- The Drake University men's basketball team plays its final home game of 2012 today when it hosts Eastern Illinois in the first meeting between the two programs.
- Drake wraps up its homestand after defeating North Carolina Central on Wednesday evening, 72-69.
- Seth VanDeest led the Bulldogs in the win with a season-high 19 points and a back-to-back baskets in the final minute to preserve the win. VanDeest is averaging 18.5 points on 14-of-19 shooting in the last two games.
- EIU, a member of the Ohio Valley Conference, is 3-9 after falling to Saint Louis on Wednesday evening. The Panthers are in their first season under head coach Jay Spoonhour. He is the son of legendary former Missouri State head coach Charlie Spoonhour.
- The Panthers average 56.1 points per game and are led by Josh Piper's 11.5 points per game.
- Drake is averaging 76.4 points per game to rank in the top 50 nationally in scoring.
- Ben Simons leads Drake with 15.3 points per game after hitting four three-pointers in Wednesday's win. The senior continues to move up the Drake career scoring ranks with 1,075 points to rank 19th.
- As a team, the Bulldogs average 9.1 three-pointers per game, the fifth most in the nation and are converting on 41.9 percent of its three-point attempts, the third highest rate in the nation.
- In head coach Mark Phelps' five seasons on the Drake bench, the Bulldogs have shot a combined 37 percent from the three-point arc with an average of 7.5 three-pointers per game. All four of Phelps' seasons rank in the top six for most three-pointers in a season at Drake.

Fifth Season

Mark Phelps enters his fifth season as head coach of the Bulldogs' men's basketball program in 2012-13, driven by a passion and commitment to elevate Drake to levels of consistent excellence on and off the court. His dedicated approach to recruiting and program-building over his first four seasons has established a solid foundation to achieve sustainable success.

The 2011-12 season showed significant signs of both the steady progress and potential of the Drake program, as the Bulldogs qualified for a postseason tournament for the third time in the last five seasons (2008 NCAA, 2009 CIT), and second in Phelps' four-year tenure as head coach. The first-round Collegeinsider.com Postseason Tournament win over North Dakota was Drake's first victory beyond the conference tournament since 1975. The Bulldogs won 18 games, the most in Phelps' career and tied for ninth-most in school history.

In addition, Drake posted a winning record for the second time in Phelps' four years, making him the first Drake head

coach in 50 years to post two winning seasons in his first four (17-16 in 2008-09). Drake's third-place finish (9-9, tied with four teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference was its second-highest in the MVC standings in the last 26 years. The 9-9 MVC record of 2011-12 was the best by Phelps and tied for second-best by a Drake team since 1986.

With 62 wins in his first four seasons, Phelps has more victories than any Drake coach in his initial four years on the job. No Drake head coach since Maury John (.555 from 1958-62) has had a better winning percentage in the equivalent span of his career than Phelps (.473).

All of that success last season was achieved without starting center Seth VanDeest, who missed the entire season after undergoing surgery to repair a torn labrum in his left shoulder. The 2011-12 Bulldogs overcame significant injury adversity that impacted the starting lineup, but were guided through the storm by a coaching staff that remained steady and consistent, helping players elevate to a new level of performance.

One of those players was Ben Simons, who played every position on the floor and more than doubled his sophomore scoring average of 8.1 to a figure of 16.4, fourth-best in the MVC in 2011-12. Simons was joined by Jordan Clarke, who put up career-best averages of 6.0 points and 7.0 rebounds, while handling the post position in VanDeest's absence.

Simons was named captain of the MVC's Most Improved Team, while also earning second-team All-MVC and second-team NABC All-District recognition along with sophomore Rayvonte Rice. Clarke was named second-team MVC Scholar-Athlete.

In the fifth year of building his program, Phelps and his coaching staff will welcome eight scholarship newcomers in 2012-13, including five freshmen and three transfers, wrapped around an experienced nucleus of five returning players who have been regular starters for the Bulldogs.

The collective talent level of the eight incoming players demonstrates the tremendous recruiting acumen of Phelps and his staff, building on previous recruiting success that has gained notice across the country.

FROM THE ARC ...

- The Bulldogs remain one of the top three-point shooting teams in the nation, ranking fifth in three-pointers per game (9.1) and third in three-point percentage (.419).
- Drake also leads the MVC in both categories.
- Drake got back to form by shooting 47.6 percent from the three-point arc (10-of-21) against North Carolina Central.
- That performance was Drake's second best of the season and best against Division I competition.
- Drake shot below 40 percent from the three-point arc just twice this season.
- Individually, Ben Simons leads the team with 2.8 three-pointers per game.
- Thanks to the three-point shooting, Drake boasts a point per weighted shot average of 1.15,

the 21st highest average in the nation and an effective field goal percentage of 54.1 percent that ranks 26th.

- Three-point shooting has been a hallmark of Drake teams under head coach Mark Phelps with the Bulldogs averaging 7.5 three-pointers per game on 37.2 percent shooting during Phelps' seasons at the helm of the squad.
- Of the top six seasons for three-pointers made, four have come during Phelps' tenure.
- Below is a summary of each team's three-point shooting over the past five seasons.

DEFENDING THE THREE

- As prolific as Drake has been scoring from the three-point arc, the team has been equally successful in keeping its opponents from scoring via three-pointers.
- Iowa State came into the game against Drake averaging 9.6 three-pointers per game and was limited to just four three-pointers on 21.1 percent shooting.
- The Bulldogs' opponents are averaging 5.7 three-pointers per game on 30.8 percent shooting.
- Saint Mary's is the only Drake opponent to shoot more than 40 percent from the arc against the Bulldogs.

SCORING UP

• Drake's offense is averaging 76.4 points per game to rank just outside of the top 50 nationally and 9.7 points per game higher than the Bulldogs' average last season through 10 games.

PICKING UP THE PACE

- Drake's offense has had 80 or more possessions in three of its first 10 games of the season and is averaging 72.6 possessions per game.
- That pace ranks 47th nationally and is tops in the MVC.
- Last season the Bulldogs played at an 80-possession or greater pace just once.
- In the opener against William Jewell, the Bulldogs scored 1.19 points per possession and scored on approximately 52 percent of their offensive possessions.
- Against Detroit, Drake scored 0.95 points per possession and scored on 42.5 percent of its possessions.
- In the loss to Cal, Drake had 70 possessions and scored on 46 percent of those possessions for an average on one point per possession.
- In the win over Rice, Drake only had 62 possessions, but scored on a season-high 56.7 percent of them and averaged 1.24 points per possession, also a season high.
- The DirecTV Classic finale saw the Bulldogs record 72 possessions with a 0.97 points per possession average by scoring on 44.4 percent of its possessions.
- At Nevada, Drake had 71 possessions and scored 1.07 points per possession on 50.7 percent of its possessions.
- The loss to Saint Mary's saw the squad have 75 possessions and score at 0.97 points per possession on 40 percent of its possessions.
- In the win over IPFW, Drake had 76 possessions and scored on 42.6 percent of them.
- The loss to Iowa State saw Drake have approximately 81 possessions.
- Against North Carolina Central, Drake played its slowest game at just 62 possessions.

CURBING TURNOVERS

- Despite playing at an increased pace, Drake's is averaging two fewer turnovers than a season ago through 10 games.
- The Bulldogs have turned over the ball on just 17.4 percent of their possessions, well below the national average of 20.2 and the MVC average of 18.7.
- The 17.4 percent turnover rate ranks 50th nationally and is just 1.1 of a percentage point away from the top-25 in the stat. Cal Poly leads the nation in turnover rate at 14.1

KING SETS CAREER HIGH

- In desperate need of rebounding with the team's top rebounder in Jordan Clarke on the bench due to injury, freshman Joey King stepped up with a career-high 10 rebounds against North Carolina Central.
- More impressively, four of them came off the offensive glass with him accounting for 80 percent of the team's offensive rebounds.
- Those rebounds led to seven additional points.
- In addition to his rebounding, he added five points and a career-high three steals.

SECOND CHANCES

- In the win at Nevada, Drake started its strong work on the offensive glass with a 10-5 advantage in offensive rebounds to help the team to a 14-0 lead in second chance points.
- In its last seven games, Drake has outscored its opponents, 66-57, in second chance points.
- This season, Jordan Clarke has been the most consistent force in creating second chance points as his 30 offensive rebounds have led to 35 points, or an additional 3.5 points per game.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- Drake has attempted 28, 32, 27, 21 and 24 free throws, respectively, in its last five games.
- Against Saint Mary's, the Bulldogs converted 25-of-32 free throws (.781), their third highest percentage of the season and highest with 15 or more attempts.
- This season, Drake has attempted 25 or more free throws in six of its 10 games and 20 or more in all but one game.
- Drake leads the MVC in free-throw attempts with 251 this season. Five Bulldogs have attempted 20 or more free throws with Jordan Clarke accounting for nearly a third of the team's attempts with 70 this season.

DEFENSE CLAMPS DOWN ON NEVADA AND IPFW

- Against Nevada, Drake committed turnovers on 15.4 percent of its possessions while forcing Nevada to turn the ball over on a season-high 20.9 percent of its possessions.
- In the second half alone, the Wolf Pack made as many free throws (8) as it did field goals. The Bulldogs' defense held Nevada to 30.8 percent shooting from the field in the second half.
- In the win over IPFW, Drake allowed just 0.76 points per possession, a season low for the Bulldogs' defense.
- That effort ties for the 12th best by an MVC opponent against Division I competition this season.

CLARKE SETS TOURNEY RECORDS

- Jordan Clarke recorded three double-doubles against California, Rice and Xavier to help the Bulldogs to a 1-2 record at the DirecTV Classic.
- He averaged 12.7 points, 13.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while shooting 55 percent from the field.
- He also set the tournament record for rebounds with 39 in three games and became just the fifth player in the six years of the tournament to record a double-double in every game.
- He opened the tournament with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Cal and followed that up with 15 points and a tournament single-game record and career-high 18 rebounds against Rice.
- In that win over Rice, he had exactly half of the team's rebounds.
- In the Bulldogs' final game in Anaheim, he posted 12 points and 11 rebounds.
- Nationally, he ranks 60th in rebounding at 8.8 per game despite only playing nine minutes against Saint Mary's, 25 minutes against Iowa State and 16 minutes against NC Central.
- His double-doubles give him six in his last 19 games and he has hauled in 10 or more rebounds in eight of his last 13 games dating back to last season.
- He has also shot 31-of-55 from the field in 10 games this season and is averaging 1.9 assists per game, the third most on the team.
- He has helped key an inside-out offense with his passing as his 19 assists have resulted in 16 three-pointers.

SIMONS HITS 1,000-POINT PLATEAU

- Ben Simons' 20 points against Xavier made him the 23rd player in Drake history to record 1,000 career points.
- Simons currently ranks 18th in all-time scoring at Drake and needs one more point to move into 17th. Below are those near him in the rankings.

SIMONS NO. 29 SHOOTER IN THE NATION

- In addition to his preseason MVC accolades, CBSSports.com's Jeff Goodman ranked Ben Simons as the 29th-best shooter in the nation.
- Last season, Simons led the MVC in three-pointers with 77 and shot 42.5 percent from three-point range and 50.6 percent of his shots from inside the arc.
- He had plenty of company on the list as one of five MVC sharpshooters to be recognized, the most of any conference.

NEWCOMERS HIGHLY TOUTED

- The Bulldogs' 2012 recruiting class was ranked No. 45 in the nation by HoopScoopOnline, and second among Missouri Valley Conference schools. The class consists of five freshmen, two junior college transfers and Chris Hines, a transfer from Utah who has one year of eligibility remaining and can play immediately.

PRESEASON NOTES

- Drake enters 2012-13 having qualified for a postseason tournament three times in the last five seasons (2008 NCAA, 2009 and 2012 CIT), and twice in the four-year tenure of head coach Mark Phelps. Drake's first-round CIT win over North Dakota was its first in the postseason since 1975.
- With 62 career wins, Drake head coach Mark Phelps has more wins than any Drake coach in his first four seasons (2nd: Maury John, 55, 1958-62). No Drake head coach since Maury John (.555 from 1958-62) has had a better winning percentage in his first four seasons than Phelps (.473).
- Drake is coming off a third-place finish (9-9, tied with four teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference in 2011-12, which was its second-highest in the MVC standings in the last 26 years. The team's 9-9 MVC record was the best under head coach Mark Phelps, and is topped in the last 26 years only by the 15-3 mark of '07-'08, and matched by the 9-9 finishes of 2001-02, '94-'95 and '92-'93.
- The 18 wins by last year's Bulldogs were the most in Phelps' four-year tenure as head coach and tied for ninth-most in school history. Drake posted a winning record for the second time in Phelps' four years (17-16, 2008-09), making him the first Drake head coach in 50 years to post two winning seasons in his first four (Maury John, 2, 1958-62).
