## NCAA RULE CHANGES

The NCAA has instituted several rule changes for women's basketball starting in 2015-16. Several of the key changes are as follows:

- Games will consist of four 10-minute quarters instead of two 20-minute halves.
- Teams will be in the bonus and will shoot two free throws starting when the opposition commits its fifth foul of the quarter. There will be no 1-and-1 free throws.
- Coaches will have three 30-second timeouts and one full timeout per game, and can only carry three total timeouts over to the second half. In the past, they had four 30-second timeouts.
- Media timeouts will come at the first deadball at or after the 5:00 mark of each quarter, or at the first team-called timeout of the quarter regardless of the game clock. The first team-called timeout of the second half will also extend to a media timeout and will not count as the official media timeout of that quarter.
- Teams will have 10 seconds to advance the ball over halfcourt. That countdown will only reset if the offensive team calls a timeout or if the defensive team commits a foul. In the past, it also reset due to the defensive team knocking the ball out of bounds or a retained jump ball.

## ABOUT SYRACUSE

The 7-3 Syracuse Orange has been ranked as high as No. 19 in the country and are currently receiving votes in both the Associated Press poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Like the Dragons, Syracuse has not played since Dec. 21, when they hosted Jacksonville and won, 65-49. The Orange is currently 4-1 at the Carrier Dome, with the lone loss coming to then-No.

24 Arizona State on Dec. 12. All three of their losses have come to ranked teams (No. 4 Tennessee, No. 5 Maryland and No. 24 Arizona State).

Alexis Peterson's 14.5 points per game lead the Orange, with Brianna Butler close behind at 14.0. Bria Day adds 8.9 a game and a team-high 7.3 rebounds per contest. As a team, Syracuse is averaging 67.9 points per game while allowing 58.5. They hit 8.6 three-pointers per game, at a .299 clip.

Quentin Hillsman is 196-111 in 10 years at Syracuse, and has brought them to three straight NCAA Tournaments.

## SERIES HISTORY

### Last Meeting

After winning their first-ever postseason game four days earlier at Fairfield, the Dragons were defeated by Syracuse at the DAC in the second round of the 2012 WNIT, 65-43. Kamile Nacickaite and Tyler Hale each scored 11. Jackie Schluth played three minutes, the only current Dragon to appear in that game.

# HEAD COACH · DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 · 13th Season · Career Record: 218-168

Denise Dillon is the winningest coach in the Division I history of Drexel women's basketball, and has led the Dragons to six postseason appearances in seven seasons. She brought the Dragons their first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, earning her second conference Coach of the Year honor that year. She followed that with four straight WNIT appearances, and in 2013, led the Dragons to the title with a 46-43 win over Utah on the Dragons' home court.

Last season, the Dragons marked their fifth-ever 20-win season, capturing second place in the CAA and earning the league's automatic bid to the WNIT. The Dragons went 14-4 in the CAA, their best-ever league mark outside of their title run in 2009. Drexel swept the regular season series from Delaware, Northeastern, Elon, UNCW, the College of Charleston and Towson, as well as claiming victories

over local foes Penn and Saint Joseph's.

Since coming to University City and taking over as head coach in 2003, Denise has inspired greatness in her players and forged a new standard for success for the program. She became the first coach in Drexel women's basketball history to lead the team with six-consecutive winning seasons when the Dragons won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title in 2012-13. The Dragons finished third in the CAA, reaching their third-ever and second-straight CAA title game before earning a bid to the WNIT. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

The first break-through season for Denise and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

During her tenure Denise has helped guide the careers of 14 All-Conference selections, three Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft.

Denise came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. She helped the Dragons bring in Catherine Scanlon, a local product from Drexel Hill, who was one of the first Dragons to go on to a pro career following graduation.

In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped her to become interim head coach of the program and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball.

The Dragons under Denise adopted a team-centered approach on the court, while playing in an offense that often illustrated that the team as a whole is greater than the sum of its parts. The genesis of this approach can be traced back to her playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Denise went on to a Hall of Fame playing career for Villanova. From 1993-96 she scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection, and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013.

Off the court, Denise's commitment to helping student-athletes grow as players and as people has been one of the program's greatest success stories. Andrea Peterson ('09), Gabriela Marginean ('10) and Hollie Mershon ('13) earned the CAA's prestigious Dean Ehlers Leadership Award. Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009.

## LAST TIME OUT

The Dragons never trailed as they defeated Quinnipiac at home to improve to 3-1 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center this season, 62-49. Sarah Curran had her first-ever double-double with 22 points and 12 rebounds. Meghan Creighton added seven points, eight rebounds and seven assists.

## BOMBS AWAY

The Dragons have now hit at least nine three-pointers in four games this season (Dartmouth, at South Florida, Vanderbilt, Hampton). Drexel did not have a single game of 10 or more three-pointers last season, but did so in the first three of those games this year. Rachel Pearson leads the team with 23 three-pointers on the season and 208 in her career.

## 20/20 VISION

Drexel is coming off its fifth 20-win season in program history, and the third under the guidance of Denise Dillon. The Dragons have won 20 or more games in two of the last three seasons, but have never put together back-to-back 20-win seasons, a feat they hope to accomplish for the first time in 2015-16.

## DRAGON DEFENSE

The Dragons have been known for their defensive prowess in recent seasons. After setting a program record by allowing just 54.3 points per game in 2011-12, Drexel went even further in 2012-13, ceding just 51.4 on its way to a WNIT championship. The last two years, they have led the CAA allowing 55.8 and 55.1 points per game in 2013-14 and 2014-15, respectively.

## PRESEASON PICKS

Drexel was chosen second in the CAA Preseason Coaches Poll, behind only two-time defending champion James Madison. Sarah Curran, a First Team All-CAA choice last year, was selected to repeat that honor this season. Rachel Pearson also is tabbed to duplicate her 2014-15 Second Team All-CAA choice.

## CURRAN-CY

Sarah Curran was named a First Team All-CAA performer last season, her second-career All-CAA recognition after being named an All-Rookie Choice in 2013-14. Curran became the first Drexel sophomore to earn First Team All-CAA since Gabriela Marginean in 2007-08. This year, she has reached double figures in eight of 10 games including four (Dartmouth, St. Bonaventure, Vanderbilt and Quinnipiac) over 20. She put together her first-ever double-double with 22 points and 12 rebounds in the win over Quinnipiac, earning her CAA Player of the Week on Dec. 28.

## CARROLL CONNECTION

Senior Rachel Pearson and redshirt-junior Meghan Creighton are preparing for their final season together on the court. They have played together since middle school, and have been joined by junior Sarah Curran both at Archbishop Carroll and here at Drexel. Together, the three won the PIAA Class AAAA state championship in 2012. The trio of Archbishop Carroll graduates are the only group of three high school teammates playing together in the CAA. 2009 CAA champions Andrea Peterson and Brooke Cornish and 2013 WNIT MVP Hollie Mershon also played for the Dragons after graduating from Carroll, and current Drexel athletic trainer Kerri Gavin is also a Carroll grad.

## PEERLESS PEARSON

The active scoring leader for Drexel women's basketball is senior guard Rachel Pearson, who now has 917 career points. She is a two-time All-CAA selection already, and was named a Preseason Second Team choice by the coaches this year. Pearson currently ranks fourth all-time at Drexel in three-pointers made (208). Pearson also ranks third in three-point percentage (.377). Last year, Pearson led the CAA and finished in the top-50 nationally with a .385 three-point percentage. Her 2.48 three-pointers per game also left her 54th in the nation. This season, Pearson drained four three-pointers in each of the Dragons' first two games, the first time in her career she reached that mark in consecutive games.

## RETURN OF THE DRAGON

Redshirt-junior point guard Meghan Creighton missed significant time last season due to a right knee injury that required surgery, performed on January 16. Creighton had started the first 76 games of her career, including the first seven of 2014-15, before being forced to the sidelines. Since returning, Creighton has picked up right where she left off. She has started every game this year for the Dragons and led the team in assists in each game. She has 60 assists (6.0 per game) and a 3.2 assist-to-turnover ratio, ranking first in the CAA in assist-to-turnover ratio. Her 6.0 assists per game ranks 34th nationally, and her 3.2 assist-to-turnover ratio leaves her 12th in the country.

## A SIXTH OF SCHLUTH

Graduate student Jackie Schluth earned an NCAA medical hardship exemption for a sixth season of college basketball, and has stepped back into the starting lineup for Denise Dillon's team. After fighting back from a pair of season-ending knee injuries, Schluth made a career-best 29 appearances in 2013-14, chipping in 3.1 points per game off the bench. Last year, Schluth showed what she could do with a clean bill of health. She started all 31 games for the Dragons, averaging 8.0 a game and adding 4.6 rebounds per contest. Schluth matched a career high with 12 rebounds in the Dragons' season-opening win over Dartmouth, adding eight points and three blocks. She then set a season high with 13 points on 6-of-8 shooting at Penn.

## LEADING LADIES

In Drexel's four victories this season, the Dragons have trailed for a total of 5:54, all in the first half of their win over St. Bonaventure. They have wire-to-wire victories against Dartmouth, Hampton and Quinnipiac. The Dragons have led the entire second half in all four games. In their six losses, Drexel has led for a total of 33:27. They never led against South Florida or Montana. They led for 12:36 at Saint Joseph's, their highest total in a loss.

## MILESTONE WATCH

- Senior guard Rachel Pearson needs 83 points to reach the 1,000 career point plateau. She is currently the Dragons' active leader in points scored. She would be the 22nd Dragon with 1,000 career points.
- With her next assist, redshirt-junior guard Meghan Creighton will break a tie with Gina Miniscalco (313 from 1985-88) for eighth place all-time on Drexel's leaderboard. She needs 23 to match Debbie Lynn (336 from 1990-93) for seventh.
- Redshirt junior Jessica Pellechio needs two more steals to reach 100 in her career, including 96 in two years spent at VCU. She would be the first active Dragon with 100 career steals.
- Junior Alexis Smith needs four more assists to become the fourth active Dragon with 100 or more career assists. Jessica Pellechio needs nine, having compiled 77 of those assists during her time at VCU.

## NEW KIDS IN TOWN

Head coach Denise Dillon and her staff have brought three newcomers to the roster for 2015-16. After the departures of Jamila Thompson and Florence Ouattara, the additions of Eline Maesschalck of Belgium and Tereza Kracikova of the Czech Republic ensure that the Drexel roster will feature at least one foreign-born player, as it has every season since 2000-01. Both players have experience in their home country's national program. The Dragons also stayed close to home when they added Aubree Brown, a Philadelphia native who attended Archbishop Wood. Brown, a combo guard, will redshirt this season.

## REVENGE TOUR

The Drexel non-conference schedule has included three games against teams the Dragons lost to in 2014-15. All three times, Drexel has won the rematch. They defeated St. Bonaventure 58-46 after the Bonnies held the Dragons to a program-low 32 points in a 43-32 defeat last season. The Dragons then went to Hampton, the team that knocked them out of last season's WNIT, and throttled the Lady Pirates, 57-36. Most recently, Drexel led wire-to-wire on Dec. 21 in a 62-49 victory over a Quinnipiac team that had defeated them 74-50 last year. Drexel also had CAA losses in 2014-15 to James Madison (twice), Hofstra, William & Mary and Delaware. Additionally, the Dragons play a Syracuse team today that they lost to in the only previous meeting of the two programs, 65-43 in the 2012 WNIT.

## ACCEPTING CHARITY

The Drexel women's basketball team entered the 2014-15 postseason as the national leader in free throw percentage, and finished the year second behind the University of Washington at .778 from the line. This year, Drexel is once again one of the national leaders in that category. The Dragons are hitting at a .768 clip (96-for-125) from the free throw line through 10 games, first in the CAA and good for 11th in the nation.

## EURODRAGONS

The Dragons spent 10 days this summer bonding as a team and visiting Europe, touring and playing four games in the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Drexel started its trip in Amsterdam, touring the city and nearby Zaanse Schans. From there, the Dragons traveled to Ghent, Belgium. They also made a day trip to Bruges while in Belgium. The Dragons spent one night in Normandy and visited the D-Day landing beaches and cemetery, then concluded the journey with several days in Paris.

Along the way, the Dragons played four games, going 4-0 against professional teams in Europe. Redshirt-junior transfer Jessica Pellechio was the leading scorer in all four games, averaging 18.0 points per game.
