THE MATCH-UP: The Marist football team (2-4 overall, 1-2 PFL) makes its first of back-to-back trips to the Central Time Zone as it faces Drake (5-2, 4-0). Kickoff at Drake Stadium/Johnny Bright Field is set for 2 p.m. EDT.

HOW TO FOLLOW US: Ed Weir (play-by-play) and Mike Ferraro (color) will provide the call on 1450 WKIP AM in Poughkeepsie. The pregame show will begin at 1:45 p.m. EDT. The game can also be listened to for free on GoRedFoxes.com and the iHeartRadio app. For live game updates, check the official Twitter account of Marist Athletics (@MaristAthletics).

FOUR GAMES, ZERO LOSSES: This is Marist's fourth PFL game of the season, and its fourth straight against a team without a loss in league play. The Red Foxes' contest against Davidson was the PFL opener for both teams, Jacksonville was 1-0 heading into the Sept. 29 game, Butler was 3-0 heading into the Oct. 13 contest, and Drake currently stands at 4-0.

SCOUTING DRAKE: The Bulldogs come into today's contest having won four straight, with league victories against Morehead State, Campbell, preseason favorite San Diego and Valparaiso. In all five of Drake's wins this year, the Bulldogs have scored between 28 and 38 points. The team's only two losses are to Montana State and Indiana State, who are ranked fifth and 21st, respectively, in The Sports Network FCS Top 25 College Football Poll this week.

MEET THE CAPTAINS: Marist has four captains on this year's team. Three are seniors on defense - linebacker **Mike Hagemann**, safety **Nick Mainiero** and safety **Tyler Ramsey**. The Red Foxes' lone captain on offense is quarterback **Chuckie Looney**, who is just the second true junior to be named captain in **Jim Parady's** 21 seasons as head coach. The first was **Rory Foley** in 2010.

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through two decades of growth, is in his 20th season as the program's head coach and 21st overall with the Red Foxes.

During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won three league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

As head coach, Parady has posted a 105-107-1 record and 10 winning seasons. The Red Foxes won the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007.

In 2011, Parady won his 100th game as head coach in the season opener, a 20-7 triumph at Sacred Heart. The Red Foxes boasted talented playmakers on both sides of the ball, as 11 Red Foxes earned Pioneer Football League honors, including four First Team selections. Following the season, wide receiver Kevin Fitzpatrick and cornerback Jaquan Bryant were invited to the rookie minicamps of the Buffalo Bills and Oakland Raiders, respectively.

Parady, who also serves as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach, presided over record-setting production in the Marist passing game during the 2010 season. The Red Foxes set a single-season program record with 2,950 yards through the air. Quarterback Tommy Reilly set the program's single-game and single-season records for completions, attempts and passing yards, and Chuckie Looney became the first true freshman to take snaps under center in Parady's tenure.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters during his career.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth.

HISTORY WITH DRAKE: This is the fourth all-time meeting between the teams, with the Bulldogs having won the first three contests. This is the second game between the teams in Des Moines.

RUSH TO VICTORY: Marist has held the opposition to under 85 yards rushing in both of its wins, but the opponent has gained at least 120 in all of its losses. Meanwhile, the Red Foxes have rushed for over 140 yards in both of their wins, but have been held under 115 in their four losses.

BIG-PLAY THREAT: WR **Mike Rios** has 11 receiving touchdowns in his career. Nine have covered over 40 yards, six have been from over 60 yards, and four have been from over 70 yards. He enters today averaging 22.8 yards per catch in his career, and currently ranks fourth in program history with 1,367 career receiving yards. Additionally, Rios has blocked seven kicks in his career.

FORCING PLENTY OF TURNS-OVERS: After forcing three turnovers in the first three games, Marist has forced nine turnovers in its last three contests. The Red Foxes forced five against Davidson on Sept. 22, and three at Jacksonville on Sept. 29. All three turnovers forced at Jacksonville came inside the Marist 10-yard line. Marist is plus-3 in turnover ratio this season after going minus-16 last year.

LINEBACKERS ON THE STOPS: Marist's starting linebacker trio of **Mike Hagemann**, **Darius Hill** and **Paul Sakowski** rank first, second and third on the team in tackles with 47, 38 and 37, respectively. Hagemann's 13 stops against Butler were the highest total by a Red Fox this season.

TOUCHBACKS FOR MYERS: Senior **Jason Myers** has led the PFL in touchbacks each of the previous two seasons. Myers had 25 touchbacks in 2010 and 2011, and was named Honorable Mention All-PFL both years. Myers has registered 12 touchbacks in 24 kickoffs so far this season,

MARGINS: Marist's two victories this season have come by a combined total of 39 points, but its four losses have been by a combined total of 18 points. Marist has lost three games by three points or less.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In recent years, the Red Foxes have had more success away from Tenney Stadium than at home. Since the start of the 2010 season, the Red Foxes are 6-8 on the road, but just 3-11 at home.

RECORD-SHATTERING RECEIVING: WR **Mike Rios** set a program record with 244 receiving yards, and tied a program record with three receiving touchdowns - becoming the third Red Fox to accomplish that feat - vs. Davidson on Sept. 22. It was the first 200-yard receiving game in the PFL since 2008, and highest yardage total since 2003. Entering this week, the total is the fourth-highest by an FCS receiver this season. Rios was named PFL Offensive Player of the Week, and earned a College Football Performance Award.

LOONEY AIRS IT OUT: QB **Chuckie Looney** had the second 400-yard passing day in Marist history when he threw for 403 yards vs. Davidson on Sept. 22. He also became the fourth Red Fox in program history to throw four touchdown passes in a game. Looney earned a College Football Performance Award for his efforts.

LOTS OF OFFENSE: Marist rolled up 550 yards of total offense vs. Davidson on Sept. 22 (403 passing, 147 rushing), its largest output since also having 550 yards at Valparaiso on Oct. 9, 2010.

FUN WITH SCHEDULES: Marist's first three games this season (at Bry-

ant, Sept. 1; vs. Bucknell, Sept. 8; at Columbia, Sept. 15) all came against teams playing their season openers. Davidson had a bye on Sept. 15, the week prior to its game at Marist, making the Red Foxes' first four games against opponents who did not play the previous week.

BIG DAY FOR FEDE: Senior DE **Terrence Fede** earned a College Football Performance Award following his effort at Columbia on Sept. 15, in which he had eight tackles, two-and-a-half sacks and a pass break-up. Fede leads the Red Foxes with three-and-a-half sacks this season.

SPREADING THE WEALTH: Three different Red Foxes (WR **Mike Rios**, 82; WR **Matt Tralli**, 76; and WR **Armani Martin**, 75) had at least 75 yards receiving against Bucknell, and a fourth - WR **Josh Royce** (53) went over 50 yards.

STRONG DEFENSE (PART I): In nine of its last 12 wins (dating back to the 2009 season), Marist has held the opposition to 10 points or less.

STRONG DEFENSE (PART II): Last season, Marist ranked first in the PFL and sixth in the FCS in total defense, allowing an average of just 285.6 yards per game. Marist held Bryant's Jordan Brown, the 2011 FCS leading rusher, to just 43 yards on 22 carries in the season opener on Sept. 1.

KEYS TO VICTORY: Marist accomplished the following in its win at Bryant on Sept. 1: a 10-for-15 third-down conversion rate, touchdowns on all five trips inside the red zone, an edge in time of possession, no turnovers, a blocked kick, holding Bryant to a 5-for-17 third-down conversion rate, and a +124 margin in total yards.

AND IT'S A TEAM EFFORT, TOO: Against Bryant, Marist registered 12 tackles for losses, which came from 12 different players. Six different Red Foxes were also credited with one pass break-up apiece.

UNVEILING THE GROUND GAME: Marist rushed for 241 yards against Bryant in the season opener, as two Red Foxes gained over 90 yards on the ground (**Calvin McCoy & QB Chuckie Looney**), and three (McCoy, **Wale Onakoya** and **Louis Cotrone**) scored rushing touchdowns. The Red Foxes averaged 5.7 yards per carry against the Bulldogs.

NO TURNOVERS: Marist's season opener at Bryant did not include a turnover for either side.

CROTON-HARMON CONNECTION: Five Red Foxes attended Croton-Harmon High School in Westchester County: sophomore WR **Matt Tralli** and his brother, sophomore WR **Joe Tralli**; senior captain and S **Nick Mainiero** and his brother, freshman S **Jesse Mainiero**; and freshman DL **John Brennan**.

Freshman CB **Mike Marston** joined his brother, junior CB **Jack Marston**, on the team this season, and freshman S **Jesse Mainiero** joined his brother, senior S **Nick Mainiero**.

LOTS OF RETURNERS: Marist returns 70 letterwinners from last year's team. The Red Foxes bring back eight starters offensively and five starters defensively.

FOUR FOR A FIFTH: Four Red Foxes have returned for a fifth year of eligibility: WR **Mike Rios**, RB **Calvin McCoy**, QB **Tommy Reilly** and S **Steve Guarino**.

COVERING THE USA: Marist has players from 16 different states (New York, New Jersey, Maryland, Florida, Pennsylvania, California, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Connecticut, Ohio, Georgia, Illinois, Rhode Island, Maine, North Carolina, Washington). Half of Marist's roster of 118 comes from New York (32) and New Jersey (27).

TOO MANY TURNOVERS: Last year, Marist ranked 117th out of 120 FCS teams in turnover margin. The Red Foxes turned the ball over 33 times (11 fumbles, 22 interceptions) and had 17 takeaways (eight fumbles, nine interceptions) for a -16 differential and -1.45 margin per game.

AVOIDING SLOW STARTS IN GAMES ... : In the 2011 season, Marist was outscored 80-17 in the first quarter. The Red Foxes outscored their opponent in every other quarter (76-74 in the second, 61-37 in the third, 39-38 in the fourth).

... AND IN SEASONS ... : From 2006 through 2011, Marist had a 5-21 record in games played prior to Oct. 1.

2012 SCHEDULE: This year's schedule includes two opponents Marist has only faced once prior to this season - Bryant (Sept. 1) and Columbia (Sept. 15). Marist faced Bryant previously in 2008, and Columbia in 2007. The Red Foxes' other non-league game comes against Bucknell (Sept. 8), which marks the eighth straight year the teams will have met as the team's longest active rivalry. Marist's eight PFL opponents (Davidson, Jacksonville, Butler, Drake, Valparaiso, San Diego, Dayton and Campbell) are the

same eight the Red Foxes faced last year, with all meetings taking place at the opposite site this season. Butler's trip to Poughkeepsie on Oct. 13 will be its first.

EXPERIENCE ON STAFF: Marist has five coaches on staff who have over a decade's worth of experience with the program. Head Coach **Jim Parady** is in his 22nd year with the program and 21st as head coach. Associate Head Coach **Scott Rumsey** is in his 15th season on staff and 12th as defensive coordinator. Kickers coach **Tom Kelly**, who is now into his 29th season, is the longest-tenured member of the staff. Cornerbacks coach **Larry Riley** is in his 25th season, and offensive line coach **Bill Roos** is in his 11th year.
