THE GAME

- The Drake University football team travels to No. 22 Indiana State for its first road test of the season and its final non-conference game as well.
- The game is the Bulldogs' second straight against a ranked opponent after falling, 34-24, to No. 4 Montana State on Saturday evening. The Bulldogs led MSU, 24-21, after three quarters but a pair of MSU touchdowns allowed the squad to escape Drake Stadium with the win and snap Drake's 11-game home winning streak.
- MSU narrowly out-gained the Bulldogs, 374-370, in that contest.
- Senior quarterback Mike Piatkowski threw for 311 yards in the loss against a defense that did not allow a 300-yard passer last season.
- Saturday's game is the 11th all-time between the two programs, but the first meeting since 1985.
- Indiana State is 1-1 on the young season with a 24-17 loss at Indiana in the opener and a 44-0 win over Quincy last weekend.
- The Sycamores out-gained Quincy, 237-73, in that win with four backs each running for nearly 50 yards or more.
- The Bulldogs defensive front has put up FCS leading numbers in tackles for loss and sacks with 11.5 TFL per game and six sacks per outing. Individually, Brandon Coleman leads the FCS ranks in TFL with three per game.
- Against MSU, the defense collected three sacks against a very mobile quarterback and 10 tackles for loss. Coleman and Brett Park combined for half of those TFL.
- The secondary of Drew Ormseth and Mike Ratelle also had a pair of interceptions to end MSU drives.
- Kevin Marshall became the team's first 100-yard receiver of the season with 11 catches for 100 yards. Joey Orlando almost matched him, finishing with 98 yards on six catches.

A WIN WOULD ...

- Make Drake 2-1 to open a season for the second straight season and the fourth time under head coach Chris Creighton
- Make Drake 3-8 all-time against Indiana State and be the program's first win in Terre Haute, Ind., since 1981.
- Be Drake's first win over a ranked opponent since Aug. 30, 2007.
- Be Chris Creighton's 32nd win at Drake and 127th career win.
- Be the program's 574th all-time victory.
- Make Drake 2-4 in non-conference road games under Creighton.
- Be Drake's first win over the Sycamores since 1981.

A LOSS WOULD ...

- Give Drake back-to-back losses for the first time since the final two games of the 2009 season
- Be Drake's second straight loss to a ranked opponent.
- Make Drake 1-2 to open the season for the second time under Chris Creighton.
- Be Indiana State's fifth straight win in the series.

BULLDOGS LEAD THE NATION IN SACKS

- Drake's defense leads the nation in both tackles for loss and sacks.
- The Bulldogs are averaging 11.5 TFL per game and six tackles per outing.
- In the opener, Drake recorded nine sacks against Grand View and tacked on three more against a very mobile Montana State quarterback.
- The Bulldogs have four players, Tyler Moorehead, Brandon Coleman, Brett Park and Matt Acree, all ranking in the top 10 nationally in sacks. Moorehead is tied for the national lead with two sacks per game.
- Additionally, Coleman and Acree rank in the top 10 in TFL as well with Coleman being tied for the national lead.

DEFENSE STOPPING THE RUN

- Through two games, the Bulldogs' defense has only allowed a meager 128 yards rushing per game and a PFL best 2.98 yards per rush.
- That dominance up front is nothing new for Creighton's teams as in his five seasons, his teams have allowed on average just 96.5 yards rushing per game.
- That defense and reputation will have its work cut out for it against an ISU squad that has averaged 196 yards per game on the ground this season.
- Montana State during the 2010 season was the last team to run for 200 yards against the Bulldogs and one of just two teams to accomplish the feat during Chris Creighton's tenure on the Drake sideline.

MARSHALL HITS 100-YARD MARK

- Tight end Kevin Marshall was Mike Piatkowski's favorite target in the loss to Montana State as he corralled 11 balls for 100 yards to become Drake's first 100-yard receiver of the season.
- He was nearly joined by teammate Joey Orlando who had six catches for 98 yards.
- In two games this season, that pair has kept the chains moving for the Bulldogs as 10 of Marshall's 17 catches have been for first downs while six of Orlando's seven have resulted in a fresh set of downs for Drake.

SCOTT BECOMES THE PFL'S FIRST 100-YARD RUSHER IN 2012

- Redshirt freshman Gary Scott, Jr., made quite the debut against Grand View with 107 yards on 17 carries and a 2-yard touchdown run.
- Of his 17 carries, seven resulted in either a first down or a touchdown.
- He also added one catch out of the backfield for 11 yards.

PIATKOWSKI CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

- Senior quarterback Mike Piatkowski threw for 271 yards in the win over Grand View to give him 7,198 career yards and push him over the 7,000-yard plateau.
- He added to that total with 311 yards against a Montana State defense that did not allow a 300-yard passer in 2011
- He is only the second Drake quarterback to accomplish this feat and the ninth in PFL history.
- He is one of eight active quarterback in FCS with 7,000 or more career yards.
- He is currently eighth in career passing in PFL history and needs 359 yards to become Drake's all-time leader.
- He also has a 62.1 career completion percent-

age (645-of-1039), the best in school history. His 62.8 percentage in 2009 (203-of-323) is the best single-season figure ever by a Bulldog, and he completed 65.3 percent of his passes in 2011 (231-of-354).

- The school record-holder in completions (645), he also needs just 11 touch-down passes to become No. 1 in that category as well (Vandever, 67; 1999-2002). Last year he threw 25, second-most in a season in school history.
- Below is where Piatkowski ranks in the Drake record book in passing yard-age.

STAFF TAKES ON NEW LOOK

- Drake's defensive coaching staff takes on a new look in 2012, including a new coordinator in Brad McCaslin, formerly the defensive coordinator and associate head coach at Nebraska-Omaha, where he coached for 14 seasons.
- Also new to the coaching staff is defensive backs coach/recruiting coordinator Todd Frakes, an 11-year coaching veteran who spent nine seasons on the staff at Centre College in Danville, Ky; defensive line coach Dain Taylor, the former Drake star who was an All-American in 2010; and cornerbacks coach Kahlil Carter, who played 11 seasons in the Arena Football League, Canadian Football League and NFL Europe.

DRAKE PICKED SECOND IN PFL POLL

- Drake was picked to finish second in the 2012 preseason Pioneer Football League Coaches' Poll behind the team with which they tied for the conference title a year ago, the San Diego Toreros.
- The Bulldogs received one first-place vote. San Diego received eight of a possible nine first place votes and 79 of 81 possible points as coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team in the poll.
- Both the Toreros and Bulldogs finished the 2011 campaign with identical 7-1 records, San Diego winning the regular-season meeting between the two teams.
- The squads will meet again this season with Drake hosting San Diego in an Oct. 6 contest at Drake Stadium.
- Jacksonville was picked to finish third with 65 points. Dayton picked up the remaining first-place vote and 56 total points to finish fourth in the preseason poll. Campbell rounded out the poll's top half with 45 points for fifth place.
- Marist (6th, 42 points), Butler (7th, 34), Morehead State (8th, 27), Davidson (9th, 20) and Valparaiso (10th, 11) rounded out the PFL Preseason Poll.

BULLDOGS LAND FIVE PLAYERS ON PRESEASON ALL-PFL TEAM

- Five Drake Bulldogs earned positions on the 2012 preseason All-Pioneer Football League team.
- Defensive end Brandon Coleman, tight end Kevin Marshall, linebackers Travis Merritt and Tyler Moorehead and quarterback Mike Piatkowski.
- Piatkowski and Moorehead were first-team All-PFL performers on Drake's conference co-champion squad in 2011, while Coleman was a second-team choice and Marshall earned honorable mention.
- Piatkowski is the reigning PFL Offensive Player of the Year and Merritt was Freshman Defensive Player of the Year.
- Coleman, a senior from Cary, Ill. (Cary-Grove) is coming off a stellar junior season in which he recorded a team-high 12.0 sacks (-76) and led all Bulldog defensive linemen with 51 tackles (31 solo) in his first year as a starter. Coleman ranked fourth in the PFL and 10th in the nation (FCS) in sacks, and added 16.5 tackles for loss.
- Marshall, a senior from Glen Ellyn, Ill. (Glenbard South) had a breakout season in 2011, in his second season of eligibility. He caught a career-high 33 passes to rank fourth on the team and totaled 280 receiving yards (8.5) and three touchdowns in his first year as a full-time starter.
- Merritt, a redshirt-sophomore from Johnston, Iowa (Johnston), ranked second on the team in tackles last year with 66 (38 solo), as well as one forced fumble and one fumble recovery in his first year as a starter. He also earned second-team Academic All-PFL honors.
- Moorehead, a fifth-year senior from Mason City, Iowa (Newman Catholic), is a 2012 co-captain for Drake, who has earned first-team All-Pioneer Football League honors each of the past two seasons, and was a first-team Capi-

tal One Academic All-District choice in 2011. Moorehead has led the Bulldogs in tackles each of the past two seasons. Last year he recorded 78 stops (55 solo), including 10.5 sacks (-87) and 21.0 tackles for loss (-109), along with two interceptions, three forced fumbles, two pass breakups and two blocked kicks. Moorehead has started all 33 games in his career and recorded 218 tackles (150 solo), including 14.5 sacks and 40.0 tackles for loss.

- Piatkowski, a co-captain and fifth-year senior from Wheaton, Ill. (Warrenville South), enters his final season as the Bulldogs' signal-caller within reach of most of the school's career passing records.

AT HOME IN DRAKE STADIUM

- Drake had won a program-record 11 home games in a row before falling to Montana State.
- The Bulldogs are now 21-4 at Drake Stadium since Chris Creighton became head coach in 2008.
- The Bulldogs last home winning streak of 10 or more games came from 1995-97.
- Under Creighton, Drake is 14-2 in PFL home games, including winning each of its last eight conference games at Drake Stadium.

BULLDOGS AMONG THE BEST

- Drake ranks 20th in overall victories (573) among the 123 schools that make up the Division I Football Championships Subdivision (FCS).
- This week's game will be the 1,089th in 119 years of football for the school, dating back to the initial campaign in 1893.
- The Bulldogs' all-time record is 573-486-29 (.539).

2012 PRESEASON NOTES

- The 2012 Bulldogs will seek to win back-to-back Pioneer Football League championships for the first time. Drake's previous titles came in 1995, '98, 2000 (co-champions) and '04.
- Five Bulldogs who earned All-PFL recognition last year return in 2012, including first-team All-PFL quarterback and Offensive Player of the Year Mike Piatkowski and Freshman Defensive Player of the Year linebacker Travis Merritt (Johnston, Iowa/Johnston). Also back are two-time first-team All-PFL linebacker Tyler Moorehead, second-team defensive end Brandon Coleman (Cary, Ill./Cary-Grove) and honorable mention tight end Kevin Marshall (Glen Ellyn, Ill. (Glenbard South)).
- Coleman, Marshall, Moorehead and Piatkowski also have been named to the College Football Performance Awards preseason Watch List at their positions.
- Though the Bulldogs lost 52 percent of their pass-catching targets from 2011, they return the QB who threw 97 percent of those pass completions.
- Tight end Kevin Marshall has earned 2012 preseason Watch List status from the College Football Performance Awards after emerging as a new favorite target of Piatkowski's in 2011. He caught a career-high 33 passes for 280 yards (8.5) and three touchdowns to earn honorable mention All-PFL honors last year.
- Four Bulldogs who earned Academic All-PFL accolades in 2011 return this season, including one first-teamer (Moorehead) and three second-teamers (Fuhs, Coleman and Merritt).
- Each of the top three tacklers, and four of the top five, return in 2012 from a defensive unit that ranked No. 2 in the FCS (No. 1 PFL) in rushing yards allowed (77.2) and No. 7 (No. 1 PFL) in points allowed (17.8). The four are: Moorehead (78 tackles), Merritt (66), Michael Ratelle (63) and Coleman (51).
- In addition, a defense that led the PFL and ranked No. 13 in the FCS in tackles for loss returns the top three players in that category, in Moorehead (21.) Coleman (16.5) and Anthony Gianaras (Mundelein, Ill./Mundelein) (9.5), and the personnel who recorded 61.0 of the team's 85.0 TFLs.
- The Bulldogs were one of the nation's top defenses in quarterback sacks (5th FCS, 3rd PFL), and return the top three players in that category, including Coleman (12.0; 10th FCS), Moorehead (10.0) and Gianaras (5.0). Overall, players who accounted for 30.5 of Drake's 39 sacks in 2011 are back in 2012.

DES MOINES, Iowa - The Drake football team trailed early but settled in to defeat Grand View 28-8 Thursday night in front of a crowd of 4,158 in their season opener at Drake Stadium.

After going down a touchdown after a mis-played punt return, the Bulldogs took the lead when Mike Piatkowski (Wheaton, Ill.) floated a one-yard pass to wideout Nick Rosa (Owasso, Okla.). Spencer Lee (Johnston, Iowa) converted the extra point to give the Bulldogs a 7-6 lead.

The Vikings opened the scoring on the night when Neko Graf (Rascine, Wis.) fumbled a punt and the ball was recovered at the Bulldogs 10 yard line. Darius White then carried the ball in on a sweep. Grand View failed to convert the extra point however.

On the ensuing kickoff Mike Ratelle (Edina, Minn.) brought the ball to the Drake 47 to start the drive. The Bulldogs marched down the field on impressive runs from sophomore Gary Scott, Jr. (Forsyth, Ill.) and were capped with the Piatkowski to Rosa connection.

Piatkowski, the 2011 Pioneer Football League Offensive Player of the Year, went 25-41 on the night for 271 yards. He threw two touchdowns and one interception. Rosa led Drake with 68 yards on four catches. Michael Hudson (Urbandale, Iowa) had six catches for 57 yards in his first game with the Bulldogs.

The Vikings put together their best drive of the evening starting at their own 33-yard line and marching the ball all the way down to the Drake 12. The Bulldogs came up with a big stop before slicing through the line in order to block the field goal attempt.

Drake's defense shone the entire night. They held the Vikings to 241 total yards of offense with 12 tackles for a loss and nine sacks.

The Drake offense took advantage of their opponent's miscues when Scott Jr. punched in a two-yard touchdown as the time dwindled down in the first quarter. It was Scott Jr.'s first collegiate rushing touchdown, in his first official game. He also led all rushers with 110 yards on 17 carries. Junior T.J. James (Des Moines, Iowa) carried the ball 11 times for 63 yards.

Yet another special teams miscue lead to the Vikings final points of the game. In the second quarter the Bulldogs lined up to punt deep in their own territory. The snap was well over the head of Jeremy Stein (Carpinteria, Calif.) and out of the endzone for a safety.

The game stalled with neither team amounting any real threat to score for nearly two quarters. The Bulldogs again turned to special teams for help. Senior Naser Hannover (West Des Moines, Iowa) split through the Grand View line and blocked a punt attempt. John Hugunin (Oswego, Ill.) scooped up the ball and took it to the house. Piatkowski again connected with Rosa on the two-point conversion and effectively put the game out

of reach at 22-8.

Drake controlled the ball for the rest of the game and sealed the victory with a Piatkowski touchdown pass to junior Dan Hohenstein (Warrenville, Ill.).

The Bulldogs moved to 1-0 on the season with the victory and 3-0 all time against their cross-town foe.

DES MOINES, Iowa - The Drake University football team kept No. 4 Montana State on the ropes for nearly 60 minutes Saturday evening, but a pair of late touchdowns helped the Bobcats escape Drake Stadium with a 34-24 victory.

The Bulldogs (1-1) led 24-21 at the end of three quarters before MSU (2-0) scored twice and made critical stops on defense to preserve the win in the contest between a pair of defending conference champions.

"This is not ok that we lost, we wanted to come in here tonight and win this game," head coach Chris Creighton said. "Don't get me wrong, that's a great football team that we played, but we came out here to win this game."

Senior quarterback Mike Piatkowski (Wheaton, Ill.) led the Bulldogs' aerial attack with 311 yards on 25-of-43 passing and a touchdown. He also added a touchdown on the ground. However, the Bobcats had a significant advantage on the ground, outgaining Drake, 168-59, with the yardage split almost evenly between Orenzo Davis, Tray Robinson and Cody Kirk.

Drake's defense, especially on the line, continued its strong play with 12 tackles for loss and three sacks against the Bobcats extremely mobile passer, DeNarius McGhee. John Hugunin (Oswego, Ill.), who finished with a game-high 13 tackles, Brett Park (Olivette, Mo.) and Brandon Coleman (Cary, Ill.) each had three tackles for loss.

"Those guys were so focused today that I didn't know what to say to them from the pre-game meal on," Creighton said. "They left everything on the field tonight. Those guys are good."

The Bulldogs took a 17-14 lead into the half on an eight play, 76-yard drive, with a 15-yard touchdown strike from Piatkowski to Hudson. Orlando grabbed another key catch on the drive, this time for 30 yards, to keep the drive alive and set Drake up in the Montana State red zone.

Montana State started the second half with renewed energy. After holding the Bulldogs to a three-and-out, the Bobcats roared down the field to take the lead, 21-17. Quarterback DeNarius McGhee scrambled for two third down conversions, including his five-yard touchdown run.

Later, it was Drake's turn to take advantage of a Montana State mistake, when Drew Ormseth (Lake in the Hills, Ill.) picked off McGhee to give the Bulldogs great field position on the MSU 41-yard line. The passing game continued to be strong as Piatkowski found Marshall once again, this time for a 16-yard gain to set the Bulldogs up inside the five-yard line. Piatkowski got into the endzone on a keeper two plays later from the one-yard line to put the Bulldogs on top, 24-21, with 3:20 remaining in the third quarter.

The Bulldogs stayed within striking distance as sophomore John Bloss (Wheaton, Ill.) recovered a fumble at the Bulldogs' 20-yard line with 7:12

remaining in the fourth quarter. Drake's offense stalled at the 40-yard line after Gary Scott, Jr.'s (Forsyth, Ill.) run on fourth down was smothered.

Montana State didn't put an end to the Bulldogs' upset bid until a touchdown extended its lead, 34-24, with 1:28 remaining in the game. The 9-play, 40-yard drive, erased 3:25 of game clock, which would not leave enough time for Drake to make a comeback.
