- Drake University men's basketball returns to the Knapp Center for just its second home game of the season to host perennial NCAA participant St. Mary's in a game that is part of the DirecTV Classic.
- Both teams participated, but did not meet, in the three-game tournament in Anaheim with each squad going 1-2. Drake defeated Rice and dropped close contests to tournament champion California and Xavier.
- In its last game, Drake defeated Nevada, 76-66, thanks to five players scoring in double-figures and a staunch defensive effort in the second half to even its record a 3-3.
- St. Mary's makes its first trip to Knapp Center with a 5-2 record this season after defeating Cal Poly, 86-68, on Saturday.
- The Gaels are led by Australian Olympian and defending West Coast Conference Player of the Year, Matthew Dellavedova. The guard averages 16.6 points and 5.4 assists per game.
- Drake's offense has averaged 78 points per game, nearly 12 more points per game than it did through its first six games last season.
- The Bulldogs sharpshooters are averaging 10 three-pointers per game, the third most in the country and are converting at a 44.1 percent clip to rank fourth.
- In the paint, Jordan Clarke has recorded four double-doubles in six games and is averaging 12.8 points and 10.3 rebounds per game this season. He ranks 19th nationally in rebounding and fourth in double-doubles.
- His work on the glass, especially on offense, has helped Drake outscore its last three opponents by a 41-14 margin in second chance points.

@DUBulldogs returns to the Knapp Center for just its second home game of the season against @SMCGaels

The last time @DUBulldogs and @SMCGaels met in 2007-08, both teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

The game is a non-bracketed game as part of the @DirecTVClassic. Both teams went 1-2 at the tournament in Anaheim.

In the win at Nevada, Drake's defense allowed just 8 2nd-half field goals and held Nevada to 30.8 percent shooting.

Jordan Clarke has four double-doubles in six games and ranks 19th in the NCAA in rebounding (10.3 rpg) and 4th in double-doubles.

Mark Phelps enters his fifth season as head coach of the Bulldogs' men's basketball program in 2012-13, driven by a passion and commitment to elevate Drake to levels of consistent excellence on and off the court. His dedicated approach to recruiting and program-building over his first four seasons has established a solid foundation to achieve sustainable success.

The 2011-12 season showed significant signs of both the steady progress and potential of the Drake program, as the Bulldogs qualified for a postseason tournament for the third time in the last five seasons (2008 NCAA, 2009 CIT), and second in Phelps' four-year tenure as head coach. The first-round Collegeinsider.com Postseason Tournament win over North Dakota was Drake's first victory beyond the conference tournament since 1975. The Bulldogs won 18 games, the most in Phelps' career and tied for ninth-most in school history.

In addition, Drake posted a winning record for the second time in Phelps' four years, making him the first Drake head coach in 50 years to post two winning seasons in his first

four (17-16 in 2008-09). Drake's third-place finish (9-9, tied with four teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference was its second-highest in the MVC standings in the last 26 years. The 9-9 MVC record of 2011-12 was the best by Phelps and tied for second-best by a Drake team since 1986.

With 62 wins in his first four seasons, Phelps has more victories than any Drake coach in his initial four years on the job. No Drake head coach since Maury John (.555 from 1958-62) has had a better winning percentage in the equivalent span of his career than Phelps (.473).

All of that success last season was achieved without starting center Seth VanDeest, who missed the entire season after undergoing surgery to repair a torn labrum in his left shoulder. The 2011-12 Bulldogs overcame significant injury adversity that impacted the starting lineup, but were guided through the storm by a coaching staff that remained steady and consistent, helping players elevate to a new level of performance.

One of those players was Ben Simons, who played every position on the floor and more than doubled his sophomore scoring average of 8.1 to a figure of 16.4, fourth-best in the MVC in 2011-12. Simons was joined by Jordan Clarke, who put up career-best averages of 6.0 points and 7.0 rebounds, while handling the post position in VanDeest's absence.

Simons was named captain of the MVC's Most Improved Team, while also earning second-team All-MVC and second-team NABC All-District recognition along with sophomore Rayvonte Rice. Clarke was named second-team MVC Scholar-Athlete.

In the fifth year of building his program, Phelps and his coaching staff will welcome eight scholarship newcomers in 2012-13, including five freshmen and three transfers, wrapped around an experienced nucleus of five returning players who have been regular starters for the Bulldogs.

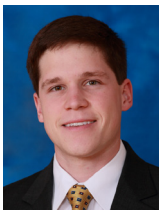

FROM THE ARC ...

- Drake was 9-of-20 from the three-point arc against Nevada to remain one of the best three-point shooting teams in the nation.
- The Bulldogs are shooting 44.1 percent from the arc this season to rank fourth in the nation. Lehigh leads the NCAA at a 45.2 percent clip.
- The team's 10 three-pointers per game also ranks third nationally. Drake leads the MVC in both categories as well.
- Individually, Ben Simons leads the team with 3.17 three-pointers per game, the 19th most in the nation.

SCORING UP

- Drake's offense is averaging 78.0 points per game, the 36th highest average in the nation and 10.2 points per game higher than the Bulldogs' average last season.

SECOND CHANCES

- In the win at Nevada, Drake continued its strong work on the offensive glass with a 10-5 advantage in offensive rebounds to help the team to a 14-0 lead in second chance points.
- In its last three games, Drake has outscored its opponents, 41-14, in second chance points.
- This season, Jordan Clarke has been the most consistent force in creating second chance points as his 23 offensive rebounds have led to 30 points, or an addition 5.0 points per game.

DEFENSE CLAMPS DOWN AT NEVADA

- Against Nevada, Drake committed turnovers on 15.4 percent of its possessions while forcing Nevada to turn the ball over on a season-high 20.9 percent of its possessions.
- In the second half alone, the Wolf Pack made as many free throws (8) as it did field goals. The Bulldogs' defense held Nevada to 30.8 percent shooting from the field in the second half.

CLARKE SETS TOURNEY RECORDS

- Jordan Clarke recorded three double-doubles against California, Rice and Xavier to help the Bulldogs to a 1-2 record at the DirecTV Classic.
- He averaged 12.7 points, 13.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while shooting 55 percent from the field.
- He also set the tournament record for rebounds with 39 in three games and became just the fifth player in the six years of the tournament to record a double-double in every game.
- He opened the tournament with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Cal and followed that up with 15

points and a tournament single-game record and career-high 18 rebounds against Rice.

- In that win over Rice, he had exactly half of the team's rebounds.
- In the Bulldogs final game in Anaheim, he posted 12 points and 11 rebounds.
- Nationally, he ranks 19th in rebounding at 10.3 per game.
- The double-doubles give him six in his last 15 games and he has hauled in 10 or more rebounds in seven of his last nine games dating back to last season.
- He has also shot 20-of-30 from the field in five games this season and is averaging three assists per game.
- He has helped key an inside-out offense with his passing as his 17 assists have resulted in 15 three-pointers.

PICKING UP THE PACE

- Drake's offense has had 80 or more possessions in two of its first six games of the season and is averaging 71.9 possessions per game.
- That pace ranks in the top 100 nationally and second in the MVC.
- Last season the Bulldogs only played at an 80-possession or greater pace just once.
- In the opener against William Jewell, the Bulldogs scored 1.19 points per possession and scored on approximately 52 percent of their offensive possessions.
- Against Detroit, Drake scored 0.95 points per possession and scored on 42.5 percent of its possessions.
- In the loss to Cal, Drake had 70 possessions and scored on 46 percent of those possessions for an average on one point per possession.
- In the win over Rice, Drake only had 62 possessions, but scored on a season-high 56.7 percent of them and averaged 1.24 points per possession, also a season high.
- The DirecTV Classic finale saw the Bulldogs record 72 possessions with a 0.97 points per possession average by scoring on 44.4 percent of its possessions.
- At Nevada, Drake had 71 possessions and scored 1.07 points per possession on 50.7 percent of its possessions.

CURBING TURNOVERS

- Despite playing at an increased pace, Drake's turnovers remain the same as last season in total numbers.
- The Bulldogs have turned over the ball on just 16.4 percent of their possessions, well below the national average of 20.3 and the MVC average of 18.6.
- The 16.4 percent turnover rate ranks 32nd in the nation and just a .04 of a percentage point away from the top-25 in the stat. Cal Poly leads the nation in turnover rate at 13.1.

SIMONS HITS 1,000-POINT PLATEAU

- Ben Simons' 20 points against Xavier made him the 23rd player in Drake history to record 1,000 career points.
- Simons currently ranks 26th in all-time scoring at Drake. Below are those near him in the rankings.

BULLDOGS OPEN THE RECORD BOOK

- Drake's sharpshooters wasted little time in etching the 2012-13 squad into the record books at Drake as the 15 three-pointers in the season opener tied for the sixth most in school history.
- Additionally, the team's 62.5 percent (15-of-24) shooting percentage from three-point range tied for the ninth highest in program history.
- Four players accounted for the 15 three-pointers including Ben Simons (5), Richard Carter (4), Micah Mason (3) and Joey King (3).

PHELPS AMONG THE BEST ON THE DRAKE BENCH

- In his first four seasons at the helm of the Drake program, head coach Mark Phelps collected 62 victories, more than any other head coach in the program's history through their first four seasons.

SIMONS NO. 29 SHOOTER IN THE NATION

- In addition to his preseason MVC accolades, CBSSports.com's Jeff Goodman ranked Ben Simons as the 29th-best shooter in the nation.
- Last season, Simons led the MVC in three-pointers with 77 and shot 42.5 percent from three-point range and 50.6 percent of his shots from inside the arc.
- He had plenty of company on the list as one of five MVC sharpshooters to be recognized, the most of any conference.

NEWCOMERS HIGHLY TOUTED

- The Bulldogs' 2012 recruiting class was ranked No. 45 in the nation by HoopScoopOnline, and second among Missouri Valley Conference schools. The class consists of five freshmen, two junior college transfers and Chris Hines, a transfer from Utah who has one year of eligibility remaining and can play immediately.

PRESEASON NOTES

- Drake will play in the 2012 Anaheim Classic Nov. 22-25, joining a field that also includes California, Drexel, Georgia Tech, Pacific, Rice, St. Mary's and Xavier.
- Drake enters 2012-13 having qualified for a postseason tournament three times in the last five seasons (2008 NCAA, 2009 and 2012 CIT), and twice in the four-year tenure of head coach Mark Phelps. Drake's first-round CIT win over North Dakota was its first in the postseason since 1975.
- With 62 career wins, Drake head coach Mark Phelps has more wins than any Drake coach in his first four seasons (2nd: Maury John, 55, 1958-62). No Drake head coach since Maury John (.555 from 1958-62) has had a better winning percentage in his first four seasons than Phelps (.473).
- Drake is coming off a third-place finish (9-9, tied with four teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference in 2011-12, which was its second-highest in the MVC standings in the last 26 years. The team's 9-9 MVC record was the best under head coach Mark Phelps, and is topped in the last 26 years only by the 15-3 mark of '07-'08, and matched by the 9-9 finishes of 2001-02, '94-'95 and '92-'93.
- The 18 wins by last year's Bulldogs were the most in Phelps' four-year tenure as head coach

and tied for ninth-most in school history. Drake posted a winning record for the second time in Phelps' four years (17-16, 2008-09), making him the first Drake head coach in 50 years to post two winning seasons in his first four (Maury John, 2, 1958-62).

- Five of the top six seasons in school history for three-point field goals have come in the last five years, four of them under Mark Phelps (2nd, 3rd, 5th, 6th). Drake finished the 2011-12 season with 213, fifth-most in school history.

- The 2011-12 Bulldogs ranked No. 1 in the MVC in three-point field-goal pct. defense (.305) and third in steals (6.9).
- Drake is coming off a season in which it was 16-2 when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent and 9-0 when shooting 50 percent or higher.
- In keeping with Coach Phelps' emphasis on strong defense, the Bulldogs did not allow an opponent to shoot higher than 50 percent from the field for an 18-game stretch in 2011-12 before Rice shot 53.1% in the season-ending CIT Tournament loss. Opponents in that stretch shot a combined 41.2 percent (408-991), including a figure of 39.6 percent over the last nine games (199-of-503). In addition, those nine opponents combined to shoot 49-of-217 (.226) from three-point range.

PLAYER NOTES

- Drake forward Ben Simons enters 2012-13 as the MVC's third-leading returning scorer after posting a 16.4 average last year. Simons led the MVC and ranked 54th in the NCAA in three-point field goals per game (2.6), while ranking No. 23 among NCAA DI players in three-point field goal percentage (42.5%).
- Simons finished the season with 77 three-pointers, seventh on the school's single-season list, and 156 for his career, sixth-most all-time.

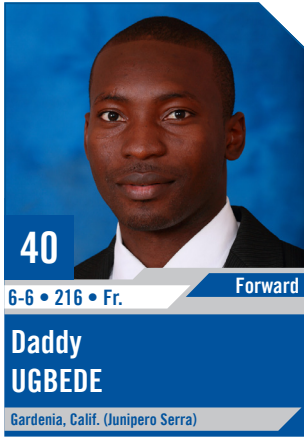

Ben Simons led all scorers with 25 points, 18 of which came in the second half. Richard Carter had a big game in his debut, scoring 19 points, including going a perfect 4-of-4 from three-point range.

The Bulldogs were hot from the field the entire game shooting 55.9-percent as a team on 33-of-59 shooting as well as 15-of-24 from three-point range for a 62.5 percent clip, the ninth highest single-game percentage in school history. At one point in the second half Drake had made 12 of its 15 three-point attempts. Additionally, Drake's 15 three-pointers tied for the sixth most in program history behind nine total three-pointers from Simons and Carter.

Led by five players scoring in double-figures, the Drake University men's basketball team defeated Nevada, 76-66, on the road in the Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge.

Richard Carter had his best game to date in a Drake uniform with 16 points, a game-high seven rebounds and four assists with just one turnover. The junior college transfer was 6-of-12 from the field as the Bulldogs shot 44.6 percent from the field and a 45 percent (9-of-20) from three-point range.

Despite the offensive numbers, Drake's defense and rebounding won the game against a Nevada squad that won 28 games and its conference title last season. The Wolf Pack shot 41.2 percent from the field as the Bulldogs' defense imposed its will in the second half to allow just 30.8 percent shooting.

On the boards, Jordan Clarke led an offensive rebounding attack that held a 10-5 advantage to allow Drake to outscore the Wolf Pack, 14-0, on second chance points. Clarke finished with six total boards to go along with his 15 points, two assists and two steals.
