**NORMAN, Okla.** - The Drake softball team (12-8) travels to Norman, Okla. for the Oklahoma Spring Preview Tournament with four games scheduled. Drake plays the Northern Colorado Bears on Friday at 1 p.m. before facing the No. 2 Oklahoma Sooners at 6 p.m. On Saturday the Bulldogs face Northern Colorado at 11 a.m. and Oklahoma at 4 p.m. The Oklahoma games will have free live video streaming and all games will have live stats available on Gametracker.

### ABOUT THIS WEEK'S OPPONENTS

#### Northern Colorado (7-11-1)

The Bears are led at the plate by senior outfielder Lindsey Smith, who leads the team in average (.345), doubles (9), home runs (3) and RBI (17). Kelci Cheney is the top pitcher for Northern Colorado with a 5-2 record and a 3.16 earned run average and 39 strikeouts. Northern Colorado is coming off a 10-0 loss to Colorado State on Wednesday night. Shana Easley is in her first season as head coach after spending the past four seasons as an assistant coach at UMKC. A Loveland, Colo. native, Easley was a four-year starter at Arkansas from 2002-06.

#### No. 2 Oklahoma (18-1)

The Sooners finished as NCAA runner-ups to the Alabama Crimson Tide in 2012. All-American Keilani Ricketts leads Oklahoma on the mound and at the plate in 2013. The senior is 9-0 with an 0.80 earned run average and 105 strikeouts and 18 walks. At the plate, she is hitting .412 with four home runs and 13 RBI. Oklahoma's lone loss this year was to the Nebraska Cornhuskers, 1-0. Oklahoma is coached by Patty Gasso, who is in her 23rd year of coaching and 19th at the helm of the Sooners. Gasso holds a 1,050-339-3 overall record.

### ALL-TIME WINNINGEST

Drake's victory over Tennessee Martin earlier this year gave head coach Rich Calvert the most wins by a Drake softball head coach in program history. Calvert in his 11th season at the helm of the program holds a 287-270 overall record. Megan Bryant, who led the Drake program from 1989-1999, finished her tenure with 282 wins.

### IN THE CIRCLE

Drake sophomore pitcher **Rebekah Schmidt** (Cottage Grove, Minn.) is off to a great start in her second year on the mound already winning MVC Softball Pitcher of the Week twice. The Minnesota native is 5-3 overall with three saves and owns a team-low 1.18 earned run average in 65 innings pitched this year. Schmidt has struck out 70 hitters, while walking 18 and is limiting opponents to a .172 batting average. Her ERA, strikeouts, saves and opponent batting average are each tops in the Valley.

Junior **Jordan Gronewold** (Carlisle, Iowa) had an outstanding sophomore season in the circle and is off to a strong start in her junior campaign. Gronewold is 7-5 overall with a 2.22 earned run average in 19 starts and 20 appearances. In 69.1 innings tossed, she has allowed 22 earned runs, while striking out 45 and holding opponents to a .234 average. Gronewold's name is found in numerous MVC pitching statistical categories. She leads the Valley in starts and appearances, ranks tied for first in wins, third in innings pitched, fourth in opponent batting average, fifth in earned run average and sixth in strikeouts.

Gronewold and Schmidt have helped Drake sit atop the MVC in earned run average (1.72), opponent batting average (.204), saves (4), wins (12) and strikeouts (119). The two along with freshman **Mariah Mckinnon** (Oxford, Iowa) have thrown 138 total innings, which trails only Illinois State (142.1) for the top mark.

### AT THE PLATE

Junior **Amy Pierce** (Olathe, Kan.) leads the team in batting average at .364 (24-of-66) with an MVC-leading 20 runs scored and is 16-for-16 in stolen bases. Pierce ranks second in the conference in hits and stolen bases. Sophomore Hayley Nybo (Minnetonka, Minn.) is off to strong second campaign, hitting .279 with a team-high four home runs, five doubles, 15 RBI and a .559 slugging percentage. Junior Nicole Randel (Alpine, Calif.), one of the top pinch hitters in the Valley in 2012, is hitting .278 with one home run and trails Nybo with 10 RBI in 17 starts this year. Sophomore Laura Brewer (Waukee, Iowa) is hitting .295 with seven RBI.

### A LOOK BACK

#### FLORIDA HOME TOURNAMENT (MARCH 1-3)

The Bulldogs finished with victories over Florida A&M, Presbyterian College and Mount St. Mary's and dropped two close contests to No. 4 Florida last weekend. Drake blanked Florida A&M, 1-0, cruised by Presbyterian, 9-1, in five innings and rallied from a 3-0 deficit to beat Mount St. Mary's, 6-5, in nine innings. Drake trailed, 4-1, going into the top of the seventh inning against the Gators in the first game before Pierce blasted a two-run home run with one out but the rally attempt fell short as the next two batters were retired and Florida won 4-3. In the second game, the Bulldogs scored first on a double steal but the Gators answered with four runs and held the Bulldogs to just one hit in a 4-1 victory.

### RED & BLUE CLASSIC (FEB. 22-24)

Drake won three out of five contests last weekend at the Red & Blue Classic hosted by Ole Miss. The Bulldogs beat Middle Tennessee, Mississippi Valley State and Tennessee Martin and lost to McNeese State and Ole Miss. Drake rallied for a 3-2 win over Middle Tennessee. Trailing 2-0 going into the sixth the Bulldogs tied it with two runs and sophomore Zeah Peterson (Baxter, Iowa) drove home the winning run in the seventh. The Bulldogs offense struggled in their next two games scoring just two runs combined against McNeese State and Ole Miss but rebounded in the wins over Miss. Valley State and Tennessee Martin. The Bulldogs scored seven runs in each of the wins. Peterson cracked her first career home run against UT-Martin and junior college transfer Cortney Wood (Alburnett, Iowa) smashed her first against Miss. Valley State.

### HILLENBRAND INVITATIONAL (FEB. 15-17)

The Bulldogs won two of five games last weekend at the Hillenbrand Invitational. Drake beat Southern Utah and Utah State and lost to No. 16 Arizona, Nebraska and Purdue. The Bulldogs led 3-2 before the Wildcats rallied for three runs in the sixth inning for the 5-3 win. Drake nearly rallied from a 6-0 deficit against Purdue before falling, 8-5, while the Cornhuskers limited the Bulldog bats to just four hits in their 2-0 win. Nybo hit a blistering .389 (7-of-12) with two home runs and three doubles and eight runs batted at the tournament while junior Amy Pierce (Olathe, Kan.) finished with a .353 average with two doubles and six runs scored and was 4-for-4 in stolen bases.

### UNI DOME CLASSIC (FEB. 8-10)

Drake started the 2013 season with four wins in five games at the UNI-Dome Classic. The Bulldogs beat North Dakota State, Illinois, Green Bay and Northern Iowa with their only loss to No. 1 ranked and defending national champions Alabama, 8-2. The Bulldogs had strong pitching during the opening weekend with Gronewold winning three games and finishing with a 1.88 earned run average. Schmidt picked up two saves along with a victory in the tournament. Brewer hit a blistering .556 with a double and five runs batted in while Pierce hit .318 with a double, five runs scored and three stolen bases in Cedar Falls. Nybo finished the tournament with two doubles, two runs scored, two stolen bases and two runs batted in. Nybo drove in the go-ahead run with a sacrifice fly in the seventh inning in the victory over Illinois.

### LOOKING AHEAD

The Bulldogs start MVC action at Southern Illinois on Saturday, March 16 with two games scheduled. First pitch is set for noon. The teams will play a single game at noon on Sunday, March 17.

### BULLDOGS PICKED FIFTH

The Drake softball team was picked to finish fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference preseason's coaches poll. The Bulldogs garnered 62 points in a vote by the league's head softball coaches.

### BULLDOGS ADD FOUR TO 2013 CLASS

The Drake softball team added four student-athletes to its roster for the 2013-14 season this past November. The Bulldogs signed **Ashlie Chambers** (Ankeny, Iowa), **Kaitlyn Finneran** (Morrison, Ill.), **Maddie Hooyman** (Trenton, Mo.) and **Megan Sowa** (Gurnee, Ill.) to National Letters of Intent.

Chambers plays for Ankeny High School and helped lead the Hawkettes to the 2012 Iowa Class 5A state softball championship. She has primarily played shortstop for Ankeny but has the versatility to play multiple positions for the Bulldogs. Chambers was named to the 2012 Iowa Class 5A all-tournament team and is a two-time Iowa Girls Coaches Association second team all-state selection. Ankeny was the Iowa Class 4A softball runner-ups in 2011.

Finneran, a shortstop from Morrison High School (Ill.), is a three-time all-conference selection and helped the Fillies win the 2011 Illinois Class 2A state championship. Finneran earned second team all-state honors in 2011 and first team Sauk Valley and Quad Cities all-area awards in 2012.

Hooyman, a multi-sport standout at Trenton High School (Mo.) is a four-time all-district and all-regional selection in softball in addition to winning multiple Missouri Class 3 state relay championships in track and field. A four-year starter, Hooyman led Trenton to an 84-15 overall record and three district championships in her career.

Sowa, an outfielder for Warren Township High School (Ill.), was selected second team Class 4A all-state by the Illinois Coaches Association this past year. The Blue Devils finished 31-5-1 overall and were the North Suburban Conference champions. The 31 wins were the most in school history.
