REWIND

Drake closed the regular season with a 4-3 comeback victory over the Iowa State Cyclones at Ron Buel Field Tuesday night. Junior **Nicole Randel** (Alpine, Calif.) drove in the deciding two runs in the four run fifth inning to help the Bulldogs split the season series with Iowa State.

TALE OF THE TAPE

The Bulldogs have a 5-3 combined record against Evansville, Illinois State and Missouri State this season. Drake took two games from Evansville in a shortened series to start MVC play, dropped two of three to Missouri State and won two of three over Illinois State. Illinois State beat Drake, 3-0, last year in the semifinals of the MVC championship in Carbondale, Ill.

STEPPING UP

Randel was named MVC Player of the Week on Monday, April 15 after hitting .818 (9-of-11) with two walks, two doubles, two home runs, four runs scored, six RBI along with a .857 on-base percentage and 1.545 slugging percentage. In Drake's series against Illinois State she went 8-for-8 with a double, two home runs, three runs scored and four RBI against the Redbirds. Randel has blasted MVC pitching this season, hitting .467 (28-of-60), which leads the squad and ranks second in the conference along with five home runs and an MVC-leading 24 RBI. Overall, Randel is batting .366 with seven home runs, 10 doubles and a team-high 41 RBI, which is the third-highest single season mark in school history. Her 41 RBI are the fifth most in the conference. She has driven in 16 runs with two outs.

WEATHER OR NOT

Drake had a crazy schedule once the calendar hit March this year due to weather conditions. The Bulldogs moved their opening home series against Evansville to Evansville, Ind. and the next series at Missouri State to Ron Buel Field due to field conditions. A doubleheader at Creighton was scheduled for April 17, but was rained out so the teams played two in Des Moines on April 30. Drake's home game against Iowa State originally set for Tuesday, March 26 was rescheduled three times before the teams were finally able to play Tuesday night. Drake's doubleheader at Nebraska Omaha scheduled for last Wednesday night was cancelled due to bad weather, and the Bulldogs final conference series versus UNI scheduled for this past weekend at home was cancelled due to rain and an unplayable field. Neither series was made up. In total, Drake lost six conference games and another two games to bad weather in 2013. Drake played 21 MVC games this year, its fewest since the 2006 campaign when the Bulldogs only played 22 MVC contests.

WORKHORSE

Junior pitcher **Jordan Gronewold** (Carlisle, Iowa) had an outstanding sophomore campaign in the circle as she set the school record for starts (48) and appearances (50) and finished with 20 victories, which is the third highest single season total in school history. She is fifth all-time in career starts with 100, eighth in career strikeouts with 315, tied for eighth in career appearances with 107 and tied for 10th in career wins with 38. This season she is 17-9 overall with two saves and owns a 3.20 ERA in 153.1 innings pitched along with 88 strikeouts in an MVC-leading 47 appearances and 44 starts. Gronewold is third in the conference in wins. The right-hander was named the MVC Pitcher of the Week on May 6 for her outstanding performances in Drake's two wins against the Creighton Bluejays.

CYCLE

Gronewold is also producing at the plate this season as she hit for the cycle in the Bulldogs 13-5 win over Missouri State on Saturday, March 30. The junior completed it in order hitting a single in the second inning, a leadoff double in the fourth inning, a leadoff triple in the fifth frame and capped it off with her first career grand slam in the sixth inning. Gronewold is blistering her fellow MVC pitchers this year batting .429 (21-of-49) with four home runs, six doubles, 18 RBI, a .509 on-base percentage and an MVC-leading .837 slugging percentage. Overall she is hitting .309 (29-of-94) with one triple, four home runs, eight doubles, 19 runs scored and 22 RBI.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Lindsay Larry, who played from 2004-07, is Drake's all-time stolen bases leader with 70, but senior **Macie Silliman** (Winterset, Iowa) is right behind her with 68 career stolen bases. Junior **Amy Pierce** (Olathe, Kan.) is third with 67 career stolen bases, while senior **Lindsey Vande Wall** (Prairie City, Iowa) is next with 64 stolen bases. Senior **Sam West** (Kearney, Mo.) is tied for 10th with 37. This season, Silliman is 18-of-20 on attempts, while Pierce is 26-of-28, Vande Wall 13-of-15 and West 8-of-9. Pierce is one stolen base away from setting a new single-season mark.

POWER SURGE

The Bulldogs have slugged 40 home runs this year led by sophomore **Hayley Nybo** (Minnetonka, Minn.), who has blasted a career-high 10. Drake is second in the MVC in home runs behind Creighton (48) as nine different Bulldogs have hit at least one home run this year. Pierce and Randel have reached career-highs with nine and seven home runs, respectively.

BALANCE

Drake is the only MVC squad to rank in the top-3 in both team batting average and team earned run average. Drake is tied for first in batting average at .287 and second in ERA at 2.97. Three Bulldogs rank in the top-10 in batting average as Pierce is third at .368, Randel fourth at .366 and Silliman 10th at .342. Sophomore pitcher **Rebekah Schmidt** (Cottage Grove, Minn.) is third in ERA at 2.36, while Gronewold is seventh at 3.20.

SECOND YEAR

Schmidt is having a great second year in the circle winning MVC Softball Pitcher of the Week twice. The Cottage Grove, Minn. native is 12-10 overall with an MVC-leading eight saves and owns a team-low 2.36 earned run average in 153.1 innings pitched. Schmidt has struck out 139 hitters, while walking 62 and limiting opponents to a .219 batting average in 43 appearances. The right-hander ranks third in the Valley in appearances, opponent batting average, strikeouts and earned run average, tied for seventh in wins and eighth in innings pitched.

PIERCING

Pierce leads the team in batting average (.368), runs (49), hits (60), doubles (12), stolen bases (26), on-base percentage (.435) and slugging percentage (.620). Among the conference statistical categories, the junior is first in runs scored, second in hits, third in doubles, stolen bases and batting average, fifth in slugging percentage and seventh in home runs. Pierce, who has started all 48 games at shortstop, set the Drake single-season record for runs scored this season.

A-NYBO-LATING THE BALL

After an impressive debut campaign, Nybo has posted great numbers at the plate in her sophomore year. She has started all 48 games at third base for the Bulldogs and is batting .313 with nine doubles, a team-high 10 home runs and 39 RBI. She is already tied for sixth all-time in career home runs with 19 and last season set the freshman season RBI mark with 49. With her 39 RBI this season, she ranks seventh all-time in career RBI with 81.

HEATING UP

Silliman, one of three seniors on the team, has started all 48 games in center field for the Bulldogs. As Drake's number two hitter in the order, she is setting the table for the rest of the lineup. The Winterset, Iowa native is batting .342 with 18 stolen bases, 30 runs scored and 54 hits. All three totals rank second on the team. In conference action, she batted .408, which ranked fifth in the Valley.

SOMETHING'S BREWERING

After seeing limited playing time in her first season, sophomore **Laura Brewer** (Waukee, Iowa) has become a player to watch in her second campaign. She is batting .336 (37-of-110) with one home run five runs scored, eight doubles, and 15 RBI in 44 games. Brewer has drawn 17 walks and sports a .422 on-base percentage.

RAKING

Brewer, Gronewold, Pierce, Randel, Nybo, and Silliman are all hitting above .300 this season. The Bulldogs' bats were on fire in conference play as Randel (.467), Gronewold (.429), Silliman (.408), Pierce (.373), Nybo (.371), junior Cortney Wood (Alburnett, Iowa) (.361) and Brewer (.333) raked Valley pitching.

IRON WOMEN

Nybo, Pierce, Silliman and Vande Wall have started all 48 games this year for the Bulldogs. Nybo and Pierce started every game in 2012. Gronewold has started 44 games in the circle for the Blue and the White.

ODDS AND ENDS

Drake is 9-7 this season in one-run games and has four one-run conference defeats... Drake has struck out a conference-low 212 times at the plate this season ... The Bulldogs have a conference-leading 10 saves in 2013 ... Schmidt leads the Valley with eight saves and going into this week led the nation ... Drake tied with Creighton for the most regular season wins in the MVC with 29.

ALL-TIME WINNINGEST

Drake's two wins over Bradley gave head coach **Rich Calvert**, in his 11th season leading the program, 300 career wins. Calvert holds a 304-281 overall record and the Bulldogs victory over Tennessee Martin earlier this year gave him the most wins by a Drake softball head coach in program history. He passed Megan Bryant, who led the Drake program from 1989-1999, and won 282 games.
