Sycamores Wrap Up Home Portion Of League Schedule Against Drake On Wednesday Evening

SETTING THE STAGE

Indiana State continues year three of the Greg Lansing era on Wednesday, February 27 when the Sycamores (17-11, 9-7 MVC) conclude a three-game home stand against Drake (13-15, 6-10 MVC) inside Hulman Center. Tip-off is set for 7:05 p.m. (ET). The game will be broadcast live online on a pay-per-view basis on Sycamore Vision with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. The game can also be heard on the radio via WIBQ 98.5 FM and along the Nelligan Sports Marketing Radio Network with Brian Fritz (pbp) and Matt Renn (analyst) on the call. GoSycamores.com will have an audio only production of the radio broadcast as well. A guide on how to access the Sycamore Vision broadcast can be found on page 2 of this release.

THE DRAKE SERIES

Indiana State holds a 40-36 record in the all-time series against Drake, which dates back to 1945. The Sycamores have won seven of the last nine games against the Bulldogs, including each of the last four inside Hulman Center. ISU is 27-10 all-time against Drake at home.

QUICK HITS

- The Sycamores are one of the best in the MVC against the RPI Top 60 with four victories, including a neutral court victory over No. 2 Miami as well as No. 57 Ole Miss, a home win over No. 41 Creighton and a road victory over No. 30 Wichita State. Indiana State has the third-best RPI in the MVC with a No. 61 mark.
- The victory over Creighton on Feb. 6 was the 1,400th victory in the history of the program and its best victory over a ranked team inside Hulman Center since joining the MVC against the Top 25 as the Bluejays were ranked No. 13.
- No. 13 Creighton is the highest ranked opponent to fall to the Sycamores since No. 13 Oklahoma was defeated by the 2001 Sycamores in the NCAA Tournament.
- Indiana State is 13-2 on the season when holding teams to 63 points or less and is 39-3 when doing so under third-year head coach Greg Lansing (and 14-0 when limiting teams to 53 or less).
- Indiana State has earned 45 close victories (five points or less) since 2005. Under Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 19-10 in close games.
- Jake Odum now has 428 career assists which ranks him eighth on the Indiana State Career List. He is one of eight Sycamores to be in ISU Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.
- Jake Odum now has 1,071 career points scored as he tossed in 10 against Iona on February 23. Odum is the 35th member of the ISU 1,000-point club and is just the eighth Sycamore to reach that mark during his junior season.
- Jake Odum has reached double figures scoring in each of the last nine games.
- Indiana State is 11-3 this season when hitting at least 36.4 percent of their 3-pointers.
- Indiana State has held two opponents this season without a 3-point field goal (Miami & Illinois State).
- The Sycamores have defeated a pair of nationally-ranked teams this season — a road win over No. 14 Wichita State on January 29 as well as a home court win over No. 13 Creighton on February 6.
- Jake Odum has made 163 free throws this season and moved into the ISU Top 10 for most charity tosses made in a single-season at Bradley (now in sixth place) while his 210 free throw attempts are 10th all-time. He made 19 in a row prior to a first half miss against Wichita State on February 19.

The Indiana State Head Coach

Indiana State head coach Greg Lansing (South Dakota, 1990) is 55-40 (.579) overall in his third season as a head coach. He is 29-23 all-time in MVC games, including a 20-6 mark at home and a 9-17 record on the road. During his career, he is 32-9 in all home games, 14-25 on the road, 9-6 in neutral court contests and 19-10 in games decided by five points or less. Lansing is 3-2 against Drake, including a mark of 2-0 at home versus the Bulldogs. With the Trees, Lansing is 4-4 in overtime games and 39-3 when holding teams to 63 points or less. Wednesday's game will be Greg Lansing's 96th as Indiana State head coach. Lansing is the second head coach to lead the Sycamores to the NCAA Tournament in their rookie campaign in the history of the program, with the other being Bill Hodges leading ISU to a 33-1 record and a Final Four appearance in the 1979 NCAA Tournament. Lansing was just the 14th rookie head coach in the history of the MVC to lead his team to 20 victories during their debut season.

A Little History

Indiana State is currently in its 117th season of college basketball at the school. The Sycamores are 1,402-1,207 all-time on the hardwood. Indiana State's 76-57 home court victory over No. 13/16 Creighton was the 1,400th victory in the history of the program on February 6.

Sycamores In Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters For Ninth Time

Indiana State's game against Iona on February 23 was part of the Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters, which marked the Sycamores ninth year of participating in the scheduling concept and was the first year ISU made an appearance on the ESPN Television package. With the victory, ISU is now 4-5 in Bracketbuster games, including a mark of 2-3 at home. The MVC made a national-best 47 appearances on the ESPN Family Of Networks over the 11-year history of the event. Indiana State had lost three consecutive Bracketbusters games, dating back to a victory at home over Toledo in 2009 prior to the victory over Iona.

Indiana State Looking To Cap Off Best MVC Home Campaign Since 1999-00

With one home game remaining in MVC play for the Sycamores (against Drake on February 27), Indiana State currently sits at 7-1 inside Hulman Center during league competition this season. With a victory, the Sycamores will finish at least 8-1 on their home court in MVC play for the first time since a perfect 9-0 mark in 1999-00, a year in which they won the league championship. All-time, Indiana State has finished with at least an 8-1 mark at home inside MVC play just five times (undefeated twice) and in the seasons in which they went undefeated the Sycamores also won the league championship. In the three times the Sycamores have gone 8-1 in MVC play, the lone defeat was at the hands of the MVC Regular Season Champions. So far, ISU's lone loss this season is to Wichita State, which currently holds a one-game lead in the conference standings with two games remaining.

Manny Arop Averaging A Double-Double Over Current Homestand

Indiana State junior Manny Arop averaged a double-double as the Sycamores split a pair of home games against Wichita State and Iona. Arop held a 13.5 ppg average and led the team with a 10.5 rebounds per game average. He was 9-of-10 from the free throw line with two assists, three blocked shots and two steals. Arop scored 10 points against Iona and pulled down a career-high 12 rebounds to post his third double-double of the season. He led the team with 17 points against Wichita State, including a pair of 3-pointers as he scored the first eight points of the game against the Shockers. Arop also had nine rebounds versus Wichita State, one rebound shy of posting a pair of double-doubles over the two-game stretch.

RJ Mahurin Leading Team In Scoring Average Over Last Two Games

Indiana State junior forward RJ Mahurin led the Sycamores with a 14.5 ppg average to go with 4.5 rebounds as the Sycamores split a pair of home games against Wichita State and Iona. Mahurin began the week with a 13-point showing against the Shockers on the strength of a 4-of-8 showing from the field, including a pair of 3-pointers and a perfect 3-of-3 mark from the free throw line with three rebounds. He added one assist and one steal and scored the first six points against the Shockers, hitting a pair of early

- Give the Sycamores their 10th MVC victory on the season, which would mark just the ninth time in 36 seasons that ISU has reached double figures in Missouri Valley victories.
- Give head coach Greg Lansing 30 MVC victories, becoming just the fourth Sycamore head coach to win at least 30 Missouri Valley games at the helm.
- Improve the Sycamores to 8-1 on the season in MVC home contests, which would be just the sixth time in 36 seasons that ISU has finished 8-1 or better at home in league play. ISU last reached that mark with a perfect 9-0 mark at home in 1999-00, the last time ISU won the MVC Regular Season Championship.

treys. He went on to score 16 points against Iona, including several second half baskets as the Sycamores won their Bracketbusters contest. He was 6-of-11 from the field, hit two more three pointers and added six rebounds with an assist, blocked shot and two steals in the contest. For the week, Mahurin was 10-of-19 from the field (52.6 percent), including a mark of 4-of-9 from 3-point range (44.4 percent) with two assists, one blocked shot and three steals.

Jake Odum Moving Up Indiana State Single Season Free Throw List

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum entered the Bradley game with 149 free throws on the year and with his 10 made in the game at Bradley on February 16, he entered the Sycamore single-season Top 10 list, passing Larry Bird, Jerry Newsom and Wayne Allison and now has 163 on the year (through Iona game), which ranks sixth. Bird's 221 made free throws in 1978-79, is the school record. Throughout the course of the Bradley game, Odum passed both Bird and Duane Klueh, the only two Sycamores to have their jerseys retired. His 10-of-10 free throw performance is the best by an Indiana State player since Dwayne Lathan made 10-of-10 against Southern Illinois on February 11, 2012. Additionally, Odum made 19 free throws in a row dating back to the Southern Illinois contest on February 9 and extending to the first half of the Wichita State game on Feb. 19. Odum is five made free throws away from tying Bird again (168 in 76-77) for fifth on the ISU single-season list. Additionally, Odum has attempted 210 free throws this season, which is eighth on the ISU single-season free throws attempted list and needs three more to tie Butch Wade for seventh.

Jake Odum Is Just Eighth Sycamore Sophomore To Join The ISU 1,000-Point Club

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum reached the 1,000-point mark for his career as he posted a team-best 22 points in the victory over No. 13/16 Creighton on February 6 inside Hulman Center. Odum became the 35th member of the Indiana State 1,000 Point Club with a free throw late in the second half against the Bluejays. Odum is just the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to reach the 1,000-point mark during his junior season. With his 10 points against Iona, Odum now has 1,074 career points, which tied with Howard Dardeen for 30th on the ISU scoring list and needs seven more to tie Travis Inman for 29th. Other Sycamores to reach 1,000 points by the end of their junior campaign are Larry Bird (1,877 in two seasons), John Sherman Williams (1,787), Jerry Newsom (1,338), Butch Wade (1,135), David Moss (1,214), Eddie Bird (1,207) and Kelyn Block (1,018).

Jake Odum Now One Of Eight Players At ISU To Reach The Career Top 10 Lists For Assists & Steals

Indiana State junior guard Jake Odum has 163 career steals, which ranks him sixth all-time in the Sycamore basketball record book, needing two more to reach fifth place, currently held by Matt Renn (165 from 1997-01). Odum also now has 428 assists for his career which is good enough for seventh place. He needs seven more to catch Larry Bird (435 from 1976 to 1979) for sixth all-time. Odum is the eighth Sycamore in the history of the program to rank in the Indiana State Top 10 for both assists and steals in a career.

Indiana State Has Reached 17 Regular Season Victories For Fourth Consecutive Season; First Time Since Early 1960's

With its 65-64 victory over Iona on February 23, 2013, the Sycamores have now posted at least 17 victories for the fourth consecutive season, which is the first time four Indiana State teams have reached that mark in succession since the 1960-61, 1961-62, 1962-63 and 1963-64 seasons. The Sycamores won 17 in 60-61, 19 in 61-62, 18 in 62-63 and 17 in 63-64. The Sycamores won 17 games in 2009-10, 20 in 2010-11, 18 in 2011-12 and 17 so far this season. Indiana State has also secured its fourth consecutive winning season for the first time since a stretch of campaigns in 1997-98 through 2000-01.

Newcomers Are No Problem For Indiana State

With Jake Odum being the lone Sycamore starter to return in 2012-13, Indiana State has relied on a stable of five newcomers so far this season for a large chunk of its offensive production. Led by Manny Arop, who is a two-time MVC Newcomer Of The Week selection and is currently second on the team with a 12.6 ppg average ISU has seen over four of every 10 points come from someone who was not on the active roster one year ago. For the season, 781 points have come from newcomers, of a total of 1,889 scored (41.3 percent).

Sycamore Success Inside Hulman Center Under Greg Lansing

The Sycamores are 32-9 (.780) inside Hulman Center under third-year head coach Greg Lansing. The Sycamores have won 23 of their last 29 home games. Additionally, the Sycamores have won 20 of their last

63 Is The Magic Number

The Sycamores win by the score of 76-57 on February 6 against Creighton was ISU's 13th this season in which they held an opponent to 63 points or less and earned the victory. ISU is currently 13-2 on the season when holding an opponent under that total. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 39-3 when allowing less than 63 points to the opposition (including a 14-0 mark when holding teams to 53 or less).

Good Starter On The Battery

Indiana State is 10-4 this season when the Sycamore starters outscore their counterparts for the opposition. Under third-year head coach Greg Lansing, the Sycamores are 34-11 when the ISU starting five scores more than their opponent's starters.

No. 13/16 Creighton Is The Highest Nationally Ranked Opponent To Fall At Hulman Center In MVC Era

The No. 13/16 Creighton Bluejays rolled into Hulman Center on February 2 as the highest ranked team to take on the Sycamores at home since No. 12 Tulsa visited on Feb. 2, 1985. With the 76-57 victory against the Bluejays, the Sycamores are now 11-18 all-time against nationally-ranked opponents and earned their first victory inside Hulman Center against a ranked foe since downing No. 14 Butler in December of 2006. It was the highest ranked opponent that ISU has beaten anywhere since a victory over No. 13 Oklahoma in the 2001 NCAA Tournament. No. 13/16 Creighton is the highest ranked opponent to fall to the Sycamores inside Hulman Center in the MVC era.

Greg Lansing Takes Suits and Sneakers For Cancer Awareness To The Indiana State Capital Building

Indiana State and Northern Iowa participated in the annual Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneaks Challenge along with the rest of the nation's teams this weekend. All of the basketball coaches in the state of Indiana have issued a challenge to the state's lawmakers to wear sneakers with their suits on Monday, January 28 as part of the program to promote cancer awareness. Through an invitation from State Representative Bob Heaton, who played for ISU on the 1978-79 team which advanced to the NCAA Final Four, ISU head coach Greg Lansing will officially issue the day's challenge to Indiana Speaker Of The House Brian Bosma at the State House in Indianapolis on January 28.

Sycamores Have Held Two Teams This Season Without A Triple

Indiana State did not allow a made 3-pointer at Illinois State on January 23 as the Redbirds went 0-for-13 from long range on their home court and snapped a string of over 400 games with one which dated back to 1999. It marked the second time this season that the Sycamores have not allowed a trey in a game as nationally-ranked Miami went 0-of-15 back on December 25 in the consolation game of the Diamond Head Classic. For the season, the Sycamores are allowing teams to make just 30.4 percent of their threes attempted (96-of-316), which ranks third in the MVC behind Missouri State and Creighton.

Jake Odum Named One Of 25 Finalists For the Lou Henson Award; Earlier Named To 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List

Jake Odum has been named to the 2013 Bob Cousy Award Watch List and is one of 25 finalists for the Lou Henson Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. The Lou Henson Award goes to the nation's top mid-major college basketball player. A fan vote determines 33 percent of the overall final award tally and fans may vote for Odum by visiting <http://www.votelouhenson.com>. The Lou Henson Award will be presented during final four weekend.

Sycamores In Postseason Play For Third Consecutive Season

With Indiana State's appearance in the 2012 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament, the Sycamores have now made three consecutive trips to postseason play. ISU played in the 2010 College Basketball Invitational as well as the 2011 NCAA Tournament in addition to the CIT Tournament in 2012. The last time the Sycamores reached postseason play for three consecutive seasons came in 1977-79 when Indiana State played in the 1977 & 1978 NIT as well as the 1979 NCAA Tournament. The last time Indiana State hosted a postseason game came on March 10, 1978 when the Sycamores hosted Illinois State in the first round of the NIT.

Jake Odum Named To The Preseason All-Missouri Valley Team

Indiana State guard Jake Odum was one of five student-athletes named to the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Team on October 29. Odum finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a 4.9 assists per game average. That mark was ranked 61st nationally. Odum recorded a career-high 12 assists against Fairfield as part of the Old Spice Classic, a number which ranked tied for fourth all-time at ISU in a single game. Odum is third in the MVC in steals per game with a 1.8 average, which ranks 81st nationally. Additionally, Odum's 4.5 assists per game average of his career is fifth-best in the history of the program while his 119 steals are ranked ninth-best in the Sycamore record books, while his 1.8 steals per game average ranks third.

Sycamores Picked To Finish 7th In Missouri Valley Conference Race

The Indiana State Sycamores were picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Conference race according to a poll of league head coaches, sports information directors and a media panel. ISU finished eighth last season, with an 8-10 MVC record, just one game out of a large logjam for third place at 9-9.

The Last Time Out ...

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. -- For the first time since a span between 1960-64 Indiana State basketball has won at least 17 regular season games in a row for four consecutive seasons thanks a Dawon Cummings lay-up with four seconds left which propelled the Sycamores to a 65-64 victory over Iona in the Ramada Worldwide Bracketbusters Series in front of 4,378 fans inside Hulman Center.

ISU stopped a three-game skid with the victory and improved to 17-11 while Iona fell to 15-13. The Sycamores also stopped a three-game Bracketbusters skid and now stand at 4-5 all-time in the scheduling concept.

Indiana State hit 25-of-62 shots from the field (40.3 percent) while limiting Iona to a 22-of-59 mark (37.3 percent). The Sycamores owned a 40-39 edge on the glass, but trailed 14-12 in second chance points.

The Sycamores had 18 assists in the game off of 25 made field goals. Justin Gant and Arop had two blocks each.

Cummings finished the game with 13 points, including a lay-up off a feed from Jake Odum with four seconds remaining to push the Sycamores ahead 65-64. ISU was paced in scoring by RJ Mahurin who scored 16 points as he was 6-of-11 from the field while Manny Arop posted a double-double with 10 points and a career-high 12 rebounds. Odum also finished with double figures scoring as he tallied 10 points with seven assists, four rebounds and two steals in 37 minutes of action.

A pair of Lamont Jones free throws with 3:51 remaining tied the game for the ninth time at 58. Arop countered with a pair of free throws of his own to surge the Sycamores ahead 60-58 with 2:48 on the clock.

Jones answered with a tough jumper at the 2:22 mark and after Mahurin missed a leaner, Jones gave the Gaels the lead at the 1:40 mark with another score to put Iona up 62-60.

Odum found himself open for a 3-pointer at the top of the key with 1:13 remaining to put the Sycamores ahead 63-62 with 1:13 left before the Sycamores forced two missed shots but David Laurey hauled in the final rebound at the 29 second mark when a jump ball was called.

Sean Armand was fouled with nine seconds left and hit both free throws to push Iona ahead 64-63, but Odum found Cummings with the game winner as he layed the ball in and was fouled with four seconds left for the 65-64 lead. Cummings missed the free throws and Iona tried a desperation half court shot at the buzzer which was well short and ISU held on for the victory.

Mahurin came out of the gate hot as he hit each of first two 3-point attempts while Cummings also scored a lay-up for an 8-2 lead just over two minutes in and forced Iona to call their first timeout.

The Gaels whittled the Sycamore lead down to just 8-6, but the Sycamores scored the the next seven points, including an Odum 3-pointer and a lay-up from Arop for a 15-6 advantage with 14:23 left in the first half.

Iona tied the game at 22 with 5:32 left before the break but did not score again before the half as ISU went on an 8-0 run to take a 30-22 advantage in the locker room. Odum converted a pair of free throws with 1:15 on the clock for the eight-point cushion.

After the half, the Sycamores got a dunk from Cummings off the feed from Odum for a 32-22 advantage -- its largest of the contest with 19:48 left in the game.

Iona put together a 7-0 run of its own which was capped off a Jones lay-up after the steals to trim the ISU lead down to just 34-21 with 17:28 left.

Mahurin stopped the bleeding with a jumper in the paint to stretch the lead out to 36-31. Taaj Ridley hit a lay-up with 12:47 left to cap a 5-0 run which ended with a jumper by Cummings at the 11:58 mark to trim the Iona lead down to 45-44.

ISU scored six in a row with back-to-back 3-pointer from Lucas Eitel at the 7:07 and 6:23 marks to stake the Sycamores to a 57-53 lead, but ISU only scored on a Mahurin free throws with 5:12 remaining over the next four minutes as the Jones knotted the score at 58.

Jones was one of two Gaels to reach double figures scoring as he hit 8-of-20 shots from the field and was 10-of-11 from the free throw line to score 26 points. Ridley added 16.

Indiana State Head Basketball Coach Third Season

Greg Lansing is in his third season as the head basketball coach at Indiana State. He previously spent eight seasons with the program as an assistant coach, including the previous three as associate head coach.

Lansing burst onto the scene as a rookie head coach with the Sycamore basketball program in 2010-11 as he became just the second-ever Indiana State head coach to lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season. He led the team to a 20-14 record, becoming just the 14th head coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to lead a team to 20 or more victories in their first year at the helm.

In 2011-12, the Sycamores finished the year with an 18-15 record and advanced to the CollegelInsiders.com Postseason Tournament. It marked the third consecutive year the team has reached postseason play -- its longest such stretch since the 1977, 1978 and 1979 seasons when Larry Bird donned the Indiana State uniform.

Jake Odum was one of just four players nationally to average at least 10 points, five rebounds and 4.5 assists per game during his sophomore season and was a Second Team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection as well as Second Team All-District selection as announced by the National Association of Basketball Coaches.

The Sycamores downed No. 25 nationally-ranked Vanderbilt on the road and finished third at the Old Spice Classic -- the best-ever finish by a MVC team in the event.

ISU reached the NCAA Tournament and took on Syracuse in Cleveland, Ohio based on the program's third-ever MVC Tournament Championship won at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis, Mo. ISU raced to the title with victories over No. 6 Evansville, No. 2 Wichita State and No. 1 Missouri State in the Championship Game as the Sycamores entered as the No. 3 seed in the tournament. Freshman Jake Odum was named to the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Odum was named a CollegelInsider.com Mid Major Freshman All-American and was named an All-MVC Honorable Mention selection as well as a member of the MVC All-Freshman, All-Newcomer and All-Defense Team. Carl Richard was also named to the All-MVC's Honorable Mention squad. ISU took two thrilling buzzer beating victories over league foes Missouri State and Creighton during the regular season at Hulman Center. The buzzer beater over Creighton by Richard was voted the No. 2 play of the weekend by ESPN's SportsCenter.

In 2009-10 the Sycamores overcame a ton of adversity to still put together its best season in nearly a decade under the professional leadership of the ISU coaching staff. Despite only having its full compliment of student-athletes for just 28 minutes of the rough and tumble Missouri Valley Conference slate, the Sycamores still recorded its first winning season since 2001 as they finished 17-15. ISU also finished the year with a 9-9 record in league play, bolstering the Sycamores out of the MVC Opening Round at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament by securing the league's No. 6 seed after

finishing in a tie for fifth in the standings.

Starting guard Jake Kelly suffered a season ending knee injury with 12 minutes left in the conference opener at Southern Illinois and subsequently also lost Dwayne Lathan and Harry Marshall for extended periods over the course of the year.

Marshall, who was the heart and sole of the team, led the MVC in scoring in league contests with a 16.0 ppg average. Marshall was tabbed Second Team All-MVC and was named to the MVC's All-Defensive Team after turning in shutdown performances against most of the league's all-conference opposition. Running a well-rounded program, the Sycamores also two representatives on the MVC's Scholar Athlete Team as both Jordan Printy and Aaron Carter took those plaudits.

The payoff for the Sycamores continued as ISU reached postseason play for the first since 2001 when they accepted a bid to the 2010 College Basketball Invitational, appearing in a road contest at Saint Louis.

With a keen attention to details that most coaches think of as an afterthought, the Sycamores concentrated on extreme efficiency on the court, finishing the year as the nation's second leading free throw shooting team. ISU's 76.9 percent mark at the line finished just behind NCAA qualifier BYU on the NCAA Division I list for the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

Additionally, the Sycamores overcame a 24-point deficit in the second half at Missouri State before falling in overtime. The 24-point comeback in front of a national television audience was the largest in the history of the MVC by a team that at least forced overtime.

During his second stint with the Sycamore basketball program, Lansing has been a key recruiting for many talented student-athletes. Lansing has also been a major part of the several all-conference accolades for several players, including Harry Marshall and Jay Tunnell, who took All-MVC honors following the 2008-09 campaign. Last season, the Sycamores concluded the regular season by winning six of their final games, including a trio of road contests.

Lansing returned to Indiana State after a seven year stint with the Iowa Hawkeyes. During Lansing's seven years as assistant coach at Iowa, the Hawkeyes went 135-92, received three NCAA Tournament invitations, three NIT appearances and won a pair of Big Ten tournament titles, the first of which came on four wins in four games making Iowa the first team in the Big Ten to ac-

complish such a feat. In 2005-06, Iowa earned a 25-9 record, the second-most wins in school history, the first undefeated (17-0) home record in the school's history and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Iowa earned seven All-Big Ten selections, 17 Academic All-Big Ten selections and four Academic All-Americans. Lansing coached four of the last five Big Ten rebounding champions, three straight conference leaders in blocked shots and, the league's 2005-06 defensive player of the year. Three of his student-athletes reached the NBA and two from the 2005-06 team were invited to NBA camps.

In Lansing's final two seasons of his first stint at Indiana State, the Sycamores posted back-to-back winning campaigns for the first time since 1979 and 1980. When the Sycamores posted a 16-11 record in 1998 it marked the first winning season for Indiana State since 1980. Indiana State advanced to the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

Prior to joining the staff at Indiana State, Lansing was the head basketball coach at Roosevelt High School in Des Moines, Iowa. Roosevelt had not had a winning season in 12 years before Lansing's initial season. The Roughriders went on to have back-to-back winning seasons under Greg's direction.

Lansing earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of South Dakota in 1990 and a master's degree in counseling from USD in 1992. As a member of the Coyote basketball team Lansing helped South Dakota reach the NCAA Division II Tournament during his junior and senior seasons, the first NCAA invitation for USD since 1954. He was twice named the South Dakota Defensive Player of the Year. Greg is currently ranked among the leaders in career assists at USD. Following his playing career, Lansing served as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota for two seasons. In 1992-93 he was a full-time assistant.

Greg's father, Dave Lansing, coached high school basketball for 33 years in Iowa. Dave Lansing was inducted into the Iowa High School Athletic Association Coaches Hall of Fame during the 1999 Iowa boys state basketball tournament. Lansing's dad, his mother, Diane, his sister, Angela, and his nephew, Jordan, live in West Des Moines. His brother, Steve, is the head basketball coach at Faribault High School (Minn.), where he was named Regional Coach of the Year in 2004. Lansing is married to the former Angie Menser, who is an Indiana State graduate and a former track and cross country academic All-American for the Sycamores. She currently serves as ISU's senior women's administrator and athletics business manager.
