster responded with a quick 13-5 run highlighted by a couple of three balls and a layup to lead by four with seven minutes remaining in the half.

DSC held Westminster to one field goal the rest of the first period and started a run with back-to-back triples from Plunkett and Whitehead to take a 33-31 advantage into the locker room.

Whitehead followed an early missed jump shot with a tip-in to start the second half. Dixie State would not make another field goal for nine minutes allowing Westminster to reel off a game-changing 23-7 run. The Griffins, who led by as much as 19, never allowed DSC within single digits seesawing points from the free throw line in the final minutes.

Westminster was led offensively by Weston Anderson with 22 points and Blair Prowse with 21.

Dixie State made 15-of-48 (31.3%) field goals and finished 70-percent (17-24) from the free-throw line.

The exhibition season continues Saturday night from Salt Lake City when the Red Storm will play Rocky Mountain (MT) College. Tipoff is scheduled for 6:00pm Mountain. Dixie State plays its only home exhibition on Friday, November 13 at 7:30pm against Whittier (CA) College inside the Burns Arena.

## BURNS ARENA – ST. GEORGE, UT

ST. GEORGE, UTAH – Playing for the first time in the Burns Arena, the Red Storm of Dixie State College displayed their most dominant exhibition performance defeating Whittier College 105-74 in front of 1,213 fans on Friday night.

Freshman center Zach Robbins (Upland, CA/Upland) had a near perfect night from the floor en route to a double-double, 20 points (10-11 FG) and 12 rebounds. Three other Storm players – starter Tom Whitehead (St. George, UT/Dixie) (19) and reserves Jeremiah Barnes (Compton, CA/Los Altos) (15) & Donovan Plunkett (Oroville, CA/Las Plumas) (10) – scored in double figures. The Storm were hot all night shooting 58.6% from the floor (41-70). Every player who saw court time scored at least four points.

Both teams pushed the tempo early in the first half. DSC won the tip leading to a quick Whitehead layup. The Poets immediately responded a three-ball from A.J. Manalo. The rapid action never allowed one team to pull away from another – Dixie State had the biggest lead at eight points (19-11) during the first 15 minutes of the game. With 3:12 left, Zach Corns hit a layup to pull Whittier within five, but Dixie State closed the half with nine straight points – seven from Whitehead – to lead 54-40 at the half.

Dixie State continued the momentum to begin the second opening a 21-point lead in five minutes. Plunkett and Whitehead hit long-distance threes and Robbins cashed in a pair of jumpers during the crucial stretch.

DSC out-rebounded Whittier 48-28 and used that advantage to take 13 more shots on the night.

Whittier was led offensively by Drew Menez and David Hayashi – each had 16 points. DaMon Perry added 13 points on 5-of-8 shooting.

The Red Storm were without the services of two key veterans. Andy Palmer (St. George, UT/Pine View) sat out with sore ribs and Nick Howard (Sandy, UT/Jordan) missed the game with an ankle sprain.

With the exhibition season completed, Dixie State starts the regular season on Saturday, November 21 at home against Cal State University, Dominguez Hills. Tip against the Toros is scheduled for 7:30pm inside the Burns Arena.
