Towson comes to Philadelphia with a 14- 7 overall record. The Tigers are tied with William & Mary at 5- 3 in the standings, just one game behind three teams who stand at 6- 2. Towson has won three of its last four games, including two in a row away from home. In fact, the Tigers have a 3- 1 road conference record,

Towson leads the CAA in field- goal percentage defense at .392. The Tigers held Drexel to just 27 percent in their first meeting in Towson less than two weeks ago. Towson is also the best rebounding team in the CAA. The Tigers outrebound their opponents by more than seven boards a game.

William Adala Moto, in his first year with the Tigers, averages 14.2 points and 8.1 rebounds. He had a double- double in the teams first meeting despite being held scoreless in the first half. Byron Hawkins has 39 three- pointers and averages 13.3 points per game. Mike Morsell leads the Tigers with 46 assists and chips in with 11.7 points per contest. John Davis, a Philadelphia product, scores just under 10 per game and is shooting 46 percent from the field.

DID YOU KNOW?

Rodney Williams blocked a career- high seven shots in Drexel's game vs. UNCW on Sunday. Williams now has 96 career blocked shots and needs just four more to become the eighth Dragon to reach 100 in his career.

2015-16 Men's Basketball Rule Changes

- *Shot clock reduced from :35 to :30
- *The restricted area arc expanded from three to four feet
- *The five- second closely guarded count on a dribble is removed
- *Reduction of :30 timeouts from four to three
- *Only two of those :30 timeouts carry over to the second half
- *Coaches can only call timeout during a deadball situation
- *The 10- second backcourt count resets except when:
 - a defender causes the ball to go out of bounds
 - the offense retains possession on a held ball
 - a technical foul is called on the offensive team

HEAD COACH • BRUISER FLINT

Saint Joseph's '87 • 15th Season at Drexel • Career Record: 328- 280

James "Bruiser" Flint is in his 15th season as the head coach at Drexel. The longest tenured coach in the CAA, he established Drexel as one of the top programs in the league since arriving in 2001. Flint was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 2012 for the fourth time, one of just two coaches in league history to win the award on four occasions. He was also named the District 10 Regional Coach of the Year by the NABC, giving him four District Coach of the Year awards. Flint has led the Dragons to 20 or more wins three times and has had at least 10 CAA wins in nine of his 14 seasons at the school. The Dragons have finished .500 or better in 12 of his 14 seasons, including each of the last seven seasons, the longest current streak of any team in the league.

Flint begins play today with a 328-280 career record. He has a 242-208 record at the school and is 149-109 in CAA play. Flint picked up his 300th career win in November of 2013 when the Dragons defeated Elon, 71-64, in the NIT Season Tip-Off. It was also his 214th win at Drexel, which moved him past Sam Cozen into the top spot for career coaching wins at the school. Since his arrival, the Dragons have had the CAA Defensive Player of the Year on four occasions, 23 All-CAA selections, 12 members of the conference's All-Defensive team, six players named to the league's All-Rookie team and two CAA Rookies of the Year.

The Dragons were decimated by injuries last year yet again but managed to go 9-9 in CAA play. In 2013-14, the Dragons finished with a 16-14 mark and an 8-8 record in CAA play. Drexel started off hot and advanced to the NIT Season Tip-Off Semifinals at Madison Square Garden. In New York, the Dragons narrowly missed upsetting No. 4 Arizona, 66-62. In the consolation, the Dragons defeated Alabama in triple OT, 85-83, Drexel's first ever win over an SEC team. Flint's Dragons had a record-breaking season in 2011-12. His squad set a school record with 29 wins and won the CAA regular-season title, going 16-2. The Dragons won a program-best 19 straight games and advanced to the CAA title game for the second time ever. Drexel came up just three points short against VCU in front of a sellout crowd in Richmond. Drexel was snubbed by the NCAA committee and settled for an appearance in the NIT. It was the fifth time under Flint that Drexel earned an NIT berth. The team won two postseason games and advanced all the way to the NIT quarterfinals.

During Flint's tenure, Drexel has been an unfriendly foe for some of the nation's top teams. In 2010-11, Drexel stunned No. 20 Louisville, handing the Cardinals their first-ever loss in their new building. The Dragons also defeated NCAA teams Old Dominion and VCU. In 2006-07, on its way to a 23-9 overall record, Drexel won 13 road games (tied for most in Division I). The Dragons won at Syracuse, Villanova and Creighton. Flint became the first coach in Drexel history ever to beat three Philadelphia Big 5 teams in one season.

Flint returned home to his native Philadelphia when he took over as Drexel's head coach on April 5, 2001. In his first year, Flint led a team that was picked to finish ninth in the CAA to an 11-7 mark, tying them for third in the league. For his efforts, Flint was named the CAA Coach of the Year. He has had three stints with USA Basketball since coming to Drexel. Flint was an assistant in 2007 for the USA Under 19 National Team in Serbia. In 2005, Flint was an assistant coach for the USA U-21 World Championship Team that went 7-1 in Argentina. His first stint came as a court coach prior to the Global Games.

Flint arrived at Drexel after 12 years at UMass. He was an assistant coach for seven seasons before becoming the school's 17th head basketball coach. He was 86-72 at UMass (52-28 in Atlantic 10 play), led three of his teams to postseason play and was the NABC District I Co-Coach of the Year in 1998. Flint was the winningest first-year coach ever at UMass. Previously, he spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Coppin State.

A 1987 Saint Joseph's graduate, Flint, 50, was a four-year letterwinner with the Hawks. He earned All-Atlantic 10 honors as a senior and led the Hawks to the 1986 A-10 championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament as a junior. He was inducted into the Saint Joseph's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998.

DREXEL UNDER BRUISER FLINT

Bruiser Flint has been a fixture at Drexel since 2001. Only Sam Cozen (16 years) has walked the Drexel sideline as long as Flint. The Philadelphia native has won the CAA Coach of the Year four times and is the winningest coach in school history with 242 victories. Flint's teams have finished at .500 or above in CAA play in each of the last seven seasons, the longest streak of any team in the league, and in 12 of his 14 seasons in University City.

CAA SUCCESS

Drexel is in its 15th season in the CAA after moving from the America East Conference. In its 14 seasons in the CAA, Drexel has a 149- 109 record in league play. The Dragons have advanced to two title games in that time and have recorded 10 or more league wins in nine of the 14 seasons in the CAA. They have finished .500 or above in seven straight seasons.

RETURNING PLAYERS

Bruiser Flint has seven letterwinners returning from last year. That number does not include Kazembe Abif, who missed the entire season last year with an injury. Despite losing their top scorer, the Dragons still return more than 58 percent of their scoring from a year ago. In addition, Drexel returns 76 percent of its rebounding numbers from a year ago. The one area where Drexel will have to get increased contributions from is behind the three- point stripe. Damion Lee and Freddie Wilson combined for 95 three- pointers a year ago and both have graduated.

DREXEL VS. THE TIGERS

Drexel and Towson are meeting for the 67th time. They first met in 1969 and have been playing on a fairly regular basis since the teams were both ECC members in the early 1980s. Last season, Drexel won both meetings, snapping a four- game losing streak to the Tigers. Before the Tigers won those four games, they had lost seven straight to the Dragons. Overall, Drexel leads the series, 48- 18, and has won 23 of the 30 meetings in Maryland.

THE CITY SIX

While Drexel isn't off to the start it would like, Bruiser Flint's team has played well against teams from Philadelphia. The Dragons are 2- 1 against their Philadelphia Big 5 rivals. Drexel opened the year with a one- point loss at Saint Joseph's. The Dragons then defeated La Salle on the road, 66- 53, behind Tavon Allen's 25 points. It was the team's first win against La Salle since 1997. In their final game against a Philly school, Drexel needed overtime to defeat Penn, 53- 52. It was the team's sixth straight victory against Penn. The Quakers made the shortest road trip of any team in Division I, walking three blocks to the DAC.

RETURNING FROM INJURY

The Dragons appear to be much deeper than they were the last few years. Kazembe Abif is back for his final year. The New Jersey native recently earned his degree from Drexel and is back for his fifth season. Abif suffered a knee injury prior to the 2014-15 season and missed the entire year. Major Canady, who played in all 30 games as a freshman, was supposed to be back this year, but suffered a knee injury and will miss his second straight season.

With the addition of Abif, Drexel now has seven players who have been in the starting line-up and eight players who have played in at least 20 games entering the 2015-16 season.

SENIOR TAVON ALLEN

Senior Tavon Allen is back for his final year. The New Haven, Conn., native is Drexel's top scorer with 12.7 points per game. Allen has shown flashes of being an all-league player at times. He has scored 15 or more points 32 times in his career and has 10 games with at least 20 points. Against La Salle, Allen had perhaps the best game of his career. He tied a career-high with 25 points and did an outstanding job defensively on Jordan Price of La Salle, who entered the game second in the nation in scoring. Allen had 21 points vs. High Point and scored 20 in the opener against Saint Joseph's. Allen is 39-for-107 (.364) from behind the arc. He is shooting 83 percent from the line and begins play today with 1,084 career points.

KAZ IS BACK...

One of the key additions to this year's roster is Kazembe Abif. Abif missed all of last year with a knee injury, but decided to play one more season and enrolled in graduate school. Abif is a tenacious rebounder who brings energy and an improved jump shot to the team. He had his fifth career double-double at Hofstra, when he tied a career-high with 16 points and had 10 rebound. Abif also had double-doubles against Penn (13 pts., 14 reb.) and against Monmouth with 12 points and 13 caroms. Abif, who was 5-for-8 with 15 points at James Madison, is averaging 8.3 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds. He is shooting .464 from the floor and has scored in double figures in three of his last four games.

...BUT MAJOR IS NOT

Drexel thought it would have Major Canady back in the backcourt. However, Canady suffered a knee injury that required surgery. The guard will be forced to miss his second straight season. Last year, Canady suffered an ankle injury which sidelined him for the season. He played in all 30 games as a freshman.

RODNEY WILLIAMS

Rodney Williams, a junior from Richmond, has the potential to be one of the top big men in the CAA. Williams blocked 34 shots in 22 games a year ago and

begins play today ninth on Drexel's career blocked shots list with 96. Williams had 17 points on Jan. 24 vs. UNCW and had a career-high seven blocked shots. In Drexel's win vs. Charleston, Williams was 7-for-11 and tied a career-high with 19 points. He had one of his best games against La Salle with 14 points and 13 rebounds. He was also 6-for-6 from the line in that game. Williams set his career-high 19 points at Elon and followed that with a 5-for-7 shooting night and 13 points against William & Mary. He has two double-doubles this year (including 15 points and 15 rebounds at UNCW) and is averaging 9.5 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. In league games he is averaging 12.8 points, 5.6 rebounds, 2.1 blocks and is shooting 51 percent. He was saddled by foul trouble at Hofstra and played only eight minutes.

SLINGIN' SAMMY

Sophomore Sammy Mojica had a solid freshman season in University City. The guard from outside of Boston has emerged as a key player for the Dragons. He scored in double figures in each of Drexel's games in the Great Alaska Shootout and had a career night at Alaska Anchorage. Mojica scored 20 points, handed out six assists and grabbed six boards. He also had 20 points at Iona and was 8-for-12 shooting. Mojica is shooting 71 percent from the line and is tied for third on the club with 9.5 points per game.

ROMAN'S RASHANN

Sophomore Rashann London, from nearby Roman Catholic High School, was pressed into duty right away last year and started every game. He responded with 7.0 points per game and was third on the team with 47 assists. This season, London is averaging 8.4 points and 2.3 assists while playing both guard spots. He is shooting 38 percent from the floor and scored a career-high 20 points in the loss to Monmouth. He has scored in double figures in nine games this season and had 12 points vs. UNCW on Jan. 24.

ROOKIE RUNNING THE SHOW

Terrell Allen, the rookie from Maryland, has started every game with London moving over to the two guard spot. Allen, who played at DeMatha, one of the top high school teams in the nation, has made an immediate impact. He scored 18 points, had four assists and four steals against Saint Joseph's and was the CAA Rookie of the Week. He scored 19 points and had six assists in the game against UNC Asheville and scored 18 vs. Penn State. He is second on the club with 10.4 points and leads the team and is second in the CAA with 41 steals. Allen also leads the team in assists with 58. He is shooting 37 percent from the floor and 81 percent from the line. In Drexel's loss at Hofstra, Allen had nine points, eight rebounds, five assists and five steals.
