## Southern Illinois (13-16, 5-12) at Drake (14-15, 7-10)

### Setting the stage

Southern Illinois will be the No. 10 seed at the MVC Tournament. If the Salukis win on Saturday, they will play the winner of the Bradley at Missouri State game. If they lose, the Salukis will play either Drake or Illinois State, depending on what ISU does (If Illinois State wins at UNI, SIU plays Drake. If ISU loses at UNI, SIU plays ISU).

### Salukis post five wins in February for first time since 2008

The Salukis were 5-3 in February games — the most victories since winning six in 2008. SIU has won five of its last seven games, including five-straight at home.

### Road losing streak

Southern has a 15-game losing streak in road MVC games, tying the longest such streak in school history (1982-84). SIU's last Valley road win came at Bradley on Jan. 4, 2012. The team's last win away from SIU Arena came on Dec. 21, 2012, versus Nicholls State in Logan, Utah.

### Series versus Bulldogs

Drake has won eight-straight games versus the Salukis. The last Saluki

victory over Drake came four years ago on Feb. 25, 2009, at the Knapp Center.

### Defense pitches shutouts

In the last four home games, the Salukis have held opponents scoreless for extended stretches — Missouri State (4:54 to open the game), Evansville (8:16 during the second half), Miami University (7:03 during first half) and Northern Iowa (3:55 to open the game).

### Desmar Jackson for All-Conference?

G Desmar Jackson (6-5, 173, Jr.) leads the team in scoring (15.2 ppg) and will become the first Saluki guard to average double-figures since Kevin Dillard, who averaged 12.3 points in the 2009-10 season. The last time a Saluki player was named to the All-Conference team was 2008 (Randal Falker-1st, Bryan Mullins-2nd). It is the longest period without a player on the First or Second team in school history.

### Jackson's 20+ point games

Jackson reeled off three-consecutive 20-point games at Wichita State (28), versus Indiana State (29) and at Bradley (21). The last Saluki to score 20+ in three consecutive games was Kent Williams in Nov./Dec. of 2001.

**Jeff Early leads nation in rebounding among under 6-foot-1**

F Jeff Early (6-1, 187, Sr.) leads in the nation in rebounding (7.4 rpg) among players who stand 6-foot-1 and under. Evansville 6-foot guard Troy Taylor (7.1 rpg) is second. Although he is only 6-foot-1, Early technically plays the hybrid "4" spot.

Last Saturday, Early had a blockbuster game versus Miami University, in which he scored a career-high 31 points, including a buzzer beater in regulation that sent the game to overtime, where SIU eventually won. Early also had 12 rebounds and three steals, recording his eighth double-double of the season and ninth of his two-year career at Southern.

**Breaking the 65-point plateau**

SIU has not surpassed the 65-point plateau on offense during regulation play since scoring 66 at Bradley on Jan. 15 — a span of 12 games. The last time Southern went 12-straight games without topping 65 points during regulation was the 1945 season.

**Trending**

G Kendal Brown-Surles (5-9, 174, Sr.) has made at least one 3-pointer in nine-straight games...G Anthony Beane (6-2, 171, Fr.) is 7-for-18 from 3-point range in the last eight games...G Jalen Pendleton (6-2, 201, Fr.) is averaging 8.0 ppg in the last seven games.

**Veteran starting lineup**

In SIU's current starting lineup, four players are age 22 or older — Jeff Early (24), T.J. Lindsay (23), Desmar Jackson (22) and Kendal Brown-Surles (22). Early is the oldest player in the MVC. Dantiel Daniels is 20.

**Beane ranks second in scoring MVC freshmen**

G Anthony Beane (6-2, 171, Fr.) averages 9.3 points per game, third-best on the team and second among freshmen in the MVC. He has scored double figures in nine conference games. Beane originally committed to Illinois State, but came with his father to SIU.

**Jalen Pendleton named MVC Newcomer of the Week**

G Jalen Pendleton (6-2, 201, Fr.) was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Feb. 11. The Evansville native averaged

12.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in a win over Wichita State and loss to Indiana State. He scored the final six points in the two-point win over the Shockers. At ISU, he scored a career-high 17 points. He was 9-of-13 from the field and 6-of-6 from the FT line on the week.

**Salukis post first win over ranked team since 2008**

When the Salukis beat No. 22-ranked Wichita State on Feb. 4, it marked their first win over a ranked team since beating No. 15 Drake in 2008. SIU had lost nine-straight games to ranked teams since that time.

**KBS is active scoring, assists leader**

G Kendal Brown-Surles (5-9, 175, Sr.) is the active leader in scoring and assists at SIU with 716 career points and 276 assists during his four-year, 115-game career. He has made 67 career starts, more than any other player on the team. KBS ranks 14th in career assists and 13th in career 3-pointers at SIU.

**No starter taller than 6-foot-5**

The Salukis have no starters and only one active player taller than 6-foot-5 (forward Davante Drinkard is 6-9).

**Dantiel Daniels second in MVC in field goal percentage**

It's been an injury-plagued season for F Dantiel Daniels (6-5, 230, So.), who has missed all or part of five games, but he is second in the MVC in field goal percentage (.600). Last year, he led the MVC in blocked shots (1.6) and was named to the MVC's All-Freshman team.

**Salukis 2-9 without Daniels**

In the last two seasons, Saluki F Dantiel Daniels has missed part or all of 11 games with injuries. SIU is 2-9 in those games, with its only wins coming at Chicago State and New Orleans.

**Points off turnovers**

One of the reasons why Southern is shooting better this year (.441) compared to last (.414) is its ability to score off of opponent turnovers. The Salukis are +5.5 in points off turnovers, out-scoring opponents 503-344.

**2002-07 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids**

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008. The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough for the program. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation

and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia.

The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

**Swan out for the season**

Josh Swan (6-2, 181, So.) is out for the season with a knee injury. He made 24-of-47 (.511) shots from the field in conference games after going 10-for-29 (.345) in non-conference games.

**Simultaneous double-doubles**

Desmar Jackson (6-5, 173, Jr.) and Jeff Early (6-1, 187, Sr.) have each recorded double-doubles in the same game (at SIUE and vs. Nicholls State) twice this year. Prior to this season, the last time two Salukis recorded a double-double in the same game was on Feb. 23, 2002, when both Jermaine Dearman and Rolan Roberts posted double-doubles at Indiana State.

**Salukis snap losing streaks**

By winning their season opener, the Salukis broke two losing streaks dating back to last year. SIU entered the game at New Orleans having lost seven-straight games overall and eight-straight on the road. The 17-point victory over UNO was the largest road margin since SIU won at SEMO by 21 points on Dec. 9, 2009 — a span of 35 road games.

**Barry Hinson is 13th head coach in school history**

Barry Hinson is the 13th head coach in 99 years of Saluki Basketball. He spent the past four years on Bill Self's staff at the University of Kansas. In that time KU posted a combined 106-20 record.

**Hinson familiar with the MVC**

Hinson was the head coach at MVC member Missouri State for nine seasons (2000-08). While at Missouri State,

he guided the Bears to a 169-117 record (.591) with postseason NIT teams in 2000, 2005, 2006 and 2007.

### Taylor returns

G Diamond Taylor (6-4, 173, Jr.) has played five games this semester after being suspended for the first semester. Taylor originally signed with Wisconsin, but transferred to SIU in the fall of 2009.

### At home versus MVC

During six seasons from 2001-02 through the 2007-08 campaign, SIU posted a 62-2 record against MVC opponents on its home court. The last four+ seasons, however, the Salukis are 20-25 in league home games.

### Transfer U

The downward trend in Saluki Basketball in recent years corresponded with the transfer of numerous key players to other successful programs. Former Salukis Brandon Wood (Michigan State) and Anthony Booker (Iowa State) helped lead their teams to the NCAA Tournament last year. Former Salukis Kevin Dillard (Dayton) and Gene Teague (Seton Hall) are currently among the leading scorers on their respective teams this year. Former Salukis Treg Setty (Ohio) and Harry Whitt (Utah) are sitting out this season after transferring during the off-season.

### NIT Championship in 1967

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

### Five at-large NCAA bids

At-large bids to the NCAA Tournament are hardly uncommon for

Southern Illinois, which received four in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

### True freshmen Bola Olaniyan and Chase Heins to redshirt

Coach Hinson said true freshmen forwards Bola Olaniyan (6-8, 219, Fr.) and Chase Heins (6-6, 264, Fr.) will both redshirt this season. Olaniyan must redshirt due to NCAA transcript guidelines, while Heins had surgery for a leg injury.

### Salukis 8-3 in BracketBuster games

The 11-year BracketBuster event was good for the Salukis, who posted an 8-3 mark, including a 6-1 home record in the series. The wins in 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2007 all strengthened SIU's resume and helped it earn at-large bids to the NCAA Tournament.
