THIS WEEK: The Drake University women's basketball team opens its 38th season of competition Saturday at Illinois-Chicago. Tipoff is scheduled for 3:05 p.m.

NEXT WEEK: The Bulldogs host in-state rival Iowa State in a men's and women's doubleheader starting at 5:50 p.m. Tuesday. Drake then hosts Milwaukee in a 7:05 p.m. matchup on Friday, Nov. 18.

BULLDOG OUTLOOK: A host of returning veterans will lead a deep and talented Drake women's basketball team in 2011-12. The Bulldogs return four starters and seven letterwinners and are looking to improve on last year's 15-15 record and sixth-place finish in the Missouri Valley Conference.

Chief among the Bulldogs' returning letterwinners is senior center Rachael Hackbarth. Hackbarth averaged 14.6 points and 8.1 rebounds per game last season and is Drake's top returning scorer and rebounder. The senior became the 22nd member of Drake's 1,000-Point Club during last season's State Farm MVC Tournament matchup against Missouri State and has a shot to become one of the 10 most-prolific scorers in Drake annals (More on page 2).

ABOUT ILLINOIS-CHICAGO: The Flames return three starters from a team that went 14-16 last season, including a fifth-place 9-9 in the Horizon League. UIC was picked to finish fifth in the League's preseason coaches poll. Seniors Jasmine Bailey and Shamiea Green earned preseason all-Horizon League honors. UIC beat St. Xavier, 73-48, in its lone exhibition contest Nov. 8.

Bailey, a guard, ranked third in the conference with 9.3 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game. She previously was named Horizon League Newcomer of the Year in 2009. Green averaged 14.4 points per game last season and is fourth among Horizon League returners in the category. Both players were teammates at Normandy High School in St. Louis, Mo.

The Flames are coached by first-year head coach Regina Miller.

DRAKE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES - ILLINOIS-CHICAGO

DRAKE VS. ILLINOIS-CHICAGO: Drake holds a 4-0 advantage in the all-time series against the Flames. The teams haven't met in Chicago since the Bulldogs earned an 89-61 victory Nov. 21, 1997 in the Knapp Center. The last time Drake played UIC in Chicago, the Bulldogs won, 96-52, Jan. 21, 1997.

DRAKE IN SEASON-OPENERS: The Bulldogs are 23-14 in 37 debut games, dating back to the program's first game on Nov. 20, 1974 - a 78-65 home victory over Iowa. Drake is 5-3 in season-openers under Amy Stephens, including 1-2 on the road. The last time Drake won a season-opener on the road was Nov. 19, 2004 in a 74-70 win at UMKC.

LEAVING ALREADY?: Saturday's game at Illinois-Chicago will serve as the earliest road contest, in terms of calendar date, in Drake annals. That title previously was held by the Bulldogs' 2009-10 season-opener at UMKC (Nov. 13). The earliest debut game, home or away, in Drake history occurred Nov. 9, 2007 against Green Bay.

MEET THE CAPTAINS: Amber Wollschlager and Rachael Hackbarth have been chosen captains by their teammates for 2011-12. This season marks Wollschlager's second as a captain after she shared the honor with Kristin Turk (2007-11) last season.

HACKBARTH CENTRAL: Senior Rachael Hackbarth is one of the Valley's top returners in 2011-12. She ranks as the conference's second-highest returning scorer and third-highest returning rebounder after totaling 14.6 points and 8.1 rebounds per game last season.

Hackbarth currently sits at 1,019 points - 22nd all-time at Drake - and can become one of Drake's 10 most-prolific scorers if she totals 586 or more points this season. Last season's leading scorer, Kristin Turk, scored 600 points.

Additionally, Hackbarth currently has 552 career rebounds, 122 short of Amy McDermott's (1978-82) 10th-place total of 674 on the all-time list. Hackbarth totaled 242 rebounds last season.

POHLMAN TO UNI HALL: Assistant coach Allison Pohlman was selected to be inducted into the University of Northern Iowa Athletics Hall of Fame last July. The former Allison Starr, Pohlman competed for UNI from 1996-2000 and finished her career as one of the best all-around players in program history. She earned Missouri Valley Conference All-Freshman Team laurels in 1997.

WELCOME KIRK CRAWFORD: Kirk Crawford, a veteran coach with over 30 years of experience, joined the staff as assistant coach in June. Crawford, who has held coaching positions at Providence, Southern Mississippi and Air Force, among others, and was a volunteer assistant for the WNBA's Portland Fire, fills the vacancy left by Todd Voss, who was named head coach at Southwest Baptist last April.

TOUGH NON-CON: Drake's non-conference schedule again ranks as one of its toughest under head coach Amy Stephens. The Bulldogs will meet 2011 NCAA Tournament participants Iowa State (Nov. 15), Marist (Nov. 24) and Iowa (Dec. 20) and travel for road games at Illinois-Chicago (Nov. 12), Wisconsin (Dec. 11) and St. Louis University (Dec. 18). In addition to Iowa State, Drake welcomes Milwaukee (Nov. 18), North Dakota (Dec. 1), North Dakota State (Dec. 8) and Loyola-Chicago (Dec. 22) to the Knapp Center for non-conference matchups.

DRAKE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES - ILLINOIS-CHICAGO

TRIPLE CROWN CANCUN CHALLENGE NOV. 24-25: This fall's Triple Crown Cancun Challenge is in its seventh year in Cancun, Mexico. The 2011 Challenge will feature 10 teams, including Chattanooga, Cincinnati, Drake, Hofstra, Idaho State, Kansas State, Marist, Purdue, South Dakota State and Tulane. Each of the 10 teams will play two games in Cancun at the Moon Palace Resort during Thanksgiving week. HEAD COACH AMY STEPHENS: Amy Stephens is in her ninth campaign as head women's basketball coach at Drake University.

Since her appointment in 2003, the Bulldogs have won 133 games and a Missouri Valley Conference championship, in addition to earning a NCAA Tournament berth in 2007 and three WNIT berths.

Under Stephens' direction, Drake became the Valley's most successful team during the last decade (Jan. 1, 2000 - Dec. 31, 2009). The Bulldogs amassed a conference-best 191-119 (.616) record during that time.

Prior to her stint at Nebraska, Stephens spent eight seasons as the head coach at Nebraska-Kearney. She built Nebraska-Kearney into one of the most successful NCAA Division II programs in the nation, while becoming the school's all-time winningest coach with a 197-43 (.821) record.

A four-time Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, Stephens led Nebraska-Kearney to five RMAC titles while the team averaged nearly 25 victories per season. UNK earned seven straight trips to the NCAA Tournament and also set an NCAA Division II record with an 87-game home-court winning streak that lasted from January of 1995 through November of 2001.

During the 2008-09 season, Stephens was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference All-Time Top Women's Basketball Coach to celebrate the RMAC's 100th anniversary.

Stephens was the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) District 7 Coach of the Year and a finalist for national coach-of-the-year honors in 2000.

Before beginning her career as head coach at UNK in 1994-95, Stephens served as an assistant coach at Iowa State from 1992-94. She spent one season as an undergraduate assistant coach at Nebraska (1990-91), before becoming an assistant coach at Omaha South High School in 1991-92.

Stephens was one of the most prolific scorers in Nebraska school history. The 5-foot 6-inch guard from Alliance, Neb., ranks third on Nebraska's all-time scoring list with 1,976 points as a four-year starter from 1985 through 1989. She also ranks third in career steals (280) and fourth in assists (444). She is one of the top three-point shooters in Nebraska history, ranking in the top five in career three-point percentage (second, .399), career three-point baskets (fourth, 129) and career three-point attempts (fifth, 323), despite only having the shot at her disposal for just two seasons.

Stephens started 113 games during her Nebraska career and earned Kodak All-District V and first-team All-Big Eight Conference honors as a senior in 1988-89. As a junior in 1987-88, Stephens helped the Huskers to their only Big Eight title and the first NCAA Tournament appearance in school history.

In February of 2000, Stephens claimed one of five spots on Nebraska's All-Century Team as part of the school's celebration of 25 years of women's intercollegiate athletics. Stephens also was inducted into the Nebraska High School Hall of Fame in 1999.

Stephens earned her bachelor's degree in physical education from Nebraska in 1991 and completed her master's degree in educational administration from Nebraska-Kearney in 1998.
