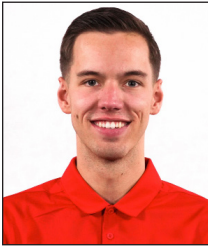

MEDIA RELATIONS

The Utah Tech University Athletics Media Relations Office is here to help the media cover the school's 15 intercollegiate athletics programs. Please let us know how we can assist you in covering the Trailblazers. The Media Relations Office is located in Rooms 205/211 of the North Burns Arena Building.

CREDENTIAL REQUESTS

Please direct all credential requests to the UT Athletic Media Relations team at least 72 hours before the contest in question.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY

Please direct all photography/video photography credential requests to Matt Brooks at least 72 hours before the contest in question.

For Men's Basketball - All credentialed sideline photographers/videographers are not permitted to shoot along the sidelines on either side of the court, and must wear their credentials in plain sight at all times. All photographers must stay behind the dashed-line zones along each baseline.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Game Interviews

The Utah Tech locker room is closed to the media following the game. A mandatory 10-minute cooling off period will be observed at the end of each game. Utah Tech Head Coach Jon Judkins, and student-athletes requested for interviews, will be brought to the postgame interview room, which is located in the Director's Club room on the floor between the Burns Arena floor level and upper concourse (access via stairs on concourse or elevator from floor or concourse). Interviews may also be conducted courtside inside the Burns Arena depending on the number of requests.

The Utah Tech Athletic Media Relations staff will secure the head coach and student-athletes for the interview room. The student-athletes will speak first, followed by the head coach as soon as any required radio/TV interviews have been completed. There will be a strict 10-15 minute time limit for the student-athlete interviews, and a 15-20 minute time limit enforced for head coaches.

Other student-athletes may be interviewed, **at their discretion**, following the 10-minute cooling off period. Please contact a member of the UT Athletic Media Relations staff for assistance.

The only pregame interviews allowed on game days will be for Utah Tech Radio and local and regional/national television productions. All requests for one-on-one interviews during game week will be facilitated by the Utah Tech Athletic Media Relations Office. No game day interviews will be allowed unless specifically requested for televised games.

Interview access for visiting coaches/student-athletes will be at the discretion of the visiting Sports Information/Media Relations Director. If the visiting team did not travel an SID, then it will be at the option of the visiting head coach for his/her availability, as well as visiting student-athletes.

Weekly Interviews

All print, television and radio interviews are to be arranged through the Utah Tech University Athletic Media Relations Office. Contact Matt Brooks for all Utah Tech Men's Basketball coach and student-athlete interview requests. Please provide at least 72 hours notice on all requests to enable the Athletic Media Relations Office the necessary time to coordinate such requests.

Contact information for student-athletes will not be provided and student-athletes have been instructed not to accept calls from the media for interview requests without prior notice from the Utah Tech Athletics Media Relations Office.

Utah Tech practices are **closed** to the public and the media. Should a practice be open, the Utah Tech Athletics Media Relations Office will notify the media in advance. Utah Tech coaches and student-athletes will not be available before or during practice unless prearranged by a member of the UT Athletic Media Relations staff.

MEDIA WORK SPACE

Utah Tech Athletics will provide work space in Burns Arena. This designated press area is limited to working media only. Seats are reserved for media covering Utah Tech on a regular basis and visiting team media representatives. Any unique requests must be made at least 72 hours prior to each game. Please reserve seating by contacting Utah Tech Sports Information Coordinator Matt Brooks.

NEWS AND NOTES

Scouting the Gamecocks:

The Gamecocks defeated NA-IA-side Brescia on Tuesday, winning 91-41 at home. With an offense led by Travis Roberts and Caleb Johnson's 12 points apiece, five different players finished in double-figures for scoring while Andres Burney led the team with nine boards and two blocks.

As a team, Jacksonville State shot over 50% in the game while finding ways to get to the line frequently, hitting 25-29 from the charity stripe in a season-opening victory.

Bench Explosion

David Elliott started off his season with a bang, scoring 24 points against Santa Clara on Thursday while also adding six rebounds, one assist, and four steals on 9-18 shooting. The Los Angeles, Calif., native came within one point of his career-high for scoring, having poured in 25 against Butler Community College last season while playing for the Garden City Broncbusters.

Elliott is no stranger to the Broncos either, having played his freshman season against fellow West Coast Conference team, Loyola Marymount.

Poster

This past offseason saw Trailblazer center Tanner Christensen shed some weight, and that showed itself early in the second half of Thursday's game. With 14:04 on the clock, Christensen received a bounce pass from Elliott on the far block and went up strongly with two hands, dunking over the 6-7 Adama-Alpha Bal to cut the deficit to single digits.

Now in his second year at Utah Tech, Christensen finished with six points, seven rebounds and two steals against Santa Clara.

Running

There were two runs that played a

key role in Utah Tech's close loss against SCU, both at opposite ends of the game.

After winning the opening tipoff, UT raced out to a quick 7-0 lead that prompted a Herb Sendek timeout just 71 seconds into the game. After the Broncos battled back and took a large lead in the second period of play, Utah Tech would use a 13-0 run from 7:50 until the 5:50 mark in the second half to bring the game within six points. Elliott (eight) and Jaylen Searles (five) fueled the late-game offensive outburst.

27-Plus

The Trailblazer starters were relied upon heavily in Thursday's game, with all five guys playing at least 27 minutes. Noa Gonsalves' 37 minutes of action led the team and he was joined by Aric Demings in the 30-plus minute club; Searles (28), Beon Riley (28) and Christensen (27) rounded out the starting five.

Scoring Early

Demings started in his first collegiate appearance against Santa Clara, finishing with a line of 17 points, three rebounds, two assists and one steal while shooting 6-14 (42.9%) from the field and 2-4 (50%) from deep. He scored his first collegiate points on a triple with 11:05 to play in the first half, bringing Utah Tech within one point of the lead.

Fellow freshman Tennessee Rainwater also earned his first collegiate action in the opener, playing nine minutes off the Utah Tech bench. Like Demings, the Davenport, Wash., native found himself on the scoreboard with during the first half, converting an and-one with 48 seconds in the half.

Free Throws

Utah Tech found its way to the free throw line early and often against the Broncos, attempting

24 shots at the line. When compared with last year's team that averaged 16.8 attempts per game, it's a 42% increase early in the season.

Unite The Family

Trailblazer men's basketball was active in the community this off-season, regularly visiting local elementary schools while completing service projects that included picking up trash at a local reservoir and passing out snacks and water during the 2023 St. George Marathon. Though all of these examples are things the team has done in the past, this year's service all centered around the idea of "Uniting the Family," which is the new program mantra that was announced on Sept. 29.

"Part of it is about coming together as a team to accomplish the same goals, but it's also about sacrifice, service, humility, those kinds of things," Head Coach Jon Judkins said. "Seeking opportunity to unite and being the best version of yourself in order to improve the strength of your family... What can we do to strengthen our family, strengthen our team and strengthen the community?"

A Long Road Trip

Utah Tech opens its 2023-24 campaign by spending the entire month of November out on the road, playing six different teams in six different venues that aren't Burns Arena. After facing Jacksonville State on Saturday, the team will play Youngstown State (Nov. 17, 4:30 p.m.), Lake Erie College (Nov. 18, 12 p.m.), Washington State (Nov. 24, 2 p.m.) and Lindenwood (Nov. 27, 6 p.m.) on the road.

Trailblazer men's basketball will open up its home slate with a conference game against Utah Valley on the first weekend of December, hosting the Wolverines at 7 p.m. on Dec. 2.

Since its founding in 1962, the **Western Athletic Conference (WAC)** continues to evolve and feature some of the nation's best programs. One thing that remains unchanged is the persistent nature of the schools in the WAC to advance their programs to contend at the top levels of the NCAA.

The WAC provides its student-athletes the chance to travel to scenic destinations and gain exposure in some of the nation's most diverse markets and largest metropolitan cities. In addition, the WAC's student-athletes work to achieve the highest levels of success with the academic support of their respective institutions.

WAC Member Institutions

The WAC's history traces back to July 27, 1962, when the original six-team league of Arizona, Arizona State, Brigham Young, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming began competition.

The first championship was held in November 1962, when Arizona won the men's cross country title and New Mexico followed with the first WAC football title. Arizona finished second in the NCAA College World Series and, less than three years later, Arizona State claimed the league's first NCAA title when the Sun Devils won the College World Series trophy. Fresno State was the last WAC school to earn an NCAA team title when it won the College World Series in 2008.

Current members of the WAC have all joined the conference within the last 15 years. Seattle University and UT Arlington became members in 2012. In 2013, the WAC added Grand Canyon, Texas-Pan American and Utah Valley; Texas-Pan American merged with UT Brownsville to form The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley in 2015. California Baptist University became the ninth member of the conference on July 1, 2018, while Utah Tech and Tarleton State both began competition in 2020 after accepting bids in 2019. Abilene Christian and Stephen F. Austin joined the WAC in 2021 while Southern Utah moved over from the Big Sky ahead of the 2022-23 season.

The WAC has had just seven commissioners in its history. Paul Brechler was named the first leader of the conference and held the position from 1962-1968. He was followed by Wiles Hallock (1968-71), Stan Bates (1971-80), Dr. Joe Kearney (1980-94), Karl Benson (1994-2012), Jeff Hurd (2012-2021), and Brian Thornton (2021-Present).

WAC Championships

Presently, the WAC crowns team and individual champions in 19 sports – nine men's and 10 women's. For the men, there are championships in baseball, basketball, cross country, golf, soccer, swimming and diving, tennis, indoor track and field and outdoor track and field. Championships for women are held in basketball, cross country, golf, soccer, softball, swimming and diving, tennis, indoor track and field, outdoor track and field and volleyball.

Six-time Pacific West Conference Coach of the Year Jon Judkins is in his 19th season on the Utah Tech bench in 2023-24, where he enters the year with a 320-183 overall record that includes a 300-171 mark during the program's NCAA era.

Coach Judkins (604 career wins; .660 W%) became the first men's coach in Utah collegiate basketball history to reach the 500-win plateau when his Trailblazers defeated Hawai'i Hilo (81-72) back on January 28, 2017. He then reached the pinnacle when he became the all-time winningest college coach in Utah history with career win No. 583 in UT's 114-49 triumph over SAGU-American Indian College (12/15/21).

Last season, Judkins' Trailblazer squad finished 14-19 but ended the year on a high note, recording the program's first-ever NCAA Division I postseason victory with an 80-76 overtime victory over sixth-seeded Stephen F. Austin in the first round of the Western Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Tournament. The 2022-23 campaign also included a six-game winning streak that featured victories over the likes of Weber State and UTRGV, while senior point guard Cameron Gooden earned Second Team All-WAC honors after averaging 16.1 points per game during the regular season and scoring a career-high 35 against Southern Utah on March 9.

In the 2019-20 season, Judkins led the Trailblazers to a school-record tying 23 victories (23-7) and to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference regular season title (17-5). The 23 victories, which tied the record previous set in the 2017-18 campaign. That record included a 10-game season opening winning streak (and 23-game regular season win streak dating back to the 2018-19 campaign), and a program-best No. 6 ranking in the NABC national poll (No. 5 in the D2SIDA media) during the streak.

Judkins would go on to guide Utah Tech to its ninth and final NCAA Division II Tournament appearance, and the No. 3-overall seed in the 2020 South Central regional, but the tournament was eventually canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. UT wrapped up its 14-year NCAA Division II affiliation with a 266-122 (.685) overall record.

The previous season in 2018-19, Judkins led UT to an 18-9 overall record, including a 16-6 mark (t-2nd place) in the program's RMAC debut season.

In 2017-18 he led the Trailblazers to a school-record 23 victories (23-7), which included a school-record 17-game winning streak, along both the 2018 Pacific West Conference regular season championship and second PacWest tournament crown, to become the first head coach in that conference's history to sweep both titles twice in the same season. Judkins also guided Utah Tech to its eighth NCAA Tournament appearance.

In 2016-17, Judkins led Utah Tech to a 19-9 overall record, which included a 16-4 (3rd place) mark in Pacific West Conference play, and his 500th-coaching victory in a home win over Hawai'i Hilo on January 28, 2017. In 2015-16, Judkins guided UT to an 18-9 overall record and a 15-5 PacWest mark, which was good for a t-first place finish in the league standings.

Overall, Judkins has led the Trailblazers to 12-straight winning seasons with seven 20-win campaigns, which includes 22 victories in the 2010-11 and 2012-13 seasons. He has also guided them to six Pacific West Conference championships overall, including four-straight titles from 2009-13 and another crown in 2014-15, along with a PacWest Tournament title in 2013. In addition, Judkins has led Utah Tech to nine trips to the NCAA Tournament in the last 11 seasons overall from 2010-17, advancing all the way to the "Sweet 16" in the 2011 West Regional final.

In 15-plus years of NCAA play, Judkins has made the Burns Arena one of the most difficult home court advantages in the NCAA ranks. During his tenure, Judkins-coached teams are 150-42 (.781) overall inside the Burns Arena, which included a dominant 87-12 (.878) mark in PacWest play, and a 19-3 (.863) record in RMAC action.

Under Judkins direction, Utah Tech has posted nine 10-win seasons at home overall, including a pair of 12-win campaigns this season (12-2) and a perfect 12-0 record in 2009-10. Additionally, Utah Tech is 137-111 (.552) away from home during the Judkins-era (11-5 in 2019-20), which includes a 109-89 mark (.550) in true road games and 28-22 (.560) in neutral-site contests.

Prior to his arrival at Utah Tech, Judkins served as head coach at Snow College for 12 full seasons and part of another season (1992-93), and posted a 284-128 overall record. He led the Badgers to a pair of Scenic West Athletic Conference titles in 1999 and 2000, which earned him SWAC Coach of the Year honors. Prior to becoming head coach at Snow, Judkins was an assistant coach at Snow from 1988-1993, and served as interim head coach for the final 11 games of the 1992-93 season. In 2014, Judkins was inducted into the Snow College Athletic Hall of Fame.

Judkins played for one season at then-Dixie State (junior college) in the 1983-84 season before transferring to Utah State, where he is one of two players in program history to record a triple-double. During the 1987-88 season, he helped lead the Aggies to the PCAA title and an NCAA Tournament bid.

Originally from Salt Lake City, Judkins graduated from Utah State with a Bachelor's degree in Physical Education in 1988. He and his wife, Lanette, are the parents of four children - Jaelle, Janessa, and twins Justin and Jillian; and the grandparents of one grandson (Jett), and one granddaughter (Millie).

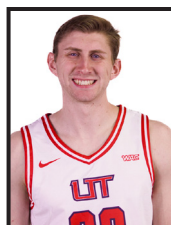
