THE OFFENSE (part 1)

PUTTING POINTS ON THE BOARD

Morehead State is averaging a Pioneer Football League-best 31.7 points in 2012. The Eagles also have more touchdowns (12) and extra-points (11) than any other conference foe.

THE PFL'S NO. 1 PASSING ATTACK

Morehead State leads the Pioneer Football League with 349 passing yards per game this season, a 66-percent completion rate and nine touchdowns via the aerial attack.

LET'S TALK ABOUT TOTAL YARDS

Morehead State ranks first in the Pioneer Football League with 7.1 yards per play this year and second with 421 yards per contest. MSU has 137 more passing attempts than any other PFL team.

NOW, HOW DOES THIS WORK?

Morehead State places second in the Pioneer Football League with 421 yards per contest, despite being last with an average of just 18 minutes and 38 seconds in time of possession.

AN EFFICIENT FIRST QUARTER

Morehead State scored in each of its first three possessions on Saturday against Saint Francis (Pa.). The Eagles put 17 points on the board in their first 23 offensive plays.

THROWING IT CONSISTENTLY

Dating back to 2011, Morehead State has recorded 300+ passing yards in each of its last seven games.

MOVING THE STICKS

Dating back to 2011, Morehead State has tallied 20+ first downs in six of its last eight contests.

THE OFFENSE (part 2)

I'M THE GUY WHO THROWS IT

Senior **Zach Lewis** ranks second in the Pioneer Football League with 302 passing yards per affair. He is 75-of-117 this season, with eight touchdowns and four interceptions.

... AND I'M THE GUY WHO CATCHES IT

Senior **Donte Sawyer** owns six career games of at least 100 receiving yards. He is tied for second in the Pioneer Football League with 6.7 catches per tilt.

LOOKING AT THE RECORD BOOK

Zach Lewis, who has completed 745-of-1,214 attempts for 8,203 yards and 55 touchdowns in 32 games, is on pace to break multiple Morehead State career records. He needs just 30 completions, 194 attempts, 826 yards and one TD toss to pass Chris Swartz, who quarterbacked the Eagles from 1987-90.

HELPING THE BOTTOM LINE

Senior wide receiver **Kevin Thomas** is tied for first in the Pioneer Football League with 18 points. He rushed for a one-yard score out of the wildcat formation on Saturday vs. Saint Francis (Pa.).

A CAREER-LONG PASS PLAY

Zach Lewis found sophomore slot receiver **Brandon Bornhauser** for a 94-yard touchdown on Saturday against Saint Francis (Pa.). The play was a career long for both players.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Morehead State has had 15 different individuals catch a pass through three games this season. **Donte Sawyer** leads the Eagles in receptions (20), while **Brandon Bornhauser** paces MSU in receiving yards (191).

THE DEFENSE

FLYING TO THE BALL

Morehead State has had 35 different players make a tackle in the first three weeks this season. Sophomore linebacker **Jordan Hendrix** leads the Pioneer Football League with 14.0 tackles per game, while sophomore linebacker **Dillion Blackburn** ranks second with 11.3.

MAKING PLAYS ON "D"

Dillion Blackburn finished just one tackle shy of the Morehead State record on Sept. 8 at No. 21 Eastern Kentucky. He collected 18 stops, including 15 in the first half, while **Jordan Hendrix** added 17 and junior defensive back **John Coleman** contributed 11.

PUTTING IN OVERTIME

Morehead State's defense has been on the field 124 minutes and four seconds this year, which is longer than any other Pioneer Football League team. The Eagles are tied for second in the conference with eight sacks and rank third in pass defense (119 ypg) despite the lopsided time of possession.

THE SPECIAL TEAMS

THIS GUY CAN SCORE POINTS

Senior **Rainer Duzan** leads all Pioneer Football League kickers with 23 points. He is 4-of-5 on field-goal attempts this year and 11-of-12 on extra-point tries.

HE'S THE PUNTER, TOO

Rainer Duzan also ranks second in the Pioneer Football League with an average of 40.5 yards per punt. He has a long of 53 yards on 10 boots this season.

GENERAL NOTES

SHOOTING FOR 100TH WIN

Head Coach **Matt Ballard** will shoot for his 100th win at Morehead State when the Eagles visit Drake on Saturday. Ballard is 99-100 (.498) in his 19th season at MSU and 134-125-1 (.517) in 25 years as a collegiate head coach.

ANALYZING THE SCHEDULE

Morehead State is currently in a 41-day stretch with just one contest at Jayne Stadium (Oct. 6 vs. Jacksonville). The Eagles finish the 2012 schedule with three home games over the final 22 days (Oct. 27 vs. Campbell, Nov. 3 vs. Davidson and Nov. 17 vs. Valparaiso).

MATT BALLARD -- 19th season as head coach at MSU -- 25th as a collegiate HC 99-100 (.498) record at Morehead State -- 134-125-1 (.517) career record

Under Matt Ballard's watch, the Morehead State offense set 17 school records in 2011. The Eagles led the Pioneer Football League in first downs (25.2), passing yards (358.2), total yards (478.9) and points (36.1) per contest.

In 18 previous campaigns, Ballard has led Morehead State to four PFL South Division championships (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005) and a school-record nine wins on two occasions (1998, 2002). He was also named the league's South Division Coach of the Year four straight years from 2002-05.

Ballard was named NCAA Division I-AA Mid-Major National Coach of the Year and Coach of the Year among I-AA Independents in 1998. That Eagle squad was ranked No. 1 among I-AA Mid-Majors by The Football Gazette.

Ballard has directed MSU to NCAA national statistical championships in first downs (2011), tackles for loss (2009), rushing defense (2007), total offense (2000), scoring offense (1997 & 2000) and punt returns (1997). In addition to first downs, his 2011 squad led the league in total yards, passing yards and points per game.

In 2003, Morehead State defensive back Charlie Byrd led the nation in passes defended. In 2005, Nick Feldman led the country in punt returns. In 2007, defensive back David Hyland paced the nation in interceptions per game.

Ballard has coached four NCAA Mid-Major National Players of the Year -- David Dinkins (Offensive Back and National POY), Doug Turner (Offensive Back), Bubba Combs (Offensive Lineman) and Toby Moeves (Specialist).

Ballard compiled a 35-25-1 record in six seasons as the head coach at Union College (Ky.) from 1988-93. He led the Bulldogs to their best single-season record and the institution's first Mid-South Football Conference championship. He was named Mid-South and NAIA District 32 Coach of the Year in 1992.

Ballard was the assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Morehead State from 1984-87. Prior to his first stint at MSU, Ballard also logged four years (1980-83) as the offensive/defensive coordinator at Georgetown College (Ky.) and one season (1979) as an assistant coach at Gardner-Webb.

A native of Davidson, N.C., Ballard graduated from North Mecklenburg High School in Huntersville, N.C. He earned a bachelor's degree from Gardner-Webb in 1979 and master's degree from Georgetown College in 1980.

Ballard is active in many community service projects. He actively supports two scholarship funds named in honor of his son, Matthew -- one at Rowan County High School and one at Morehead State. Matthew was a student football coach at MSU when he was tragically killed in a motorcycle accident on July 12, 2005.
